Merging State OTBs a Hot

SADLER PAIR WORKING SWEETLY

The Craig Family Trust's pair of **"TDN Rising Stars"** **Sidney's Candy** (Candy Ridge {Arg}) and **Twirling Candy** (Candy Ride {Arg}) worked over Santa Anita's recently installed dirt surface Thursday in preparation for starts on the Arcadia oval's Dec. 26 opening day card in the grassy one-mile GIII Sir Beaufort S. and seven-furlong GI Malibu S., respectively. The former worked six

furlongs on his own in 1:11 flat, good for the fourth fastest of 12 spins at the distance. The GI Santa Anita Derby winner, who showed an affinity for the lawn when breaking Del Mar's 1 1/16-mile course record with a 5 1/2-length tour-de-force in the GI La Jolla H. Aug. 14, is coming off a sixth-place effort in the GI Breeders' Cup Mile behind superstar Goldikova (Ire) (Anaaba). Of that effort, conditioner John Sadler, who holds the last two Santa Anita winter meeting training titles, told *Daily Racing Form*, "I think he got beat by one of the best horses, Goldikova. I don't think the course helped him any. It was sticky." Twirling Candy, whose four-race career unbeaten streak was snapped when he weakened late to finish fourth in the GI Goodwood S. at Oak Tree at Hollywood Oct. 2, also worked six panels in company with barnmate Hammurabi (Horse Chestnut {SAf}). The homebred covered the ground in

1:10.80, which was the third fastest six-furlong drill of the day. As he watched the dark bay finish up, Sadler told the trade daily, "Oh that is nice. That's perfect because he got dirt in his face." Sadler has three other runners who will compete in stakes races on opening day. **Switch** (Quiet American), runner-up to Zenyatta (Street Cry {Ire}) in the GI Lady's Secret and second again most recently in the GI Breeders' Cup Filly and Mare Sprint, will face fellow sophomore fillies in the seven-furlong GI La Brea S.; **Don Tito** (Trippi) will join Twirling Candy in the Malibu; and **Contemplated** (Bertrando) takes on statebred juveniles after a fourth-place finish in the GIII Hollywood Preview S. Nov. 20.

ALCINDOR TAKES TO SANTA ANITA DIRT

Thoroughbred Legends Racing Stable's Alcindor (Unbridled's Song), who was pegged a **"TDN Rising Star"** after decimating a Hollywood allowance field by 7 1/2-lengths Nov. 28 in his second career start, got in his first work over Santa Anita's conventional dirt surface Thursday as he crams for his class test in what is expected to be a very contentious running of the GI Malibu S. The \$1,150,000 KEESEP yearling covered six furlongs in 1:12.20. "He worked really well and it seemed like he handled [the track] well," Hall of Fame conditioner Bob Baffert told *HRTV*. "He reminds me a lot of his sire, Unbridled's Song. He has a tremendous stride and he covers a lot of ground. [His stride] is deceiving. You don't think he is going that fast, but he is just cruising around." In addition to the aforementioned Twirling Candy, Don Tito and Alcindor, expected entrants for the seven-furlong three-year-old dash include **Caracortado** (Cat Dreams), **Indian Firewater** (Indian Charlie), **Noble's Promise** (Cuvee), **Setsuko** (Pleasantly Perfect) (who also worked six furlongs at Santa Anita in 1:14.20 Thursday), **Smiling Tiger** (Hold That Tiger), **Thiskyhasnolimit** (Sky Mesa) and **Thomas Baines** (Johannesburg).

One of trainer Rusty Arnold's biggest career wins came at Saratoga when the talented Seeking the Gold filly Victory Ride handed subsequent champion three-

year-old Xtra Heat (Dixieland Heat) an emphatic 3 1/4-length defeat in the 2001 GI Test S. Owned by longtime client G. Watts Humphrey Jr., the now 12-year-old mare has gotten off to a quick start in the breeding shed as well. Her first foal Magical Ride (Storm Cat), also conditioned by Arnold, was a razor sharp victress in her July 2006 Belmont debut, then added a third-place finish in the GI Adirondack Breeders' Cup S. at the Spa.

Victory Ride's two-year-old colt Shadow Warrior (A.P. Indy) stamped himself as one to watch with a good-looking three-length tally in his second career attempt beneath the Twin Spires Nov. 19 ([video](#)). With Robby Albarado aboard, he raced with the early leaders between horses through an opening quarter in :22 4/5. Three-wide entering the turn for home, Shadow Warrior put his blinkered head in front, shook clear at the head of affairs, and kept finding in the stretch. The dark bay stopped the timer for a mile in 1:37 2/5, good for a respectable 75 Beyer.

Does Shadow Warrior have Arnold dreaming of the first Saturday in May yet?

"He's a long ways from a Derby horse, but we all are looking in that direction," the Paris, Kentucky native dead-panned. "I'd be kidding you if we weren't hoping that he's a Derby horse. That's what we're all looking for. He's out of a mare who's the best horse that I've ever had my hands on. She didn't end up looking like that because all of her starts after [the Test] came after a condylar fracture and she wasn't the same horse. Had she not gotten hurt, she was by far the best horse that I've ever had."

Shadow Warrior was an encouraging fourth going seven furlongs over Keeneland's Polytrack in his Oct. 21 debut ([video](#)). Outsprinted early in a 12-horse field, the Kentucky-bred was forced to steady sharply on the turn for home as a tiring rival backed out of it, but regrouped nicely in the stretch, rallying late along the rail to come within a length of the winner.

"We were really happy with him," Arnold said of his charge's maiden tally. "We were happy with his first race too. He didn't leave the right way [from the gate]. He got on the inside on the Poly and made a pretty good late run. He probably would've gotten there, but got in a little trouble and had to alter course. That race *really* woke him up. After that, he trained very well. We took him to Churchill and he broke good that time, ran well and galloped out good. We were very happy with it and Robby [Albarado] was very happy with his race as well."

The G. Watts Humphrey Jr. homebred recently returned to the worktab with an easy four-furlong move in :49 1/5 at Palm Meadows Dec. 11. According to Arnold, Shadow Warrior will make his sophomore debut in a first-level allowance early in the Gulfstream Park meeting.

“He’s done very well since he’s been here,” Arnold offered. “He’ll breeze again Saturday. He had one easy work so far. I gave him a little time when he got here. We knew we were going to have a little time off from Churchill to the next start and he’s done excellent since. He actually doesn’t need to grow and mature, because he’s a pretty good-sized horse as he is.”

Did Victory Ride pass anything down to the soon to be turned three-year-old?

“He looks a lot like her, but doesn’t act like her,” the conditioner explained. “She was a little more excitable and he’s a little bit more laid back. He’s got a very good mind on him and doesn’t get shook up. She was a little bit more of a handful. She was obviously faster than him; she was *brilliantly* fast. Hopefully, the A.P. Indy is going to stretch him out and carry her speed. That’s what the mating was for and, hopefully, it will work.”

Off to a pretty good start so far. -SS

NEW YORK OTBS TO MERGE? Assemblyman J. Gary Pretlow, the chairman of the Assembly's Racing and Wagering Committee, called a hearing in Albany Wednesday to discuss the possibility of consolidating New York's five regional off-track betting operations. Convened after New York City OTB closed its doors last week, the hearing was attended by representatives of the state's horsemen, racetrack operators and OTB operators. While OTB operators opposed the idea of a merger, the horsemen and racetrack operators were in favor of the move, and floated the possibility of creating a partnership between the racetracks, horsemen and breeders to oversee the OTBs. New York Racing Association President Charles Hayward told *Daily Racing Form* that an objective party should be brought in to audit the books at the OTBs, as well as at NYRA, and come up with a plan for consolidation. "I don't think it would be difficult to get somebody objectively under the aegis of the Assembly or Senate or the Governor to form a task force," Hayward told *DRF*. "There's plenty of good models that are out there. We'd be happy to contribute to that, we'd be happy to do the study, but frankly it would be tainted and it wouldn't go anywhere. I think, with the demise of New York City OTB, we need a call to action. The solution shouldn't be for the other OTBs asking for more money, that's just not going to work for anybody." According to Pretlow, the Racing and Wagering Committee will go over the testimony offered at the hearing before making recommendations next year.

GULFSTREAM/HORSEMEN REACH DEAL *Daily Racing Form* has reported that Gulfstream Park has reached a handle/purse distribution agreement with horsemen through only half of their upcoming 2011 meet. The deal will expire on Feb. 28, and further negotiations on an extension will have to take place during the meet, which extends to Apr. 24. Florida HPBA executive director Kent Stirling said that while the track had asked the horsemen to agree to a deal that would last through the last day of racing, the horsemen were adamant about having a contract that extended through the calendar year. Horsemen do not only receive a percentage of handle from races run at Gulfstream, but also of handle generated from simulcast wagering at the track. Stirling said that Frank Stronach, chairman of Gulfstream Park's owner MI Developments, said that "He wanted to do a lot of brainstorming on how to make new revenues" with the horsemen as they work towards a second deal. The short-term contract calls for daily purses of \$400,000, a \$75,000 increase from last year, due in part to recent legislation that allows horsemen to share in the state's casino revenue.

Red's Round Table graduated by a neck against \$40,000 company at Delaware July 19 and aired by 6 1/2 in an Aug. 13 optional claimer at that track before finishing last of six in Monmouth's Sorority S. Sept. 6. The bargain yearling purchase took another crack at stakes company in the White Clay Creek S. Oct. 27, and the decision paid dividends, as the chestnut registered a front-running 6 3/4-length success. FINANCIAL EMPIRE (Empire Maker)

The relationship between Ian Banwell's St George Farm and two-time Grade II winner Bank Audit (Wild Rush) is still in its relative infancy. But the two are getting along swimmingly, and the mare was represented by her first winner in the form of Brushwood Stable's Financial Empire.

Banwell was extended to \$600,000 for Bank Audit (Wild Rush), a one-time claimer who went on to land the GII Distaff Breeders' Cup H. and the GII Genuine

Risk H. in the span of three starts in 2005. Retired early the next year with 10 wins from 30 starts and earnings of \$567,934, she was offered by Hinkle Farms as agent at Keeneland that November. Banwell, fairly new to the business, reached in and grabbed her

with an eye on giving her every chance to succeed as a broodmare.

"She's lovely, physically, and she's a complete outcross," explained Banwell, who is based in North Carolina, but owns St. George Farm in Lexington. "We have mated her to leading sires throughout. Empire Maker is one of our favorites, and we were obviously sad to see him go."

Bank Audit had special appeal to Banwell.

"She's a medium-sized, athletic mare, but what's great about her is the versatility in how she can be mated," he commented. "For this mating [to Empire Maker], he goes well there, because she'll give him some speed."

Financial Empire got Bank Audit off to a solid start, commercially speaking, selling to pinhooker Murray Smith for \$150,000. The mare has since produced a "spectacular" Dynaformer filly [a \$900,000 KEESEP grad this year], has a weanling Pulpit filly, and is in foal to Smart Strike.

Banwell hopes the mare's produce going forward are as popular as what she's dropped to date.

"My sense is that the market looks for athletes from proven athletes as a first, and I do think that breeders look for outcross when they can," he offered. "For our racing stock, that's typically what we try to focus on, and also for what we breed."
