TWIRLING CANDY MAKES IT A SADLER SWEEP

Twirling Candy (Candy Ride {Arg}) outgamed Smiling Tiger (Hold That Tiger) to the wire for a track-record setting victory in yesterday's GI Malibu S., giving trainer John Sadler and jockey Joel Rosario a clean sweep of the three graded stakes on Santa Anita's opening-day card. Earlier on the program, Sadler sent out **Switch** (Quiet American) to victory in the GI La Brea S., and stablemate **Sidney's Candy** (Candy Ride {Arg}) went wire-to-wire in the GIII Sir Beaufort S. Over Santa Anita's blazingly fast new dirt surface, Twirling Candy

tugged his way up to be a stalking fourth down the backstretch, as Smiling Tiger pressed pace-setting **Alcindor** (Unbridled's Song). Smiling Tiger took over in upper stretch, but Twirling Candy loomed a threat to his outside, and the pair battled down to the line with Twirling Candy just getting the better of that foe in the final jump. Sadler missed his big day with an injured knee, but assistant trainer Larry Benavidez credited his boss with strategic pre-race works for his three stakes winners. "John made a million-dollar move on Thursday by sending the three horses to Hollywood Park to breeze them," Benavidez said. "That might have helped in the cause. But we have three Grade I horses, so we were pretty confident going into today." The lightly raced Twirling Candy, a **"TDN Rising Star"** (★), opened his career with four straight victories, culminating with a 3 1/4-length tally in the Sept. 5 GII Del Mar Derby. He suffered the first loss of his career last time out when tiring to fourth in the Oct. 2 GI Goodwood S. at Hollywood. SWITCH DOMINATES LA BREA

Switch (Quiet American), coming off a runner-up effort in the GI Breeders' Cup F/M Sprint, cut the corner turning for home and sailed clear to a four-length victory in Sunday's GI La Brea S. at Santa Anita. The three-year-old filly covered the seven furlongs in a sparkling 1:20.33 over a new dirt track that was producing fast times all day. Switch raced just off the early pacesetters, while skimming the rail. She moved to challenge with an inside move turning for home and quickly spurred clear in upper stretch for an authoritative score. The inside trip was never a concern for assistant Larry Benavidez, deputizing for trainer John Sadler, who was sidelined by a "bum knee." "She kind of had the same trip she had in the Breeders' Cup, right behind the speed," Benavidez said. "She's a pro. She'll go inside, outside, it doesn't matter. That was pretty impressive, huh?" Winning rider Joel Rosario was happy with the new Santa Anita surface. "The track feels pretty good," Rosario said. "It's a little faster, but I don't think it's an issue."

With her stablemate and controversial G1 Japan Cup victor **Rose Kingdom (Jpn)** (King Kamehameha {Jpn}) sidelined with colic, super-filly **Buena Vista** was the horse on everyone's minds and everyone's tickets in this last major event on Japan's 2010 racing calendar. **Victoire Pisa**, however, winless since annexing the G1 **Satsuki Sho** (Japanese 2000 Guineas) in April, off the board in two starts in France, and third last out in the Japan Cup, would be the one to end the term on the highest note. The sophomore showed more speed than his favored rival and took command before they turned for home. While **Buena Vista** put in a valiant run down the center of the course to make up a ton of ground late, her efforts came up just a nose short. Winning trainer **Katsuhiko Sumii** said, "The horse was a bit tense after returning from his overseas campaign, but his last start in the Japan Cup put him back into his good form. The campaign has definitely helped him develop mentally." The conditioner added, "I asked [rider] **Mirco [Demuro]** to race near the pace, and it was his decision to take the lead in the backstretch, probably because of the slow pace. He has studied the horse well. I was relieved when the final results were announced, and I am very happy for the owner. I am not sure yet about his future plans on whether he will travel abroad again or not--but it is a likely option. I'm just happy to be able to train such an amazing horse." Sidney's Candy captured the GI Santa Anita Derby, GII San Vicente S. and GII San Felipe S. on the synthetic, and annexed the GII La Jolla H. on the turf at Del Mar two back Aug. 14, but he handled the move to conventional dirt in stride here. The chestnut had been on real dirt just once before, but that was over a sloppy strip in the May 1 GI Kentucky Derby, where he faded badly to finish 17th. Freshened after that effort, he was second by a head after setting the pace in the GII Swaps S. July 17, then made his turf bow in the La Jolla and cruised by 5 1/2 lengths. The sophomore was not disgraced when sixth, just three lengths adrift of the great Goldikova (Fr) (Anabaa), after setting the pace in the Nov. 6 GI Breeders' Cup Mile, and he was the heavy chalk to take a liking to the new Santa Anita strip. Sidney's Candy broke sharply and had company through a half in :45.03, but he opened up in the final four furlongs to win as much the best. "He's a really good horse and he likes to run free and easy," explained winning rider Joel Rosario. "Even though he went fast fractions, he just kept going. When we went to the first turn, I could hear [track announcer] Trevor [Denman] say we made an easy lead. The fractions were fast and he maybe got a little bit tired at the end. The Usual Q.T., a perfect three-for-three over the Santa Anita lawn, was very rank in the early going of the GI Breeders' Cup Mile, but still came home third, just a neck behind runner-up Gio Ponti (Tale of the Cat). The four-year-old gelding took the GI Eddie Read H. at Del Mar in July at this same nine-furlong distance. **Proudinsky** has captured this race the last two years, but was purchased privately by Stella Perdomo and went to the sidelines after the 2009 renewal. The seven-year-old resurfaced with a runner-up finish in the Nov. 27 GI Citation H. last time out. **Jeranimo**, winner of the GII Strub S. in February, was sidelined after a fourth-place finish in the GI Santa Anita H. in March. Fifth in a Golden Gate stakes in his return Oct. 23, the four-year-old made his turf debut a winning one last time out, taking a Hollywood 1 1/16-mile allowance by 1 1/2 lengths Nov. 27.

Booming, second in the G1 Auckland Cup earlier this year, broke clear of the pack with 200 meters remaining to earn the first Group 1 tally of his career. "He's a great horse, he has some potential," trainer Jeff Lynds said of the winner. "We wanted to take him to [the G1 Melbourne [Cup] for the spring, but he was weighted out of it. It has turned out to be a blessing and this is a great thrill to come here and win this. We will head to the G1 Auckland Cup now, and who knows, maybe even keep an eye out for the first Tuesday of November next year." The six-year-old gelding was purchased by D R Frampton for NZ\$50,000 from Seaton Park at the 2006 Karaka Select Sale.
