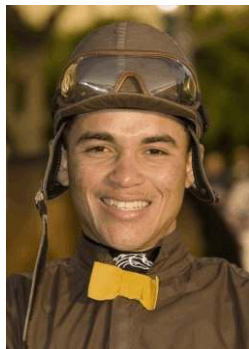

**HARMONIOUS LOOKS TO HIT HIGH NOTE**

Pam, Martin and Emily Wygod's **Harmonious** (Dynaformer), a disappointing 10th in the GI Breeders' Cup Filly & Mare Turf at Churchill Downs Nov. 5, looks to get back on track in Santa Anita's GII Robert J. Frankel S. on New Year's Day. "Turning for home, I didn't have much horse left," jockey Joel Rosario said of the GI American Oaks S. and GI Queen Elizabeth II Challenge Cup S. heroine's effort in the Breeders' Cup. "It didn't seem like she liked the grass very much in the Breeders' Cup. I got bumped by a horse outside of me, and my filly sort of lost control after that. But she has a really good chance Saturday."

Trained by John Shirreffs, Harmonious has posted five workouts since, including an easy six-furlong breeze over Hollywood's Cushion Track in 1:16 Dec. 24. Rosario has already won three graded races at the Santa Anita meeting, which kicked off the day after Christmas. "You have to work hard every day," he said. "That's the only way to do it." **Eclair de Lune (Ger)** (Marchand de Sable), trained by Ron McAnally, tuned up for the Bobby Frankel with a four-furlong move over the Santa Anita lawn in :50.80. The GI Beverly D. S. victress dead-heated for sixth in the Filly & Mare Turf last time.

The American Graded Stakes Committee has reviewed the Sir Beaufort S., which was automatically downgraded when it was taken off the turf Dec. 26 at Santa Anita. The race, won by Sidney's Candy (Candy Ride {Arg}), will remain a Grade III event.

**MARWING GETS RIDE ON GITANO HERNANDO**

South African-born and Hong Kong-based jockey Weichong Marwing will replace Kieren Fallon aboard Team Valor's **Gitano Hernando (GB)** (Hernando {Fr}) in his two-race lead-up to and in the G1 Dubai World Cup at Meydan Mar. 26. Fallon had been in the irons for each of the soon-to-be five-year-old's last six starts, including a sixth-place effort to the now-retired Gloria de Campaeo (Brz) (Impression {Arg}) in the \$10-million feature last March. "Weichong has ridden many good winners for us in Hong Kong, Dubai and South Africa," commented Team Valor President Barry Irwin. "We have a ton of faith in him and we know that he will give us his best ride. That's why we chose him to ride our horse during the winter in Dubai." Marwing has had his fair share of success during the Dubai International Racing Carnival, including four wins in the rich World Cup undercard stakes. Marwing carried the Team Valor green and red silks to victory in the 2006 G1 Queen Elizabeth II S. at Sha Tin aboard Iridescence (SAf) (Caesour).

## HRRN WINS MEDIA ECLIPSE AWARD

*Edited Press Release*

Horse Racing Radio Network has won the 2010 Media Eclipse Award in the Audio/Multi-Media Internet category for its live coverage of this year's Breeders' Cup World Championships, the National Thoroughbred Racing Association, *Daily Racing Form* and the National Turf Writers and Broadcasters announced Thursday. "It's overwhelming to win the Eclipse Award," HRRN President Mike Penna said. "It's the highest honor we have in our sport. To win an Eclipse is the ultimate recognition for our broadcast team, which has devoted itself to year-round racing coverage the past six years." During its 10 hours of live coverage of the Breeders' Cup, the Lexington, Kentucky based HRRN covered a wide range of news and feature topics, including reports from the paddock and post-race interviews and analysis. "Obviously Zenyatta was the overwhelming story of this Breeders' Cup," Penna continued. "We knew that's why people were tuning in. Our goal for that last hour was to have listeners feel as though they were there at Churchill Downs with us." Adam Frenier and John Edwards produced the broadcast. In addition to Penna, who hosted the coverage, the announcing team was comprised of analysts Jude Feld and Kurt Becker; paddock reporter Sean Clancy and paddock commentator Roy Steele. Honorable mention went to ESPN Radio, for its live broadcast of the 2010 Kentucky Derby. Judges for the Audio/Multi-Media Internet category were: Mike Kane, Thoroughbred racing journalist; Marc Malusis, WFAN New York radio host and SNY-TV commentator; and Joe Withee, Director of Broadcast Publicity at Emerald Downs. The 40th Annual Eclipse Awards will be held Jan. 17 at the Fontainebleau-Miami Beach in Miami Beach, Florida.

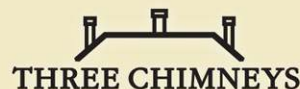

Indy) was a \$90,000 KEESEP yearling, but blossomed into a \$450,000 specimen this year at KEEAPR. She debuted with a fourth to subsequent Grade I winner Rigoletta (Concerto) in a Del Mar maiden Aug. 8, and followed that with a pair of narrow defeats, at the Oceanside oval Sept. 5 and at Oak Tree Oct. 10. Third in a Hollywood sprint Nov. 7, the bay filly attempted to wire her rivals in a route at that track Dec. 2, but was caught near the wire and wound up second by a nose as the 2-5 chalk. This time, though, the bettors got it right. Sent off at 4-5, Star Presence shadowed Lunch Time Diva (Posse) through splits of :23.47, :46.78 and 1:11.33. The favorite drew even in front of the stands and opened up to earn her diploma by 3 1/2 lengths. Star Presence's dam is a full-sister to leading sire Pulpit, and her second dam is Grade I winner Preach (Mr. Prospector). ### First Kranji Runner Pending for Harvey

*Edited Singapore Turf Club release*

In Singapore, he is better known as one half of popular Australian-owned furniture and home entertainment store Harvey Norman, but its multimillionaire founder and chairman Gerry Harvey is now bringing his other passion to our shores—horse racing.

Regarded as one of the biggest owner-breeders in Australian racing, the 71-year-old entrepreneur is no stranger to Singapore racing as he is also the part-owner of famous horse auction house Magic Millions, which sells hundreds of yearlings and ready-to-run racehorses to Singapore every year.

But the stakes are different this time as he will for the first time be involved as a horse owner at Kranji. Harvey, who counts

G1 Golden Slipper winner Polar Success (Aus), G1 Cox Plate winner Savabeel (Aus) and top sprinter Fashions Afield (Aus) (co-owned with Magic Millions partner John Singleton) among the most notable racehorses he owned and bred, will soon see his famous blue and white crossed-sashed colours worn by his first Singapore-based runner **Parfumier (Aus)**.

The Belong To Me eight-year-old gave a glimpse of his handy Sydney form with a narrow barrier trial win Dec. 9 ([video](#)), but took it easy at his second trial Tuesday, running fifth.

New trainer John Meagher expressed satisfaction at the way the former seven-time winner has acclimatised to his new environment and is looking forward to “having some fun” with Harvey’s first Kranji runner.

“I’ve known Gerry for a long time. I trained a few fillies for him back home,” recalled the Melbourne Cup-winning conditioner. “I only recently asked him via email if he’d be interested to race a horse in Singapore and he sounded very enthusiastic. After I’ve looked at some videos of this fellow [Parfumier] and checked his record, I told him he would be suited here.”

Armed with his renowned patience, Meagher has not rushed Parfumier’s preparation, with a view to a debut in a 1200-meter race on turf Jan. 7, which will hopefully give him a better idea how his Sydney form stacks up in Singapore.

“[Parfumier] was a sprinter-miler who ran second in a Group 2 [*sic*] race, the Villiers S. (1600m),” said Meagher. “He’s very sound and is a nice welter kind of horse. He can carry a bit of weight, and if he’s not killed by the handicapper, I think we can have some fun with him. I think the long course will also suit him better.”

Meagher said Parfumier’s above-average age for an import was not an issue.

“He’s a good old galloper who had a pretty solid form in Australia, and an exception was made to allow him to race here,” said Meagher in reference to the Malayan Racing Association general rule that limits the age of imported tried horses to six years. “Generally speaking, a lot of those old horses come here and don’t fire, don’t seem to fit in, but I don’t think this one will have any problem at all.”
