TASK GETS EASIER FOR HARMONIOUS

Pam and Marty Wygod's **Harmonious** (Dynaformer) would have vied for favoritism with **Eclair de Lune** (Ger) (Marchand de Sable) in today's GII Robert J. Frankel Memorial H. at Santa Anita, but the likely defection of

that rival leaves her as the overwhelming choice in what would be a diminutive four-horse field. Trainer Ron McAnally, who conditions Eclair de Lune for Richard Duchossois, told *Daily Racing Form* the newly turned five-year-

old would bypass the Frankel because recent rains in California hampered her work schedule. "She hasn't worked in three weeks," McAnally told *DRF*. "I decided to enter, but I call Dick [Mr. Duchossois] and he said, 'if you don't think she's fit, you don't have to run her.'" **Cont. p4**

STANDRIDGE MULLS 'DINNER' OPTIONS

William Terrill's **Gourmet Dinner** (Trippi) failed to add another chapter to his rags to riches story in the GI CashCall Futurity at Hollywood Park Dec. 18, coming home fourth at 7-2 odds, beaten five lengths by Comma to the Top (Bwana Charlie). But the Florida-based colt returned from his West Coast jaunt in excellent order, said trainer Steve Standridge, who is now contemplating future plans. Winner of the Dr. Fager and Affirmed divisions of the Florida Stallion series in consecutive starts at Calder in August, Gourmet Dinner posted the 20-1 upset in the GIII Delta Jackpot Nov. 20--a \$600,000 payday for the \$40,000 OBSAPR juvenile. He ran wide much of the way in the CashCall and lacked the needed rally, but Standridge isn't too concerned about the effort. "A lot of things went wrong out there, including getting pinched back at the start," he said. "But he's acting great. In reality, he doesn't act like a horse that traveled cross-country. We thought we'd back off him a little bit when we came back from the West Coast, but he doesn't seem to want that. We're still looking at what to do next. Right now we're thinking about the GIII Holy Bull S. at Gulfstream [Jan. 30] or the GIII Sam Davis at Tampa Bay Downs [Feb. 12]."

MUCHO MACHO MAN WORKS FOR HOLY BULL

Reeves Thoroughbred Racing and Dream Team One Racing Stable's **Mucho Macho Man** (Macho Uno) breezed a half-mile yesterday as he prepares for the GIII Holy Bull S. at Gulfstream Jan. 30. The Florida-bred stopped the clock in :50 2/5 under Eibar Coa. "This was his first official breeze back today, going a half mile," said trainer Kathy Ritvo. "We just went easy with him and didn't ask him for much. From here, the plan is to work next Saturday, and he should have three more breezes before the Holy Bull. We just hope to keep him mature and improving." Mucho Macho Man has one win in five starts, but has been chasing home some top-class talent. He ran a close second in his debut at Calder in July to subsequent GIII Delta Jackpot winner Gourmet Dinner (Trippi). After breaking his maiden two starts later at Monmouth in September, he completed the exacta behind To Honor and Serve (Bernardini) in both the GII Remsen S. (beaten four lengths) Nov. 6 and GII Nashua S. (beaten two lengths) Nov. 27. Also on the worktab Friday morning at Gulfstream was Jay Em Ess Stable and Hot Racing Stable's **Boys At Tosconova** (Officer), runner-up in the GI Breeders' Cup Juvenile. The Richard Dutrow Jr.-trained colt breezed five furlongs in 1:00 while working in company. The GI Three Chimneys Hopeful S. hero is also scheduled to make his 2011 debut in the \$400,000 Holy Bull, won last year by Winslow Homer (Unbridled's Song).

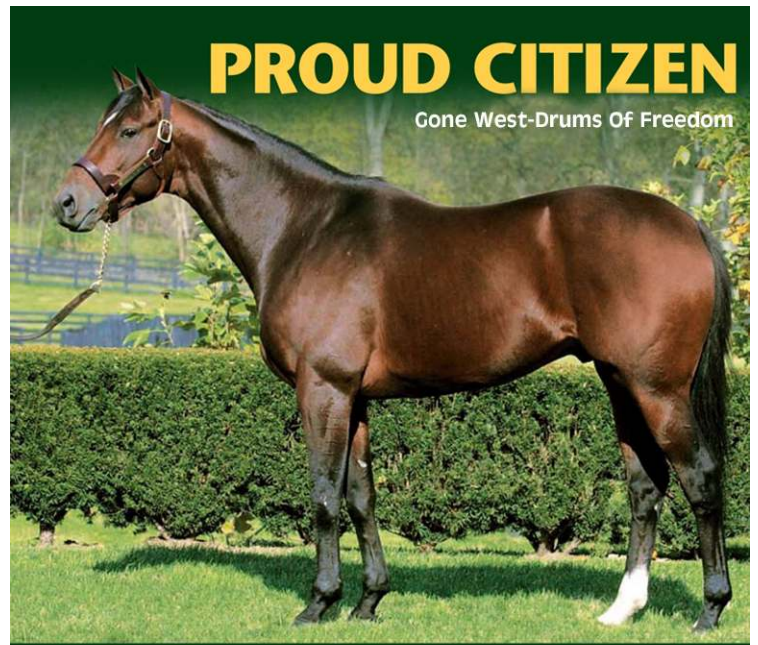

Jockey Joel Rosario, the leading rider in California, will make the trip to ride **Final Mesa** on Gulfstream Park's opening day. Considered one of the leading two-year-old fillies in the nation briefly in early summer, Final Mesa romped in Delaware's Polly Drummond S. in May, won Woodbine's My Dear S. by 7 3/4 lengths in June and was the 8-5 choice in the GIII Sorrento S. at Del Mar Aug. 6. But she could do no better than sixth that day to Wickedly Perfect (Congrats), later the winner of the GI Darley Alcibiades S. at Keeneland, and hasn't raced since. "She's been doing well," said Wesley Ward, who owns and trains the New York-bred filly. "She just had some problems [in the Sorrento]. I gave her a little time off and now she's ready to go."

Gulfstream Files for December Dates in 2011...

Gulfstream Park has filed an application with Florida regulators to begin its 2011-12 meet some four weeks earlier than usual, in early December, according to *Daily Racing Form*. That could put the track at odds with Calder, which typically runs its Tropical meet during that stretch. Mike Rogers, vice president of racing and gaming for Gulfstream's parent company MI Developments, Gulfstream's parent company, told DRF that Gulfstream applied to race from Dec. 2, 2011, through Apr. 8, 2012. This year's meet, which begins Wednesday, is scheduled to run through Apr. 24. Rogers added the track might consider moving the 2012 GI Florida Derby to four weeks out from the GI Kentucky Derby, rather than the current five weeks out.

Jockey Berrio Suffers Stroke...

Jockey Omar Berrio suffered a stroke following the races at Santa Anita Thursday, reports *Daily Racing Form*, and is currently recovering. The 42-year-old rider concluded his afternoon guiding Celtic Princess (Brz) (Public Purse) to victory in the day's featured seventh race, a \$100,000 optional claimer, and had returned to his Temple City home when his wife Karina became concerned. "I saw it in his face; he said he felt weak on the left side of his body," she told the publication. Berrio was admitted to Arcadia Methodist Hospital and diagnosed with a stroke. He still hospitalized as of Friday afternoon, but Karina said that her husband "is doing good right now--he is talking and he understands."

While Eclair de Lune's defection puts Harmonious in the driver's seat in the Frankel, the latter has to shake off a poor 10th-place showing in the GI Breeders' Cup Filly & Mare Turf at Churchill Nov. 5. Prior to that, the then-sophomore had been a model of consistency, winning four of five heading into the race, including the GI Queen Elizabeth II S. at Keeneland in mid-October. Harmonious also won the GI American Oaks in July for trainer John Shirreffs, who has tapped Joel Rosario to ride today. Rosario has been on Harmonious in her last two starts as well, and the Dominican will have to be on his toes in what looks to be a paceless affair. Breaking just to his inside is Garrett Gomez and the likely early leader **Spring Style (Ire)** (Pivotal {GB}), who dropped in to win a one-mile Hollywood Park allowance Nov. 19. Before that, Spring Style was unplaced in five straight stakes events, and would need a career-best effort to spring the upset.

Weather Won't Derail Evening Jewel from Monrovia...

Dirt or turf, **Evening Jewel** (Northern Afleet) will kick off her four-year-old season in tomorrow's GIII Monrovia S. at Santa Anita, said trainer Jim Cassidy. The \$100,000 race for fillies and mares is scheduled for 6 1/2 furlongs on the turf, but a forecast for showers may prompt officials to move the event to the main track. Her regular jockey Victor Espinoza, aboard for her wins in the 2010 GI Las Virgenes S. and GI Del Mar Oaks and in her third-place effort in the GI Filly & Mare Sprint in her most recent Nov. 5, said it didn't matter to him. "She always tries hard," said Espinoza. "Every time she runs, she runs hard, and she's ready to go. I worked her and she worked unbelievable."

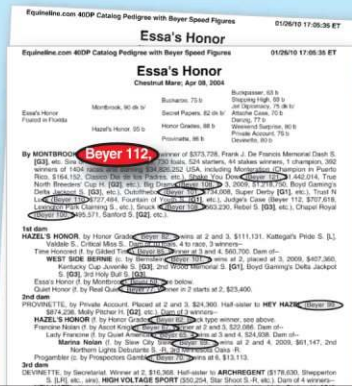

RAKTI DIES Multiple Group 1 winner **Rakti (GB)** (Polish Precedent--Ragera {Ire}, by Rainbow Quest) died after sustaining a pelvic fracture that pierced an artery, according to *Racing Post*. The 11-year-old was at Australia's Chatswood Stud at the time of his death. Bred by Azienda Agricola Rosati Colarieti, the bay began his career in Italy for trainer Bruno Grizzetti, capturing the 2002 G1 Derby Italiano. He was purchased privately by Gary Tanaka and sent to Michael Jarvis, winning the G1 Gran Premio Presidente Della Repubblica and G1 Champion S. at four. Rakti added victories in the G1 Prince of Wales's S. and G1 Queen Elizabeth II S. in 2004, and secured the G1 Lockinge S as a six-year-old in 2005. He was the highweighted miler in Britain at five, and was the joint highweight at that distance for 2005. Rakti retired to stud in 2006 with a record of 26-11-4-1 and earnings of £1,870,762. From his first crop of three-year-olds, he has been represented by listed winner Carioca (Ire).
