STYLISH WIN AT SANTA ANITA

Spring Style (Ire) (Pivotal {GB}) returned to her favorite venue and got her nose down ahead of odds-on **Harmonious** (Dynaformer) for a career best in Saturday's GII Robert J. Frankel S. at Santa Anita. Winner of a second-level allowance last January, the chestnut

was a midpack sixth to the late Tuscan Evening (Ire) (Oasis Dream {GB}) in the GII Buena Vista H. the following month before getting a break. She ran fifth in the GII Royal Heroine Mile at Hollywood July 3, then made her next three starts at Del Mar, finishing seventh in

the restricted Osunitas H. July 24, fourth to Zenyatta (Street Cry {Ire}) in the GI Clement L. Hirsch S. on Polytrack Aug. 7 and seventh back on the lawn in the GI John C. Mabee S. Aug. 15. Given three months to regroup, Spring Style took a one-mile Hollywood allowance Nov. 19, and she was the third choice here after the scratch of GISW Eclair de Lune (Ger) (Marchand de Sable). The 6-1 chance was a tracking second under jockey Garrett Gomez as they went at a walk up front, got the jump on the come-from-behinders to take the lead nearing the eighth pole and just held as Harmonious cut into the margin late. "She can get a little lazy if she's up front on her own, so I told Garrett, 'Just sit right off somebody if you can,' and he rode her perfect," trainer Ben Cecil remarked, adding, "I did [think I won it] when I was sitting down, but as I walked down and watched the head bob, I wasn't totally sure. It's huge. It makes her worth quite a bit of money now. She's got a reasonable pedigree, and Pivotal is a leading sire in Europe. And winning the race named for Frankel is significant. Since I came to California, he's the trainer I've had certainly the most respect for, so it's great to win." NED EVANS DIES AT 68

Prominent owner and breeder Edward 'Ned' Evans, who operated Spring Hill Farm in Casanova, Virginia, died Friday, Dec. 31 at Mount Sinai Hospital in New York after a brief illness. He was 68. While many of Evans's friends and his associates knew Evans was dealing with health issues, news of his death came as a shock, and left the industry contemplating the man who bred over 100 stakes winners through the years.

"He was his own man in every way," said Chris Baker, manager of Spring Hill. "That's what we are going to miss most about him. For us at the farm, it's a great loss to all of us who got to work with him. He was a man of great intellect, drive and focus. But it's also a great loss for the sport of racing. There are very few of those old-style owner/breeders left in the game." **Cont. p5-7**

That Toocleverforwards had raced five times on the main track was not exactly by design, as four of those races were scheduled for the turf. But, the daughter of a versatile sire in Arch performed well in those appearances, with runner-up efforts in her first two tries after switching to this barn Aug. 7 and 22 prior to a fourth in the grassy Ms. Brookski S. Sept. 4. The dark bay romped by 6 1/4 lengths in yet another off-turf affair Oct. 1 and came full circle in her latest, a first black-type success and career-best figure in the Oct. 16 Cinnamon Girl S. Allowed to stalk a moderate pace while saving all the ground from her inside post, Toocleverforwards was angled out for run leaving the turn, came calling for the lead outside Joanie's Catch entering the final furlong and edged clear. The Swettenham homebred was beaten just a head when filling out the exacta in the Oct. 2 GI Flower Bowl Invitational S., and made a mild bid in the 1 1/2-mile Nov. 13 GIII Long Island H. at Aqueduct before finishing an even-paced fourth. She makes her first appearance since. Castleton Lyons's **Tarrip**, on the board in five of seven on the lawn, set the pace in the Long Island before weakening to be third last time out.

(Edited press release) **Blind Luck** (Pollard's Vision), favored to win an Eclipse Award as the nation's outstanding three-year-old filly of 2010, worked six furlongs on Santa Anita's traditional dirt main track Saturday in 1:11.80 as she prepares for her 4-year-old debut in the GII El Encino S. Jan. 16. "Fantastic," is how Jerry Hollendorfer's assistant Dan Ward termed the drill. "She's all cranked up and ready to go," Ward said. "She'll have at least one more breeze before the race." Asked if the multiple Grade I stakes winner has had any physical changes as she turns four today, Ward said, "She's the same. She looks like a three-year-old filly champion."

Berrio on the Improve...

Jockey Omar Berrio, who suffered an apparent stroke after the races at Santa Anita Thursday, was showing improvement at Arcadia Methodist Hospital Saturday. "I visited him twice yesterday," said trainer A.C. Avila. "He had his first MRI Thursday night, with more scheduled. He has responded well to medication, but has to be evaluated again. He's moving his [left] arm, and it looks like he's going to be OK."

OBITUARY

EDWARD EVANS, 1942-2010

In 2010, Ned Evans was represented by GI Donn H., GI Met Mile and GI Woodward S. hero Quality Road (Elusive Quality), as well as GI Ruffian H. heroine Malibu Prayer (Malibu Moon) and GI Jim Dandy S. hero A Little Warm (Stormin Fever), all homebreds. Evans also bred the likes of Saint Liam (Saint Ballado), who was named 2005 Horse of the Year after winning the GI Breeders' Cup Classic for owners Mr. and Mrs. William K. Warren.

Evans was indeed regarded as one of the last of a kind, that of the genteel sportsman. Over the span of more than 40 years, Evans crafted a formidable operation. He purchased the 3,000-acre Spring Hill Farm in 1969 and populated his broodmare band with mares from fashionable lines. He was equally comfortable selling as he was racing, but often kept and campaigned his fillies before retiring them to Spring Hill. That was the case with Misty Gallore (Halo), who became one of Evans's first major stakes winners. She won five graded events in the late 1970s, and would go on to be the dam of the sire Silver Ghost (Mr. Prospector).

Misty Gallore was a daughter of Flight Dancer, herself a granddaughter of the great Gallorette. In addition to Misty Gallore, Flight Dancer also produced Minstrella, who carried Evans's colors to victory in the G1 Phoenix S., G1 Cheveley Park S. and G1 Moyglare Stud S. in 1984 and was named that year's champion juvenile in Ireland. As a broodmare, Minstrella produced Evan's GSW Minidar (Alydar), who in turn produced A Little Warm. Minstrella also produced Grade II winner Colonial Minstrel (Pleasant Colony), subsequently the dam of two black-type winners.

Flight Dancer would prove to be a foundation mare for Evans. Another of her daughters, Misty Dancer (Lyphard)--who interestingly was sold as a yearling by Evans and later bought back as a broodmare--produced SW Quiet Dance (Quiet American), who gained fame as the dam of the \$4.4-million earner Saint Liam, as well as GSW Congressionalhonor (Forestry) and SW Quiet Giant (Giant's Causeway).

Evans also bred and raced the good full-siblings Stormin Fever and Raging Fever, both by Storm Cat. Raging Fever was a three-time Grade I winner of over \$1.4 million; Stormin Fever was a graded winner and twice placed in Grade I company, and is now a successful sire.

Homebreds Summer Colony (Summer Squall) and Gygistar (Prospector's Music) both carried Evans's familiar yellow-and-black silks to victory in Grade I events and earned in excess of \$1 million, while Evans also bred (and sold) Grade I winner Yonaguska (Cherokee Run).

Evans occasionally bought yearlings, too. He went to \$230,000 for Christmas Gift (Green Desert) as a 1993 Keeneland September yearling. Mark Hennig trained the filly to win the Gill Beaugay S. at three, but Christmas Gift would prove an even better broodmare, producing Evans's homebred Grade I winner Christmas Kid (Lemon Drop Kid). In all, Evans bred over 100 stakes winners.

Evans was chosen as the 2009 Breeder of the Year by the Thoroughbred Owners and Breeders Association, and was presented with the Ogden Phipps Award, along with the Phipps family, as the outstanding breeder by the New York Turf Writers Association in 2002. He was the leading owner at the 2001, 2002 and 2004 Aqueduct spring meetings, and the leading owner at the 2000 Belmont Park spring and Saratoga meetings, and was leading owner at the 2010 Spa meet. Evans was named Virginia Breeder of the Year by the Thoroughbred Owners and Breeders Association in 1999-2001 and 2004-09.

"He was a terrific owner for us and our stable and he cared greatly about his horses," said Todd Pletcher, who trained the recently retired Quality Road and Malibu Prayer for Evans. "He was a tremendous person for the sport and loved the game, and took great pride and pleasure in breeding, raising, and racing his horses."

Born in Pittsburgh in 1942, Evans was the son of the late Thomas Mellon Evans, who bred champion Pleasant Colony and owned Buckland Farm, and is brother to Thomas Mellon Jr. and Robert "Shel" Evans. Ned Evans graduated from Yale University and Harvard Business School. Later, he was chairman and CEO of various companies, and for a time was the head of the publishing house MacMillan Inc. Evans never married and had no children. Last week, it was announced that Evans donated \$50 million for construction of a building at the Yale School of Management's planned campus. Yale said it was the largest gift ever received by the business school. The building will bear Evans's name.

Evans enjoyed a long relationship with Will Farish's Lane's End Farm. Quality Road will begin his stud career at the Versailles nursery, and Silver Ghost was a successful stallion there.

When his father died, he and brothers Tom and Shel took ownership of the stallions Pleasant Colony and his son Pleasant Tap, and moved them to Lane's End, as well. Evans boarded his mares at Lane's End when they were in Kentucky, and the farm consigned the majority of Evans's stock at public auction.

"He was an incredibly bright person," said Lane's End's Bill Farish. "At times he could be pretty demanding, but he was never unfair. If Lane's End's Bill Farish Ned didn't respect you, then you were in trouble, but we had a very good working relationship with him."

Farish added, "The one word that comes to mind with Ned is loyalty. He was very loyal to us, and we will miss that relationship greatly."

It is not going to be the same without his presence at the NYRA tracks, and he will be sorely missed throughout the industry."

DOMINGUEZ, PLETCHER, DUBB TOP 2010 NYRA STANDINGS Ramon Dominguez capped a runaway performance as the leading rider on the New York Racing Association circuit with four winners at Aqueduct on New Year's Eve. The 34-year-old finished the season with 353 victories, easily besting runner-up David Cohen, who had 180 wins. Dominguez earned the NYRA title in 2009 as well, his first full year in New York. "To be able to feel that 2010 was as good or better than 2009 is very gratifying," said Dominguez. "It's hard to pick out one highlight, but I thought the [GI] Jockey Club Gold Cup with Haynesfield and the [GI] Hopeful with Boys At Tosconova were special, and it's always great to win with Gio Ponti, because he's such a good horse." Todd Pletcher, who last topped the NYRA trainer standings in 2004, ousted four-time champ Gary Contessa in 2010, 120-86. Pletcher captured 32 black-type events in New York last year. "We had a great year in New York from beginning to end," said Pletcher. "Taking the inner track title at Aqueduct for the first time was a big accomplishment, and recapturing the Saratoga training title was very gratifying. Winning the [GI] Wood Memorial and the [GI] Met Mile, two races we'd never won before, kind of jump out. It was a great year for us all over the country, and particularly in New York." The leading owner at the NYRA tracks last year was Michael Dubb, who took his first title by edging out Repole Stable, 50-49.

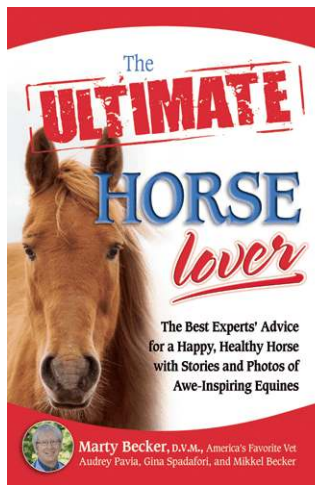
