GETTING A 'LINE' ON THE HAL'S HOPE

The late-blooming **Morning Line** (Tiznow), a very game second in the GI Breeders Cup Dirt Mile at Churchill Downs Nov. 6, heads a field of seven in today's Gill Hal's Hope S. at Gulfstream Park. "It was so tough in 2010," trainer Nick Zito reflected. "In 10 major races, I had horses finish second, including that one. He ran his guts out." The Thoroughbred Legends Racing Stable colorbearer punched his ticket to the Breeders' Cup with a narrow victory in the GII Pennsylvania Derby Sept. 25. "He ran a great race in the Pennsylvania Derby and he came back and duplicated that effort in the Breeders' Cup," Zito continued of the \$700,000 KEESEP yearling graduate. "Like someone told me, he did all the work. We just hope he'll start off good in 2011." Morning Line has tuned up for the Hal's Hope with a trio of works at Palm Meadows, including a bullet five-furlong move in :59 3/5 Dec. 24. "He's had a couple of terrific works--one was very, very outstanding," the Hall of Famer continued. "We think he's ready and it's a good stepping stone for his comeback race for 2011." Looking ahead Zito concluded, "Obviously, everybody would like to win the [GI] Donn [H., Feb. 5]. It's one of the most prestigious races early in the year, so we'll put that on the radar. We have a few things lined up for Morning Line, but we don't want to get ahead of ourselves, so we'll see what happens this weekend." **Feature Pres. cont. p2**

'TOSCONOVA' GEARING UP

Jay Em Ess Stable, Hot Racing Stable and others' **"TDN Rising Star" Boys at Tosconova** (Officer), most recently second behind Uncle Mo (Indian Charlie) in the GI Breeders' Cup Juvenile, breezed five furlongs in 1:00.60 at Gulfstream Park Friday. The GI Three Chimneys Hopeful S. winner is scheduled to make his sophomore debut in the one-mile Gill Holy Bull S. Jan. 30. "That's just what we wanted from him," trainer Rick Dutrow Jr. reported. "I didn't see Michelle [Nevin] asking him at all. I would say he's right where we want him heading into his next race. We're very happy with him." Dutrow continued, "Uncle Mo isn't running in the Holy Bull. Our horse is a Grade I winner at a one-turn seven furlongs so this shouldn't be a problem for him." The conditioner also sent out last term's GI Davona Dale S. heroine **Amen Hallelujah** (Montbrook) for a five-furlong bullet in :59.90. The dark bay, owned in partnership by a group headed by IEAH Stables, has been sidelined since completing the exacta in the GI Acorn S. on the GI Belmont S. undercard. The Florida-bred is pointing toward the Sunshine Millions Filly & Mare Sprint Jan. 29. "[Julien] Leparoux was up on her, and I thought she went very well also," he said. "She's coming off a bit of a layoff, but she's good."

WinStar Farm homebred **Rule** (Roman Ruler), off since a third-place finish as the 9-5 favorite in the GI Florida Derby, makes his four-year-old bow in the Hal's Hope. The GIII Delta Jackpot S. and GIII Sam F. Davis S. hero turned in a bullet five-furlong workout in 1:00 4/5 at Palm Meadows Jan. 2. "He was a little subpar coming out of the Florida Derby so we just backed off and here we are,"

trainer Todd Pletcher told *Daily Racing Form*. "Hopefully he'll give us a good effort and then we'll look at the Donn." **Soaring Empire** (Empire Maker), a close sixth in the GI Hill 'n' Dale Cigar Mile H. Nov. 27, also figures to attract plenty of attention from the Gulfstream faithful. An allowance winner over this course last February, the four-year-old completed the trifecta behind Afleet Express (Afleet Alex) in the GIII Pegasus S. June 19 before annexing Monmouth's six-furlong Rutgers S. Nov. 6.

BUENA VISTA JAPAN'S HORSE OF THE YEAR
 The Japan Racing Association named **Buena Vista (Jpn)** (Special Week {Jpn}--Biwa Heidi {Jpn}, by Caerleon) Horse of the Year Friday. The recently turned five-year-old, who previously earned champion two-year-old filly and three-year-old filly honors, is owned by Sunday Racing Co. Ltd. and conditioned by Hiroyoshi Matsuda. Bred by Northern Farm, Buena Vista posted a 7-3-4-0 record in 2010 with earnings exceeding \$7 million. She took the G2 Kyoto Kinen to kick off the campaign before finishing second in the G1 Dubai Sheema Classic at Meydan in March. The dark bay returned to her homeland to annex the G1 Victoria Mile and G1 Tenno Sho (Autumn) before a controversial and disappointing end to her season. Despite a decisive 1 3/4-length victory in the prestigious G1 Japan Cup at Tokyo Racecourse Nov. 28, the heavy favorite was demoted to second behind Rose Kingdom (Jpn) (King Kamehameha {Jpn}—also owned by Sunday Racing Co. Ltd.—for minor interference in the stretch. Buena Vista finished the year with another runner-up effort, losing by a desperate nose in the Dec. 26 G1 Arima Kinen. She also earned champion older female honors and, according to *Daily Racing Form*, is being pointed to a 2011 return in Dubai. **Victoire Pisa (Jpn)** (Neo Universe {Jpn}) was named champion three-year-old colt, while G1 Prix de l'Arc de Triomphe runner-up **Nakayama Festa (Jpn)** (Stay Gold {Jpn}) received the award for champion older horse. **Espoir City (Jpn)** (Gold Allure {Jpn}) won champion dirt horse honors.

Blind Luck Ready for Return...

Five-time Grade I winner **Blind Luck** (Pollard's Vision) worked seven furlongs in 1:25.20 at Santa Anita Friday. The four-year-old, last seen placing second in the GI Breeders' Cup Ladies' Classic at Churchill Nov. 5, is set to make her seasonal bow in the GII El Encino S. Jan. 16. "She just needs a little blowout and we're all ready to go for next week," trainer Jerry Hollendorfer said. "It'll be a half-mile. We're very happy with how she's training." Exercise rider Marco Ramirez was aboard for yesterday's move.

Isn't She Dreamy?

John Oxley's unbeaten ☆ **"TDN Rising Star" ☆ Dancing in her dreams** (Tapit) continues to gear up at Palm Meadows for her much-anticipated sophomore bow, most recently firing a five-furlong bullet in 1:00 4/5 Jan. 5. "I think I've brought her back up where she needs to be--about 21, 22 days to go," trainer John Ward said of the GII Pocahontas S. victress. "She's been training just as good as you'd want." The gray is expected to return to action in Gulfstream's GII Forward Gal S. Jan. 30. "She's a fun filly to train, because she's got a lot of talent, but also because she's such a mature animal when she is actually racing or at a higher speed," Ward continued. "She's like a five-year-old racehorse, as far as experience goes, with a teenage girl's body and mind. So you've got to work with both scenarios. But she's most comfortable when she's actually in a race." Ward concluded, "To put it in football terms, she's like a wide receiver who can make the cut-and-go and nobody can cover."

BLACK N BEAUTY (c, 3, Devil His Due--Harbor Girl, by Boston Harbor), fourth in his debut at Belmont Park Sept. 25, was a solid second in his second appearance Oct. 16. The dark bay scored as the 1-2 favorite going 6 1/2 panels at Churchill Downs Nov. 12, and was the 5-2 third choice trying a one-turn mile in his sophomore bow. Sent right to the front, he led them along through splits of :46.91 and 1:12.02 and easily held Printing Press (Tapit) at bay to post a 2 1/2-length tally. The performance likely punched Black N Beauty's ticket to the Jan. 30 GIII Holy Bull S. "We said before the race that if he won and did it the right way, we would go on and bring him back three weeks later in the Holy Bull," trainer Dale Romans said. "Naturally, we'll talk to Mr. [Ahmed] Zayat, but that looks like the way we'll go." Jockey Kent Desormeaux was pleased with the effort. "Most horses are fighting to go as fast," Desormeaux said.
