He didn't seem to have his mind on running last time, but **Soaring Empire** (Empire Maker) was all business yesterday. The four-year-old wrested the lead from

front-running **Morning Line** (Tiznow) on the far turn and held off the late bid of returning **Rule** (Roman Ruler) to take the Gill Hal's Hope H. at Gulfstream Park by 1 1/4 lengths. Sixth in the Nov. 27 GI Hill 'n' Dale Cigar Mile H. at Aqueduct last time out, the four-year-old gave the gate crew all they could handle

before loading that afternoon. "He's always been a very talented horse, but a little quirky," trainer Cam Gambolati said. "We've had him to the gate maybe 10 times since his last race." **Cont. p2**

UNCLE MO TO TAMPA BAY DERBY?

Appearing on the "Down the Stretch" program on Sirius XM radio Saturday, trainer Todd Pletcher said GI Breeders' Cup Juvenile winner **Uncle Mo** (Indian Charlie) will likely make his three-year-old debut in the Mar. 12 GII Tampa Bay Derby. "The most attractive scenario seems to be the Tampa Bay Derby," Pletcher said. "They don't run a mile and a sixteenth at Gulfstream, so, there, I could either run him at seven-eighths in the [GII] Hutcheson or at a mile and an eighth in the [GII] Fountain of Youth [both Feb. 26]. When coming back and getting ready to go a mile and a quarter, I like a mile and a sixteenth. It's a ways down the road, but if you ask me today where we're going with him, I'd say the Tampa Bay Derby." Uncle Mo is likely to have only two preps for the GI Kentucky Derby. Owner Mike Repole, who enjoys racing in his native New York, has said he wants to run Uncle Mo in the Apr. 9 GI Wood Memorial at Aqueduct. The Tampa Bay Derby was upgraded to a Grade II event for 2011 and carries a purse of \$350,000. Pletcher has been a big supporter of the Tampa Bay Derby, and used the race last year with eventual Kentucky Derby winner Super Saver (Maria's Mon). He won the 2004 Tampa Bay Derby with Limehouse (Grand Slam).

Budding Empire...**

Soaring Empire kicked off his career with a decisive maiden victory at Monmouth Park in September of 2009, and came back to be a promising third in the GIII Iroquois S. at Churchill. He opened 2010 with a Gulfstream allowance score Feb. 25, but showed little after an eventful stretch run in the GI Florida Derby, finishing eighth. Fourth in the May 8 GII Dwyer S. and third in the June 19 GIII Pegasus S., he earned his

first black-type win in the Rutgers S. at Monmouth Nov. 6. The dark bay did not factor in the Cigar Mile, but he turned it around in his 2011 opener. Up to press Morning Line through a half in :46.56 and six panels in 1:10.30, he took control as they hit the quarter pole. Morning Line rerallied after jockey John Velazquez eased him off the rail, and Rule closed ground on the outside, but Soaring Empire was not threatened late. "I saw they weren't going that fast, so I decided to take a chance and stay up close to the lead," winning rider Jose Lezcano said. "I really didn't have to ask him until the last quarter and, from there, he ran on well." The colt could go next in the seven-furlong GII Gulfstream Park Sprint Championship Feb. 12. 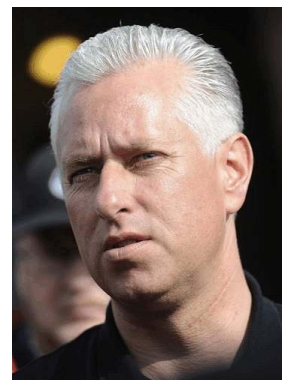

Return of Rule...

Rule was making his first start since finishing third in the Mar. 20 GI Florida Derby. Rated just off the early pace, he ate into the gap in the stretch, but had to settle for second. "We thought we were going to get a stalking trip, will all the speed in the race, and that's the way things turned out," trainer Todd Pletcher said. "He ran very hard and should really get a lot out of the race. We'll see how he comes out of the race, but the [Feb. 5 GI] Donn [H.] is a race were looking at." Added jockey Javier Castellano, "I was really playing the race by ear. We got bumped a little at the beginning, and that let the speed horses take advantage, so I just relaxed my horse. I didn't really have a choice. My horse ran really well. I was very happy with him."

Second in the Wickerr S. on the Del Mar turf July 28, he faded to sixth in the Windy Sands S. on the all-weather at that oval, but rebounded to take an off-the-grass optional claimer at Oak Tree Oct. 22. The chestnut went gate to wire to annex the Dec. 4 GIII Native Diver H. at Hollywood, and was the crowd's choice to add to his streak. Mucho Macho Man Preps for Holy Bull...

Reeves Thoroughbred Racing and Dream Team One Racing Stable's **Mucho Macho Man** (Macho Uno) worked five-eighths in a bullet :59 at Gulfstream Park Saturday morning. The Florida-bred bay capped off his juvenile campaign with second-place finishes in the Nov. 6 GI Nashua S. and Nov. 27 GI Remsen S. Eibar Coa, who was in the irons for the Remsen, was aboard for the breeze. "I was very happy with the way he worked. I believe he's improving every week," Coa said. "I was way happier than I was last week, so that's a good thing." The colt went a half in :50 2/5 at Gulfstream Dec. 31, but trainer Kathy Ritvo opted to send him in company yesterday. "He had a horse two lengths in front of him, just something for him to focus on," Ritvo explained. From five starts, Mucho Macho Man has compiled a record of 1-3-1 and earned \$110,643.

Sharing the Joy...

When Ken and Sarah Ramsey's homebred turf champion Kitten's Joy (El Prado {Ire}) entered stud at Ramsey Farm in 2006, the couple was committed to supporting their young stallion. Through the sales ring and the claim box, they acquired a wide array of mares perfectly suited to the multiple Grade I winner. The result was a battalion of kittens: Dean's Kitten, Sweet Kitten, William's Kitten, Lisa's Kitten, Kera's Kitten, Becky's Kitten, Cozy Kitten. And the kittens could run. Dean's Kitten led the way, capturing last year's GI Lane's End S., with William's Kitten, Becky's Kitten, Cozy Kitten and Holiday for Kitten all earning graded-stakes placings from Kitten's Joy's first two crops to hit the track.

Kitten's Joy, who will stand for \$25,000 in 2011, has enjoyed so much success with his progeny on the track, the Ramseys no longer have to support him with their own mares, according to Ramsey Farm Manager Mark Partridge.

"Going into this, with Kitten's Joy as a grass horse, we didn't think he'd be terribly commercial," Partridge explained. "And it's so important the first two or three years to get mares to your stallion, or otherwise you just don't have a shot. So we went out and claimed and bought a lot of broodmares that would fit him. Now he's doing so well that the outside mares are keeping him supported, so we have an excess of mares that we're selling in foal to him."

Ramsey Farm has consigned 31 mares to the Keeneland January sale and, of those, 23 are selling in foal to Kitten's Joy. All 14 of their Book 1 offerings were covered by the 10-year-old stallion.

"We expected he would take off," Partridge said of Kitten's Joy's success. "You don't go into it expecting him not to. We expected we would be selling off these mares. We sold off another 50 mares that were in foal to Kitten back in November. It's tough to say in this market, but we hope that his success will make the mares more popular."

Among the Ramsey's January consignment is **Slyka** (Stuka) ([hip 554](#)), a half-sister to graded stakes winner Bimini Blues (Cure the Blues) and the dam of stakes-winner Warrior Within (Catienus); **Surpriseinthebox** (Outofthebox) ([hip 578](#)), a half-sister to Canadian champion Judiths Wild Rush (Wild Rush); and **Daylatedollarshort** (Lemon Drop Kid) ([hip 700](#)), a half-sister to graded stakes winner Summer Raven (Summer Squall), the dam of graded stakes winner Winslow Homer (Unbridled's Song).

All the mares have something in common. "We have a pedigree analyst," Partridge said. "We don't buy any mares or claim any mares without him. He fits them with Kitten's Joy especially, so they've all been matched genetically with Kitten. If you go down the list and look at the broodmare sires, you've got Dynaformer, Silver Deputy, Quiet American, Dixieland Band, Elusive Quality, Lemon Drop Kid.

They're all good sires, they are all very good broodmare sires. So all of these mares are going to fit well with Kitten's Joy."

In Book 2, Ramsey Farm will offer the nine-year-old mare **Holly Smoke** (Unbridled's Song) ([hip 1144](#)). The gray is from the family of Griffinite and Devil His Due.

"She's a big typical Unbridled's Song," Partridge said of Holly Smoke. "She's a good-looking mare, and she throws really good-looking foals."

Kitten's Joy's progeny have enjoyed success over turf, dirt and synthetic, and Partridge expects things to only get better in the future.

"[His foals] definitely all look alike," Partridge said. "They all have long legs, long necks, there is a lot of scope to them. All of them, or most of them, look like routers, 1 1/8-mile, 1 1/4-mile type horses. We're expecting his horses to get better as they get older. We were actually surprised that his two-year-olds did so well the first year. It wasn't expected at all."

The Ramsey Farm broodmare band recently numbered almost 200 head, but Partridge is looking to reduce that population in the next year.

"We had 194 broodmares and, after Keeneland January, we should be down to around 130," he commented. "We want to go lower. I think the stallion is now supporting himself, and it's just so expensive to keep a big crop of mares. You can't sell everything, so you end up with a huge amount of horses to go into training and it's just so expensive. This time next year, if we have 100 mares, I'll be happy."

While the Ramseys are known for racing such stars as Precious Kitten, Roses in May and GI Breeders' Cup Dirt Mile winner Furthest Land, Partridge thinks expanding the farm's activities makes sense.

"The first priority is always racing with Mr. Ramsey, even though I think we need to broaden and get into more commercial stallions," Partridge admitted. "It's

tough when we go to the sales, people think that we're culling. So that's always a misconception that people have with us. We've sold some good ones. We started out selling under the Ramsey name, but then we got away from it just

because people would come by the barn and say, 'Well, what's wrong with this one. I know there is something wrong with it because you guys race.' Then we started using other people. But the last few years, probably the last three years, we've got away from that and are selling under our own banner again."

Kitten's Joy is currently the only stallion standing at the Ramsey's Nicholasville farm, but Partridge did not rule out additions in the future.

"If we breed another [champion], we'd definitely stand another one," he confirmed. *-J Martini*

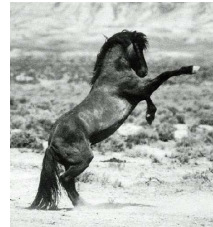

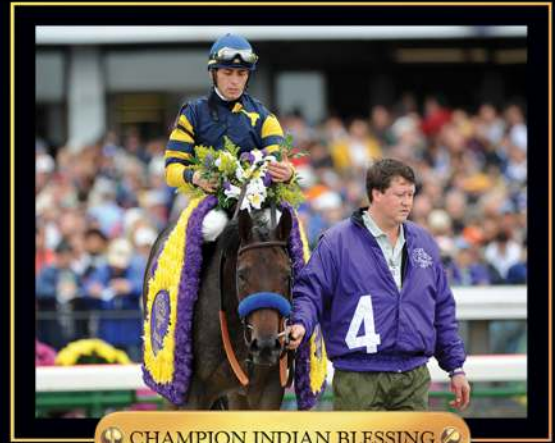

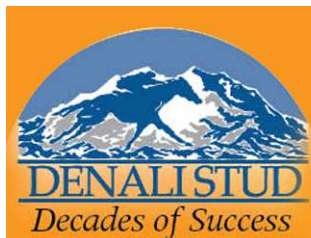
