

**ALWAYS A PRINCESS UPSETS EL ENCINO**

**Always a Princess** (Leroidesanimaux {Brz}) spoiled the 2011 debut of **Blind Luck** (Pollard's Vision), holding off the champion's late bid by a confident 3 1/2 lengths in Sunday's GII El Encino S. at Santa Anita and continuing the hot streak of trainer Bob Baffert. Over a Santa Anita strip that was favoring speed, Always a Princess duelled with **Champagne d'Oro** (Medaglia d'Oro) through early fractions of :22.38 and :45.41 and 1:08.72 as Blind Luck trailed the field. The 7-2



*Benoit* shot easily put away Champagne d'Oro turning into the straight

and opened a clear lead. Blind Luck, making her first start since finishing second in the GI Breeders' Cup Ladies' Classic, rallied late despite changing leads several times in deep stretch, but could not catch the winner. The chestnut filly tripped while being pulled up on the backstretch, tossing jockey Joel Rosario, but neither horse nor jockey appeared injured. Trainer Jerry Hollendorfer took the blame for Blind Luck's loss. **Always a Princess** won last year's GII Indiana Oaks at Hoosier Park and finished third in the GII Chilukki S. at Churchill Downs in November before ending her 2010 campaign with a fourth-place effort in the Dec. 26 GI La Brea S.

Winning rider Rafael Bejarano admitted his plan in the El Encino was to be on the front end. "I tried to be on the lead," Bejarano said. "I sent my horse really hard in the beginning. When I saw [Joe Talamo on Champagne d'Oro] rush his horse, I decided to put my horse right next to him. When I saw her getting tired, I decided to give my horse a little breather before coming to the stretch. After that, I just let her run and she showed me a big kick. Last time [in the La Brea] I stayed too far back with her. It was only seven furlongs, and I know this horse is better with more distance."

A\$200,000 final bid from Peter Caporn was [Lot 743](#), a son of Not a Single Doubt (Aus) out of Group Certificate (Aus) (Honour and Glory). Offered by Darlington Stud, the bay is a half-brother to this season's stakes performer Internal Revenue (Aus) (Exceed and Excel {Aus}). Also by Not a Single Doubt was the top-priced filly of the session, [Lot 760](#), a member of the Cressfield consignment. The first foal out of the stakes-winning and group-placed Karalee (Aus) (O'Reilly {NZ}), the bay realized a A\$150,000 final bid from Griffiths Training Party LTD. Final figures for the session saw the gross climb to A\$7,358,000 from A\$6,719,000 in 2010, as well as an increase in average from A\$42,258 to A\$46,866. **No Reserve on Loyd Williams Draft...**

A draft totalling 31 racing prospects from the Loyd Williams stable will be up for grabs--without reserve--at the Magic Millions Gold Coast complex Jan. 18. "None will be coming home," confirmed Williams' son Nick. "The value of each lot will be determined by the bidders and that will be the sale price for each of them." According to Williams, the majority of the stock were purchased for between A\$200,000 and A\$400,000 as yearlings, including the most expensive yearling purchase by Williams--four-year-old Ingleby (Aus) (Redoute's Choice {Aus})--who cost A\$850,000. The racing prospect is out of Hill Of Grace (Aus) (Zabeel {NZ}), winner of the G1 Moonee Valley Oaks. In the past, Williams sold a slew of top-shelf performers, including Subscribe (NZ) (Zabeel {NZ}), who following a name change to Vengeance of Rain, became a champion in Hong Kong and earner of over \$HK75 million. "Any syndicate of owners could buy a horse ready to race without the high costs associated with the breaking in, training and other expenses with a yearling purchase," said Williams. "There is something for everyone who wants to have a racehorse competing within weeks." Selling begins at 1 p.m. (Queensland time) Tuesday and all horses in the racehorse sale will be available for inspection at the Magic Millions complex Monday and Tuesday (prior to the start of the sale). 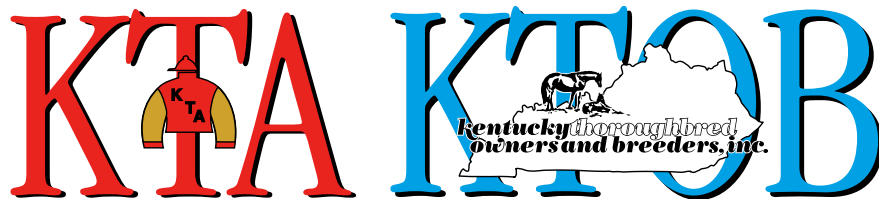

**SACRED KINGDOM REPEATS IN CENTENARY SPRINT CUP** Sacred Kingdom (Aus) (Encosta de Lago {Aus}) returned from a two-race losing streak to successfully defend his title in Sunday's HKG1 Centenary Sprint Cup at Sha Tin in Hong Kong. Ready to roll late, the seasoned pro wore down those rivals and inched ahead late to score by 3/4 of a length over Dim Sum, who held on for second over closing **Sweet Sanette (SAf)** (Jallad). "I asked him at about the 400, and he picked up and gave me a nice turn of foot," said the eight-year-old's regular rider Brett Prebble, who collected the victory on the day he returned from suspension. "He may not be quite what he was as a five-year-old, but he's in great form; he's got a great heart, and he's always doing his best." Winner of the Shya Tin Sprint Trophy Oct. 1, the gelding was fifth in the inaugural G2 Cathay Pacific Jockey Club Sprint Nov. 21 before coming home third in his most recent start in the G1 Hong Kong Sprint Dec. 12. "We won the first leg and now we're looking forward to the second," said trainer Ricky Yiu, referring to the HKG1 Chairman's Sprint Prize over 1200m Feb. 5. When asked whether the final leg of the series--the 1400-meter HKG1 Queen's Silver Jubilee Cup Mar. 6--was also on the agenda, Yiu added, "We'll give it some thought."
