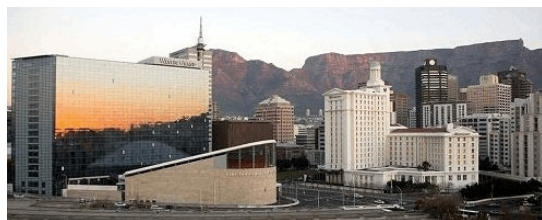

## Cape Premier Yearling Sale

### CAPE PREMIER YEARLING SALE DEBUTS

Cape Town plays host to the inaugural Cape Premier Yearling Sale, which begins its two-day run today at

the Cape Town International Convention Centre. Representing the first major yearling sale to be held in the centre of

South Africa's largest city, the event is hosted by Bloodstock SA, the marketing division of the Thoroughbred Breeders Association. The concept behind the new sale is to combine the beauty and quality of lifestyle that exists in the Cape with a mainstream sale of top-class Thoroughbreds. The catalogue consists of 290 yearlings, with 150 selling today. The remainder go under the hammer Friday. The sale begins daily at 4 p.m. (SAf time).

"This is a new venture for Bloodstock SA, and I am confident that it will be a hugely successful event," said Jan Naude, CEO of the TBA. "There has been interest in the Premier Sale from all over the world, and we are expecting visitors from 13 different countries. A special emphasis has been made to attract a new clientele. We have already received many compliments in the set-up of the sale, which allows visitors easy access to the sales arena from their hotels. Our team is doing a great job."

South African horses have been competing successfully at the highest level in international company over the last few years, led by **J J The Jet Plane (SAf)** (Jet Master {SAf}). Out of the South African-bred mare **Majestic Guest (SAf)** (Northern Guest), the R70,000 (\$9,900) juvenile purchase won the G1 Hong Kong Sprint in December, and currently has earnings of over R12 million. Other notable horses with strong South African ties to excel on an International arena over the last year include **Lizard's Desire (SAf)** (Lizard Island {Aus}), winner of the G1 Singapore Cup; G1 Matriarch S. heroine **Gypsy's Warning (SAf)** (Magok); and last year's GII Breeders Cup Juvenile Turf winner **Pluck** (More Than Ready), who is out of the South African-bred mare Secret Heart (SAf) (Fort Wood).

From the first South African crop of Trippi (End Sweep), this colt has been described by Klawervlei's Grant Knowles, as a "wow horse." The striking bay is the second foal of a winning Jet Master mare, who is a half-sister to the useful juvenile filly Summer Mist (SAf). The colt is from a powerful family, whose members include champion filly Prairie Oyster (SAf) and Guineas winner Savonarola (SAf).

**Lot 19, f, Captain AI (SAf)--Cry for the Lion (SAf), by Elliodor (Fr)**

*Consigned by The Alchemy*

Without question, this is one of the best bred fillies on offer. Her sire currently leads the South African general sires list, having recently been represented by Group 1-winning filly Emerald Cove (SAf). She is a half to G1 Summer Cup winner Aslan (SAf) (Silvano {Ger}).

**Lot 22, f, Jet Master (SAf)--Dame Kiri (SAf), by Flaming Rock (Ire)**

*Consigned by Klipdrif Stud, agent*

The first yearling by Klipdrif's champion sire Jet Master to be offered is out of a winning Flaming Rock (Ire) mare. The filly is a half to Group 1 winner Talahatchie (SAf) (Jallad). "She is a very nice, well balanced filly," said Klipdrif's Bennie Marais. "She is a very likable sort and is a very good walker."

**Lot 30, c, Royal Academy--Dubai's Fairy (GB), by Medicean (GB)**

*Consigned by Cheveley Stud*

This is just one of only two Royal Academy yearlings on offer here. The G1 Breeders' Cup Mile hero has done extremely well in South Africa, siring a pair of Group 1 winners in Express Way (Brz) (Bloodstock SA Cape Guineas) and champion Eyeofthetiger (Brz) (Vodacom Durban July). Dubai's Fairy is a half-sister to the high-class British performer Just James (GB) (Spectrum {Ire}), winner of the G2 Challenge S. Cheveley purchased the mare carrying this foal from Australia. "He is an athletic sort, who is racy, but is a good-sized individual," said Cheveley's Vaughan Koster.

**Lot 35, c, National Emblem (SAf)--Enchanted Dollar, by Spend a Buck**

A son of proven sire National Emblem, sire of the top-class sophomore Shea Shea (SAf), he is out of one of Highlands' most successful broodmares, who has already produced ill-fated champion sprinter National Currency (SAf) (National Assembly). The latter ran second to Silent Witness (Aus) in the G1 Hong Kong Sprint. National Assembly is also the sire of National Emblem (SAf), a champion on the racetrack and a former leading sire of juveniles.

A colt by the sire of last year's G1 Spinaway S. heroine R Heat Lightning, he has been described by connections as a "proper horse." His dam was a very talented race filly, who won five races and was stakes-placed. This colt is her first foal. Girl In Every Port, a full-sister to the stakes winning sprinter Mainbrace (SAf), is a descendant of South Africa's greatest broodmare Drohsky (GB) (Polyphontes {GB}).

*Consigned by Maine Chance Farms*

A magnificent son of leading sire and G1 Arlington Million winner Silvano, this colt is a full-brother to G2 SA Oaks winner Happy Spirit (SAf). The latter was subsequently sent to Dubai.

**76, c, Victory Moon (SAf)--Inspired (Ire), by Fasliyev**

*Consigned by Maine Chance Farms*

This is a son of the ill-fated 2003 G2 UAE Derby hero Victory Moon (AI Mufti), who died after siring four crops. The pedigree received a boost when his half-sister Illumiere (Aus) (Giant's Causeway) won a listed race. His dam is a full sister to Group 3-winning juvenile Kings Point (Ire), and this is the family of the popular British champion Sergeant Cecil (GB) (King's Signet). John Slade, Maine Chance's stud manager, said, "He is a lovely individual, very solid. The sire has been in great form with his three-year-olds, and it's a shame we lost Victory Moon."

By the sire of champions Pocket Power (SAf), Mythical Flight (SAf) and top international sprinter J J The Jet Plane (SAf), this colt is a son of the very talented, but lightly raced Lady Acton. The Group 3-placed Lady Acton is a full-sister to the ill-fated champion juvenile filly Historic Lady. Maine Chance's John Slade rates the colt highly. "He is lovely specimen," Slade reflected. "The mating is a perfect combination of speedy and Classic influences."

**102, c, Jet Master (SAf)--Laptop Lady (SAf), by Al Mufti**

*Consigned by Klawervlei Stud*

This youngster is one of the highlights of the sale. A son of champion sire Jet Master, he is a half-brother to international champion Jay Peg (SAf) (Camden Park). Now standing at stud, Jay Peg won four Group 1 races during his career and over R40 million in prize money. His wins include scores in both the G1 Dubai Duty Free and G1 Singapore International Cup. This colt is also a half-brother to Group 3-winning sprinter Cyber Case (SAf) (Casey Tibbs {Ire}).

This miss was described by Klawervlei's Grant Knowles as a "wow horse." The bay is a half-sister to two winners, and her dam is a half-sister to stakes winner Winning Purple (SAf) (Complete Warrior).

**133, f, Var--Model I.Q. (SAf), by Jallad**

*Consigned by Avontuur Thoroughbred Farm*

A daughter of leading freshman sire Var, this bay is out of a winning half-sister to two multiple Group 2 winners in Royal I Q (SAf) (Dominion Royal {GB}) and Mentor (SAf) (National Assembly). Model I.Q. is also a half-sister to Group 1 performer My Kazzie (SAf) (Western Winter). "She stands over a lot of ground, and looks like she will stay further than her pedigree might suggest," Avontuur's stud manager Pippa Mickleburgh noted. "She is a nicely balanced, classy filly."

GI Three Chimneys Hopeful S. winner and GI Breeders' Cup Juvenile runner-up **Boys At Toscanova** (Officer) will skip Sunday's Gill Holy Bull S., it was announced yesterday. Co-owner Samantha Siegel told *TDN*, "The horse missed some training, and [trainer] Rick [Dutrow Jr.] thought that he's not 100 percent, so we're not going to run. Rick said [Wednesday] that he's doing better and he's sound, but he's too important a horse to

mess around with. All the scans and X-rays have been negative, but it's just frustrating not to understand completely what's going on. We have no immediate goals, other than to make sure that the horse is healthy. I told our partners that it would be great to run in the [GI Kentucky] Derby, obviously, but I also told them that there's lots of money that three-year-olds can run for all year long." In a press release, trainer Rick Dutrow Jr. said, "I don't see anything wrong with him. I don't think it would be smart to rush him into a race when we have a lot of time heading up to a race. He's not showing his usual high energy. It would be stupid to rush him."

**Printing Press Looking to Make the Grade...**

**Printing Press** (Tapit), third in the NATC Futurity and the Seton Hall University S. at Monmouth last fall and second in a one-mile allowance test in his 2011 bow Jan. 7, climbs the ladder for his second start of the year. The Klaravich Stables and William Lawrence colorbearer worked a half in :47 flat at Gulfstream Jan. 23, the second-fastest move at the distance that morning. "We think he's a nice horse," trainer Terri Pompay said. "But now he has to step up and show he can take his game to the next level. He's done everything right so far and is training great, so now it's up to him to prove what he can do in this kind of race." Pompay is cautiously optimistic about the colt's chances. "It's Gulfstream Park and pretty much any stakes race you run in down here is going to have a star in it," Pompay remarked. "We're going to take our shot to see what he can do."

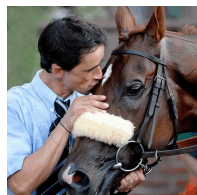

**ILLINOIS DERBY PURSE HALVED** Officials at Hawthorne Race Course applied for and received permission from the Illinois Racing Board to cut the purse for the GII Illinois Derby in half, from \$500,000 to \$250,000. Additionally, the track will postpone the spring's other graded stakes event, the GIII Sixty Sails H., until sometime during the fall meeting. Despite a statistically positive fall/winter stand in late 2010, Hawthorne had a difficult time overcoming a large purse overpayment and was forced into this action when the Illinois State Legislature failed to consider measures which would have boosted racetrack revenues. In addition to the stakes changes, Hawthorne will not race on Sundays, Mar. 27, and Apr. 3, 10 or 17, reducing the racing week to a four-day schedule and the total number of live racing programs from 46 to 42.

**FIVE STAKES UPGRADED IN CANADA FOR 2011**

The graded stakes committee of The Jockey Club of Canada has announced that there will be a total of 37 graded events run across the country in 2011, up from 35 in 2010. The five Grade I races remain unchanged, while the Connaught Cup S., a seven-furlong event on turf, has been bumped up to Grade II status from Grade III. Canada will now host a total of 11 Grade II races. Four stakes were hiked from listed to Grade III status: the Valedictory S., the Ontario Matron S., the Ontario Fashion S. and the Bessarabian S. All races carry purse money of C\$150,000 and take the overall number of Grade III tests to 22. Two races have been downgraded from Grade III to listed, the Mazarine S. at Woodbine and the BC Premier's S. at Hastings Park.

**HARBOR SPRINGS DIES** Harbor Springs (Vice Regent--Tinnitus, by Restless Wind), whose first foal Boston Harbor (Capote) won the 1996 GI Breeders' Cup Juvenile and was named that year's champion two-year-old, died yesterday at Craig and Carrie Brogden's Machmer Hall due to the infirmities of old age. The stakes-winning half-sister to champion Groovy was 22. Racing in the colors of W. T. Young's Overbrook Farm, Harbor Springs, a \$500,000 Keeneland July purchase, won in her first three trips to the post and seven of 11 overall before being retired with earnings just shy of \$200,000. She recorded a career-best in the 1993 Wishing Well S. and was bred a short time later to Capote. The result was Boston Harbor, who inherited his dam's precociousness, knocking down six of eight juvenile starts capped by his front-running Breeders' Cup score at Woodbine. Boston Harbor entered stud at Overbrook and stood there for a handful of seasons before being sent to Japan. Also the dam of SW Cloudburst (Storm Cat), Harbor Springs was purchased by Haymarket Farm/Machmer Hall for \$23,000 at the 2010 Keeneland January sale. The foal she was carrying at the time, a filly by Street Boss (Street Cry {Ire}), is being retained by Machmer Hall and Haymarket to race.

**NTRA REPORT FROM CAPITOL HILL**



**SPLIT CONGRESS CONSIDERS HEALTH CARE, TAX REFORM AND JOB CREATION**

With the 112th Congress under way, federal lawmakers are operating in a political environment not seen in 25 years - a split in control of the House and Senate between Republicans and Democrats, respectively.

Unsurprisingly, the split brings political maneuvering. The Obama administration's signature health care law was quickly tackled by House Republicans who voted to repeal the law. However, Senate Majority Leader [Harry Reid](#) (D-NV) has shown no interest in bringing the health care law repeal bill to the floor. Senate Minority Leader [Mitch McConnell](#) (R-KY) has promised that the Senate eventually will vote on it, as Senate rules allow.

Tax reform also is top of mind. Signaling Republican interest in tax overhaul legislation, new House Ways and Means Committee Chairman [Dave Camp](#) (R-MI) used his first hearing to address the issue, while House Democratic Whip [Steny Hoyer](#) (D-MD) released his ideas on tax reform.

Both sides agree on the need for job creation. In advance of Tuesday's State of the Union address that centered on this topic, President Obama released a [four minute video](#) highlighting his speech.
