UNCLE MO TOPS EXPERIMENTAL

The Jockey Club revealed Thursday that Repole Stable's unbeaten champion **Uncle Mo** (Indian Charlie) has been assigned a ranking of 128 pounds for the 2010 Experimental Free Handicap, two pounds above the

standard 126 top impost. He is the highest-weighted juvenile since Favorite Trick, who was weighted at 128 for his Horse of the Year campaign in 1997. Uncle Mo, a **"TDN Rising Star"**, captured both the GI Champagne S. and GI Breeders' Cup Juvenile during his perfect season. Five pounds below him at 123 is Live Oak's **To Honor and Serve** (Bernardini), winner of the

GII Remsen S. and GII Nashua S. Jay Em Ess Stable's **"TDN Rising Star"** **Boys At Tosconova** (Officer) was weighted at 122 pounds for winning the GI Three Chimneys Hopeful S. and finishing second in the BC Juvenile. Topping the fillies at 123 pounds was unbeaten champion **Awesome Feather** (Awesome of Course). The Florida-bred carried breeder Jacks or Better Farm's colors to victory in the GI Breeders' Cup Juvenile Fillies. Sharing a 120-pound impost were Bobby Flay's **More Than Real** (More Than Ready), winner of the GII BC Juvenile Fillies Turf; and unbeaten **Turbulent Descent** (Congrats), who carried the colors of Blinkers On Racing, et al, to victory in the GI Hollywood Starlet. The committee weighted a total of 99 males and 92 fillies. All two-year-olds of 2010 that finished among the top four in graded or listed stakes races run in the continental United States were eligible for weighting. Listed stakes in 2010 were those with a value of \$75,000 or more available to all starters, and no restrictions other than age or sex. Published annually since 1935, the weights are compiled by a committee of racing secretaries and based on a hypothetical race at 1 1/16 miles on the dirt. This year's weighting committee of racing secretaries was composed of Ben Huffman of Churchill Downs, P.J. Campo of the New York Racing Association and Thomas S. Cape Premier Yearling Sale

GOOD START FOR CAPE PREMIER SALE

The inaugural Cape Premier Yearling Sale attracted plenty of international interest yesterday, with buyers coming from all over the globe, and a pair of yearlings breaking the R2-million barrier. Leading the session was [lot 102](#), a colt by Jet Master (SAf), who realized a final bid of R2.5 million (*US\$354,286*) from prominent Gauteng owner Ebrahim Khan. A member of the Klawervlei Stud consignment, the dark bay--named One Sunday Morning--is out of Laptop Lady (SAf)

(Al Mufti), who produced South African Horse of the Year Jay Peg (SAf) (Camden Park). Jay Peg, who also won both the G1 Dubai Duty Free and G1 Singapore Airlines International Cup, now stands at Klawervlei.

Shortly after that, [lot 106](#), a son of Captain Al (SAf) attracted a bid of R2 million from Singapore-based trainer Pat Shaw. Shaw's current charges include top sprinter Rocket Man (Aus) (Viscount {Aus}). Consigned by Klipdrif Stud as agent, the bay colt is a half-brother to the Group 1-placed Lizarre (SAf) (Jet Master {SAf}), who is now based in Dubai.

Proven sires were in great demand during Thursday's session, with the stock of top sires Western Winter and Captain Al selling well. Jet Master, widely regarded as one of the best stallions currently at stud in South Africa, had two yearlings sell for R1 million or more. Also sought after were yearlings by Silvano (Ger), who was responsible for [lot 101](#), a colt acquired by Shadwell for R1.7 million. Offered by Varsfontein Stud, the son of Lady Windsor (SAf) (Al Mufti) hails from the family of GII BC Juvenile Turf hero Pluck (More Than Ready).

"Everyone has been tremendously positive and upbeat for this sale, and judging on what I have seen, they have every right to be," said Shadwell's Angus Gold, who signed the ticket for the Silvano colt. "The venue is wonderful, and there are a number of wonderful horses up for sale, who compare favourably with the horses I have bought at the country's National Sale. Despite being in the middle of a busy city, the horses at the sale have been remarkably settled and relaxed."

Also In attendance for the sale's unveiling was leading bloodstock agent Jehan Malherben, who was upbeat about the opening session.

"It is a wonderful concept, and the nice horses, like all sales, were hard to buy," Malherben offered.

In total, nine yearlings surpassed the R1-million mark during the opening session. Of 137 yearlings to pass through the ring, 105 changed hands--at a clearance rate of 76.7 percent. At the conclusion of the day, the aggregate was R43,680,000, and the average stood at R416,000.

Presvis finished last season with a ninth-place run in the G1 Prince of Wales's S. at Ascot. "They went quickly, which always helps him and he travels so strongly he almost pulls his way into the race," said pilot Ryan Moore. "He quickened nicely at the 200-meter pole to win his race in a few strides. Hopefully he is on target for the [Mar. 26] Dubai Duty Free."

The Factor Could be San Vicente-Bound...

George Bolton and Fog City Stable's ☆ "TDN Rising Star" ☆ The Factor (War Front) could resurface in the seven-furlong GII San Vicente S. at Santa Anita Feb. 20, conditioner Bob Baffert reported yesterday. The \$250,000 BESMAY topper, who broke Santa Anita's six-furlong track record with an 8 1/4-length maiden breaker Dec. 26, has not recorded a work since drilling a speedy :58.00 for five furlongs over the Arcadia oval Jan. 9. "He didn't need a breeze," explained Baffert.

SECOND-CROP STAREDOWN

Since we last looked at the *TDN's* Second-Crop Cumulative Earnings List three weeks ago, no new sire has cracked the Top 10, though there has been some movement within the rankings. One that has stayed put is Vinery's **Congrats** (A.P. Indy), who has maintained his hold on the number-one spot with \$1,698,904 in earnings.

Congrats ended 2010 with 12 stakes horses to his credit, and since then, daughter Scarlet Starlet has made it a baker's dozen. The Doug O'Neill-conditioned filly finished third in the three-horse GIII Santa Ysabel S. at Santa Anita Jan. 9 ([video](#)). She was beaten 1 1/2 lengths by the crowd's heavy favorite May Day Rose, a daughter of another sophomore sire, **Rockport Harbor** (Unbridled's Song).

Scarlet Starlet becomes the fifth graded horse from Congrats' first crop; May Day Rose, one of two juvenile stakes winners for her sire, is Rockport Harbor's first graded winner.

May Day Rose, incidently, caused a minus win pool-- of over \$18,000. She hails from a Bob Baffert barn that can do no wrong at Santa Anita--he was hitting at a 43-percent clip (19/44) heading into Thursday's card.

Splitting May Day Rose and Scarlet Starlet in the Santa Ysabel (an all sophomore 1-2-3 was guaranteed with the late scratch of two rivals) was Bluegrass Chatter, by **Bluegrass Cat** (Storm Cat). She is now her sire's fifth graded horse, which puts Bluegrass Cat, Congrats and current fourth-placed sire

Bernardini (A.P. Indy) as the leaders in that category. She also helped bump Bluegrass Cat up to the second spot on the Second-Crop List. More of the credit for that bump, however, goes to a filly many regard as the best in her division, at least with **Awesome Feather** (Awesome of Course) on the sidelines. That horse is **Kathmanblu**. The versatile **Ken McPeck** charge, third in the GII Breeders' Cup Juvenile Fillies Turf and a decisive winner of Churchill's GII Golden Rod S. on the dirt at two, made a successful 2011 bow in the Sweetest Chant S. at Gulfstream Jan. 22 (90 Beyer) ([video](#)). Bluegrass Cat also has four new maiden special weight winners since the new year (at Aqueduct, Laurel, Turfway and Golden Gate) and a pair of horses that finished third in stakes, **Bluegrass Bull** and **Bluegrass Dreamer**.

Making the jump from ninth to sixth on the list is the Florida-based **With Distinction** (Storm Cat). The Grade III winner, a half-brother to the dam of GSW Sightseeing (Pulpit), drew attention at last year's juvenile sales when several from his first crop sold well, including a pair who went for \$200,000. Word on the street was that they were big, stretchy horses, and took plenty from **With Distinction's** damsire **Alydar**. In any case, the **Hartley/De Renzo** stallion can thank his son **Decisive Moment** for the big leap forward. Runner-up in November's \$1 million GIII Delta Downs Jackpot S., **Decisive Moment**, a \$70,000 RNA at OBSAPR, came back to air by 3 1/2 lengths in the \$250,000 **Jean Lafitte S.** at Delta Jan. 14 ([video](#)).

Sharp Humor (Distorted Humor), another who stands at WinStar, sits in eighth on the Second-Crop Sire List, down a notch despite recording his third black-type winner in the form of **Angelica Zapata**. The bay filly skimmed the rail to a good-looking victory in the \$50,000 **Cincinnati Trophy S.** at Turfway Jan. 22 ([video](#)). He is one of five sophomores with at least three black-type winners, joining **Bellamy Road** (Concerto), Congrats, **Kodiak (GB)** (Danehill) and **War Front** (Danzig). Darley's **Bernardini** and Coolmore's **Aussie Rules** (Danahill) share top billing with four black-type winners each. **Hot List cont. p10**

If you remember, Sharp Humor had two juveniles who sold big from the WinStar horses-in-training draft at Keeneland November. Stakes winner Glint, purchased by Kevin and Tammie Hulse for \$340,000, has three works since the sale, including an easy four-furlong move at Oaklawn Tuesday in :51 flat. The maiden-winning filly Funny Sunny, acquired by Mandy Pope's Whisper Hill Farm for \$380,000, also has three drills, including a smart 1:00 flat drill at Gulfstream Jan. 20. She's entered in a first-level allowance going 6 1/2 furlongs on the main track this Sunday for trainer Bob Hess Jr.

Of the aforementioned Bellamy Road and Bernardini: both had good-looking maiden special weight winners

recently. The former suffered a tough blow when his undefeated daughter Position Limit suffered a season-ending--and possible career-ending--ankle injury in September. Prior to that, she was a 6 3/4-length winner sprinting 5 1/2 panels on debut at Belmont in July, then won off by five lengths in the Gill Adirondack S. in August. The folks at Pauls Mill, where Bellamy Road

stands, hope that last weekend's maiden special weight winner Lumberyard Jack develops into a horse who can help fill her horseshoes. The Mike Stidham-trained gelding drew off to a two-length win at Fair Grounds Jan. 22 in his second career start, earning an 86 BRIS figure ([video](#)).

A week earlier at Gulfstream, meanwhile, Bernardini's Heron Lake looked like a racehorse in the making when he took his debut going seven furlongs for the Bob LaPenta/Nick Zito team ([video](#)).

Three Chimneys' **Flower Alley** (Distorted Humor) has had two black-type winners so far in 2011. Bouquet Booth, who rallied to victory in the Gill Delta Downs Princess S. in November, then came back to get her neck down in last Saturday's Silverbulletday S. at Fair Grounds ([video](#)). She was a savvy \$30,000 OBSJUN purchase by Right Time Racing and trainer Steve Margolis. She's got some pedigree, too, as she's from the immediate family of Riskaverse (Dynaformer), et al. Previously, on New Year's Day, Flower Alley got the second stakes winner in Lilacs and Lace, heroine of the \$100,000 California Oaks ([video](#)), while Sassy's Dream looked like another promising daughter after winning a Gulfstream MSW by daylight Jan. 13 ([video](#)).

War...and What It's Good For

Claiborne Farm's War Front has emerged as one of the bright young stars of his crop. He's an easy horse to root for, being one of the last from Claiborne's late, great Danzig, as well as being a former pupil of the

great Allen Jerkens. Only Hard Spun remains of Danzig's young major sire prospects...at least in the U.S.

War Front concluded the 2010 season ranked fifth on the *TDN's* First-Crop List with \$1,158,265 in cumulative earnings. His 19 individual winners from 39 starters represented an eye-

catching winner/starter percentage of 48.7 percent. His three juvenile stakes winners trailed only Bernardini, and was on even terms with Bellamy Road, Congrats and Sharp Humor.

A closer look at War Front's stakes winners reveal some interesting trends, including the fact that all three hail from Mr. Prospector-line mares, and are thus inbred yet another sire who called Claiborne home (War Front is out of Starry Dreamer, by Rubiano, by Mr. P's son Fappiano).

- **WARNING FLAG** - A colt owned by Michael Tabor and trained by David Wachman, Warning Flag broke his maiden in his second career start on the all-weather at Dundalk Sept. 5. Stepped up to the Listed Star Appeal S. at that course Oct. 8, Warning Flag showed good energy late to best another Tabor horse in Park Avenue (Ire) (Mr. Greeley). He followed that initial black-type win with a no-threat second to Dubai Prince (Ire) (Shamardal) in the G3 Killavullan S. at Leopardstown Oct. 25. Bred by the Good Vibes Syndicate, Warning Flag was produced by the Unbridled's Song mare Good Vibes, herself the product of a rare breeding done by trainer Nick Zito. (Zito, of course, trained Unbridled's Song for two starts at the end of the big gray's career). From her sire's first crop, Good Vibes took her grass and route debut in a Monmouth maiden special weight in July of 2002, her lone win from four starts. As a broodmare, she produced four winners from four to race before Warning Flag, but no stakes horses. Good Vibes's dam Rose Jade (Jade Hunter) didn't produce any stakes horses, either, though she herself was a half to three stakes winners.

- **TENSAS PUNCH** - A filly owned and trained by Merrill Scherer and bred in Louisiana by Curt Leake. After making three of her first four starts in claiming company, Tensas Punch stepped up to win the \$250,000 Louisiana Jewel S. at Delta Downs Nov. 20. Like Warning Flag, she's out of a Mr. Prospector-line stallion, albeit a much different branch than Fappiano. She is a son of the little-known stallion Pulling Punches, by Mr. Prospector's son Two Punch. Tensas Punch's dam, Indy Punch, is a half-sister to the good racehorse Galloping Gal (Victory Gallop), winner of two stakes and runner-up in the GII Darley Alcibiades S. in 2003.
- **SOLDAT** - War Front's big horse last year, the colt ran second in two starts on the dirt for trainer Kiaran McLaughlin and owners Harvey Clarke and Craig Robertson III. McLaughlin stretched Soldat out and moved him to the lawn in the GIII With Anticipation S. at Saratoga, and Soldat responded by breaking his maiden by a stylish three lengths. He then ran second, to Air Support (Smart Strike), in the GIII Pilgrim S. and to Pluck (More Than Ready) in the GII Breeders' Cup Juvenile Turf. Despite being a graded winner on the spinach, it was perhaps Soldat's latest effort--in allowance company--that raised the most eyebrows. Returning to the main track in his 2011 bow, he dominated a seemingly graded-stakes-caliber field by 10 3/4 lengths at Gulfstream Jan. 21 ([video](#)). The Beyer Speed Figure he earned, a 102, is the highest in the country for a horse of any age at a mile or more. The caveat is that the win came on a sloppy track, and even McLaughlin said it was still a question of how Soldat will handle dry underfoot conditions. But it understandably has his connections thinking Derby trail, and at very least it booked his ticket to the GII Fountain of Youth S. at Gulfstream Feb. 26. Soldat, too, was produced by a daughter of a Mr. P-line stallion in Coronado's Quest, who is coming on strongly as a broodmare sire. Coronado's Quest's daughters have produced the likes of Grade I winners Kodiak Cowboy (Posse), Boys at Toscanova (Officer) and Mani Bhavan (Storm Boot), as well as the impressive Dubai performer Mendip (Harlan's Holiday). Soldat's dam is the unraced seven-year-old Le Relais, a daughter of the SP Malbay (Apalachee) and a half to GSW Mulrainy (Star de Naskra).

While Soldat has established himself on the East Coast, War Front's son The Factor has been the most-talked-about maiden winner in California since...who? Rags to Riches? Fusaichi Pegasus? Fusaichi *Samurai*? Ah, who knows. But the Bob Baffert-trained colt wowed 'em in his second career start on Santa Anita's opening day Dec. 26. The handsome gray, a \$250,000 BESMAY juvenile purchase by George Bolton and Fog City Stable, ripped through fractions of :21 3/5, :44 and :55 2/5 before stopping the clock in 1:06.98 ([video](#)). The winning margin was 8 1/4 lengths, and the final time over Santa Anita's new--and still lightning fast--dirt course established a new course record.

Fast track or not, the colt clearly has a V-10 for an engine, though it's anyone's guess whether he'll be able to throttle that speed and be effective at routes. His innate ability alone, however, should make him fun to follow. The Factor has only one official work since, a five-furlong drill in :58 flat (3/53) at Santa Anita Jan. 9.

The Factor is yet another War Front produced by a mare hailing from Mr. Prospector. His dam, the winning

Greyciousness, is by Miswaki. Any clues to The Factor's ability to handle two turns, based on pedigree, are inconclusive. Greyciousness won twice, facing maiden \$40,000 claimers at Hollywood going six furlongs, and then against \$62,500 claimers on the grass going 1 1/16 miles.

She has produced three winners other than The Factor. Two won up to six furlongs; the third won up to one mile and 70 yards. None earned black-type.

Greyciousness' biggest claim to fame, before The Factor, is that she's a half-sister to GI Breeders' Cup Juvenile runner-up Chief Seattle (Seattle Slew).

Since the beginning of the year, War Front also has two grassy allowance winners at Gulfstream, the filly War Prospector (who, ironically, is not out of a Mr. Prospector-line stallion--her dam's by Unaccounted For, a grandson of Damascus) and the colt Data Link (dam by Known Fact, by In Reality). And on Monday, Great Mills improved to two-for-two on the grass when he won a 5 1/2-furlong dash at Fair Grounds by two lengths. The Millennium Farms homebred is out of a Known Fact mare.

ADW was not affected. The CHRB has been advised that the \$3,896 wagered at California racetracks and simulcast facilities was never merged with the Turf Paradise pools, so the problem did not affect the integrity of the Turf Paradise pools. All legitimate winning wagers placed prior to the start of the race by persons at California racetracks and simulcast facilities will be paid, while the 84 tickets purchased after the start of the race will be refunded. The CHRB will issue a full report when its investigation is completed.
