### CLASSIC UPSET

**Tackleberry** (Montbrook), winner of Calder's Jack Dudley Sprint H. in November and GIII Fred W. Hooper H. in December, came out of the gate firing in Saturday's Sunshine Millions Classic at Gulfstream Park and kept finding in the stretch to record a 27-1 wire-to-wire upset over **Duke of Mischief** (Graeme Hall). Favored **First Dude** (Stephen Got Even) got tagged late for third. "He loves to run and wants the lead," owner/trainer Luis Olivares said of Tackleberry, who entered off a fourth-place finish in the

GIII Hal's Hope S. Jan. 8. "Last time he stumbled and broke bad at the start, and didn't get to run his race. He's a fighter. He looks like he's dead at the top the stretch and he fights back. I might run him back next weekend. This is the biggest purse I've won."

**Dancing in her dreams** (Tapit). The promising gray makes her first start since blowing away six rivals in the GII Pocahontas S. at Churchill Oct. 31. "It's a quality field of horses and, if she's going to be vulnerable, it's going to be at seven-eighths of a mile against this type of speed," trainer John Ward told *Daily Racing Form*. "But she's doing good and she'll run her race. I think there should be an honest early pace, and it will strictly be up to [Julien Lejaroux] to figure out how the track is playing and where to place her. Holy Bull morning-line favorite **Mucho Macho Man**, second-best behind the very talented To Honor and Serve (Bernardini) in his last two attempts at the Big A, finally doesn't have to worry about that rival here. The bay has been lighting up the Gulfstream worktab in preparation of his three-year-old debut, firing three five-furlong bullets in January. "He couldn't be doing any better," trainer Kathy Ritvo told DRF. "I don't think I could have him any sharper, and I'm very confident he's going to go out and run his race. I'm not sure a mile is really a comfortable distance for him, but he always breaks sharp, and is quick enough to sit close."

Jockey Javier Santiago has been aboard Tackleberry in all 10 of his career starts. "The trainer told me to go to the lead no matter what," Santiago commented. "He said this horse does his best when he's on the lead. I was a little surprised there wasn't more pressure on me, but I guess the other riders saw my horse as a longshot and left us alone. In the stretch, I was asking him and asking him--I wasn't looking back at anybody else." First Dude, last year's popular GI Preakness S. runner-up and GI Belmont S. third-place finisher, remains eligible for a first-level allowance following a disappointing off-the-board finish as the 4-5 chalk. Jockey Kent Desormeaux guided the massive bay to the outside on the clubhouse turn after breaking from post one. "I did run into traffic on the first turn, but it was mission accomplished," Desormeaux said. "We wanted to take him off the pace today, and I was able to do that. He hasn't been performing up to what the team thinks he should, so we wanted to get him to the outside and give him his best chance."

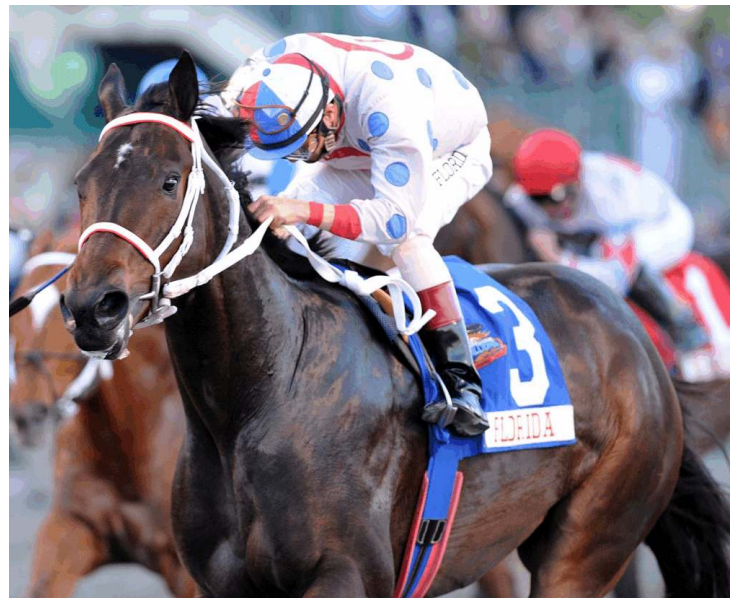

Say hello to my little friend! Caracortado, Spanish for Scarface, won his first five career starts, including the GI Robert B. Lewis S. at Santa Anita last February.

Fourth in the GI Santa Anita Derby, the chestnut earned a vacation following a seventh-place finish in the GI Preakness S. May 15. Caracortado returned to the races in style, successfully switching to grass in a Hollywood Park optional claimer Nov. 11, and entered off a good third in the GI Malibu S. over

Santa Anita's dirt Dec. 26. Settled in fifth through a half mile in :47.02 as Presious Passion (Royal Anthem) took his customary spot on the lead, Caracortado made a flashy move to reach contention on the turn for home and outkicked GI Breeders' Cup Mile third-place finisher The Usual Q. T. to the wire for a good-looking victory.

"The Sunshine Millions has always been really good to us, and to win this race, and managing this horse to get to this point, has been very satisfying," owner/breeder Mike Machowsky said, who also campaigned Southern Image to a win in the 2004 S/M Classic. "The great thing about him is he's run on every surface so far. Right now, percentages would point to staying on the turf, but he's so versatile I'm just going to play out my options." As for what's next he continued, "Right now, Mar. 5 will be the date, whether it's the [GI] Kilroe Mile [on turf] or the [GI] Santa Anita H. [on dirt], we'll just wait and see how it all plays out. At the level he's at now, every race is going to be a tough, tough race, but I want to make it as easy as possible on him. He's a gelding and I want him racing with us a long time."

J. had a three-race skein snapped when she ran fourth in the off-the-turf Judy's Red Shoes H. at Calder Sept. 24, but she rebounded to take the Calder Oaks by 5 3/4 lengths Oct. 16. Unplaced once more on that deep main track in the Elmer Heubeck Distaff H. Nov. 13, the chestnut couldn't quite hold off Askbut I Won'ttell in the Gill My Charmer H. Dec. 4 and settled for second. In her most recent appearance, the Peter Fuller homebred was a close fifth in the Gill Marshua's River H. over this course Jan. 9. Trip for A. J. came away cleanly from post two and secured a perfect spot on the rail in fourth, while favored Dynaslew (Dynaformer)--who had been fractious in the gate--raced keenly alongside.

Millionairess Evening Jewel was one of the very best --and arguably most versatile--members of her generation last term. During a busy campaign, she was first or second in seven of nine while never missing the frame. She took Keeneland's GI Ashland S. by a neck in April, then was just tagged by Blind Luck (Pollard's Vision) in the GI Kentucky Oaks at Churchill in late April. She did her best to make amends for that tough beat, winning her next three on the lawn: the GII Honeymoon H. at Hollywood in May, the GII San Clemente S. at Del Mar in July, and the GI Del Mar Oaks in August. She closed out her season with a pair of fine third-place efforts, to Harmonious (Dynaformer) in the GI Queen Elizabeth II Cup at Keeneland in October and to Dubai Majesty (Essence of Dubai) in the GI Breeders' Cup Filly & Mare Sprint at Churchill. The new year was off to an inauspicious start when she ran a well-beaten fifth to course ace Unzip Me (City Zip) in the GIII Monrovia S. down the hillside turf Jan. 2, a rare lackluster effort that left the bettors soft on her in this return to the main track. The tepid 2-1 choice given her credentials, she saved ground in seventh, launched a three-wide bid into the lane, wore down a game Amazing to get the lead and safely held the closing Ultra Blend. Trainer James Cassidy admitted Evening Jewel's last effort had him questioning whether her mind was still on racing. I still had horse underneath me. If anything had to come, he could have run with them through to the line. He won nicely, very easily." 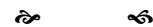

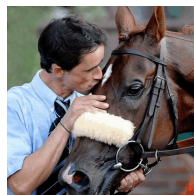

**Court Rules on Kingmambo/Lemon Drop Kid Shares:**

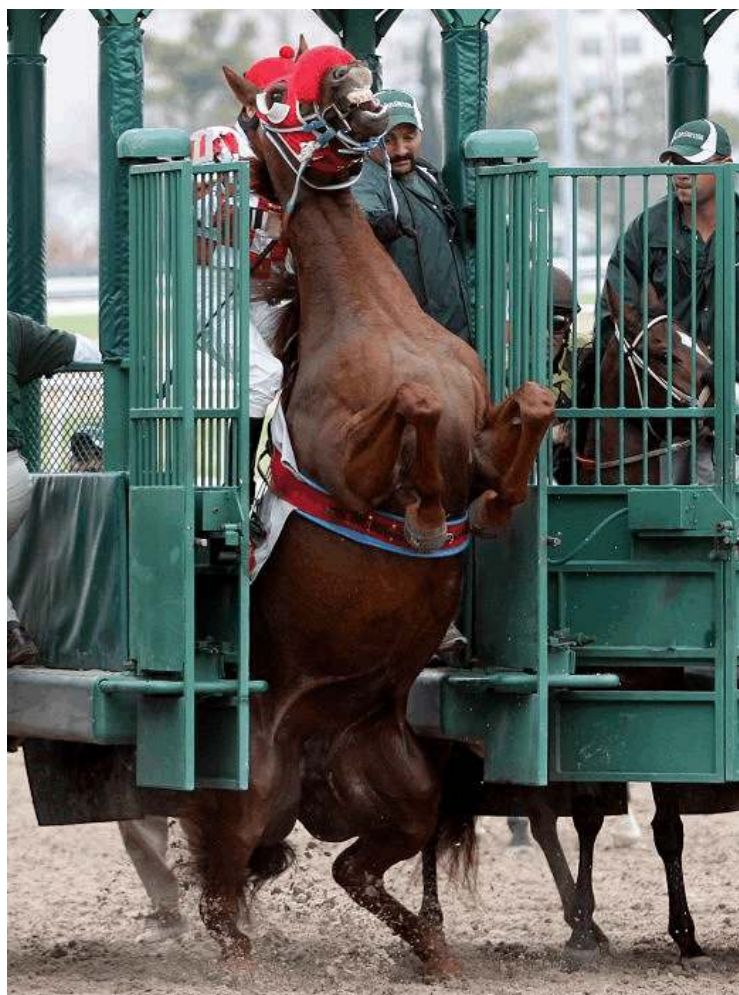
U. S. District Court Judge Karen K. Caldwell ruled Friday that shareholders in Lane's End stallions Kingmambo (Mr. Prospector) and Lemon Drop Kid (Kingmambo) must now be offered right of first refusal on shares in the two sires that syndicate members have offered for sale. Ashley Andrews, who owns a share in Lemon Drop Kid, and Andrews and Robert Raphaelson, who co-own a share in Kingmambo, came to an agreement with a group called KNC Investments to sell the two shares last September. Under the terms of the agreement, KNC would pay \$350,000 for the Lemon Drop Kid share, and \$175,000 for the Kingmambo share, with a \$50,000 commission from each of the purchase prices going to KNC principal Jerry Jamgotchian, who acted as a dual agent on the transactions. Lane's End, as syndicate manager for the two stallions, would normally have notified shareholders of the impending sales, giving them seven days to match the offers, but was granted a temporary restraining order on the deadline. "That TRO was based on Lane's End's assertions in its initial Complaint and Temporary Injunction that the notices it received from Jamgotchian insufficiently detailed the terms and conditions of the KNC offer and failed to detail the commission to be paid Jamgotchian," Judge Caldwell said in decision. "There is no dispute that KNC has now sufficiently disclosed to Lane's End all of the terms and conditions of the KNC offers, including information regarding Jamgotchian's commission. Accordingly, the TRO will be dissolved." Explaining Lane's End's decision to take the case to court, their attorney William Hoskins III told *Daily Racing Form* that Lane's End was "seeking the court's advice on notices to the members of two syndicates regarding offers made to purchase shares in those syndicates. Lane's End requested the court's advice because of the very unusual factual circumstances presented by the offers." The farm also questioned the commissions involved. "Given all that, we thought it best and appropriate how we should handle it," Hoskins continued. "The court has now given us the advice we requested and, frankly, we appreciate the court's efforts and intend to proceed in accordance with the advice the court gave us." Kingmambo was pensioned last fall, but, according to *DRF*, Jamgotchian stated that KNC is still willing to buy the share.

Runflatout was picked up for \$22,000 as a yearling at FTKOCT, but blossomed over the winter. Catalogued at Barretts March, the dark bay worked in an eighth in :10 at Fairplex and wound up going for \$165,000. He was sent to trainer Carla Gaines and, though he was entered at Del Mar, didn't see afternoon action, and wound up being transferred to John Sadler's shedrow. Going postward as the 2-1 second choice to Bob Baffert trainee Tokubetsu (Congaree), Runflatout traveled ominously in second as the 6-5 chalk put up splits of :22.19 and :44.53. Jockey Garrett Gomez gave him a tap on the shoulder on the turn, and the colt drew even entering the stretch. They raced in tandem before Runflatout asserted himself stylishly, crossing the line 2 1/2 lengths clear as Gomez remained motionless in the final 100 yards. Tokubetsu remained 8 1/2 lengths clear of stablemate Midnight Interlude (War Chant). Slammin' Lil has a two-year-old Flatter colt, and was bred back to the Claiborne stallion last spring. **RUNFLATOUT (Flatter)**

**Out-Sized Success...**

Runflatout is the product of a pinhooking partnership between Terry Finley's West Point Thoroughbreds and Florida horseman David Scanlon, who runs the breaking and training operation Scanlon Training Center. West Point's primary bloodstock agent Buzz Chace unearthed the colt at the 2009 Fasig-Tipton Fall Yearling Sale in Kentucky from Grade I Bloodstock's draft. The price tag was a mere \$22,000.

"I bought from the first crop of Flatter--I had bought a horse named Flat Bold [an allowance winner at Aqueduct Friday for West Point]--and I thought he was a sire who had a chance of making it," Chace said of the A.P. Indy stallion, a full-brother to the 2010 leading freshman sire Congrats. "Those guys wanted to pinhook some horses at a reasonable price, and he was an athletic type of horse who had some ability. He was a racy, nice individual--a very straight-forward horse."

Chace has enjoyed considerable success buying from the Fasig Kentucky October sale. His buys there include graded winners GISW Into Mischief (Harlan's Holiday) (\$80,000), GSW True Quality (Elusive Quality) (\$280,000) and MGSW El Gato Malo (El Corredor) (\$95,000)--all of whom were purchased at the same 2006 renewal--as well as MSW Achilles of Troy (Notebook) (\$120,000).

"I can just go on and on about that sale," said Chace. "You can find a really nice athlete there. You don't have to have a ton of pedigree, but you have to have a little bit to get them across the wire."

Runflatout was sent to Scanlon, and he made a favorable impressive despite being a bit rough around the edges.

"He was young and very immature--he was a late foal," said Scanlon. "He was coming around a little more, a little more, and we were just hoping he'd get there by Barretts sale. He was one that just floated over the ground. He's got a real easy, natural stride. Going out to Barretts, I told Terry, 'Boy, this horse can really run.' But he was still a baby--he still had that look to him."

Entered in the Barretts March Sale in Pomona, California, Runflatout gassed an eighth in :10 flat. Chace was duly impressed with the horse's development.

"David took him out to California, and when I saw him out there, he was all I thought he was going to be," said Chace. "So Terry and I talked it over, and we decided to keep the horse and buy David out." West Point signed the ticket for \$165,000.

Runflatout is something of an exception, given they had a 50-percent interest in the horse, but West Point and Chace have also enjoyed success at Barretts March, where they landed eventual Grade I winner Awesome Gem (Awesome Again) for \$150,000.

Runflatout was originally sent to trainer Carla Gaines, whom Chace credits for putting a good foundation into the colt, before being moved to John Sadler's barn.

Scanlon was jogging on a treadmill yesterday when he started getting congratulatory texts regarding Runflatout's big win, including one from Finley.

"You know, Terry had said before that the horse got sick a few times [as a two-year-old], and he said, 'Boy, what a blessing that might have been,'" related Scanlon. "They turned him out for a little bit, and that time off probably was great for him."

Runflatout was produced by the Grand Slam mare Slamming Lil', who won twice going a mile over Turfway's dirt track in 2003, one facing maiden specials, once against allowance foes. She later took a one-mile allowance at Mountaineer in her only other victory.

Asked whether he thought Runflatout would be able to get a distance of ground, Scanlon said, "His demeanor was very much like that of a two-turn horse. Plus he has a real high cruising speed. He could cruise, but then he always had an extra gear. So I wouldn't be surprised if he gets a route of ground."

Scanlon and West Point teamed on three or four yearling-to-juvenile pinhooks.

"Buzz has a heck of an eye, and any time you get a chance to have him pick out a horse for you, it's always a good thing," said Scanlon, who added Runflatout was always the star of the group.

The team at Scanlon Training Center will be paying close attention to this afternoon's GIII Holy Bull S. at Gulfstream--the farm broke Robert LaPenta's Dialed In (Mineshaft).

"He was a real pretty, nice horse," said Scanlon. "He's one they bought just to race. He was a pretty expensive baby, and we thought he'd be a nice horse. He was a real typical Nick Zito horse--a horse who was going to really come around in the fall and be a horse for the spring."

Zito trains Dialed In, as well as another potential young star owned by LaPenta and broken by Scanlon, the first-out Gulfstream maiden winner Heron Lake (Bernardini).

"Heron Lake was a horse last year that we were really touting," said Scanlon. "We had everyone at the farm coming to look at him, and I thought we had him really dialed in. I told Mr. LaPenta, 'We're going to go to the sale and top this thing. They're going to have to bring a freak to beat us.' Then he ended up chipping an ankle, and Mr. LaPenta bought him back for \$800,000. I really thought he'd bring \$2 million. But it turns out that's pretty lucky for Mr. LaPenta. The same thing happened to [champion juvenile colt] War Pass. They're going to have to start calling it the 'lucky chip.'"

Scanlon said that his current crop of two-year-olds is shaping up well. "I've got a really good group of horses --a Tiznow, a few Bernardinis, I've got a nice Empire Maker," he said. "We've got all the right sires, and right now, they're looking like race horses." -LM
