"They approached us and expressed an interest in the horse, and we struck a deal," said Olin Gentry, managing director for Thoroughbred Legends Racing Stable. "In the end, it was just a good business decision for us to make." Carrying the colors of Thoroughbred Legends, the dark bay captured the GII Pennsylvania Derby last fall and capped his sophomore season

with a second in the GI Breeders' Cup Dirt Mile. In his first 2010 appearance, he finished third in the GIII Hal's Hope H. at Gulfstream Jan. 8. Morning Line, who will remain in the care of trainer Nick Zito, will reportedly be pointed for the \$10-million G1 Dubai World Cup at Meydan Mar. 26. Drawn in the three hole with rider John Velazquez in the Donn, the four-year-old will carry 119 pounds, three pounds less than stablemate and highweight **Fly Down** (Mineshaft).

**FIRST FOAL FOR DUAL CHAMP INDIAN BLESSING**

Hal and Patti Earnhardt's two-time champion **Indian Blessing** (Indian Charlie--Shameful, by Flying Chevron) produced her first foal Jan. 30, a colt by Zensational (Unbridled's Song). The six-year-old mare is boarded at Hill 'n' Dale Farms in Lexington, Kentucky. Bred by the Earnhardts, the dark bay earned an Eclipse Award for her two-year-old campaign that included wins in the GI Breeders' Cup Juvenile Fillies and GI Frizette S. She was named champion female sprinter during her three-year-old season, when she captured the GI La Brea S., GI Test S., GI Prioress S., GII Gallant Bloom H. and GII Santa Ynez S. Indian Blessing was also runner-up in the 2008 BC F/M Sprint at Santa Anita and the 2009 G1 Dubai Golden Shaheen, and retired with an enviable record of 16-10-5-0 and a bankroll of \$2,995,420. Her 2011 mating plans have not yet been decided.

Five Group 1 winners go postward, including last year's G1 Dubai Duty Free hero **Al Shemali**. The seven-year-old, who has not been out since running third in the G1 Singapore Airlines International Cup May 16, will tackle the all-weather here. The long-term goal is the G1 Dubai World Cup next month. "He has won on the all-weather, but not at this level," trainer Ali Rashid Al Raihe said, adding, "He will improve for the outing, but we would love a go at the Dubai World Cup itself this year, and this is the obvious place to start." **Bold Silvano**, sidelined since taking the G1 Durban July S. July 31, is also targeting the World Cup. He makes his Dubai and synthetic debut for trainer Mike de Kock. "He is not 100-percent fit, certainly, but definitely ready for a race," de Kock said. "He is working well in the mornings [on the all-weather], and we are very hopeful he can transfer his turf form to the new surface. It should be a true test with such a high-class field."

J P's Gusto (Successful Appeal), who won four straight stakes last season, capped by an easy 4 1/2-length victory in the GI Del Mar Futurity, will make his sophomore debut in the one-mile GIII Southwest S. at Oaklawn Park Feb. 21, *Daily Racing Form* reports.

Owned by John Waken's GEM Inc., the bay was being pointed for the GII San Vicente S. over seven furlongs Feb. 20 prior to the change of heart. "We like the distance and we like the spot," Steve Bajen, racing manager to Waken, told the *Form*. "We'd like to showcase him for the rest of the country." In his lone previous appearance on a conventional dirt surface, J P's

Gusto was a distant sixth to Uncle Mo (Indian Charlie) in the GI Breeders' Cup Juvenile Nov. 6. He bounced back nicely in his most recent appearance, rallying from seventh to be runner-up to Comma to the Top (Bwana Charlie) in the GI CashCall Futurity at Hollywood Park Dec. 18. In the Southwest, J P's Gusto will have the services of Eclipse Award winner Ramon Dominguez for the first time.

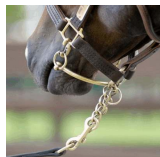

opening session of New Zealand Bloodstock's three-day Select Yearling Sale in Karaka Wednesday. Consigned by Trelawney Stud, the bay was purchased by New Zealand trainer Roger James. James trained Sayyida, a winning half-sister to the dam of G1SW Prince Kaapstad (NZ) (Kaapstad {NZ}). The leading buyer at Wednesday's session was Willie Leung's Magus Equine, which acquired six yearlings for an aggregate NZ\$630,000. His top-priced yearling on the day was [lot 658](#), a colt by Holy Roman Emperor (Ire) (Danahill).

Leung also bought three lots during the Premier Sale. "I

am happy to see very nice horses here, but also at an available price," Leung said. "My most expensive purchase, the Holy Roman Emperor colt, was bought because the family produces very nice horses in Australia, and it was a nice type. He might need a bit more time, but I think he will be a good miler, and they are doing very well in Europe, which is why I was prepared to pay a higher, but still reasonable, price." He added, "I'm looking forward to the rest of the sale, and have two or three other horses that I will try for as well." NZB Co-Managing Director Petrea Vela said, "Buyers are reporting that the market is still very competitive at this session, and quality lots are still tough to buy. A few more local buyers have made their presence felt today, which is encouraging, but there are also a number of international buyers who have stayed on from the Premier Sale hoping to find some value. While buyers are being selective in their purchasing, we're hopeful that the quality on offer will encourage some good competition over the next few days." ## PREAKNESS HEADLINES PIMLICO SCHEDULE

The Maryland Jockey Club revealed a 2011 Pimlico spring stakes schedule worth \$2.9 million, highlighted by the \$1-million GI Preakness S. May 21. The Maryland Racing Commission, which will meet Feb. 15, still needs to approve the proposed schedule. In addition to the second jewel of the Triple Crown, the Baltimore oval will host six other graded stakes, including the \$250,000 GII Black-Eyed Susan S. May 20 and the \$100,000 GIII Allaire

duPont Distaff on the Preakness undercard. The latter was shelved last year due to a purse shortage. "Having a strong stakes schedule during the Pimlico meet is vital for our success," said Maryland Jockey Club President Tom Chuckas. "The Preakness weekend experience is strengthened with the return of the Distaff and the purse increase for the Black-Eyed Susan. We are working hard to increase the profile of the entire week, not just focusing on the third Saturday in May." ## NTRA SAFETY & INTEGRITY ALLIANCE REPORT

### INDEPENDENT MONITOR THOMPSON ISSUES PUBLIC REPORT

The Honorable Tommy G. Thompson, the former four-term Governor of Wisconsin and U.S. Secretary of Health and Human Services who now serves as the independent monitor for the [NTRA Safety and Integrity Alliance](#), yesterday issued his [public report on the Alliance for 2010](#).

The Alliance was formed in October 2008 to establish national uniform standards in the areas of safety and integrity. The Alliance includes 55 racetracks and every major U.S. horsemen's organization.

The Alliance operates through a [Code of Standards](#) and an [accreditation process](#). The Code sets forth a common minimum set of standards for participating racetracks and their horsemen. The Code covers (1) injury reporting and prevention; (2) creating a safer racing environment; (3) medication and testing; (4) jockey safety and health; (5) aftercare of retired horses; and (6) wagering security. Each year's Code contains new standards and protocols, continuously raising the bar for accreditation, compliance and excellence in racing.

**INDEPENDENT MONITOR ISSUES REPORT ON NTRA SAFETY ALLIANCE**

The Honorable Tommy Thompson, the former governor of Wisconsin and head of the U.S. Department of Health and Human Services who serves the National Thoroughbred Racing Association as the independent monitor for the organization's Safety and Integrity Alliance, yesterday issued a 12-page report ([click for full text](#)), covering the progress made by the Alliance since its inception in 2008. While the report lauded the significant and numerous safety improvements at the 19 racetracks accredited thus far, it also expressed disappointment that just five tracks pursued accreditation in 2010, while citing the prevailing difficult economic climate as a possible contributing factor. The Alliance set out to give its stamp of approval to 20

tracks in each of its first two years of operation. "This is particularly disconcerting due to the fact that 55 racetracks originally pledged their support of the Alliance, yet, as of the end of 2010, not all of them have participated in the accreditation process," the report stated. Racetracks that have received accreditation to date include: Aqueduct, Belmont, Canterbury Park, Churchill Downs, Delaware Park, Del Mar, Fair Grounds, Finger Lakes (pending), Golden Gate Fields, Hollywood Park, Keeneland, Monmouth Park, Pimlico Oak Tree/Santa Anita, Sunland Park, Turfway Park and Woodbine. "The number of accreditations may seem small in quantity, but it should be recognized that the tracks accredited thus far represent most of racing's premier venues," the report continued. "In addition, nearly 70 percent of annual nationwide wagering handle is represented by the tracks already accredited. However, for the Alliance to succeed, broader support must be garnered." In an attempt to encourage more tracks to become accredited, and in light of the effects of the current economic downturn on the racing industry, the Alliance has created a sliding scale for accreditation fees based on annual overnight purses offered at each track. The Independent Monitor underlined this as an important step toward the goal of accrediting all tracks, though the report admitted there exist no means of compelling tracks to seek accreditation.

**NJ GOV SIGNS BILL, RETAINS VETO POWER**

While New Jersey Governor Chris Christie signed legislation Tuesday that could funnel \$30 million from the Atlantic City casinos to the horse racing industry, it remains unclear as to whether the funds will actually make it to the racetrack. The state's top executive is on record that he does not support such subsidies, and could use his veto power to reject the legislation. The bill would channel \$15 million this year to the New Jersey Racing Commission followed by \$10 million in 2012 and another \$5 million in 2013. "These bills are another step towards transitioning the horse-racing industry into something that is not only self-sustaining, but profitable," said Jennifer Beck, a Republican state senator from Monmouth County, where the state's most important Thoroughbred facility is located.

"These bills provide revenue that is dedicated towards purses in order to keep this vital industry alive. If the Governor deems it necessary to help in this transition, there is funding from Casino Reinvestment Development Authority that may be made available to the horseracing industry, thus ensuring New Jersey retains a diversified entertainment industry that includes both casino gaming and horseracing," Beck continued. Under a three-year agreement that finished last year, the state's Thoroughbred and Standardbred industries received \$30 million from the casinos, with the stipulation that the tracks did not seek the installation of slot machines. In 2010, Monmouth Park used \$19 million of the subsidy to fund an elite summer meet at the track, allowing for a daily average purse distribution of about \$800,000.
