SOLID WOOD

Just a half hour after Teaks North (Northern Afleet) pulled off the upset in the GI Gulfstream Park Turf H., **Giant Oak** (Giant's Causeway) cast a shadow on the favorites in the GI Donn H., powering past the leaders in the final sixteenth to win going away at 7-1. It was just the fifth win in the five-year-old's 24-start career, but the chestnut appears to be a late bloomer. After getting blanked in 14 straight appearances, Giant Oak was awarded

the win on the DQ of Successful Dan (Successful Appeal) in the Nov. 26 GI Clark H. at Churchill Downs, and he proved worthy of that victory at Gulfstream yesterday. **Cont. p2**

TAKING DOWN THE FAVORITE

Zazu (Tapit) was second to **Turbulent Descent** (Congrats) in the Moccasin S. Nov. 21 and fifth behind that filly in the GI Hollywood Starlet S. Dec. 11, but handed that rival her first-ever defeat in the GI Las Virgenes S. at Santa Anita Saturday. The grey was the 6-5 chalk in the Jan. 15 GI Santa Ynez S. and just missed, running second by a neck. Taken in hand off a hot pace in the Las Virgenes, she went after the leader as they came off the turn. **Turbulent Descent**, the 2-5 favorite, was at her neck when they turned for home, but **Zazu** shook off the challenge and edged clear to take it by 1 1/4 lengths. **Cont. p3**

He was the rank outsider at 25-1, but **Teaks North** (Northern Afleet) wasn't looking at the tote board. The four-year-old gelding came charging down the outside to catch **Smart Bid** (Smart Strike) in the dying strides, taking the GI Gulfstream Park Turf H. by a nose. **Teaks North** batted .500 in 2010, with the Restoration S. on the turf and the Big Brown S. on the main track, both at Monmouth Park, among his four victories. **Cont. p3**

Going Green...

Giant Oak (Giant's Causeway) started his career on the grass, breaking his maiden at first asking on the Arlington spinach in August of 2008. He made it two in a row in an off-the-turf allowance test on the Arlington all-weather the following month, and proved adept on conventional dirt when second by a neck in the GII Kentucky Jockey Club S. at Churchill that November. The Illinois-bred was back on the weeds after a second-place finish in the GII Illinois Derby, adding the Arlington Classic to his resume in May of 2009. It would be his last trip to the winner's circle for 18 months. Giant Oak did hit the board six times during his 14-race losing streak, running second in the GII Indiana Derby at three and in the GIII Washington Park H. and GII Hawthorne Gold Cup last year at four. Moved up to fourth in the Breeders' Cup Marathon Nov. 5, he was let go at 11-1 in the GI Clark H. three weeks later. The Virginia Tarra homebred closed ground to be second by a head, but was awarded the victory in the stewards' booth. He needed no help from the judges this time.

Lucky Seven...

Sent off at 7-1, Giant Oak settled in seventh as **Square Eddie** (Smart Strike) and **Morning Line** (Tiznow) fought it out through a half in :46.73 and six furlongs in 1:10.50. Morning Line grabbed a short lead as they swept into the stretch, with **Rule** (Roman Ruler) and **I Want Revenge** (Stephen Got Even) looming large to his outside. Those three battled it out across the track, but it was Giant Oak who had the most left in the tank in the final panel, powering to the front and pulling away to a two-length triumph. Trainer Chris Block was not surprised by the outcome. "He's by Giant's Causeway, and I think he's just gotten better with age and maturation, as that line seems to do," Block said. "He trained very well over track and seemed to like the change of scenery. I had a good feeling going into the race." Looking ahead, Block added, "We'll talk about the options, including [Mar. 26 G1] Dubai [World Cup], and make a decision with the owners." Second in her career opener at Del Mar last September, Zazu came back to graduate going 6 1/2 furlongs at Oak Tree Oct. 15. The Moss's budding filly phenom was a 1 1/2-length runner-up in the Moccasin S. the following month, then made her two-turn bow in the GI Hollywood Starlet S. and ran an even fifth. Trying conventional dirt for the first time in the Jan. 15 GII Santa Ynez S. at seven furlongs, she was last away from the gate, but closed with a flourish to be second by a neck. The added furlong made the difference here. Zazu once again broke at the back of the pack and trailed through the opening quarter, but she saved ground around the first turn. Poised off the lead-



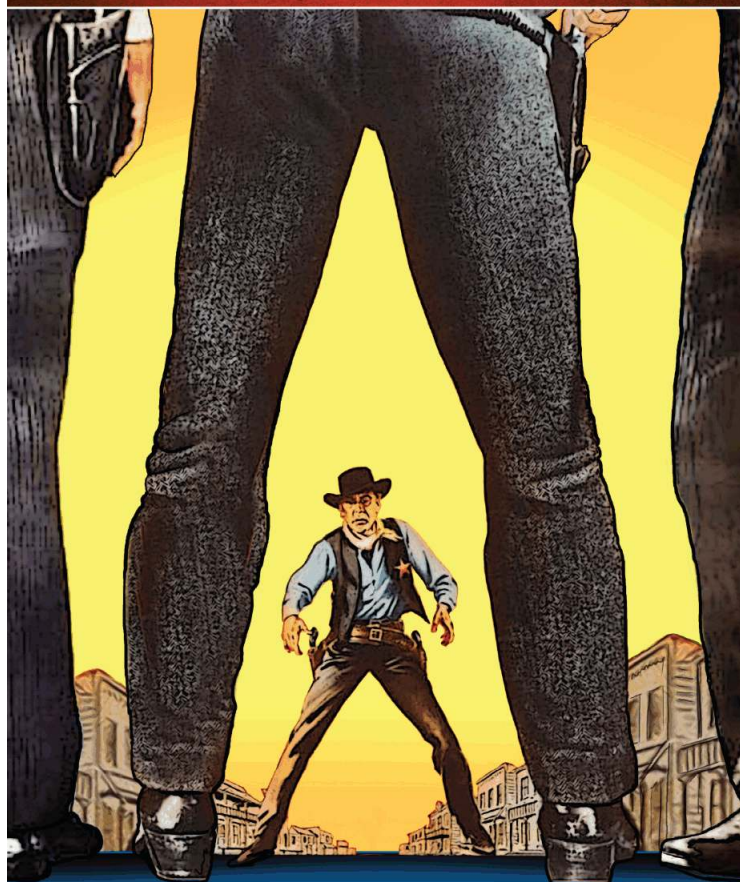

ers as they dashed off a half in :44.25, she closed the gap on the final bend and was head and head for the lead as they came into the lane. Odds-on Turbulent Descent made her bid to the outside, but Zazu shook off the challenge in a matter of strides and pulled clear to win handily. Teaks North broke his maiden on New Year's Day 2010, cruising to a five-length tally on the main track at Calder. The dark bay was sidelined after that effort,

returning under new management to finish a tired seventh in a Monmouth allowance test July 3. Switched to the turf, he captured a NW1X Aug. 1 and the Restoration S. Aug. 28, but could do no better than fifth in the GI Jamaica H. Oct. 9 at Belmont Park. A dropdown and change of surface did the trick, and

Teaks North came back to win the Oct. 30 Big Brown S. at Monmouth before running third in a pair on the Big A main track--the Nov. 20 Gill Discovery H. and the Dec. 15 Cosmic Bob S. The Florida-bred was back on the lawn for his 2011 debut. Little Mike (Spanish Steps) was hustled out to set the pace through fractions of :23.52, :47.40 and 1:10.48, with Teaks North rating in sixth while tucked in at the rail. The longshot swung to the outside when they turned for home and came running, getting up in the shadow of the wire to get the bob. "It's unbelievable," jockey Jose Valdivia Jr. enthused. "I just think he's really coming into his own and is a really good turf horse. I couldn't have had a better trip. 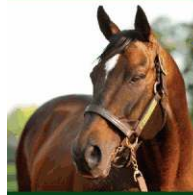

The Craig colorbearer lost his unbeaten record when fourth in the Oct. 2 GI Goodwood S. at Oak Tree, but he rebounded to get

up for a nose victory in the Dec. 26 GI Malibu S. and was a deserving odds-on favorite in his first appearance of the new year. Up to press the pace from second through six panels in 1:09.95, Twirling Candy inhaled the leader at the top of the lane and bounded away to win as much the best. "He's such a nice horse," trainer John Sadler said. "My job is just to be a good steward and take good care of him, because he's a natural runner." "That is Plan A at the moment," confirmed Steve Young, bloodstock advisor to Mill House's Nicholas and James Brady, following yesterday's impressive allowance victory at Gulfstream. "Hopefully, [previous owner/breeders] Mr. and Mrs. Ramsey got it right when they named him. It certainly worked for Sheikh Mohammed and Dubai Millennium."

The attractive dark bay made two starts as a juvenile for his breeders, flying home to run second at 14-1 in his Oct. 30 unveiling going a mile over yielding Woodbine turf ([video](#)). Despite failing to win, Young definitely sat up and took notice after watching the colt finish off his race strongly.

"In that first race, it looked like he had lost his way and was about as far back as a horse could be," Young recollected. "But then he came with this tremendous run and it ended up being a great race for him. That's when we first became aware of him."

Queen'splatekitten faced the starter one more time for Brian Lynch and started the 11-10 favorite in an 8 1/2-furlong maiden over the Woodbine Polytrack Dec. 3. After settling in midfield, he launched his bid approaching the stretch and displayed a devastating turn of foot to swamp his rivals by 5 1/4 lengths, then could barely be pulled up afterwards ([video](#)).

"In that race, he was obviously more forwardly placed than he was first time out, and the way he swept past them was just incredible and then he opened it up even more on the gallop out," Young summarized.

Queen'splatekitten joined the stable of Todd Pletcher in early January and turned in four steady, if not eye-catching, breezes at Palm Meadows, each on the turf. Yesterday's win stamps him one to watch whenever and wherever he shows up. But those are the questions: where and when.

"It's really unlikely that we'll find a second-level allowance, so there's a pretty good chance that he'll end up in a stakes race," Young offered. "In the end, that will be up to the Bradys and Todd, but that's what I would expect." One option is the Gill Palm Beach S. at nine furlongs on turf Mar. 12.

Although Queen'splatekitten was nominated to the Triple Crown, Young's hunch is that the colt will excel on other surfaces.

"We put him in the Triple Crown races, but there's a little something in his action that probably suggests that he'll be a little better on turf and synthetics," Young stated.--*Alan Carasso*

3rd-GPX, \$40,500, Alw, NW1X, 3yo, 1 1/8m, 1:50, ft. SHACKLEFORD (c, 3, [Forestry--Oatsee {SP, \\$106,945}](#), by Unbridled), a half-brother to Lady Joanne (Orientate), GISW, \$987,094; and Baghdaria (Royal Academy), MGSW, \$725,433, flashed some speed in his Oct. 16 career debut on the Keeneland Polytrack, but faded to finish ninth. The blaze-faced chestnut put that effort behind him with a game victory going seven panels at Churchill Nov. 27, and was 9-2 while stretching out to two turns in his first start since. Away alertly under Jesus Castanon from his outside post, Shackleford went up to race in second, just off the flank of El Grayling (El Prado {Ire}) through splits of :24.33, :48.39 and 1:12.22. Meanwhile, even-money Casper's Touch (Touch Gold) broke from the rail, but was very unhappy to be reined back to fourth by jockey Julien Lejaroux. Shackleford took over turning for home and, despite getting lackadaisical with his lead changes, came home clear by 2 1/4 lengths. Casper's Touch, hampered by Shadow Warrior (A.P. Indy) at the top of the stretch, finally switched to the outside and rallied to snatch second from El Grayling on the line. Oatsee sold for \$135,000 as part of the Bentley Smith dispersal at KEEJAN in 2006, when she was in foal to Langfuhr. 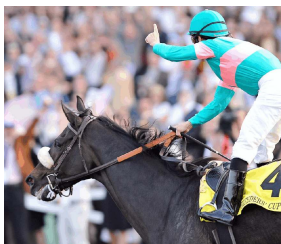

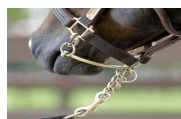
