Winner of the G1 Three Chimneys Hopeful S. and runner-up in the G1 Breeders' Cup Juvenile, the dark bay had been slated to make his 2011 bow in the GIII Holy Bull S. two weeks ago, but was removed from consideration when trainer Rick Dutrow Jr. revealed that the colt was displaying a low energy level. "He just wasn't right," Dutrow told *DRF*. "All the

tests we took came back negative. I'm not sure what's bothering him, but he just wasn't himself. I originally thought it was a knee, it might be an ankle. So we'll just back off and let him regroup." A **"TDN Rising Star"** **Boys At Tosconova** ran second in the GIII Kentucky Juvenile S. in his career debut last spring, and has earned \$562,060 in four starts.

Unblemished Record...

Brethren was the preferred part of an entry that was favored at 7-10 in a six-furlong Belmont maiden Oct. 16, and the homebred stumbled a bit at the break, but recovered to stalk a good pace and outlasted the talented Black N Beauty (Devil His Due) by a half-length while stopping the timer in 1:08.88. Connections resisted the urge to try to let him follow in Super Saver's footsteps in the GII Kentucky Jockey Club S. and instead sensibly opted for a one-mile allowance Nov. 27. After drifting out again at the start, he covered ground, but swept five wide to lead in upper stretch and finished off his race well, scoring by 1 3/4 lengths. He came into this sophomore bow off a strong worktab, but one which suggests there could be additional improvement off the Davis, win, lose or draw.

As is his custom, Brethren was a touch slow to break after proving reluctant to load, but went forward from the 10 hole to secure a good spot up close while a path or two off the inside. Despite having to be used a bit by Ramon Dominguez to get that stalking position, the colt came back nicely to his rider and had only longshot **Ribo Bibo** (Louis Quatorze) in front of him after a half-mile in :48.20. Still traveling supremely well on the turn, Brethren was sent to the lead at the three-eighths pole and immediately opened up on his rivals. He drifted wide into the stretch, but kept to his task and was ridden out in the final 100 yards. "It might have been our best race out of any three-year-old we've had," WinStar's Elliott Walden offered. "It was extremely impressive to the eye. Ramon said he liked what he felt underneath him. He got into the race very quickly, but was very responsive and switched off until Ramon asked him to run. It was very impressive."

The Second Coming...

While Super Saver was purchased in utero (\$160,000 at Keeneland November in 2006), Brethren is the first foal produced by the mare on a mating planned by the WinStar braintrust. The decision to send the mare to Distorted Humor was a logical one, as the cross had previously been responsible for the aforementioned Any Given Saturday, who missed by a nose to subsequent GI Kentucky Derby hero Street Sense in the GIII Tampa Bay Derby before becoming the second straight winner of the GI Haskell Invitational S. to carry WinStar colors. Any Given Saturday was co-owned by Padua Stables. "We love A.P Indy mares with Distorted Humor, and that's the main reason we bought her," Walden commented. "Also, Supercharger is a full sister to She's a Winner [dam of Bluegrass Cat], so the fact that we were familiar with the family was part of it as well." Supercharger has a two-year-old filly called Lisa T (Awesome Again) who will be retained for the WinStar broodmare band. She is also the dam of a yearling colt by Medaglia d'Oro named Superfection, is currently due to Tiznow and will pay a return visit to Distorted Humor this breeding season. Yesterday's Santa Maria results illustrates the ups and downs that is horse racing. Last summer, Jay Em Ess said it was transferring Rail Trip (Jump Start) to trainer Richard Dutrow Jr., a tough blow for a Ron Ellis barn that sent the gelding out to three graded wins. Jay Em Ess, meanwhile, suffered its own disheartening news just yesterday when GISW Boys At Toscanova (Officer), considered one of the best sophomore prospects on the East Coast, was removed from Kentucky Derby consideration with an undetermined ailment. But both Ellis and Jay Em Ess principal Samantha Siegel were all smiles last night when Vision in Gold, coming off an impressive daylight win in her dirt debut here Dec. 30, took down her first graded win with a gutsy effort. She beat winners for the first time at Santa Anita in her latest, and was looking to make it two straight against the returning odds-on favorite St Trinians. Up to take the lead under Joel Rosario, Vision in Gold settled into a smooth stride and cut out sensible splits. She looked as if she'd be swallowed up by the Zardana and the rally favorite in mid-stretch, but found a little something extra. "I hate to throw the name around, but she's 'Zenyatta-esque,'" said Ellis. "I pointed her out to John Shirreffs before this filly ever raced and I said that's what Zenyatta must have looked like when she was that age. He just kind of laughed, but she is that tall. I'm just hoping she at least will physically fill out like Zenyatta did later in life. She's a big, long-striding filly, and there didn't look like there was much speed in here. I told Joel, if she breaks and wants to go, just let her place herself. The money poured in for Tapizar, making him the betting favorite at long odds-on in the win pool and attracting a six-figure show pool. But it proved to be an off day for the Steve Asmussen trainee, and it was Anthony's Cross who proved narrowly better than Riveting Reason following a stirring stretch drive. The bay colt commenced his career on the East Coast over the summer, finishing a debut fourth at Saratoga July 31 after brushing the gate at the break, then proceeded to round out the trifecta behind MGSWs Astrology (A.P. Indy) and To Honor and Serve (Bernardini) in a similar event Sept. 4. Fourth when trying the Keeneland Polytrack and two turns for the first time Oct. 9, he broke through with a 2 1/2-length graduation beneath the Twin Spires Nov. 4 and earned a bit of a breather. He had the misfortune of hooking Tapizar when that one was on his best game in the GIII Sham S. Jan. 15 and was beaten just over nine lengths into third, but was back for another crack while adding blinkers. Quail Hill won the break from his outside draw, but by the time they'd completed one furlong, Tapizar was fired up and was pulling jockey Garrett Gomez to the lead. Tossing his head and racing erratically, the heavy favorite covered the opening half-mile in :45.64, with Anthony's Cross in closest attendance from second. When the latter came to tackle the pace-setter in earnest leaving the quarter pole, it was apparent that Tapizar would have little to offer and, indeed, called it a day at the eighth pole. That left it to Anthony's Cross and Riveting Reason to decide the outcome. Arianne de Kwiatkowski's colorbearer was narrowly in front and down on the fence into the final furlong and stayed on dourly to deny Riveting Reason. Tapizar crossed the line fifth, beaten 6 1/4 lengths. "I could see the favorite [Tapizar] was giving [Garrett] Gomez some trouble," said winning rider Garrett Gomez. "I saw [Garrett] Gomez try to take his horse back a bit, and his horse fought him a little bit. I stayed a little closer to the pace today but it probably didn't make the difference in the race. He's a good horse and it was no surprise to see him run that good." Of Tapizar, Gomez stated, "He was super aggressive today. I couldn't ever really get him shut off too much. He was kind of wound in post parade, a little antsy at the gate. He was a little more of a handful. He was just antsy. I thought when he cleared and made the lead he would come back to me but he never really would. He just kept pulling."

The Rodney Dangerfield of the Florida racing scene, Tackleberry made it six wins from his last seven outings with this comfortable success. A 3/4-brother in blood to the hard-knocking GISW Outofthebox (Montbrook), Tackleberry took back-to-back Calder allowances Oct. 10 and Nov. 6 before backing up on just a week's rest to add the Jack Dudley Sprint H. Nov. 13. He stretched back out to nine furlongs and led every step of the way for a first graded-stakes badge in Calder's GIII Fred Hooper H. Dec. 11, and gave a decent account of himself when fourth to Soaring Empire in this track's GIII Hal's Hope S. Jan. 8. He was let go at 27-1 for the Sunshine Millions Classic Jan. 29, but turned back all challenges and drew clear late for a 2 1/4-length upset. Making his sixth start in the last 100 days here, Tackleberry was content to lay second off the pace of Gaucho (Ghostzapper), who took them along through modest splits of :22.84 and :45.86. Javier Santiago sent his mount to the front leaving the far turn and was never seriously threatened from that point onward. Soaring Empire was fractious pre-start and unseated Jose Lezcano in the gate. He broke a half-step slow, made a middle move on the turn, but could not sustain his bid and earned the place spot.

It was a good day for Brereton Jones, as he came away with big wins as breeder and owner. First, his homebred Silver Reunion won the GIII Endeavor S. at Tampa Bay. Then Silver Medallion, a horse he bred and sold to Mike Ryan, registered an initial graded tally. Silver Medallion, a half to the classy Sweet Talker (Stormin Fever), won at first asking going two turns on the grass at Saratoga in August. But lackluster efforts in the GIII With Anticipation S. at the Spa Sept. 3 and in the GI Dixiana Breeders' Futurity at Keeneland Oct. 9 took some of the sheen off that strong debut. He finished second in a grassy one-mile allowance at Churchill Nov. 5, and connections opted to regroup, transferring the colt from Chad Brown to Steve Asmussen's new West Coast string. Silver Medallion responded to his new environs with a victory in the Eddie Logan S. at Santa Anita on New Year's Eve, and was looking for bigger game returning to the main track for the first time since Keeneland. Reserved off the pace by Russell Baze, he came with his run down the center of the track and surged past longshot pacesetter Jakesam. GI CashCall Futurity winner Comma to the Top was ideally placed, but, after rallying to a narrow lead two furlongs out, flattened out.

Bettors were undeterred by the layoff lines in her past performances and made her the favorite here, and the dark bay duly obliged. She assumed her customary spot on the front end, covered her opening six furlongs in 1:13.90 over the good going, and kept digging in to deny C. S. Silk in the run to the line. "The great thing about the situation is that she's in very good hands, and it's difficult to bring a horse back in that kind of a race against that kind of competition when she hasn't run in quite a while," Jones said about his mare's hiatus. "So, obviously, she's a quality horse with a quality trainer, and we're just along for the ride--it's a lot of fun!" He added, "Our future plans arte to go into the top turf races for older fillies around the country and, hopefully, we'll be able to be in the right position for the Breeders' Cup when the time comes, but that's a long way down the road." Silver Reunion's dam is a half-sister to MGSW Comic Strip (Red Ransom), the good European sprinter Lucayan Prince (Fast Play) and--it's a small world alert--1995 Sam F. Davis S. winner Akiba (Tejano).

“Belmont Stakes winner **A.P. "Her last three works have been phenomenal." That includes a four-furlong blowout Thursday morning deemed "fantastic" by Ward. Harmonious, a dual Grade I winner on grass in 2010, tries the main track for the first time in a race which will shed some light on the remainder of her season.

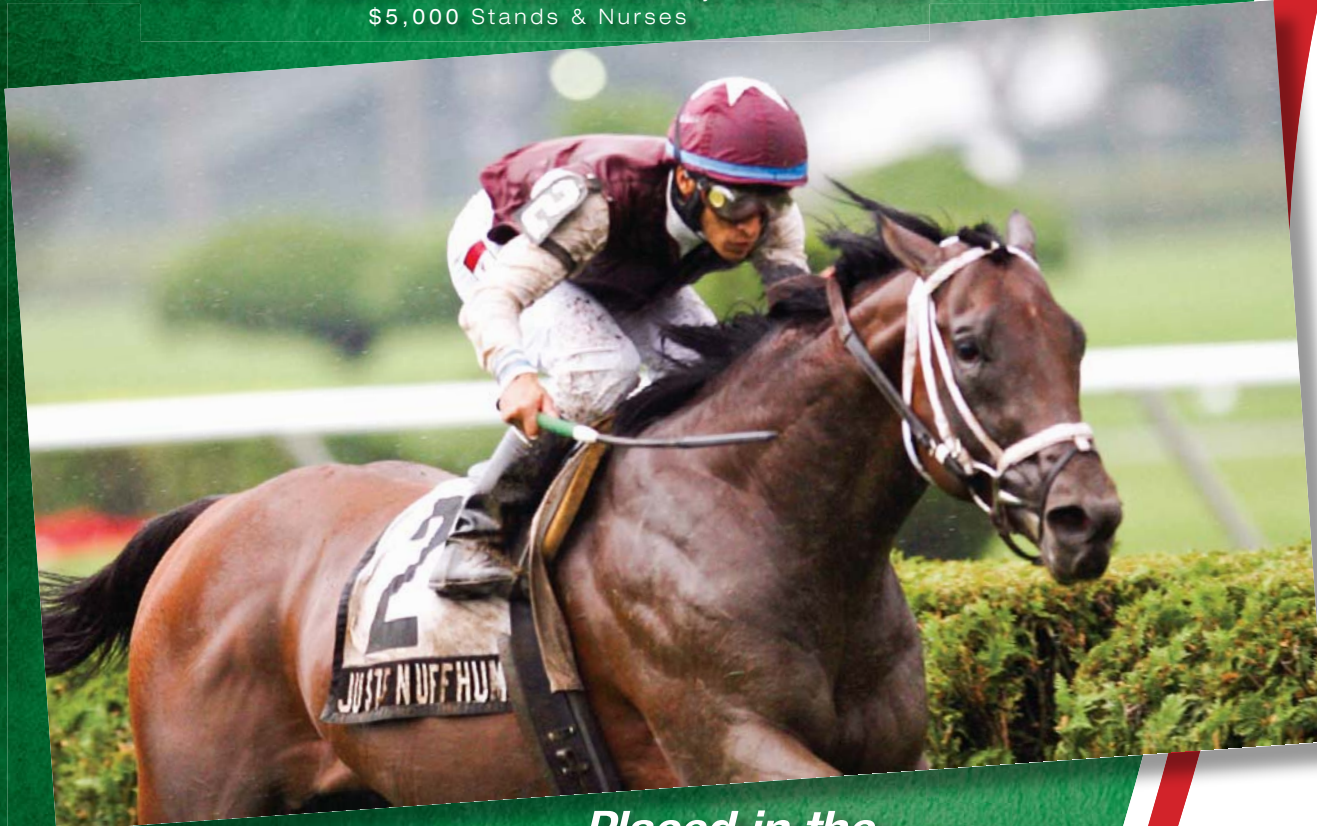

NATHAN'S H Q (Yonaguska)

Dual Duty for Martin...

Win number 1,851 for Clyde Martin the jockey came in yesterday's second race on Nathan's H Q (Yonaguska). Win number 17 for Clyde Martin *the conditioner* came in the same race. Martin, you see, is

something of a rarity in racing--a rider who also operates a training operation. The numbers above essentially tell the story: the 52-year-old is a veteran jockey, having booted home his first winner back at River Downs in 1979 before going on to success at

places like Rockingham Park, Philly Park and Delaware. But he is reasonably new to the training game. Over the past four seasons, he has saddled just 123 starters, winning with 17 of them (a clip of roughly 14 percent).

"You can't be a jockey forever," Martin admitted to the Gulfstream notes team. "Unfortunately, it's a young man's sport--that's why I decided to start training."

A native of St. Petersburg, Florida, Martin currently has three horses stabled at Gulfstream. During the summer, he heads to Delaware Park, where he has a larger string. Martin also owns a farm in Unionville, Pennsylvania, a custom-built operation in which the living quarters and barn are integrated. Martin is able to give his horses a break from the track there, and can train them over fields and local trails.

"It's wonderful for them," he said. "It gives them a shot to get out in the open without feeling pressure. Just taking them out there hacking around and walking is wonderful."

Martin's training career almost ended before it began when tragedy struck in November of 2005. He was just getting going with a few horses at Fair Hill Training Center when a fire broke out, and lost several in the blaze.

"That was an awful way to start in the business," he said. "They never found a source. It was awful. It was the worst. It was months and months and months that it haunted me, knowing that they were trapped in there."

Martin eventually regrouped, and two years later he notched his first win as trainer and jockey--and owner--of a horse named Fancy Runner (Robyn Dancer), who Martin booted home to four straight victories that year in allowance and starter allowance competition.

I tell him all the time, 'Anytime you want to put someone else on him, it doesn't hurt my feelings.' But he feels like the horse likes me a lot."

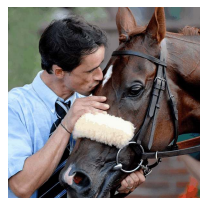

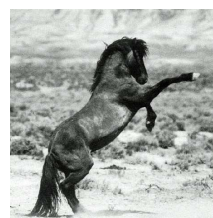

Representatives of Southern Electric were on site Saturday inspecting the grounds at Newbury. The race was contested as scheduled, but Kid Cassidy was withdrawn after veterinarians observed the five-year-old walking unevenly. Unconfirmed reports suggest that other runners appeared to have burn marks around their mouths. "After those horses collapsed in the parade ring, we took the decision that it was safe to continue with the rest of the meeting. After running the first race, we isolated that area, and some of the trainers were uncomfortable with continuing," steward Paul Barton told *Racing Post*. "We had a meeting with the racecourse executives and, at that meeting, because we could not establish what the causes of death of the two horses were, the executives weren't comfortable with continuing on health and safety grounds, and therefore we had no decision but to abandon [after the first race]." Barton defended the decision to run race one. "They were extremely unusual circumstances," he said. "At the time, we did not know whether those horses had had a heart attack, we did not know what had happened. We had all the horses examined by the veterinary surgeons before they raced. These are highly unusual circumstances; I have never seen anything like this before." Professor Tim Morris, the BHA's director of equine science and welfare, told the trade daily, "Whilst there are suspicions that an electrical fault was the cause, and this is being looked into by the racecourse and relevant authorities, it is important that we investigate other possible causes." He added, "Both horses have been sent for post-mortem examinations and samples from both horses, and from the other two horses involved in the incident, have been taken and will be analysed. We will also be testing a sample of the water supply, and have secured and will review all of the CCTV footage from the racecourse stables and footage from the parade ring itself at the time. We have gathered evidence and statements at the racecourse from the connections involved with the incident, including trainers, jockeys, stable staff and owners, the racecourse and BHA veterinary officers, and the racecourse executive, including the health and safety officer."



NEWBURY ACCIDENT UNDER INVESTIGATION

According to *Racing Post*, a strange incident that occurred in the Newbury paddock yesterday before the track's first race is under full investigation. A pair of runners--Fenix Two (GB) (Milan {GB}) and Marching Song (War Chant)--both collapsed and died within 10 yards of each other in the western portion of the parade ring. Two others in the field of hurdle horses, Kid Cassidy (Ire) (Beneficial {GB}) and The Merry Giant (Ire) (Curtain Time {Ire}), also appeared to be affected by what is speculated to be an electric shock. Supporting that theory, Robert Garner, co-owner of Marching Song, told *Racing Post*, "One of the horses had done a real strange cavorting move and then ours came round and went over and couldn't get up like a normal horse. I'm told when they went to touch him they got an electric shock, and then, when they went to take the head collar off, they got another shock."
