UNCLE MO TOPS 364 TRIPLE CROWN NOMS

Unbeaten champion **Uncle Mo** (Indian Charlie) heads the list of 364 early nominees to the Triple Crown. The U.S. Classic series kicks off with the GI Kentucky Derby at Churchill Downs May 7, followed by the GI Preakness S. at Pimlico May 21 and the GI Belmont S. June 11. The first nomination phase, when sophomores could be nominated for \$600, closed Jan. 22. A late period for nominations--at \$6,000 each--will conclude Mar. 26. Four fillies were among the early nominees, topped by Grade I winner **Turbulent Descent** (Congrats). Just six

European-based runners are on the list. "The impressive roster of nominees to the Triple Crown provides proof that the desire to achieve horse racing's ultimate dream of a Kentucky Derby win and Triple Crown sweep of the Preakness and Belmont Stakes is as strong as ever," said Don Richardson, senior vice president of racing for Churchill Downs. "Despite a difficult economy, a reduction in annual foal crops and other challenges to our horse industry, the Triple Crown's early nominations are basically flat with last year's total. That's a wonderful show of faith on the part of the international group of owners and trainers that have nominated horses to this year's races. We appreciate their support and anticipate a thrilling and memorable Triple Crown series in 2011." Uncle Mo's trainer Todd Pletcher has a total of 20 three-year-olds nominated, as does Hall of Fame conditioner Bob Baffert. Darley leads the way as an owner, with 13 runners made eligible. Leading young sire Bernardini (A.P. Indy) leads all stallions with 18 nominees. The complete list of Triple Crown nominees can be viewed [here](#). Additional TC stats, p2

TWICE LUCKY

Always A Princess (Leroidesanimaux {Brz}), who bested **Blind Luck** (Pollard's Vision) by 3 1/2 lengths in the Jan. 16 GII El Encino S., got the better of the champ once again in Sunday's GII La Canada S. The chestnut filly went right to the front, cruised along through tepid fractions, and came into the stretch with a clear lead. Blind Luck sat closer to the pace than is her habit, and was geared up on the far turn, but was late switching leads and never threatened, finishing 3 1/4 lengths back in second. "This filly is quicker than all these horses and, if she gets the right pace, she'll just keep going," winning trainer Bob Baffert said. Always a Princess set the pace in her stakes bow, the 2009 GI Oak Leaf S., but was caught by Blind Luck and finished second. She faded to fifth in the GI Breeders' Cup Juvenile Fillies, then disappeared for 10 months. After making a winning return in an optional claimer at Del Mar in September, she led every step in the Oct. 2 GII Indiana Oaks, but had to settle for third after stumbling at the start in the Nov. 6 GII Chilukki S. on the Breeders' Cup undercard. The Arnold Zetcher homebred faded to fourth in the Dec. 26 GI La Brea S., but pulled off the mild upset at 7-2 in the El Encino. She was 6-5 in the La Canada. **Cont. p2**

The bay filly captured four of her seven starts last term, annexing a maiden test at Turfway Park in January and an optional claimer at Arlington in May. Fourth in an allowance when trying the turf for the first time at Monmouth July 18, she came back to romp home an 8 3/4-length winner in the off-the-grass Bennington S. at Saratoga Aug. 23. The Todd Pletcher trainee showed her grit in her next appearance, battling down the lane in the Oct. 23 GII Raven Run S. on the Keeneland Poly and holding on to win by 3/4 of a length. She couldn't quite get to Tar Heel Mom (Flatter) in the Jan. 15 GIII Sugar Swirl S. at Gulfstream, finishing a neck behind that rival in second, but turned the tables in handy fashion here.

Eclipse champion **Uncle Mo** (Indian Charlie) worked at
 Palm Meadows Sunday morning, going a half in :47.45
 in company with stablemate **Stay Thirsty** (Bernardini). It
 was the colt's third work since
 his dominating performance in
 the Nov. 6 G1 Breeders' Cup Ju-
 venile. "It was a tad quicker than
 we expected," trainer Todd
 Pletcher said. "We wanted him to
 go in :48 and change, but he did
 it effortlessly. It's amazing what
 a couple of works have done for
 his fitness level. I feel like I'm
 ahead of schedule. I'm particularly pleased with the
 way he galloped out." Uncle Mo is expected to make
 his sophomore bow in the GIII Tampa Bay Derby
 Mar. 12. According to *Daily Racing Form*, G1 Three
 Chimneys Hopeful S. runner-up Stay Thirsty will go
 next in the Mar. 5 GIII Gotham S. He has not been out
 since finishing fifth in the BC Juvenile.

Santa Anita Derby Next for Anthony's Cross?

GII Robert B. Lewis S. winner **Anthony's Cross** (Indian Charlie) may make his next appearance in the GI Santa Anita Derby Apr. 9, *Daily Racing Form* reports. The Pennsylvania-bred, a distant third behind **Tapizar** (Tapit) in the Jan. 15 GIII Sham S. to kick off the year, outbattled Riveting Reason (Fusaichi Pegasus) to take the nine-furlong Lewis by a nose under jockey Joel Rosario. "I don't want to overcook him, but I don't want to undercook him," trainer Eoin Harty told *DRF*. "It might be a good time to back off a little bit. I want to have a semi-fresh horse for the [GI Kentucky] Derby, if we're good enough to get there." Fractious in the gate and rank early, Tapizar set the pace in Saturday's test and faded to fifth. "I've got to find out why he was so mad," trainer Steve Asmussen told *DRF*. "I don't think matches a good description of who he is." Plans for his next start are up in the air.



RACETRACK Round-Up

Keertana Preps for The Very One...

Keertana (Johar), who missed by just a half-length when third at 31-1 in the Nov. 5 GI Breeders' Cup F/M Turf, worked six furlongs in 1:15 4/5 on the turf at Gulfstream Park Sunday morning. The Barbara Hunter colorbearer made her 2011 bow in an allowance at Tampa Bay Downs Jan. 23 and finished in a dead-heat for first ([video](#)). She is being pointed for the 1 3/8-mile GIII The Very One H. at Gulfstream Feb. 20. "She ran a huge race at Saratoga last year to win the [GIII] Glens Falls [S. at 11 furlongs]," said trainer Tom Proctor. "Then she ran the big race in the Breeders' Cup, so she seems to like the longer races, and that's what we'll probably be doing with her this year. I want to have a good spring with her, then maybe she gets a little break sometime in the summer and comes back in the fall."

Life At Ten Back on Tab...

Candy DeBartolo's MGISW **Life At Ten** (Malibu Moon), idle since being eased in the GI Breeders' Cup Distaff at Churchill Downs Nov. 5, was back on the work tab at Palm Meadows yesterday morning, going an easy three-eighths in :38.50. The six-year-old was five-for-seven last year, with wins in the GI Ogden Phipps H. and GI Beldame S., but, after appearing listless in the paddock and post parade prior to the BC Distaff, never lifted a hoof and was pulled up by jockey John Velazquez. The substandard performance in the subject of an ongoing investigation by the Kentucky Horse Racing Commission. "I don't know what would have happened if she won the Breeders' Cup or ran better, but they decided to try again," trainer Todd Pletcher said of the decision to bring the chestnut back for a 2011 campaign. As for when the mare might make her return, Pletcher added, "I don't know if she'd be ready for something like the [Apr. 2 GII] Rampart at a 1 1/8 miles. We'll have to play it by ear." To date, Life At Ten has compiled a record of 17-8-5-2 and earnings of \$1,149,267.

It might be a stretch to call it a vision of gold, but Liberation Farm's Rob Whiteley liked what he saw when he laid eyes on Corporate Vision (Corporate Report) at Monmouth Park back in the mid-1990s.

"I was struck by her appearance on the track,"

Whiteley remembered yesterday about the horse who would ultimately produced yesterday's GII Santa Maria S. winner Vision of Gold (Medaglia d'Oro). "She was a big, beautifully made, athletic, great-moving individual."

Whiteley hadn't forgotten the filly roughly eight years later when she entered the ring at Fasig-Tipton's Adena Springs November Sale, but he didn't have dead aim on her, either.

"When she was offered with Frank Stronach's horses, I didn't even have her on my list, because I thought she'd be too expensive for our budget," he explained. "Pam Robinson saw her and said, 'Boy, she's really good looking,' and we went in, not thinking we'd be able to get her. But we were lucky."

Whiteley was able to acquire the 10-year-old graded stakes placed mare for \$46,000 with partners Jim and Pam Robinson, who operate under the Brandywine Farm banner. Corporate Vision sold in foal to Adena's Macho Uno, producing the good stakes winner and \$246,467 earner National Pride. Corporate Vision didn't have a foal in 2006, but Whiteley and the Robinsons sent her to the then-unproven Medaglia d'Oro the following year, a mating that produced Vision of Gold.

"In many ways, it was type to type," Whiteley said when asked about the decision to pair Medaglia d'Oro and Corporate Vision. "They both had very similar frames, with almost identical scope. Corporate Vision was especially attractive and smooth, which in turn smoothed out Medaglia d'Oro slightly, producing a very beautiful filly."

He added, "When I'm looking at a stallion, I'm trying to accentuate what [the mare] brings to the genetic mix, and I'm also trying, in the choice of the stallion, to improve or correct her conformational weaknesses."

Unfortunately for Liberation and Brandywine, Corporate Vision died not long after foaling Vision in Gold.

But her daughter indeed proved a grand individual, bringing \$360,000 from Jay Em Ess Stable at the 2008 Keeneland November Sale. That was the third-highest price for a Medaglia d'Oro that year.

"She was eye-catching at the sale, and eye-catching on the track and in the post parade on Saturday, I thought," said Whiteley.

Vision of Gold ran to her looks in a breakout performance. Looking to remain unbeaten on conventional dirt, she set a measured pace under Joel Rosario and gamely turned back the challenges of runner-up Zardana (Brz) (Crimson Tide {Ire}) and third-placed favorite St Trinians (GB) (Piccolo {GB}). "It would be nice, wouldn't it, if she developed into a star? That would be great," Whiteley remarked.

Liberation and Brandywine had another reason to celebrate when, earlier Saturday, Gallant Stable's Majestic Harbor won impressively in a two-turn Fair Grounds maiden special. (Click for the [brisnet.com chart](#) or [Video, sponsored by Taylor Made.](#)) They also bred that three-year-old colt, who was the well-regarded 3-2 choice for the Paul McGee barn. Majestic Harbor lived up to advanced billing, drawing off to a 6 1/4-length win.

Interestingly, if the Medaglia d'Oro--Corporate Vision mating was planned on matching similar traits, the Rockport Harbor--Champagne Royale (French Deputy) mating that produced Majestic Harbor was a case of pairing two different physical types.

"Rockport Harbor gave [Majestic Harbor] some scope, as Champagne Royal is medium-sized, with good quarters and a shorter back," said Whiteley. "The two complemented each other really well to get an individual with strength and stamina. I'm looking forward to seeing him as he continues to stretch out. He certainly finished well; we'll just have to see how far he wants to go."

Majestic Harbor hit the board in a pair of Churchill sprints last fall and was making his first start of the year and his two-turn bow Saturday.

Majestic Harbor wasn't the big sales score that Vision in Gold was, but Liberation and Brandywine still own the mare, Champagne Royale, whom they purchased as a broodmare prospect for \$29,000 at the 2006 Keeneland January Sale. Champagne Royale's first foal, the four-year-old filly Consider Yourself (Afleet Alex), sold for \$110,000 at the 2008 Keeneland September Sale. The mare produced an Elusive Quality filly in 2009, had a Street Boss filly last spring and is currently in foal to the Darley stallion again. Whiteley said 2011 breeding plans are undecided.

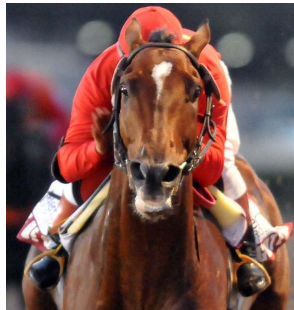
