SHOOTING FOR THE STARS

Just for Fun Stable's **Decisive Moment** (With Distinction), second at 48-1 in the GIII Delta Downs Jackpot S. Nov. 20, heads to the big leagues in today's

GII Risen Star S. following a sharp wire-to-wire victory in Delta's Jean Lafitte S. Jan. 14. Third in the Florida Stallion In Reality S. at Calder in October, the Florida-bred made the trip from Calder Monday evening. "He's an excellent shipper," trainer Juan Arias offered. "I've been to Louisiana three times now, but this is my first trip to New Orleans," the former jockey

continued. "We went down to the French Quarter and got to experience some of the pre-Mardi Gras happy feeling." The highly regarded ★ **"TDN Rising Star"** ★ **Machen** (Distorted Humor), owned and bred by Donald Adam's Courtlandt Farms, puts his perfect record on the line. A 5 1/2-length debut winner at Fair Grounds, Machen successfully stretched to two turns with another runaway tally in a \$50,000 optional claimer Jan. 30. **Santiva** (Giant's Causeway) makes his first start since annexing Churchill's GII Kentucky Jockey Club S. Nov. 27. The Tom R. Walters colorbearer, no worse than third in four career starts, completed the exacta in Keeneland's GI Dixiana Breeders' Futurity Oct. 9. Catesby W. Clay's **Rogue Romance** (Smarty Jones), a distant third in the GI Breeders' Cup Juvenile, also begins his sophomore campaign. **Field, p2**



Risen Star (Secretariat), who won this race when it was known as the Louisiana Derby Trial in 1998, went on to finish third in the Kentucky Derby before capturing the Preakness and Belmont. He was named champion three-year-old for his exploits, and Fair Grounds renamed this contest in his honor the following year.

KATHMANBLU HEADS RACHEL ALEXANDRA

Top sophomore fillies will also be on display at Fair Grounds in today's GIII Rachel Alexandra S. The versatile **Kathmanblu** (Bluegrass Cat) returns to dirt following a visually impressive tally in the Sweetest Chant S. over a yielding Gulfstream turf course Jan. 22. An unlucky third in the GII Breeders' Cup Juvenile Fillies Turf, the bay concluded her two-year-old campaign with an 8 1/2-length tour-de-force in Churchill's GII Golden Rod S. Nov. 27. **Inglorious** (Hennessy) tries conventional dirt for the first time after beginning her career with two good looking stakes victories at Woodbine, including the restricted Ontario Lassie S. last time Dec. 4. "She'll be in against some really good fillies like Kathmanblu and Bouquet Booth, but our objective is to find out where she fits with fillies like those," trainer Josie Carroll said of the Donver Stable colorbearer. "We thought about going in that earlier race here [the Silverbulletday], but she's already been two turns and we don't need to hit every race. It's a long year." **Bouquet Booth** (Flower Alley), last term's GIII Delta Downs Princess S. heroine, enters riding a three-race winning streak. She was last seen annexing this track's Silverbulletday S. Jan. 22. **Field, p5**

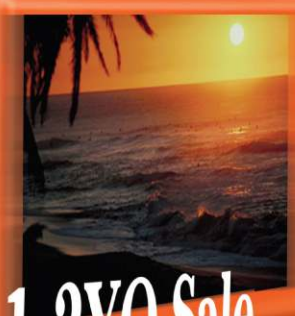

Defending Barbara Fritchie heroine **Sweet Goodbye** was well back in third that day. "Knock on wood, she couldn't be doing any better," said Aspenglow's trainer, Gary Capuano. "It seems like she gets better every time she runs. Being on the rail is not the ideal situation, so we have no choice but to go to the lead. The big thing will be if she is able to relax, and the first quarter will tell whether or not she has relaxed enough to finish. We hope she can step up to this level." **Harissa** tries a one-turn race for the first time in her career. The versatile **Prince Will I Am**, a winner at this distance over the Saratoga turf last summer, used a victory in the GI Jamaica H. going nine panels on the Belmont sod as a springboard to the Breeders' Cup. He crossed the line second in the GIII BC Marathon, but was infamously disqualified in that Nov. 6 test, and wound up closing out 2010 with a win in the 12-furlong GII W. L. McKnight H. that was washed off the Calder turf Dec. 18. **Al Khali**, who prevailed despite a troubled trip to land the GII Bowling Green H. at Belmont in September, couldn't overcome traffic in the GI Canadian International at Woodbine the following month and wound up fourth, beaten just over a length. Sent off at 9-2 in the GI Breeders' Cup Turf Nov. 6, the big bay failed to mount a threat and finished seventh. He gets the services of Kent Desormeaux here. Veteran **Musketer** made just two starts last season, but they were both good ones at Keeneland. The German-bred grey landed the GII Elkhorn S. in April, and followed that with an honest third in the GIII Sycamore S. in October.

Defending titleist **Bourbon Bay** saw his four-race skein snapped when he ran third by a length to **Champ Pegasus** in the GI Clement Hirsch Turf at Oak Tree in October. Freshened up after that, the bay returned to turn the tables on his rival in the 10-furlong GII San Marcos S. over this course Jan. 17, and is a perfect three-for-three at today's 12-panel distance. The San Marcos was the first start for Champ Pegasus since his gallant second in the GI Breeders' Cup Turf Nov. 6. "It looked like he might have needed the outing in the San Marcos," trainer Richard Mandella offered. "He seemed tired afterward, but that race ought to put him in pretty good shape."

MGISW **Smiling Tiger**, third in the GI Breeders' Cup Sprint and second by a nose in the GI Malibu S. Dec. 26, was upended as the 2-5 chalk in the GII Palos Verdes S. at Santa Anita Jan. 22. The chestnut was third throughout that six-furlong affair, and gets the services of Joel Rosario this afternoon. Trainer Jeff Bonde thought about keeping his colt in the barn, but opted to race here instead. "It was a last-minute [decision to run]," Bonde told *Daily Racing Form*. "He has continued to train very well, and has not been raced that hard." **Supreme Summit**, second by a half-length to Smiling Tiger in the GI Ancient Title at Oak Tree Oct. 9, was freshened up after finishing fourth by two lengths in the BC Sprint. Trainer Mike Puype thinks his five-year-old can turn the tables on his rival at today's seven-furlong distance. "Smiling Tiger ran a hard race in the Malibu, and a hard race in the Palos Verdes," Puype told *DRF*. "If he is loose at seven-eighths, I might run him down anyway."

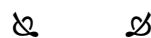

The filly is owned by her breeders, Dark Hollow Farm's JoAnn and David Hayden, Arnold Davidov, Alice Wolf, Dorsey Brown and David Schwaber, and races under the banner Dark Hollow Racing Partnership. The group purchased the three-year-old's dam Dream Out Loud (Stravinsky) for \$315,000 at the 2006 Keeneland November Sale. The mare, then five, was carrying her first foal, a colt by Gone West who later would be sold as a yearling for \$100,000 at the '08 September Sale.

"She was just a beautiful physical," David Hayden said yesterday. "She was a very pretty, elegant mare, and she had enough pedigree for us."



Dream Out Loud

Dream Out Loud, from the extended family of the Grade I-winning grass horses Damister (Mr. Prospector) and Selous Scout (Effervescing), is a

half-sister to another accomplished turf runner in English highweight and millionaire Magistretti (Diesis {GB}), whose victories included the GI Man o'War S. at Belmont.

When it came time to picking Dream Out Loud's second mate, the partners chose Malibu Moon, a fitting choice given that the son of A.P. Indy got his start in Maryland, where Dark Hollow calls home.

"I just love him as a stallion," said David. "I didn't breed to him when he stood here for \$3,500, but I'm happy to breed to him now at his current fee [of \$60,000]."

The mating produced Dream, who was precluded from the yearling sales with an unsightly ailment. "She had some calcification on one of her hind hooves, and it was a blemish that would have put a lot of people off," said Hayden. "Plus, she had a little bit of a splint. If we had sold her, we would have gotten hammered. So thank God for blemishes."

Put into training with Rodney Jenkins, Dream gave every indication the decision not to sell was the right one, and the word was out in her debut, when she went postward as the 4-5 choice in a 5 1/2-furlong dash at Delaware in July.

"In the paddock before the race, Larry Jones said to Rodney, 'Hey Rodney, how come you're running that four-year-old filly against these two-year-olds?'" Hayden recalled. "She's just a big, good-looking filly with a lot of power." When she won off by nearly five lengths in an impressive effort, Hayden said she was simply living up to expectations. "I'll just say she did what we thought she'd do," he said.

Unfortunately, small chips in each knee, as well as one in an ankle, put a stop to the rest of Dream's two-year-old year. "But we took them out and gave her all the time she needed," Hayden explained. Asked what's next, he added, "Well, we'll have to look at a schedule. Two other-thans can be hard to find sometimes. Obviously we'll look at some stakes, too. Ultimately, we really think she wants to go long, and I think she'll love the grass, too."

Dream's dam Dream Out Loud produced an Elusive Quality filly in 2009, had a Street Boss filly in 2010 and will head to WinStar stallion Speightstown in the near future.

Nearly the entire breeding partnership made the trip to Laurel yesterday. "Everybody but Alice Wolf was there; she lives in Naples," said Hayden. "We just had a great time." If Dream keeps progressing, the great times may just be beginning. -LM

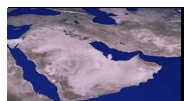
