THE FACTOR MOTORS TO SAN VICENTE WIN

Prior to Sunday's GII San Vicente S. at Santa Anita, most of the hype swirled around the stakes debut of **"TDN Rising Star" The Factor** (War Front). And, after a blistering seven furlongs in 1:20.34, the Fog City and George Bolton sophomore proved that all the pre-race attention was justified as he bagged his first black-type win. Up to take a narrow early advantage over **City Cool** (City Zip), the 4-5 favorite zipped through splits of :22.2 and :43.41. Comfortably in front after a sparkling three quarters in 1:07.31, the grey began to

show the signs of his early exertions, but his class shone through and he held off the rapidly-closing **Sway Away** (Afleet Alex) at the wire. "He has a lot of speed and I know that [City Cool] had a lot of speed too," said winning rider Martin Garcia. "He doesn't want to be behind horses, so I just let him be comfortable and he kept going. I don't think any horse can keep up with him, as fast as he went. He is still learning..I think the more that he runs, the better he will get." *Cont. p2*

KEERTANA THE VERY ONE AT GULFSTREAM

Confirmed closer **Keertana** (Johar) might have appeared to be compromised by a pedestrian opening pace in yesterday's GIII The Very One S. at Gulfstream. However, the five-year-old mare overcame the disadvantage--and early pacesetter **Belle Watling (Chi)** (Dushyantor)--to take the 11-furlong test for older fillies and mares. **Zapparition** (Ghostzapper) closed well to be second, while **Musical Rain (Ire)** (Val Royal {Fr}) rounded out the trifecta. "I was a little worried that we were going so slow," admitted winning rider Jose Lezcano. "I didn't really know how good the horse on the lead, Belle Watling, was. I thought other than her, the one horse [Changing Skies {Ire} {Sadler's Wells}] was the horse I had to beat, and I was able to keep [that rival] on the inside the whole way. The main thing was I didn't want to move too early. [Zapparition] came up to me around the turn and my horse was very game in the stretch." Belle Watling, a multiple Group 1 winner in her native Chile, tired in the late stages to be fourth.

Despite all the backstretch whispering in advance of The Factor's career debut at Hollywood Nov. 28, the dream failed to materialize as the \$250,000 Barretts May sale topper could only manage a fourth-place finish over the Cushion Track, beaten 3 1/4 lengths. Armed with a race under his belt--as well as new pilot Rafael Bejarano--the colt was taken to the front from the word 'go' and rebounded with an eye-popping 8 1/4-length victory over Santa Anita's brand new dirt surface Dec. 26. Drawing from the same well this time, the colt flashed his natural speed once again en route to his second consecutive victory. This time, however, Martin Garcia was in tow. "I knew it was going to be a really fast pace," said Baffert. "The more I looked at the race, we were right in between the two speed horses, and I was afraid they would leave there and try to put the squeeze on him..and that was the only way we he could get beat, was if they put the squeeze on him and he had to check him and take him back.. FLA DERBY POSSIBLE FOR 'MACHO MAN'

Mucho Macho Man (Macho Uno), winner of Saturday's GII Risen Star S. at Fair Grounds, exited his 1 1/2-length victory in excellent condition, Kathy Ritvo said Sunday. "He came out great," confirmed the winning trainer. "It was great to see him get back to two turns; he really needed that. I was really happy overall. [Jockey] Rajiv [Maragh] said he had a lot of horse left." Campaigned by Reeves Thoroughbred Racing and Dream Team One Racing Stables, the bay is expected to return to his home base at Gulfstream this morning. As for the sophomore's next start, Ritvo said, "We're going to see how he comes back before we make plans, but I would love to stay home for the GI Florida Derby [Apr. 3]." Ritvo also indicated that the Mar. 26 GII Louisiana Derby remained a possibility. **Decisive Moment** (With Distinction), who set the pace in the Risen Star before weakening to fifth, came out of the race with a slight soft tissue injury to his left hind leg, according to trainer Juan Arias. There is little doubt that 2010 Cal-bred Horse of the Year **Evening Jewel** will get the lion's share of the support in today's mile test. However, the four-year-old didn't receive the most favorable draw for her third start of the season. "It's a disadvantage going a mile, certainly," said trainer James Cassidy. "We've got a lot going against us. We're the highweight [122 pounds], the rail's at 15 feet, we're in the 11 hole and the ground might be a little soft." Fifth in the 6 1/2-furlong GIII Monrovia S. Jan. 2, the \$8,000 KESEP yearling scored in her latest while going 1 1/16-miles on the dirt in the Sunshine Millions Distaff Jan. 29. In her 16-race career, the stalking filly has triumphed on dirt, turf and synthetic surfaces. "There's some speed in there and that'll be helpful, certainly," Cassidy offered. "I did nominate her for the Valentine Dancer S. next Saturday, but now that I think about it, it's supposed to rain next Saturday and Sunday, so we might be in the same sort of situation."

BREEDERS' CUP/JRA ANNOUNCE NEW RACE IN INTN'L BC CHALLENGE *Edited Press Release*

The Breeders' Cup and the Japan Racing Association announced that the G1 Takarazuka Kinen has joined the international Breeders' Cup Challenge, a global series of stakes races whose winners earn automatic starting positions into this year's Breeders' Cup World Championships at Churchill Downs. The winner of the 1 3/8-mile turf event, which will be contested at Hanshin Racecourse June 26, will automatically qualify for a berth in the 12-furlong GI Emirates Airline Breeders' Cup Turf. As part of the enhanced benefits program for Breeders' Cup Challenge winners introduced this year, the Breeders' Cup will pay the entry fees of \$90,000 and a travel allowance of \$20,000 to the winner of the Takarazuka Kinen to start in the Breeders' Cup Turf. "Breeders' Cup is honored that the Takarazuka Kinen, as one of the world's greatest turf races, is included in the 2011 Challenge series," said Greg Avioli, President and CEO of Breeders' Cup Ltd. "I would like to extend a personal thank you to Dr. Kenji Tsuchikawa and the JRA management team for their efforts that resulted in this landmark agreement providing for the first-ever Breeders' Cup Challenge race in Japan." Last year, Japanese Group 1 winners Espoir City and Red Desire both competed in the Breeders' Cup World Championships. As a further expansion of the JRA and Breeders' Cup partnership, this year's Breeders' Cup Turf winner will be given an automatic berth in the G1 Japan Cup Nov. 27 at Tokyo Racecourse, and will be eligible for up to a \$1-million bonus in addition to its prize money based upon a top three finish in the Japan Cup. "We are very pleased that the Takarazuka Kinen has become the first ever Japanese race to be a part of the Breeders' Cup Challenge series and we are delighted to join with so many other outstanding races from around the world in the program," said Tsuchikawa, President and CEO of the Japan Racing Association. "Over the years, the Takarazuka Kinen has been won by many outstanding horses, and we would be very excited if this year's winner participated in the Breeders' Cup Turf. The winner of the Breeders' Cup Turf is included in the list of horses eligible for the Bonus System for our Japan Cup, and the winner will also receive an automatic invitation to the race. It is my earnest wish that this collaboration between Breeders' Cup Limited and the JRA will not only enhance racing in the United States and Japan, but further encourages and promotes global racing." The complete 2011 Challenge schedule will be announced in March.

RACETRACK Round-Up

SIMCOCK LOOKING AHEAD Trainer David Simcock was yesterday pondering Classic plans for Khalifa Dasmal's joint juvenile champion **Dream Ahead** (Diktat {GB}). Rated the equal of Frankel (GB) (Galileo {Ire}) by the international handicappers at the end of a 2010 campaign which saw him win the G1 Prix Morny and G1 Middle Park S., he will head straight to either the G1 2000 Guineas at Newmarket Apr. 30 or the G1 Poule d'Essai des Poulains at Longchamp May 15. "He looks fantastic, he has wintered very, very well and put a lot of weight on," Simcock told *PA Sport*. "Physically, he looks great and started cantering again three weeks ago. Whether he stays a mile, I don't know, but he will head for a Guineas--either the English or French. I wouldn't give him a prep race as he is a horse who takes a lot out of himself. Ground would be a factor if it came up very quick at Newmarket. The French race might be easier, too, but he'll be entered in both and I'll decide nearer the time."

Coa Continues to Improve; Lopez "Well":

Jockey Eibar Coa showed some improvement after undergoing surgery on his C4 vertebrae Saturday after sustaining serious injuries in the sixth race at Gulfstream Friday. According to Coa's agent Tito Fuentes, the rider exited the surgery well and has recovered some movement in his arms and shoulders. "As of now, he can move his arms and he can feel everything," Fuentes said Sunday morning. "He just can't move everything, but that isn't to say that won't change." According to Fuentes, Coa is scheduled to undergo a second surgery at Memorial Regional Hospital either today or tomorrow. "Eibar's spirits are very good and he's been getting a lot of visitors," said Fuentes. "The fact he can move his arms and feel everything is a very good thing." Paco Lopez, who injured his left elbow in the same spill, presented the trophy for the GIII Sabin S. at Gulfstream Saturday. Lopez, who had his arm in a sling, said he was a "little sore," but otherwise feeling well. Lopez's agent Cory Moran confirmed that Lopez suffered a little chip in his elbow, but doctors did not believe it would require surgery. The jockey is expected to see a specialist today to evaluate the situation and determine when Lopez could return to the saddle.

AMBITIOUS DRAGON TAKES CLASSIC CUP

Ambitious Dragon (NZ) (Pins {Aus})--Golden Gamble {NZ}, by Oregon) gamely overtook favored **Lucky Nine (Ire)** (Dubawi {Ire}) late and forged clear to win Sunday's G1-HK Mercedes-Benz Hong Kong Classic Cup at Sha Tin by 1 3/4 lengths. Ambitious Dragon rated in midpack before moving to challenge Lucky Nine, who appeared to be running easily, at midstretch and outkicked that foe to the wire to complete the 1800 meters in 1:48.03. "They don't know what their rating is," commented winning trainer Tony Millard. "They just know when they're feeling really well on the day. He's just kept improving. We had one little hiccup when we got the riding tactics wrong, but he's a relaxed straightforward horse and a high Grade 1 who can really turn it on." Millard is optimistic about his charge's chances in the Mar. 20 2000-meter G1-HK Hong Kong Derby. "I've no doubt that he'll get the Derby distance," Millard said. "I've looked at his pedigree and there's enough stamina there." Jockey Maxime Millard, who now returns to France, added, "He has to be among the favourites for the Derby now if he remains in today's form and I will definitely be back to ride him." Lucky Nine, coming off a win in the Jan. 23 G1-HK Classic Mile, will also head for the Derby. "We're going forward," confirmed trainer Caspar Fownes. "I'll need to look at the race a few times, but the jockey [Brett Prebble] is happy with him and he ran a very good race today." The Fownes-trained **Let Me Handle It (Ire)** (High Chaparral {Ire}) was third and **Xtension (Ire)** (Xaar {GB}) was a running-on fourth. [Video](#).
