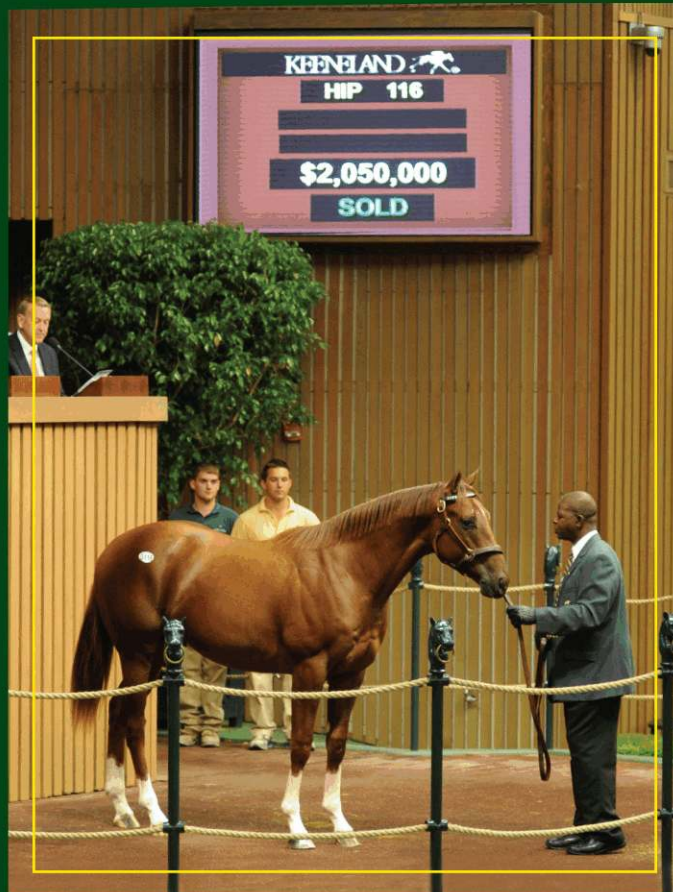

**MICHAEL JARVIS RETIRES** Newmarket-based trainer Michael Jarvis has announced his retirement due to ill health after 43 years in the profession. Famed for his handling of stars Rakti (GB), Carroll House (Ire) and Eswarah (GB), the 72-year-old has had to endure heart

surgery and treatment for prostate cancer in recent times and has begun the process of handing over charge of his Kremlin House stables to his longstanding assistant Roger Varian. "It was obviously a tough decision to have to take and it's disappointing I've been forced to retire," Jarvis told *sportinglife.com*. "I've had a wonderful career and I've loved every moment of it. We've got a lovely yard here and I intend for myself and my wife

Gay to carry on our business. We are installing Roger Varian as a salaried trainer and he will be doing the training. All the owners have been very supportive. We have 90-odd horses here and without exception every owner is very happy to stay." Jarvis's top performer was the six-time Group 1 winner Rakti, who collected five of those after being transferred to his care from Bruno Grizzetti by owner Gary Tanaka in 2003. Carroll House was the winner of the 1989 G1 Prix de l'Arc de Triomphe, while the Maktoum-owned fillies Ameerat (GB) and Eswarah provided Classic glory in the 2001 G1 1000 Guineas and 2005 G1 Epsom Oaks, respectively. Fellow trainer Ed Dunlop paid tribute on *twitter*, "Just read the very sad news that Michael Jarvis has announced his retirement, one of my heroes, a true gent and a great trainer." Longtime stable jockey Philip Robinson added, "Michael has done remarkably well considering how he's been recently and the very strong team he put around himself helped a lot. The greatest asset for any trainer is understanding his horses as individuals and getting the best out of them, and Michael did that. He was a genius at finding out what they liked and what they wanted. Rakti was a very tricky customer, but we worked him out and Michael used to know saddling up whether he was in a good mood or a bad mood and that's how well he knew his horses." Roger Varian later told *sportinglife.com*, "It's an unbelievable opportunity and I'm very grateful for the support Michael has given me and the support our owners have given me. I've been with Michael for 10 years, which is a good stint, and we've had some great years. I've learned an awful lot off arguably one of the best trainers there has been. I hope we're in a very strong position for the season ahead."

## RACETRACK Round-Up

**PAIR TO MISS KILROE MILE** A pair of California's top turf milers have been ruled out of next weekend's GI F. E. Kilroe Mile due to injury, *Daily Racing Form* reports. **Sidney's Candy** (Candy Ride {Arg}), last year's GI Santa Anita Derby hero who switched to turf to take the GII LaJolla H. at Del Mar, has a quarter crack in his right front foot, and will be forced to pass the event. "It's not that bad, but it's cost me the training I think I need for a Grade I race," trainer John Sadler told *DRF*. "It's bad timing." Sidney's Candy closed out his three-year-old campaign with a 7 1/4-length romp in the GIII Sir Beaufort S. off the Santa Anita turf Dec. 26. **The Usual Q. T.** (Unusual Heat), last year's GI Eddie Read S. hero and third to Goldikova (Ire) (Anabaa) in the GI Breeders' Cup Mile, has been hampered by an abscess and will now await the GII Arcadia H. Apr. 9.

**GULFSTREAM VOWS TO ACCOMMODATE CALDER SHIPPERS** Officials at Gulfstream Park have amended their application for dates--moving forward by one week their opening date to Nov. 26--and promising Calder horsemen that there would be extra stall space created for horses that ship from Calder. These are the newest developments in response to an edict issued Tuesday by Calder management which said that any horse leaving the track to race elsewhere would not be permitted back on the grounds without the permission of racing secretary Mike Anifantis. Horses which have started in graded stakes would be excepted from that rule, though they would not be allowed to return until the following day. According to *Daily Racing Form*, officials at Gulfstream are taking measures to assure Calder horsemen that there will be space to house those horses that run at Gulfstream over the coming weekend. *DRF* reports that Gulfstream is considering temporary stalls in tents similar to those used at Hialeah for their Quarter Horse meeting. Additionally, some 250 to 300 stalls at the Palm Meadows training center are set to come available following the Fasig-Tipton sale Mar. 3. Tim Ritvo, vice president of racing for Gulfstream, told *DRF* that any Calder horsemen wishing to relocate would be allowed to do so rent-free for as long as the Calder restrictions remain in effect.

**NTRA REPORT FROM CAPITOL HILL**



**NEW CONGRESS LIKELY TO CONSIDER NEXT FARM BILL AND INTERNET GAMING**

Two important Congressional issues to monitor are development of the next Farm Bill and Internet gaming legislation.

Rep. [Collin Peterson](#) (D-MN), former chairman and now ranking member of the Agriculture Committee, oversaw development of the 2008 Farm Bill that included accelerated depreciation for young racehorses. Last year, he championed early discussions of the next Farm Bill, which determines farm policies for a five-year period. Rep. [Frank Lucas](#) (R-OK) now chairs the Ag Committee and will develop the Farm Bill with Peterson. NTRA will seek a change in the capital gains holding period for racehorses from two years to one and an extension of accelerated depreciation.

Renewing a push from the last Congress to legalize other forms of Internet gaming, the casino industry is expected to revive effort efforts to secure online Poker. With online pari-mutuel wagering already legal under the Interstate Horseracing Act, NTRA remains in discussions with casino interests and Congressional allies to protect and advance horse racing's interests. Rep. [John Campbell](#) (R-CA) may be poised to introduce such a bill and is a featured speaker at an [upcoming I-gaming conference](#).

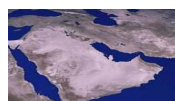

**OLD VIC DIES** Former Sheikh Mohammed colorbearer and dual Derby hero **Old Vic (GB)** (Sadler's Wells--Cockade {GB}, by Derring-Do {GB}) was euthanized Monday after a bout of colic at Sunnyhill Stud in County Kildare. He was 25. Trained by Henry Cecil, the Old Vic, who was to become a major national hunt stallion, annexed the 1989 G1 Prix du Jockey-Club by seven lengths before following up in the G1 Irish Derby. After an initial spell at Dalham Hall Stud, during which he sired the multiple group-winning stayer Orchestra Stall (GB), he was sent to Japan before beginning his highly successful spell as a jumps stallion at Barleythorpe Stud and later Sunnyhill, where he had been pensioned since last year. Former jockey Steve Cauthen paid tribute to the powerful frontrunner yesterday when telling the *Racing Post*, "He was a tremendous galloper with fierce determination. He was really suited by Chantilly and The Curragh and he was a brilliant winner at both tracks. Looking back, I find it very hard to separate Old Vic, Slip Anchor and Reference Point."

**LANWADES SPONSOR NELL GWYN** Kirsten Rausing's Lanwades Stud has announced its sponsorship of Newmarket's G3 Nell Gwyn S. Apr. 13.
