## DUDE, REALLY?

They were playing bumper cars at the top of the stretch and the stewards took a very long look at the tapes, but, in the end, they opted to leave the order of finish untouched, and 14-1 **Game On Dude** (Awesome Again) was the upset winner of the GI Santa Anita H. Game On Dude, on the pace from the start, grabbed the lead as they approached the stretch. Odds-on **Twirling Candy** (Candy Ride {Arg}) was closing, with 25-1 **Setsuko** (Pleasantly Perfect) moving in tandem to his outside. That's when the trouble started. The judges deemed that Twirling Candy set things in motion when brushing Game On Dude.

Game On Dude, tattooed twice left-handed by Chantal Sutherland, then came out sharply, bumping Twirling Candy. Twirling Candy dropped back abruptly after the incident, leaving Game On Dude and Setsuko, who had also been bothered, to battle it out to the wire. It was Game On Dude getting the nod. Sutherland and winning trainer Bob Baffert, understandably, applauded the stewards' decision. "I think the stewards made the right call," said Baffert. "It was a tough call, but, after watching the replay, I knew he had a chance to stay up." Said Sutherland, "When I watched the replay, I thought it was clear that Joel [Rosario, on Twirling Candy] kind of tipped into Victor [Espinoza, on Setsuko], and bumped into me." But the rival connections were not happy. "I don't know why it took so long to make the wrong decision," Espinoza said. "I think the stewards are blind. Obviously, those three stewards, they don't know what they're looking at. I don't mind running a legitimate second, but when you knock the air out of my horse and you get beat by a head, it's just insane." Added John Sadler, trainer of Twirling Candy, "Everybody was riding against him, so he got hammered every which way. There just wasn't much of a chance." Cont. p2

She suffered the first defeat of her career when second to **Zazu** (Tapit) in the GI Las Virgenes S. Feb.5, but **Turbulent Descent** (Congrats) turned the tables with a neck victory in the GI Santa Anita Oaks yesterday. Rated just off the pace as Zazu trailed the five-horse field early, the bay cruised up outside the leaders on the far turn and set sail for home. Zazu came charging late, but ran out of real estate. The final time for the 1 1/16 miles was a stakes record 1:41.05, eclipsing the mark set by Bold 'n Determined in 1980. Cont. p2

Game On Dude, a maiden winner at Gulfstream Park in February of 2010 for trainer Michael Mareina and owners Kuehne Racing and Bernie Schiappa, joined the Bob Baffert stable after finishing off the board in the GI Florida Derby last March. He ran fifth in the GIII Derby Trial in April for Schiappa and new owners Lanni Family Trust and Mercedes Stable, then galloped to a handy score in the May 8 GIII Lone Star Derby. The performance earned him a trip to the GI Belmont S. June 5, and Game On Dude was not disgraced, finishing fourth by 2 1/4 lengths. But that was it for the year--the dark bay did not start again until annexing a Santa Anita allowance test Jan. 27. He was overlooked by the bettors in his second start of the season. Up to press the pace from third, the longshot shook off the antics at the top of the lane and fought it out with Setsuko, getting his nose down on the line. Turbulent Descent was a handy maiden in her Oak Tree debut Oct. 3, and came back to take the Moccasin S. at Hollywood Nov. 21. She made it 3-for-3 in the GI Hollywood Starlet S. Dec. 11, where Zazu finished fifth, but had to settle for second behind that rival in the Las Virgenes last time out. Fitter for that effort, the Florida-bred swept to the lead at the top of the lane and put her head down as Zazu closed to get to the wire in front. Turbulent Descent will not target the GI Kentucky Oaks, but could have a trip to New York in her future for the GI Acorn S. at Belmont and/or the GI Test S. at Saratoga. The filly's owners include Scott Sherwood and William Strauss, both of California, and Robert Butler of Colorado Springs. Sherwood, a childhood racing fan, owned and operated a retail sporting goods company, and now heads the Blinkers On Racing syndicate. Strauss is the founder of retailer ProFlowers. Trainer Humberto Ascanio, an assistant to trainer Bobby Frankel for 36 years, saddled Fluke to a 9-1 victory in the 2009 GI Citation H. just 11 days after Frankel passed away. Ascanio has struggled since that victory, going 0-for-40 in 2010, but Fluke has remained a stalwart of the string. The dark bay made three starts last term, running second by a nose behind Proviso (GB) (Dansili {GB}) in the Kilroe, then filling out the exacta in the GI Arcadia H. in April and in an allowance at Hollywood Nov. 27.

Fluke got his conditioner off the schneid with a win in the GIII Thunder Road H. at Santa Anita Feb. 5, and he was well-backed to make it two in a row. Rated off the pace while tucked in along the rail early, the Brazilian-bred edged closer on the far turn. He was gifted an opening on the inside at the top of the lane and powered on through, then held off the hard-charging Caracortado in a game effort. "I was worried the horse might be a little short, because in one month I only gave him two works, but I wanted a fresh horse, a happy horse and it paid off," Ascanio said. Owner Patricia Bozano is the daughter of Julio Bozano, owner of Haras Maria de Araras in Brazil. She now resides in Greenwich, Connecticut. Emerging from the shadow of stablemate and champion Uncle Mo (Indian Charlie), Stay Thirsty proved himself worthy of Triple Crown chatter with this decisive victory. The dark bay was a sharp 5 1/4-length maiden winner when making his second start at Saratoga Aug. 14, and came back to be second in the GI Three Chimneys Hopeful S. Sept. 6. He was a disappointing fifth in the Nov. 6 GI Breeders' Cup Juvenile, but he opened his sophomore campaign in style here. Jockey Ramon Dominguez was sitting high in the saddle as he reined in Stay Thirsty to sit just off the leaders while floated wide going into the first turn. He sat chilly down the backstretch, finally giving Stay Thirsty a nudge on the final turn. The rider drew his whip at the top of the lane and went to work left-handed, and the crowd's choice responded, sweeping to the front inside the final furlong before drawing clear. "Today is all about Stay Thirsty, and I think he proved that when you get away from Boys At Tosconova (Officer) and you get away from Uncle Mo, this is a pretty special horse," owner Mike Repole said, adding, "Uncle Mo will go to the [GI Apr. 9] Wood Memorial, and Todd [Pletcher] and I will discuss the two options for Stay Thirsty, probably either the [Apr. 16 GI] Arkansas Derby or the [Apr. 3 GI] Florida Derby." Four starts back, Mike Repole's Repole Stable reached in and claimed Calibrachoa from breeder Nelson Bunker Hunt and trainer Steve Asmussen for \$40,000. The dark bay was a 4 1/4-length winner in that Nov. 18 claiming event at Aqueduct, and came back under new management to take the Dec. 18 Gravesend S. as part of an entry sent off the 3-2 chalk. Bet down to 2-5 in the Jan. 22 GIII Toboggan S., he made it three in a row with a determined half-length tally, and the 4-year-old continued the streak at odds-on once again here.

Calibachoa was taken in hand to race behind the dueling duo of stablemate Have You Ever (Van Nistlerooy) and Deputy Daney. Those two opened up on the field as they raced down the backstretch and around the far turn, but Calibrachoa eased out at the top of the lane, caught the fading Have You Ever in a matter of strides and collared Deputy Daney at the eighth pole before drawing off. He was eased up at the wire. "It was Mike's idea to put another horse in there to make sure we had an honest pace, and that allowed Ramon [Dominguez] to ride him however he saw fit," trainer Todd Pletcher said. "Obviously, Ramon sensed that they were flying early, so he just let him settle and he relaxed really well. It looked like he won with something left." Added Repole, "I looked at the horse, and asked Todd [about claiming him], but, at the end of the day, Todd makes the final decisions on anything I do. He trained him. Here's a \$40,000 claimer and now he's come back and won an ungraded stakes, a Grade III, and a Grade III. He looked like a monster. He's only moving up. Todd's done an amazing job with him." **RACING BILLS PASS KENTUCKY GENERAL**

**ASSEMBLY** *(Edited press release)* Two major pieces of horse racing legislation achieved final passage Saturday in the Kentucky General Assembly. HB 387 will require advance deposit wagering companies to report handle to the Kentucky Racing Commission, and SB 24 would create an Interstate Compact for horse racing states. "I'm pleased a bipartisan group of legislative leaders came together to pass two bills that will improve horse racing, not only in Kentucky, but also in the United States," said Senator Damon Thayer. "In particular, I would like to recognize House Speaker pro-tem Larry Clark and Representative Susan Westrom for collaboration on these important racing bills." HB 387 was sponsored by Rep. Clark and will require ADWs to become licensed with the Racing Commission and report their handle on Kentucky races quarterly. Currently, ADWs do not report handle on individual states or tracks, unlike the reporting of on-track or simulcasting handle. The reporting requirement will give the industry a better understanding of how the ADW market functions. SB 24 was sponsored by Sen. Thayer and creates an interstate racing and wagering compact, with Kentucky becoming the first state to enact the provisions of the compact. The Compact will give state racing commissions the option--but not require them--to participate in the same rules and programs as other states. It will also simplify procedures for horsemen racing in multiple jurisdictions. "The racing industry should thank Senate President David L. Williams for his leadership ensuring the passage of the compact bill," explained Senator Thayer. "Senator Williams made the compact a national priority when he hosted a panel discussion on its provisions at the 2010 meeting of the National Council of State Legislators in Louisville."

## in sharper focus.

### WILBURN (Bernardini)

Reached for a comment yesterday, Woodbridge Bloodstock's Mike Helmbrecht, co-breeder of Wilburn, had to cut the conversation short after just a few seconds.

"Can I call you back at this number?" he asked politely. When he phoned back a few minutes later, he was laughing. "I had one that was trying to get out of the paddock there! I tell you, this game will keep you on your toes!"

Helmbrecht, having arrested the progress of the Houdini horse, didn't really need any more evidence that he's on his toes. Not after Wilburn's impressive victory. Helmbrecht is the president of Woodbridge, a small operation that also includes his brother, trainer Bill Helmbrecht, and a few partners. Woodbridge bred Wilburn, from the first crop of the red-hot Bernardini, and originally offered him as a yearling at the 2009 Fasig-Tipton October Sale. The colt was listed sold at \$75,000, but was actually bought back by the group.

"He was one of those horses that, everyone who was around him was impressed by him," explained Helmbrecht. "When he was a baby, he was a great big colt, and he laid on a hock and got a little blemish, and it took us a while to get him over that. By the time we took him to the October Sale, he had impressed the hell out of us--we'd go out and look at him and he was just improving in leaps and bounds--and we just couldn't let him go for that."

They decided instead to keep and race Wilburn, and put him into training at Turfway Park. By March, Wilburn was breezing from the gate and being pointed to the Keeneland meet. And Keeneland was where the colt would wind up, though not in one of the baby races. He held an entry to the April Two-Year-Olds in Training Sale, and, with a little prodding by Dr. Gary Lavin from Keeneland's inspection team, Woodbridge decided to send him through the sales ring.

"Doc Lavin came to look at him at Turfway, and he showed my brother the score he gave him," Helmbrecht explained. "He said, 'This is the highest 2-year-old I've ever scored. You've got to sell him.' We said, all right, if he's that impressed, someone else will be, too."

It was the right move. At Keeneland, Wilburn drew the attention of Darley's Jimmy Bell and Fox Hill Farm's Rick Porter, each of whom made a play for the colt. But in the end John Moynihan, on the phone with Stonestreet Stable's Jess Jackson, proved gamest, buying the horse for \$625,000.

"He's a nice horse, we hope," Moynihan said at the time. "They've done so much with him. He's been working every week--he's working half-miles out of the gate. You know he's sound. I don't know if we're going to keep going to the same extent they were going. I think we may just stop on him a little bit. He looks like he's a big two-turn horse to us."

Helmbrecht agrees the horse looks like a two-turn animal, but said that, despite his size, he's athletic enough to be effective at nearly any distance. That was proven yesterday when he scorched 6 1/2 furlongs in 1:13.95, or four ticks off Square Eddie's track record. "No matter what spot they picked, they would have been right," Helmbrecht said. "We all had that kind of confidence in him. I congratulate them. They obviously did the right thing [giving the horse time]. He's a great big horse, and to break on top, then take back like he did, that's an athlete."

Woodbridge's association with Wilburn's family goes back to the colt's second dam, the Wheatly Hall mare Wheatly Way. Helmbrecht bought her privately off the track in the mid-1990s. "She was a 2-year-old stakes winner, her mother was a 2-year-old stakes winner, and her grandmother was a stakes winner," said Helmbrecht when asked of Wheatly Way's appeal. "She had a pin in her hock, and they had bred her two years in a row while keeping her in training, and didn't get her in foal. So I got her for a song--something like \$15,000. When I got her up to Kentucky, I got her in foal on one cover, and it's been a good story ever since." **Cont. p7**

Wheatly Way's second foal for Woodbridge was Bevo (Prospectors Gamble), who they sold for \$31,000 as a weanling. Bevo went on to win the GI Futurity S. and GII Saratoga Special at two and place in the GII Riva Ridge S. at three. A few foals later came Moonlight Sonata, who they kept and campaigned to a victory in the GIII Arlington-Washington Futurity S. in 2002.

Moonlight Sonata quickly showed her worth in the breeding shed, too. Her first foal was Beethoven (Sky Mesa), a \$235,000 KEENOV weanling who resold to John Oxley 10 months later at KEESSEP for \$300,000. Beethoven won the GII Jockey Club S. at two.

Moonlight Sonata's next foal was the filly Southern Sonata (Dixieland Band), a winner on the track and now, in foal to Sky Mesa, back in the Woodbridge broodmare band. Wilburn is Moonlight Sonata's third foal; her fourth, a 2-year-old full-sister to him named Venetian Sonata, also holds an entry to Keeneland April, though Woodbridge hasn't made an firm plans with her.

"We plan on keeping her, but if the price gets up there, we'll see," said Helmbrecht. "She's not as big as her brother. She's like a lot of the Bernardini fillies. They're not as big and strong as the colts. But she's real neat and real pretty, and she's doing everything right. She's at Turfway, doing the same things we did with her brother."

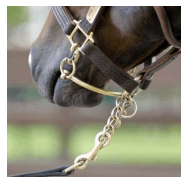
Moonlight Sonata had another Sky Mesa colt in 2010. She's currently in foal to A.P. Indy--grandsire of Sky Mesa and Bernardini's sire--and is booked back to Lane's End's star.

Helmbrecht, who manages Destiny Oaks farm in Ocala, said Woodbridge just has the three mares from the family--Wheatly Way, still going strong at 22, Moonlight Sonata and Southern Sonata--but three is all you need with that sort of production.

"We've had some luck," said Helmbrecht. "It's just one of those families that works for you." -LM

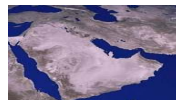
## BEAUTY FLASH PREPS FOR DUTY FREE

He too cuts back in trip, but trainer Caspar Fownes has not ruled out the 2000-meter Hong Kong Derby for his next start, pending today's results. "He stayed the 1800 meters no problem," says the trainer. "He had a minor issue with one of his feet after the race which may have affected his ability to finish off. 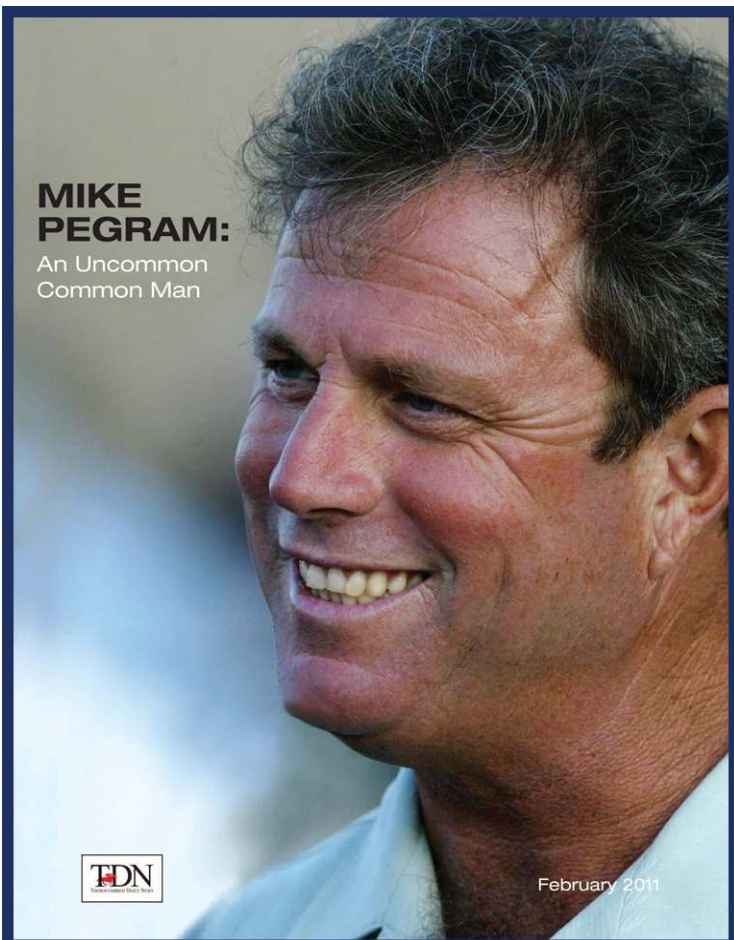
