## DROPPED CALL, BUT STILL DIALED IN

Robert LaPenta's three-year-old **Dialed In** (Mineshaft), winner of the GIII Holy Bull S. Jan. 30, suffered his first career loss when he failed to reel in stablemate **Equestrio** (Elusive Quality) in a nine-furlong allowance

at Gulfstream yesterday (see ATW-p1 for full result). But connections, pointing out the race was a prep for the GI Florida Derby Apr. 3, took the loss in stride. "The jock [Julien Leparoux] was happy," trainer Nick Zito said. "The horse that beat him isn't a bad horse. It was two turns, they were older horses and there was no speed in the race.

I would have liked to win, but I have to be happy." Sent off the hot 1-5 choice in his first two-turn test, Dialed In was at the back of the small five-horse field early. He began his rally two furlongs out, splitting horses, but 4-year-old Equestrio got the jump on him and was long gone after pressing through a slow three-quarters in 1:13.89. The winning margin of a half-length would have been more had Equestrio not veered out abruptly in the last sixteenth. "He made the mile and an eighth," Zito said of Dialed In. "When [Equestrio] bolted at the end, [Dialed In] made another dash for the wire. You know the Florida Derby is going to have more speed. If he has a good month, we'll still look at that." Leparoux added, "We got a trip, a good teaching trip, but there was no pace unfortunately. It's horse racing, he's going to have horses next to him in the [Kentucky] Derby, so he's got to learn that. The horse on the outside made me be patient, that's all. It was a good race. The first two races, the half was :45 and :46. This race it was almost :50." In his only other start, Dialed In won a Churchill MSW Nov. 12.

## BIG 'CAP CONTROVERSY RAGES ON

Fall-out from Saturday's GI Santa Anita H. controversial non-disqualification raged on Sunday morning as Hall of Fame trainer Richard Mandella announced that runner-up **Setsuko** (Pleasantly Perfect) exited the roughly run event with an injury. The Wertheimer et Frere homebred, who finished a nose short of **Game on Dude** (Awesome Again) and remained in that slot when the race went official 12 minutes later, bumped with odds-on favorite **Twirling Candy** (Candy Ride {Arg}) (ultimately fifth) as part of a chain reaction caused by initial contact between Game on Dude and the chalk.



## Big 'Cap Controversy continued...

"Setsuko came out of the race with a cut on his left front leg," said Mandella. "He's got a lot of swelling in the leg and we're treating it, hoping that it isn't going to become more serious. There's no question he got cut by Twirling Candy." Mandella added, "I don't want to drag the game down by saying anything now about the decision the stewards made. I think [the stewards] should talk to the jockeys, but I think it was chicken [expletive] that [winning trainer Bob] Baffert was trying to talk to the other jockeys and to the stewards." The three-time Big Cap winner continued, "I was trying to be a gentleman and, unless the trainer is claiming foul, I just don't think it's right that he is trying to talk to the jocks and to the stewards."

Winning rider Chantal Sutherland, who became the first female rider to win the Santa Anita H. and returned to the winner's circle to the sound of boos from fans who believed that her mount instigated the contact with Twirling Candy, was understandably more upbeat the following morning. "People are saying that I floated out when we turned for home, but I didn't," said the Canadian native. "I was in

the path I was in when we turned for home and my horse maintained a straight path [before being bumped by Twirling Candy]."

Cristina Patino's **Snow Fairy (Ire)** (Intikhab) will bypass the G1 Dubai World Cup and run in the G1 Dubai Sheema Classic instead, trainer Ed Dunlop announced yesterday. Connections ruled out a first try of the Tapeta surface in the Mar. 26 main event and have opted to stick with the turf option for the four-times top-level scorer. "She worked on Saturday morning with Ryan Moore and we've all made the decision to run her in the Sheema," Dunlop told *PA Sport*. "Putting everything together, we've decided to stick to what we know best. We know she goes well on fast turf, and we were not totally certain about running her on Tapeta for her first race of the season. It is something we've all agreed on." Snow Fairy was last seen annexing the G1 Cathay Pacific Hong Kong Cup at Sha Tin Dec. 12.



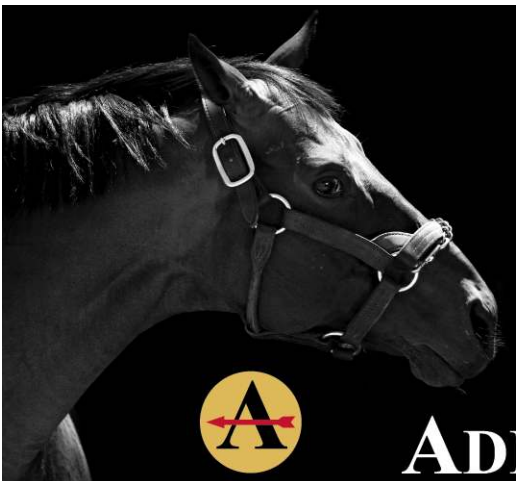

# Triple Threats

## The Factor Could Go in Rebel...

Last year, trainer Bob Baffert used Oaklawn's GII Rebel S. as a stepping stone to the GI Kentucky Derby for Lookin At Lucky (Smart Strike), and now appears to be favoring that route with **"TDN Rising Star" ⚡ The Factor** (War Front). The 1 1/16-mile race will be held Mar. 19.

After The Factor took the seven-furlong GII San Vicente S. at Santa Anita Feb. 20, Baffert said he was eyeing the \$800,000 GIII Sunland Derby over nine furlongs at Sunland Park Mar. 27. Connections

were attracted by the big purse, likely modest competition and speed-favoring track in what would be The Factor's first time around two turns.

But on Sunday, Baffert reversed course. "If he works well next week, and I'm happy with him, we'll go to the Rebel," Baffert told *Daily Racing Form*. "If I'm not happy, we'll go to the next one. That's my plan." Lookin At Lucky won the 2010 renewal of the Rebel, and while the victory didn't translate into Derby glory, Lookin At Lucky went on to be the divisional champ. "I think [The Factor] deserves one chance at two turns," said Baffert, who admitted it might be tough throttling the speed of a horse who broke Santa Anita's track record in his maiden win, sprinting six panels in 1:06.98 Dec. 26. "He's a runaway train," added Baffert. George Bolton and Fog City Stable's colorbearer underscored that point in a six-furlong work at Santa Anita Saturday morning, which he completed in a best-of-18 1:10 3/5. In recent years, the Rebel has been won by Curlin (Smart Strike) ('07), Lawyer Ron ('06), and Smarty Jones ('04).

Four expected contestants for Oaklawn's GII Rebel S. stretched their legs over the track Sunday in preparation for the Mar. 19 event. Robert Yagos's **Archarcharch** (Arch), who took the GIII Southwest S. over the Hot Springs oval Feb. 21, breezed six furlongs

in 1:13.40, the second-fastest of seven drills at the trip, under regular rider Jon Court. "I'm very pleased with the work," said conditioner William "Jinks" Fires. "Jon was really happy with it and said it felt like he's getting better. I told him 'I sure hope he is.'" Elite Alex LLC's **Elite Alex** (Afleet Alex), third in the

Southwest with a wide trip for trainer Tim Ritchey, drilled six panels in 1:12.40 while outclassing a pair of workmates to earn the bullet under Calvin Borel. "That was very awesome," said Borel. "He's just hitting everything right. He's such a big horse, I think he's only going to get better the farther we go. He's going to love the big sweeping turns at Churchill. He really reminds me of [2007 Kentucky Derby winner] Street Sense. I think that's why I love him so much. I wouldn't trade places with anybody for nothing right now."

**Alternation** (Distorted Humor), who defeated Elite Alex two back before earning the ☆ **"TDN Rising Star"** ☆ tag when he took an allowance by 3 1/4 lengths on the Southwest undercard to up his route record to three-for-three, fired a bullet of his own. The Pin Oak Stable homebred

traveled as many as seven lengths behind two-for-four workmate Pulpitarian (Pulpit) early in his drill, but picked up the fellow Pin Oak runner easily when set down to come through on the intentionally open rail and finish well clear in :59.80, the swiftest of 47 spins at the distance. "It's probably going to be a big field he sees next time," said trainer Donnie Von Hemel. "We wanted to make sure he could come through there like that, and [rider Luis Quinonez] said he handled it nicely." Von Hemel also sent out Smarty Jones S. winner **Caleb's Posse** (Posse), who had a tough trip when finishing sixth in the Southwest for McNeill Stables LLC and Cheyenne Stables, to a five-furlong workout in 1:02.20. "He was on the muscle," said pilot Eddie Razo. "He always works good, but today he just felt more solid. He's getting better every time. I think next time he's going to be really tough."

**Turbulent Descent New York-Bound...**

Blinkers on Racing Stable, et al.'s **Turbulent Descent** (Congrats), who turned the tables on rival Zazu (Tapit) by a neck in Saturday's GI Santa Anita Oaks to up her career record to 5-4-1-0, will be pointed towards a campaign in New York this summer. "She definitely has the [June 11 GI Acorn S. at Belmont] and the [Aug. 6 GI Test S. at Saratoga] as two of her highest priorities," said conditioner Mike Puype. "Those are career-making races both for winning an Eclipse award and for a broodmare." Despite victories in last term's GI Hollywood Starlet and the Santa Anita Oaks at 1 1/16 miles, as well as a runner-up effort behind Zazu in the eight-furlong GI Las Virgines S. in Arcadia Feb. 5, Turbulent Descent's connections feel she is best going shorter, and will bypass the May 6 GI Kentucky Oaks. "I have no doubt that she will be better going shorter," Puype said. "She has a brilliant amount of acceleration, and is best going seven furlongs or a one-turn mile with a target to run behind." Apr. 9. "He is doing very, very well right now," said Arthur Magnuson, assistant to McLaughlin. "He is a young

horse, and we are trying to let him grow up between starts, especially since he ran so big in his last race. 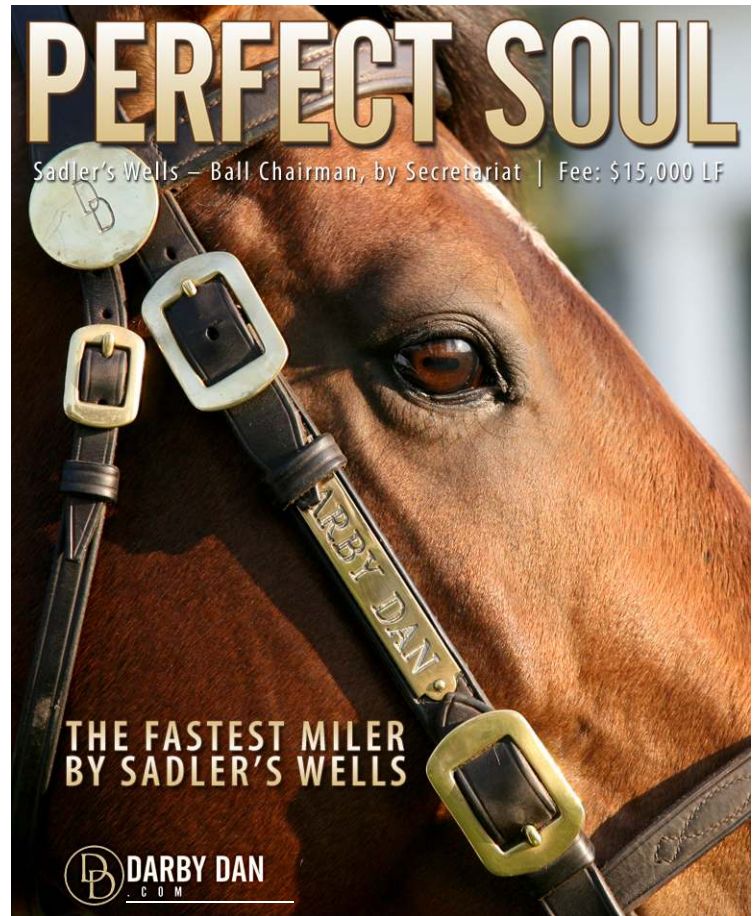

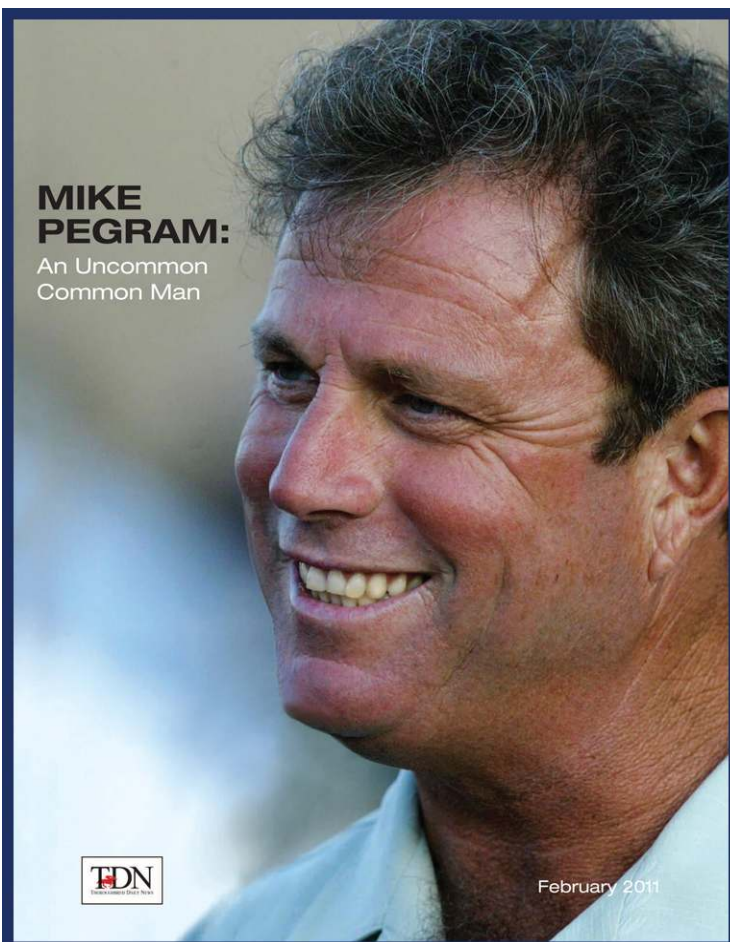


victory in the HK\$6-million (US\$770,530) Queen's Silver Jubilee Cup, and is now poised for an attempt at the 1800-meter, US\$5-million G1 Dubai Duty Free at

the Dubai World Cup meeting Mar. 26.

Scaling back to 1400 meters, or roughly seven furlongs, after wins at a mile in the Hong Kong Mile Dec. 12 and Stewards' Cup Jan. 30, Beauty Flash wasn't operating at his ideal distance, and the local bettors let him go at 3-1 odds. But while he had to work for the win, his class shone through. Positioned in third while racing wide, Beauty Flash was given his cue by Gerald Mosse in upper stretch, forged to the front not long after and safely held Stewards' Cup runner-up Sunny King (Ire) (Desert Sun {GB}) and the favorite and sprint specialist Lucky Nine (Ire) (Dubawi {Ire}) by a half-length. The final time for the race was 1:21.74.

"I was a bit worried about the drop down to 1400 meters because of the different pace of the race," said Mosse, who had been suffering from mild dehydration earlier in the day. "But this horse had enough speed, so he was always there and always ready when I pressed the button. He's a superstar, and I want to say thank you to the trainer and the owner for letting me ride this lovely horse." Tony Cruz was equally thrilled with the performance of his stable star. "The plans just all seem to be falling into place," said Cruz, who also won last week's Citibank Hong Kong Gold Cup with California Memory (Highest Honor {Fr}). "I visualized this race beforehand, and it all seemed to happen exactly as I'd seen it." Cruz commented of the 6-year-old's progression...and future. "Beauty Flash suffered from bleeding when he was younger, but he just seems to have grown out of it," said Cruz. "Meydan is definitely where he's going next, and I'm not worried about racing left-handed, because in New Zealand, where he was foaled and raced before he came to Hong Kong, he was running that way every time." Trainer John Moore was impressed enough by runner-up Sunny King's effort to make immediate enquiries about supplementing the 8-year-old for the 1200-meter G1 Dubai Golden Shaheen on World Cup night.

eye-catching win in the 1200-meter RDA Cup over Kranji's Polytrack Sunday in Singapore. Rocket Man will be trying to do one better from a year ago, when he ran **Kinsale King** (Yankee Victor) to a half-length in the Golden Shaheen. The champion galloper, hammered down to 1-20 favoritism, showed his

usual speed under Barend Vorster and cruised to the line 5 3/4 lengths clear of his nearest rival. Trainer Patrick Shaw said Rocket Man was in great shape for his Dubai mission. "I said to Barend, if the circumstances permit, to try and tuck in behind...early in the race and then let him open up once in the straight," Shaw said. "It was important to try and get him to settle. He did it beautifully, and we know he is spot on now looking forward to Dubai." Shaw added, "We'll get him x-rays, as we always do, before he goes. With horses like him you just hope they come back sound." Vorster was full of praise for his mount. "He just felt superb in himself today," he said. "I had goosebumps when I got on him, as he was bouncing around in the back yard, but he eventually switched off and was nice and relaxed. They went quite quickly in the early part, and I just let him go through his paces. From the 600, he just picked it up himself and worked his way through. In the straight, it was important to give him a good hit-out and keep his mind on what he was doing, not have him twitching his ears and having a look around. Everything is 100% with him. His weight is spot on, so all we can do now is touch wood and keep our fingers crossed."
