Augustin Stable's **Dynamic Holiday** (Harlan's Holiday) secured her first graded stakes victory when she came from off the pace to take the GIII Herecomesthebride S. at Gulfstream Park Sunday. Sent off at 4-1, the attractive bay was content to settle in fifth as early

pacesetter **War Prospector** (War Front) reeled off early splits of :24.23, :47.95 and 1:10.86. Ready to roll turning for home, the Pennsylvania-bred angled out turning for home and drove clear late to post a two-length victory over closer **Mystical Star** (Ghostzapper). Michael

Tabor's **Excited** (Giant's Causeway), trained by Todd Pletcher, made a mild bid to be third as the 5-2 choice. "Our trip was perfect," said winning rider Ramon Dominguez. "I was hoping she was going to put herself into contention, because it seems like you have to be pretty close to the pace on the turf right now. Everything worked out perfectly. There was enough speed to set up her run and she was good again today. Her last few races, she's really gotten good." cont. p2

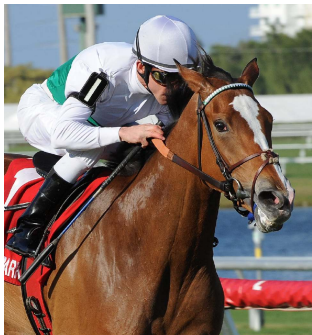

J P'S GUSTO WORKS FOR REBEL Gem Stable's **J P's Gusto** (Successful Appeal) tuned up for Saturday's GII Rebel S. with a bullet five furlongs in :59 2/5 at Oaklawn Sunday. "We were looking for something a little sharper," said trainer Joe Petalino. "He had been just plodding along by himself with what he had been doing and had been doing it easily. We wanted to put something in front of him to make him a little sharper. That's what he needs because the water is getting a little deeper

now." Working in company, J P's Gusto completed the drill in fractions of :24, :47 3/5 and galloped out in 1:12 1/5. In his first start for Petalino, the GI Del Mar Futurity winner was runner-up in his sophomore debut in the Feb. 21 GIII Southwest S. Petalino has been peppered with questions about J P's Gusto's ability to go the Kentucky Derby's 1 1/4 miles, but the trainer is taking each race as it comes. "All the national handicappers and media are calling and comparing his chances to get a 1 1/4 miles," he said. "Last I checked, the Rebel and the [Apr. 16 GI] Arkansas Derby aren't 1 1/4 miles. The owners don't appear to have Derby fever too much. They sent him here because they liked the distance progression and they are out to enjoy each race as it comes." Also working towards the Rebel yesterday, **Dreaminofthewin** (Successful Appeal) went five furlongs in 1:00 4/5. Second in the Jan. 17 Smarty Jones S., Dreaminofthewin has been bothered by a quarter crack all winter. "He went good," said trainer C.R. Trout. "The time was fine and the foot is holding up. You've heard of a wing and a prayer? That's kind of how we are flying with that foot right now. But he's training awfully good and it's exciting. We know we are swimming up hill, but I think he will make a good account of himself." Rebel hopeful **Glint** (Sharp Humor) went an easy half-mile yesterday at Oaklawn in :51 3/5. The TK Stable colorbearer is coming off a third-place effort in the Mar. 5 Mountain Valley S.

Premier Pegasus (Fusaichi Pegasus), who exited a 7 3/4-length victory in Saturday's GII San Felipe S. in fine form, appears to be headed to the Apr. 9 GI Santa Anita Derby. "He looked great after the race, and we'll

take a look at the Santa Anita Derby as the next step," said Raxon Cho, 17-year-old son of Myung Kwon Cho. The 68-year-old Cho is owner, breeder and trainer of Premier Pegasus. "We spent most of the night watching replays of the race," added Raxon, who is working toward getting his own training license. "His margin looked even bigger

after watching them." According to trainer Tim Yakteen, **Bench Points** (Benchmark), third behind Premier Pegasus, is also possible for the nine-furlong Derby. **Quail Hill** (Candy Ride {Arg}), who reported home fifth in the San Felipe S., is "out of the picture" for the Santa Anita Derby, confirmed trainer David Hofmans. The sophomore will instead try allowance company next time out.

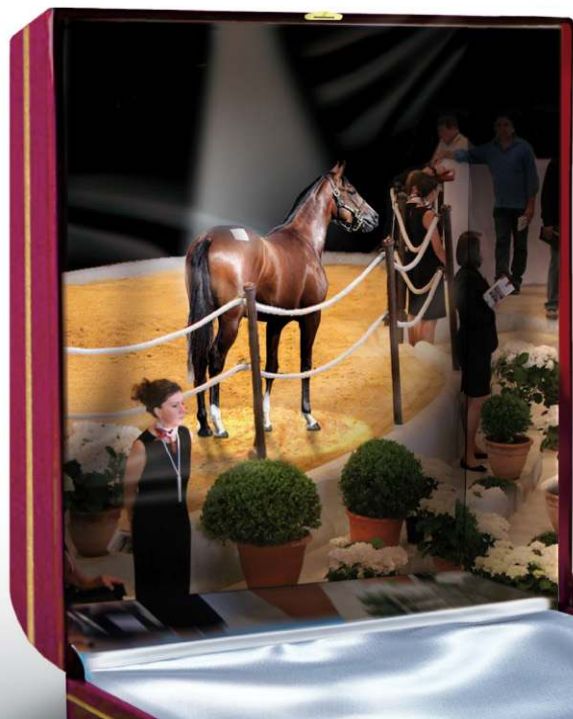

FLYING HIGH

The O'Farrell family's Ocala Stud, a perennial leading Florida commercial breeding operation since its inception in the late 1950s, enjoyed a banner season in 2010, spearheaded by GI Hollywood Starlet S. heroine **Turbulent Descent** (Congrats--Roger's Sue, by Forestry), GI Oak Leaf S. victress **Rigoletta** (Concerto--Almost Apron Queen, by Montbrook), and \$1-million GIII Delta Downs Jackpot S. winner and current Triple Crown contender **Gourmet Dinner** (Trippi--Potluck Dinner, by Pentelicus). The big three--all bred or co-bred by Ocala Stud--grossed \$235,000 at last year's OBS April two-year-old in training sale.

"It was an incredible year for us," Ocala Stud President and General Manager J. Michael O'Farrell Jr. reflected. "It started out with **Lisa's Booby Trap** (Drewman) winning a stakes at Saratoga--that's a filly that we bred and actually gave away. The next thing you know, she's undefeated and they're looking to do a book and movie about her--it was crazy. I didn't realize that was going to be the start of something big.

He continued, "Lisa's Booby Trap kind of fizzled, but from there on in, it seemed like almost every weekend we had something that we had either bred, or had here for some clients that we raised or trained that were winning graded stakes. It really was an exciting year for us."

The numbers are impressive. From 89 starters in 2010, horses bred by Ocala Stud--including in partnership--grossed \$3,849,579 in purse earnings, good for 11th on the leaderboard behind Adena Springs, according to *equineline.com*.

Boasting eight black-type winners in 2010, Ocala Stud jumps into a tie for fourth on the list with the late Edward P. Evans, trailing only Frank Stronach's operation (16), Brereton C. Jones (12) and WinStar Farm LLC (9). Each year Ocala Stud sells its entire juvenile crop at OBS or privately. The operation doesn't race.

"We own about 50 mares now, and that's more than we've had," O'Farrell, who began managing Ocala Stud in 1971, revealed. "From a produce standpoint, a big crop for us is 30. We're not what you call a big breeder, numbers wise. I think we've done pretty well, but you've got to keep doing it. You can't rest on last year. They've got to go out and run again this year too."

The former residence of influential sire Rough'n Tumble is currently the home of six stallions, led by Montbrook, sire of last year's champion sprinter Big Drama. Concerto, Gottcha Gold, High Cotton, In Summation and Silver Tree round out the roster. O'Farrell isn't looking to expand Ocala Stud's stallion operation for the time being.

"The truth is that the stallion market has gotten extremely hard to get the quality of stallion that you want," he explained. "At one point, Grade III horses were bringing a couple of million dollars, then you go up the ladder. It didn't really make sense for me, especially being based in Florida. When the market dropped I was able to pick off a couple that I felt I'd do well with and not have to pay a lot for. In today's world it's hard for me to go out and invest in a real nice horse when you have to depend on selling seasons, and quite frankly, it's a tough marketplace. It's not that I don't need or want a nice horse. I just don't know if the timing is right. I have to wait and see."

Ocala Stud, which sold successful young sire Trippi to South African interests in 2008, also breaks and trains approximately 150 horses per season. Jim Tafel's Kentucky Derby/Breeders' Cup Juvenile winner Street Sense (Street Cry {Ire}) is a recent graduate of the program.

"I can only stay in this business if our horses go out there and run," the 63-year-old commented. "Somebody told me a long time ago, our ads aren't written, they're running."

In Sharper Focus...

O'Farrell acquired Turbulent Descent's unraced dam Roger's Sue in foal to Golden Missile for \$105,000 at the 2004 Keeneland November sale. The ensuing colt realized \$230,000 at the 2007 OBSFEB two-year-old sale. Pleased by the first foal, he decided to send Roger's Sue back to another son of A.P. Indy.

"Congrats is from the same sire line, and we really did like the Golden Missile colt," he explained of the mating decision which produced 2010 juvenile filly Eclipse finalist and recent GI Santa Anita Oaks heroine Turbulent Descent. "He sold well, was a good-looking horse, and breezed well at the sale.

Unfortunately he got hurt, and never reached his potential for Silverton Hill. In the meantime, we bred the mare to Congrats, an extremely well-bred and good-looking horse. He didn't win his first graded stakes until he was older, didn't show a lot of speed in his races, but we felt like we had a very nice looking mare by Forestry, which tends to be speed, and we felt like the cross was good."

With recently retired trainer-turned-bloodstock-agent Greg Gilchrist handling bidding duties, Turbulent Descent brought \$160,000 on behalf of Scott Sherwood's Blinkers On Racing Stable after breezing a quarter in :20 4/5 ([video](#)) at the 2010 OBS April Sale. An injury suffered from a rocky plane ride to the West Coast delayed the cleverly named bay's debut a bit, but she has certainly proven worth the wait, bursting on the scene with an eye-catching win at the Oak Tree meeting Oct. 3. One race later Rigoletta capped a huge day for Ocala Stud, lighting up the tote board at 32-1 for owners Erik and Pavla Nygaard's Thor-bred Stable LLC in the Oak Leaf. She was a \$35,000 OBSAPR graduate.

"It was an amazing day," O'Farrell said. "Turbulent Descent ran a *super* race in the maiden, then Rigoletta won the Oak Leaf. They won back-to-back races and one was as impressive as the other.

"But one was a maiden race and one was a Grade I," he added with a slight laugh.

Barren in 2010, Roger's Sue recently produced an In Summation foal. The 10-year-old mare was sold privately about a month ago, according to O'Farrell.

Ocala Stud's ties with Rigoletta and Gourmet Dinner trace all the way back to the duo's third dam, Victorious Meg (Soy Numero Uno). She was purchased for \$20,000 at the 1985 OBSOCT sale as a broodmare prospect.

"We had two or three daughters from the family and they were producing nice-looking horses and had talent," O'Farrell. said of Victorious Meg's appeal. "They weren't bred to the top stallions in the world, but they were getting runners. I kept accumulating more fillies from the family--all of them were producing runners, so I just kept getting more of them. The family's been good to us. Three daughters of Victorious Meg have produced stakes winners for us--that's what you try to do. We've been fortunate that they've run so well."

Gourmet Dinner punched his ticket to the GI Kentucky Derby trail with a third-place finish in the GIII Holy Bull S. Jan. 30 and an honest runner-up effort behind Soldat (War Front) in the GII Fasig-Tipton Fountain of Youth S. Feb. 26. Our Sugar Bear Stable's \$40,000 OBSAPR acquisition currently sports \$989,660 in earnings.

"He's built a little bit like me--I'm 6'5" and weigh 175 pounds and he's kind of built the same way," the

Westminster, Maryland native quipped. "He's withstood his training and has filled out now and is running very well. He's run his race every time. They're trying to decide where to run him--in the Florida Derby or Santa Anita Derby. We look for big things from him going forward."

The recent success hasn't stopped there for

the consignor. **Tackleberry** (Montbrook--Box Of Joy, by Concerto) capped a four-race winning streak with a nose success in the GIII Fred W. Hooper H. last December. Fourth in the GIII Hal's Hope S. Jan. 8, the four-year-old has been unbeatable at Gulfstream since, taking the nine-furlong Sunshine Millions Classic S. Jan. 29, returning on quick notice to record a sharp score in the GII Gulfstream Park Sprint Championship S. Feb. 12, and most recently securing the GII Gulfstream Park H. Mar. 12. Tackleberry, owned and trained by Luis Olivares, hails from the family of Ocala Stud standouts MGISW Mighty Appealing (Valid Appeal) and GISW Outofthebox (Montbrook). Ocala Stud bred Tackleberry's first three dams.

"We had him in the [OBSFEB] sale two years ago," said O'Farrell, who also serves as the Ocala Breeders' Sales Company's Chairman of the Board. "He's a big and strong, grand-looking horse--a lot like his father. He's actually bigger and stronger, but not quite as good looking as Chapel Royal (Montbrook), who we also [bred and] sold [for \$1.2 million at the 2003 OBSFEB sale]. Tackleberry had an extremely good breeze for our final prep before the breeze show, but chipped a knee. We had to scratch him from the sale, and he was operated on. We wound up selling him privately. We were extremely high on him; he was the nicest horse we had that year."
