HOLDING "SWAY" IN THE REBEL?

He came up just short in the GII San Vicente S. at seven furlongs Feb. 20, but **Sway Away** (Afleet Alex) should have the advantage over San Vicente winner **The Factor** (War Front) in today's GII Rebel S. going

1 1/16 miles at Oaklawn Park. Sway Away came up 3/4 of a length short last time, and his connections are confident he will make up the difference in his two-turn bow. "It has been near impossible to close on the new track at Santa Anita," said owner Phil Lebherz. "We've been about the only horse

who has come close to doing it. The main thing we want is a fair track [Saturday]." Lebherz and trainer Jeff Bonde took the 2008 Rebel with Sierra Sunset, who scored by three lengths as a 4-1 chance. "We're all excited to be back," the owner remarked. Sway Away makes his third career start this afternoon. A 3 1/4-length maiden in his debut at Pleasanton last June, he was second by a half-length to **J P's Gusto** (Successful Appeal) in the GII Best Pal S. in August. The colt injured his knee after that effort, and was making his return in the San Vicente. "This horse looks like he's built for the distance," Lebherz said. "We will find out [Saturday]." Sway Away will bid to avenge the sixth-place finish of his sire in the 2005 Rebel.

TWICE OVER HEADS WORLD CUP PROBABLES

Juddmonte Farms' **Twice Over** (GB) (Observatory) heads a list of 14 horses from all corners of the world that are likely to face the starter in next Saturday's \$10-million G1 Dubai World Cup at Meydan Racecourse. The six-year-old was 10th as an 11-2 chance in last year's running, but zoomed to the top of this year's market with his impressive first-up run in the Round 3 of the G2 Maktoum Challenge over the World Cup course and distance Mar. 3.



Twice Over *Horsephotos*

The American contingent, which arrived Thursday in Dubai, is led by three-time Eclipse Award winner **Gio Ponti** (Tale of the Cat), who will be having his first run since finishing second to the irrepressible Goldikova (Ire) (Anabaa) in the GI Breeders' Cup Mile at Churchill Downs last November. **Cape Blanco (Ire)** (Galileo {Ire}) will mark the first World Cup starter for Aidan O'Brien, while former Ballydoyle runner Joshua Tree (Ire) (Montjeu {Ire}), last-out winner of the Qatar Invitational Cup Feb. 24, is one of the more notable absentees. He was expected to race in the G1 Dubai Sheema Classic, a wide-open affair headed by the globetrotting **Snow Fairy (Ire)** (Intikhab). **Probable Fields, p5-6**

Go For the Gusto?


J P's Gusto (Successful Appeal) looks to get back on track after four straight losses. The bay reeled off wins in the GIII Hollywood Juvenile Championship, GII Best Pal S. and GI Del Mar Futurity last year, then ran second when making his route bow in the GI Norfolk S. Sixth in the GI Breeders' Cup Juvenile, he was runner-up again in the Dec. 18 GI CashCall Futurity at Hollywood and in the Feb. 21 GIII Southwest S. over the local strip. He prepped for this with a bullet five-eighths in :59 2/5 at Oaklawn Mar. 13.

Two Defections...

The Rebel field was reduced to 11 with after the connections of two contenders opted out of the race. **Dreaminofthewin** (Successful Appeal), first or second in his five career starts, has been scratched due to a problems with a quarter crack. "We put on a different shoe, and he just wasn't comfortable this morning," said trainer C.R. Trout after watching his charge gallop Friday. "With the big field and the foot not 100 percent, we didn't want to take a chance. It's a long year." **Glint** (Sharp Humor), third in the Mar. 5 Mountain Valley S. after going two-for-two as a juvenile, was taken out of the race after drawing post 11 in the 1 1/16-mile test. "With what happened with the draw and the big field, it looked, to me, like about as tough a prep race as I've seen," said trainer Kellyn Gorder.

Eclair de Lune looks to get back on track after a pair of off-the-board efforts. The bay captured the GI Beverly D. S. last August, but was let go at 23-1 in the GI Breeders' Cup F/M Turf Nov. 5. Beaten just two lengths when sixth in that event, she was the even-money chalk in the Megahertz S. at Santa Anita Jan. 23, and finished an even fourth. The 5-year-old stretches out off that one-mile test. **Turning Top** capped a three-race winning streak with a one-length tally in the GIII Beverly Hills H. at Hollywood last June. Fifth in the GII John C. Mabee S. at Del Mar in August, she ended the year with a second in the Oct. 2 GI Yellow Ribbon Invitational S. and a third in the Oct. 31 GII Las Palmas H. The dark bay was last seen finishing a rallying sixth in the Feb. 21 GII Buena Vista H. **Malibu Pier**, two-for-four on the weeds, closed ground late to be third in the Buena Vista, and should appreciate the added furlong here.

Dream steps up as she bids to run her record to three-for-three. The bay made one start at two, graduating by 4 3/4 lengths at Delaware Park in July. After taking the remainder of the year off, she returned to post a six-length allowance score at Laurel Feb. 18. "She had a little chip after her debut race," said trainer Rodney Jenkins. "She was never lame, but she is 16.2 hands and built like a colt, so we decided to take it out. She was about 80-percent ready for her return effort, but she still ran a good race. We thought about coming back in Wide Country [at Laurel Mar. 5], but that was probably a little quick, as it was two weeks later. The Cicada's timing suited us better." **Quantum Miss**, a 16-length winner in state-bred stakes company at Penn National in November, was the 7-5 chalk in her 2011 opener, the Jan. 5 GII Old Hat S. at Gulfstream. The grey stumbled at the break, however, then rushed up to press the pace before fading to fifth. She makes her second start of the season here. **In Step**, a \$1-million KESEEP purchase for Darley, made her debut at Gulfstream Feb. 20 and got up to win by a half-length. She takes on stakes foes at second asking. "Graded-black type is very important, and the allowance races [at Gulfstream] are as tough as the ones at Saratoga," said trainer Kiaran McLaughlin. "This is not the normal next step we'd take, but, even if she ends up finishing third it, will do a lot to enhance her value."

TRF RESPONDS TO NEGLECT ALLEGATIONS

The Thoroughbred Retirement Foundation held a teleconference yesterday to respond to allegations in a *New York Times* article by Joe Drape that horses involved in the TRF program were suffering from serious neglect. Last December, the TRF's largest benefactor, the estate of the late Paul Mellon, commissioned a Missouri-based veterinarian to head up an evaluation of the 1,200-plus ex-racehorses, cared for at more than 25 different farms around the country, in the TRF herd. There were instances of neglect uncovered, but, according to TRF President George Grayson, his organization lent its full support to the evaluation, and acted immediately when cases of neglect were uncovered. "We had pretty extensive discussions with the [Mellon executors] in December and before that, too, in regards to herd inspection," Grayson said. "We authorized, approved and facilitated the herd inspection. In fact, [during] one of my conversations with an executor early on, she said, 'George, what would you do?' I said, 'I'd get a vet.' The story in the *New York Times*, at least as I read it, implied that we were somehow not in favor of or in support of [the herd inspection], when, in fact, we've had two of our employees--and we don't have many employees--dedicated just to assisting the Mellon executors with questions that they had. We've done our best to make the process work." The Mellon Estate established a \$5-million endowment for the TRF in 2001, but Grayson pointed out that the TRF cannot tap more than a fraction of the endowment in any given year. "I think one of the biggest misconceptions is that we can freely access the whole [Mellon] endowment, and that's not the case," Grayson explained. "The whole endowment is worth approximately \$7 million--it has done very well as far as performance. But the terms of the endowment specify that the TRF is entitled to expend annually an amount not to exceed 5% of the market value, and those funds are used solely for the care and maintenance of the horses. Obviously, that works out to be a very significant sum--\$350,000--but that covers about 12-13% of our operating expenses. So, I think, understandably, there's a misconception that the TRF is very wealthy, that we have this healthy endowment, 'why don't we use the endowment to pay certain costs?,' etc. And people say 'I'm not going to give to the TRF because I know they have this endowment thanks to Mr. Mellon,' but the reality is that we're limited to the 5% per year, which of course is fairly customary in the tax-exempt world."

TRF Chairman Tom Ludt acknowledged that the organization has been under heavy financial pressure and, due to a growing herd and diminishing donations, have fallen behind in payments to the facilities that care for the TRF horses. "I would obviously agree that the TRF has taken on an enormous amount of horses," Ludt said. "We had around 300 horses eight years ago, and now we have more than 1,200. That was compounded, obviously, by the issue of economic pressure. People have had to cut back on their support of the TRF. But, our mission is to keep these horses. We have an aging herd, but our horses are under decent care and in decent condition." He added, "Our intentions are to continue to give these horses a happy and healthy environment until their time comes." The Jockey Club, which has donated just under \$250,000 to the TRF over the last two years, issued a statement in support of the organization. "The [TRF] has done terrific work with retired Thoroughbreds for a long period of time," said James L. Gagliano, president and chief operating officer of The Jockey Club. "We are working with the foundation's board and management team to get a better understanding of this matter and to ensure that all TRF horses are cared for in the appropriate manner. We will continue to support retirement efforts, including those of the Thoroughbred Retirement Foundation, and we encourage others in the Thoroughbred industry to do the same." The 3-year-old is expected to be bred this spring. "She came out of the race with a real slight tendon," trainer Dan Hendricks told *DRF*. "It's enough that there was concern. They're settling on a breeding right now." After graduating in her second start at Del Mar last August, the Florida-bred ran third to Tell a Kelly (Tapit) in the

GI Darley Debutante at the oceanside oval Sept. 4, then turned the tables on that filly in the GI Oak Leaf S. at Hollywood Oct. 3. A splint bone injury kept her out of the Breeders' Cup, and the bay returned to run fifth in the GIII La Habra S. on Santa Anita's hillside course Feb. 21. She heads to the breeding shed with a record of 6-2-0-1 and earnings of \$184,070.

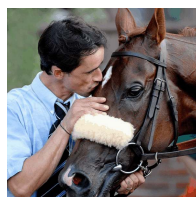

THE NEWS AT TEN: 13 ZIP :10 FLAT

Ten flat was a popular number at yesterday's Barretts March Sale of Selected 2-Year-Olds in Training under-tack show. No fewer than 13 horses shared the bullet for the single-session preview, which came in advance of Monday evening's auction in Pomona, California. All of the :10 flat workers came in the second and third sets, giving the impression the track got a tick faster after the initial renovation break and as the day warmed up. Though there was forecast for showers today, the weather was ideal Friday, with sunny skies and temperatures in the mid-60s. The day's fastest quarter-mile breeze went to [hip 102](#), a colt by Rock Hard Ten--Barbara Orr from Ciaran Dunne's Wavertree Stable.

Things didn't go off without a hitch. After working fine earlier in the morning, the timer malfunctioned, delaying the breeze show by 45 minutes as track technicians tried to figure the problem out. That meant the first group of horses, about 10 in all, had to wait things out while under tack at the chute at the head of the stretch. The horses remained cool and calm, however, and finally the first worker of the day, Sequel Bloodstock's [hip 19](#), a filly by Malibu Moon--Fighting Countess, by Ringside, kicked things off.

Later in the day, a pair of horses from Dunne's Wavertree were galloping out after breezing in company when one, an Indian Charlie--Mama Tia colt ([hip 40](#)), dumped his rider on the backstretch. The colt, none the worse for wear, trotted away in opposite direction, toward the 4 1/2-furlong chute, but was soon collected by the outriders. The colt had worked in :10 1/5. His stablemate, a filly by Master Command--Stylish Mission ([hip 85](#)), worked in :10 2/5.

Many of the faces seen earlier in the week at OBS March were in attendance, but there seemed to be a few new shoppers, as well. The crowd included California trainers Bob Baffert, Dan Hendricks, Kathy Walsh and Craig Dollase. The colorful Cajun Eric Guillot was present, as was The Sarge, Nick Hines, who recently purchased a trio of horses at OBS March. Bloodstock agents Steve and Gary Young, Buzz Chace, Pete Bradley, Alex Solis II and Bob Feld were on hand, as well.

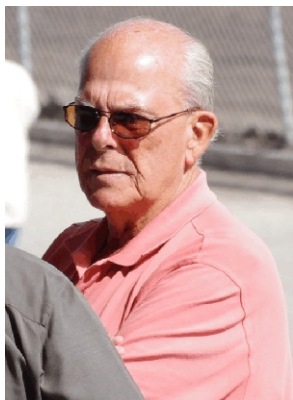

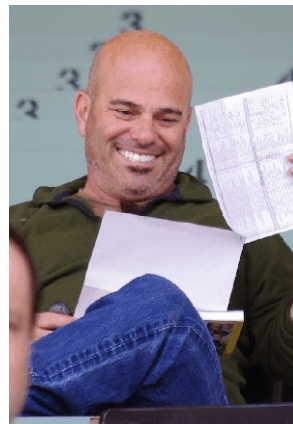

MONMOUTH AMENDED SCHEDULE

APPROVED *Daily Racing Form* reported Friday that an amended 2011 schedule for Monmouth Park was approved by the New Jersey Racing Commission. The 141-day schedule, which was changed to push back the track's opening to May 14 and the scheduled closing day to Nov. 27, remains up in the air, however. The New Jersey Sports and Exposition Authority, which owns Monmouth, is expected to lease the track to a winning bidder by June 1, and the lessee is expected to request further amendments to the track's schedule. While state law requires Monmouth to run for a minimum of 141 days, the requirement could be waived if an agreement between the lessee and Jersey horsemen is reached. Under the approved schedule, the Oceanport oval will only run on weekends and Memorial Day in May.

MCDONALD BUYS OUT EATON PARTNERS

Reiley McDonald, who has owned a majority interest in Eaton Sales and managed the business for 18 years, has bought out his former partners in the company. McDonald said that he will retain his core staff while greatly streamlining his business. "We've been analyzing the mega-consignment business for a year or two now, and I've come to the opinion that the large-consignment business model is flawed and I really don't think that, at least for us, the huge consignments are really practical, efficient or even financially sustainable anymore," he explained. "We're going to run the company in a much more consolidated manner, with an emphasis on quality and keeping our numbers in check."

McDonald Buys Out Eaton Partners cont.

For McDonald, it's time for a change in philosophy to quality over quantity and more painstaking attention to detail. "When I work a horse sale, I want to feel like all the horses are getting maximum attention, our sellers are getting maximum attention, and the buyers as well, but I haven't felt that way in the last couple of years," he reflected. "Because the consignment business has become more complicated, when you have that many horses, it's hard to maintain quality control." McDonald paid homage to the large consignors, but asserted that the time has come to become more focused in his approach. "I think we've been one of the top three consignors for as long as I have been doing it," he offered, "but, I want to feel more in touch with our product and clients. It's not that large consignments don't have a place, but I just want to change the way we do business." He added, "My partners and I discussed it and agreed, if changes were to be made, I would take over their interests in the company." Among the former shareholders in Eaton was Gaines-Gentry Thoroughbreds. "They really want to concentrate on their core businesses--breeding, stallion shares and racing--which they do very well," McDonald said. "I'm in the horse sales business, and that's what I want to concentrate on. It made sense for me to take over their interests in the company." The consignor brings renewed enthusiasm and energy with this shift in strategy. "I love Thoroughbreds and horse racing," he commented. "I get a big high off selling a horse well. There is nothing better than showing and selling a good horse, and that's what we want to emphasize over the coming years." He added, "It is still Eaton Sales. We will continue to operate with the very best sales personnel in the business at the Keeneland and Fasig-Tipton auctions."

LONG RUN STRIKES GOLD Little had eluded Cheltenham's winningest trainer Nicky Henderson, but the veteran handler could at last boast a G1 Cheltenham Gold Cup success after **Long Run (Fr)** (Cadoudal {Fr}) surged up jumping's most famous hill, in track-record time, to claim a stellar renewal of steeplechasing's blue riband event yesterday. The seven-length victory, at the expense of trainer Paul Nicholls' champions **Denman (Ire)**



(Presenting {GB}) and **Kauto Star (Fr)** (Village Star {Fr}), was the first by a 6-year-old since Mill House (Ire) (King Hal {GB}) garnered the 1962 edition, and the first amateur-ridden winner for 30 years. Giving the 7-2 favorite a ride that belied his amateur status, jockey Sam Waley-Cohen positioned Long Run in fifth until coming under pressure when inching into third approaching the home turn. He joined Kauto Star and Denman traversing the penultimate obstacle and bounded to the fore approaching the final barrier, where a prodigious leap carried him beyond recall of the veteran duo, who were followed in fourth by their stablemate What a Friend (GB) (Alflora {GB}).

AMERICAIN BACK IN TRAINING Gerry Ryan's **Americain** (Dynaformer) has resumed training in France with Alain de Royer-Dupre, but is eyeing a return to Australia for a defense of his G1 Melbourne Cup title in November. The former Wertheimer et Frere runner was a revelation for his new connections, winning three of four starts in France at marathon trips, capped by the G2 Prix Kergorlay over 3000 meters. He prepped for last year's Melbourne Cup with a head success in the G3 Geelong Cup, and registered a 12-1 upset in the "race that stops a nation" Nov. 2. He cut back in distance for the G1 Cathay Pacific Hong Kong Vase Dec. 12, and gave a good account of himself, finishing third to Godolphin's Mastery (Ire) (Sulamani {Ire}). "It was a pretty good effort in a tough race," bloodstock agent Rob Roulston, who brokered the purchase of Americain, told *AAP*. "After that, he went back to France...and is being aimed at the [G1] Coronation Cup in June. It would be a six- or seven-run year with the Melbourne Cup at the end of it, although it's possible he could go back to Hong Kong for the Vase."

HIGH CLEARANCE AT INGLIS MARCH SALE
