trained Lookin At Lucky (Smart Strike) emerged victorious in last year's Rebel. While The Factor was credited with a bullet six furlongs in 1:12 1/5 Mar. 12, he breezed a mile, for all intents and purposes, finished up well and was given the green light for a midweek flight. **Cont. p2**

GRACE AND POWER

It was almost as entertaining a duel on the tote as it figured to be on the track. Fox Hill Farm's **Havre de Grace** (Saint Liam) opened with at 3-5 with the lion's share of the early action, while champion **Blind Luck** (Pollard's Vision) sat up there as the 9-2 third choice. The gap gradually narrowed, and, as they approached the gate, the old acquaintances were joint favorites at 3-2 with about 900 smackeroos separating them. At the last flash, it was the California raider at 6-5 to the locally based Havre de Grace at 8-5, but they can't read the tote, and, making her 4-year-old debut, the

second choice turned in a stakes-record equalling performance, defeating her rival on the square by 3 1/4 lengths. "She did everything we expected her to," said winning trainer Larry Jones. "She had trained very well. It was awesome. I wasn't planning on going out and equaling the stakes record, but it was a bonus that she did it fast. She's an incredible mare."

Fact Checking...

The \$250,000 salestopper at last year's Barretts May Sale, The Factor was deemed "a freak" by trainer Bob Baffert as related to owner George Bolton ([Click here for the Take Two feature on The Factor with owner George Bolton](#)). Though he was put into steady training in June, The Factor did not race at Del Mar and instead was prepared for a start at Hollywood Park in late November. He was bet down to 70 cents on the dollar going 6 1/2 furlongs on the Cushion Track Nov. 28, but the grey never looked a winner, as he had just one rival behind him entering the final furlong and ran on evenly to finish fourth, beaten 3 1/4 lengths. His next appearance would feature a dramatically different performance. Trying Santa Anita's conventional dirt surface on opening day of that meeting Dec. 26, The Factor ran a hole in the wind, drawing off by 8 1/4 lengths in 1:06.98 and earning a speed figure similar to the one given to Twirling Candy (Candy Ride {Arg}) for his win in the GI Malibu S. later on the card. The San Vicente was selected for his stakes debut, but the colt was plagued by foot issues and turned in just three works in the 56 days between his maiden score and the San Vicente. It didn't matter. He streaked through a half-mile in :43 2/5 on that occasion and stayed on well under the circumstances, stopping the clock in 1:20 1/5 in handing the late-running **Sway Away** (Afleet Alex) a 3/4-length defeat.

Two Turns? No Factor Whatsoever...

The start of the Rebel was delayed for a few minutes when Pin Oak Stable's ☆ **"TDN Rising Star" ☆ Alternation** (Distorted Humor) became cast in the gate and was subsequently scratched. He suffered some superficial cuts and will be treated with antibiotics, trainer Donnie Von Hemel said. Once the gates flew back, it took but a few strides for The Factor to show the way, and he raced--his mouth firmly against the bit--through an opening couple of furlongs in :23.33. He was still eager turning up the backside and tugged jockey Martin Garcia through a second quarter-mile in :23.44, traveling freely, but comfortably. The quarter pole loomed after six panels in a testing 1:10.98, and when his pursuers began taking closer order, it was left to be seen how the 7-5 chalk would respond. Garcia went for his mount in earnest in upper stretch, and in an instant, The Factor put three lengths on the field and came home powerfully, quieting distance questions, at least for the time being. "He is really that fast," the victorious rider commented. "He surprises a lot of people. He doesn't look like he's going as fast as he is. He just keeps going. Nobody would was going to catch him today. He's a really nice horse." Sway Away got shuffled back into the clubhouse turn and "never got a chance to run his best race," according to trainer Jeff Bonde. The Factor and Sway Away are candidates for the GII Arkansas Derby Apr. 16.

Perfect in two starts on turf to begin her career, Malibu Pier was a running-on fourth in the GIII Harold C. Ramser H. at Oak Tree Oct. 17, then made a winning debut on the main track by taking an off-turf allowance Nov. 21. She tried conventional dirt for the first time in the GI La Brea S. Dec. 26, and, despite steadying at the start, outfinished every rival bar Switch (Quiet American) for some Grade I black-type. Never a factor when last of five in the GII El Encino S. Jan. 16, the homebred was last seen finishing third as the chalk in the GII Buena Vista H. going a grassy mile Feb. 21. Narrowly the second favorite here behind Turning Top, Malibu Pier and Lilly Fa Pootz engaged in an enervating speed duel which saw them draw some eight lengths clear of Turning Top midway down the backstretch. She conceded the lead to Lilly Fa Pootz, who looked to be going much better of the two as they reached the turn, but re-engaged entering the stretch. Turning Top was in the middle of launching her bid with just under three furlongs to race, when she bobbed and lost her footing. That may have made the difference in the end, as Malibu Moon took command past midstretch and held sway late. "I gave her a little breather before I came to the turn, and then let her go," commented winning jockey Rafael Bejarano. "When I came to the top of the stretch, I let her shoot to the lead. A two-time winner in four trips to the post for Jeff Thornbury, Hilda's Passion was troubled fourth in her first start for this barn, a 5 1/2-furlong turf sprint at Monmouth July 18, but atoned for that with a smashing 8 3/4-length victory in the off-turf Bennington S. at Saratoga Aug. 23. She was given a bit of a breather off a season-ending success in the GII Lexus Raven Run S. at Keeneland Oct. 23. The bay couldn't quite overcome the 10 hole when the 2-1 favorite in this track's GIII Sugar Swirl S. Jan. 15, going down by a neck to the classy Tar Heel Mom (Flatter), but bounced back with a coast-to-coast victory over Ms Vanenza (Successful Appeal) in the Feb. 13 GIII Hurricane Bertie S. Flaunting her speed here as the heavy chalk, Hilda's Passion found the front readily, but Amen Hallelujah was not going to make life easy and hounded her from a close second. The IEAH runner tried the eventual winner leaving the quarter pole, but Hilda's Passion put three lengths on her at the eighth pole and drew off to an easy victory. "She travels so smoothly that you don't realize how fast she's going, but when I saw the 44 (half-mile), and Amen Hallelujah inch up to her, I thought she might have a real race on her hands until she drew away in the stretch," said winning trainer Todd Pletcher, who indicated the GI Humana Distaff S. May 7 is up next. Hilda's Passion's final time of 1:20.45 bettered the track record of GI Breeders' Cup Sprint hero Big Drama (Montbrook) by 0.43 seconds. SCAT ATTACK AT OBS MARCH

Japanese interests, bidding in front, outlasted Coolmore rep Demi O'Byrne out back to land the top-priced horse, a ridgling from the first crop of Scat Daddy, for **\$400,000** during the opening session at OBS March Sale of Selected Two-year-olds in Training Tuesday..... He put buyers on notice at the first breeze show, soaring through an eighth in :9 4/5 (video)--the fastest during that session and co-fastest of the sale. Old South was selling the horse on behalf of Carrie and Craig Brogden and Sandy Willwerth's Machmer Hall, which bred the Mar. 2-foaled bay.

Scat Daddy, winner of the **GI Champagne S.** at two and the **GI Florida Derby** at three, stands at Coolmore's Ashford division for a 2011 fee of **\$10,000**. He is also the sire of hip 170, colt out of Mrs. Filio (Eastern Echo) from Niall Brennan Stables who elicited a bid of **\$170,000** from Eric Fein, Ian Brennan agent.

"I love the Scat Daddies we have," said Brogden, who elaborated, "He throws the bigger hip--he throws the hip he has, rather than the hip Johannesburg had, so he has more of a dirt feel to him. Every single one we've dealt with has had very good vetting and great brains."

Havre de Grace spotted Blind Luck a fair bit of experience last season while under the care of trainer Tony Dutrow, but engaged in a pair of thrilling duels with her last summer, first going down by a nose when making her graded-stakes bow in the GI Delaware Oaks July 10 before succumbing by a neck after leading late in the GI Betfair/TVG Alabama S. at Saratoga Aug. 21. She exacted her revenge while in receipt of 10 pounds from the GI Kentucky Oaks winner in the GI Fitz Dixon Cotillion S. at Philly Park Oct. 2, but finished in third, a length behind Blind Luck, and 2 3/4 lengths adrift of Unrivaled Belle (Unbridled's Song) in the GI Breeders' Cup Ladies' Classic Nov. 5. She was unraced since, but was the subject of wildly positive reviews from her trainer, who was saddling her for the first time. With Ramon Dominguez accepting the call, Havre de Grace raced in a midpack fourth in the three path, as her arch-rival assumed her usual place at the tail. Absinthe Minded, one of two in the race for D. Wayne Lukas, took the field through six furlongs in a solid 1:11.58, but began to feel the pressure of Havre de Grace as they reached the stretch. She quickly put that rival away and opened up readily while being kept to her task. Blind Luck was asked for her best leaving the three-eighths pole, took the overland route in the stretch despite an opportunity to go inside and turned in a performance far superior to either of her previous two starts this season. Doubles Partner served it up to his rivals late, flying home in the final 50 yards to take a blanket finish. A maiden winner over the Churchill turf course to close out his freshman campaign, the bay--out of a full sister to Serena's Song--added a Gulfstream allowance before finishing down the field in eighth in the GII Lane's End S. He bounced back with a 9-2 victory in the GII American Turf S. at Churchill Apr. 30, but finished fourth to Paddy O'Prado (El Prado {Ire}) in the GIII Colonial Turf Cup June 19 and bid adieu for the season. The WinStar runner missed the kick in his Feb. 2 return to action and ran on well to miss by 3/4 of a length in second behind the front-running Don Cavallo (El Prado {Ire}). 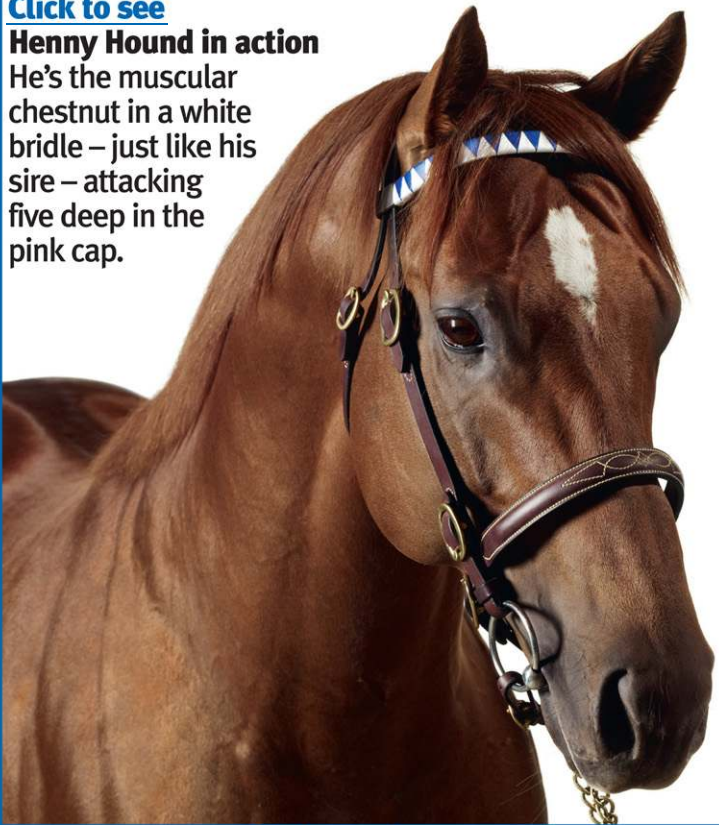

Shipped to South Florida for her three-year-old debut, the grey was sent off the 7-5 favorite in the GIII Old Hat S., but stumbled and was bumped at the break and retreated in the stretch to finish a well-beaten fifth. Quantum Miss dueled heads apart with Roman Treasure (Roman Ruler) here through an opening quarter in :22.49 before gaining command for good at the quarter pole. She drew clear leaving the furlong marker and held sway late as Coax Liberty came with a solid run. The latter was skittish in the gate and was unprepared for the start. She was therefore last to leave the gate and lingered towards the back of the pack before her late bid fell just short. "She went a little fast the first part of the race," said winning jockey Cornelio Velasquez. "I tried to relax her, but she fought it too much. I had enough horse at the end." Trainer Tony Dutrow will not try to reinvent the wheel. "Her performance [today] kind of confirms what we thought all long: she's a six-furlong filly," he offered. Elite Alex Switched to Fair Grounds...

Elite Alex (Afleet Alex) was scratched out of yesterday's \$300,000 GII Rebel S. in favor of a tilt at the \$1-million GII Louisiana Derby next Saturday at Fair Grounds. Calvin Borel will ride the Tim Ritchey trainee in the nine-furlong test. "It's all about getting to the [GI Kentucky] Derby," Ritchey explained. "We can get another week. The stretch there is longer, and there are 700,000 more reasons down there, than running from a wide post in a big field here. I hope he runs well enough so we don't have to worry about it, but it also gives us three weeks after that to the Arkansas Derby." Elite Alex is coming off a third-place finish in the GIII Southwest S. at Oaklawn Feb. 21. Borel will work the colt this morning at the Hot Springs oval.

In other Louisiana Derby news, GII Risen Star S. hero **Mucho Macho Man** (Macho Uno) breezed five-eighths in 1:02.60 at Gulfstream yesterday morning. "He went very well and he galloped out great," said trainer Kathy Ritvo. "It was more of a maintenance move than anything. He's ready to run." The Reeves Thoroughbred Racing colorbearer is slated to ship to New Orleans Wednesday. Claiborne Farm and Adele Dilschneider's **Left** (Arch), perfect in two starts at the Fair Grounds, worked a half in :47.80 at the New Orleans oval yesterday. After breaking his maiden on the turf Jan. 29, the bay gelding captured an optional claimer on the main track Feb. 26. He has worked several times with his stablemate, ☆ **"TDN Rising Star"** ☆ Bind (Pulpit). "Left stayed close every time they worked together," said trainer Al Stall Jr.

Rogue Romance Sidelined...

Catesby Clay's **Rogue Romance** (Smarty Jones) has been taken off the Triple Crown trail after a fracture was discovered in his left front foot. The injury was detected following the colt's three-furlong breeze Saturday at Gulfstream. He will have two or three months of stall rest before gearing up once more. "This is unfortunate and the worst timing imaginable," said Martin O'Dowd, Runnymede Farm's vice president and general manager. "But we look forward to the colt returning to training and, hopefully, making it back to the Breeders' Cup this year." Third in the GI BC Juvenile last year, the chestnut was most recently third in the GII Risen Star S. Feb. 19. He is trained by Ken McPeck.

Maiden Voyage for Venture Thoroughbreds...

There are a few new faces among the consignor ranks at the Barretts March Sale of Selected Two-Year-Olds in Training, to be held Monday evening at the Hinds Pavilion at Fairplex Park in Pomona, California. The newest is Venture Thoroughbreds, which debuted as a juvenile consignor this spring. Venture is the nom de course of Jason Hall, Kory Porter and Cole Clinger. All three hail from Idaho, an unlikely breeding ground for Thoroughbred horsemen, some might think.

"That's usually one of the first questions people ask, how we got into racing being from there," laughed Hall. "All three of our dads where into Quarter Horse racing, actually."

In 2004, Hall launched American Thoroughbred Review (www.thoroughbredreview.com), a website that, among other things, offers conformational analysis of stallions, as well as some very frank assessments of sires that has left him unpopular with some farm managers. It wasn't long before Hall began consulting, which evolved into other bloodstock services.

"That's kind of where it all started," said Hall. "I basically began pulling in clients from that. Then we started doing some weanling-to-yearling pinhooks with a few clients and partners, and now we're doing yearling-to-2-year-old pinhooking. We've got a lot of skin in the game ourselves, and I think the clients like that."

Venture's current client roster include Don Brooks of Wyckoff, N.J.; and Roland Mackie of Nashville, TN.

Though not under the Venture banner, Hall and Clinger's first juvenile pinhook came right here at Barretts March. College friends from Boise State, they purchased a Gulch yearling filly in 2007 for \$52,000, then put the filly into training with a 2-year-old consignor and offered her at the '08 March Sale.

She touched off a bidding duel that ended when Southern Equine purchased her for \$450,000. Named Elle A Gent, she went on to be a black-type placed for the Eric Guillot barn.

The success of Elle A Gent contributed to the decision to launch Venture Thoroughbreds, and last year the trio purchased nine yearling prospects. Venture is a little bit different than other consignors in that they outsource breaking and training duties, and about half the Venture group went to Utah, while the others went to Al Pike in Louisiana.

Venture had five catalogued for Barretts March, but two scratched. The remainder of the group includes [hip 26](#), a filly by First Samurai--Gilded Diablo (Diablo), as well as another filly, [hip 57](#), by After Market--Our

Friend Terry (Cox's Ridge) who breezed an eighth in :10 1/5 on Friday ([video](#)). After Market, a Grade I-winning son of Storm Cat, is represented by his first 2-year-olds in 2011.

"She's a three-quarter sister to a horse [White Cat, by Mountain Cat] who won a Grade III at Keeneland going a mile and an eighth on the grass, so for her to show that kind of quickness this early is impressive," said Hall. "The After Markets have been well-received so far at the 2-year-old sales, so we're optimistic. She's squeaky clean medically, and she looks like she's going to be a versatile type."

The Venture horses also include [hip 38](#), a colt from the second crop of leading young sire War Front (Danzig) who was produced by Light and Liberty (Arch).

"There aren't many sires who are as hot as War Front right now," said Hall. "He's out of an Arch mare, and everybody loves Arch. And the cross has worked in the family--the second dam got a Grade III horse [stakes winner Awesome Lady] to Bianconi, who like War Front is a son of Danzig. They had a heckuva time pulling him up on the backstretch, so we're looking at him like he'll probably be a two-turn horse." The dark bay breezed an eighth in :10 2/5 ([video](#)).

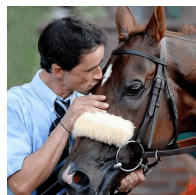
