Cape Blanco Gets First Taste of Meydan...

G1 Irish Derby winner **Cape Blanco (Ire)** (Galileo {Ire}) had his first visit to the Meydan oval after clearing quarantine yesterday. Jockey Jamie Spencer was

aboard as the G1 Dubai World Cup hopeful spent approximately a half-hour exploring the track with fellow Aidan O'Brien trainees and G2 UAE Derby contenders **Master of Hounds** (Kingmambo) and **Alexander Pope** (Daneshill Dancer {Ire}). "He had a steady canter just to stretch his legs, which is just what Aidan wanted," Spencer reported. "We are here now and there are two days to

go, so we'll just have to see how we get on." Cape Blanco won the G1 Irish Champion S. last September before ending his season with a 14th-place effort in the G1 Arc de Triomphe. He will be making his first start on an all-weather surface in the World Cup.

Queally Confident with Twice Over...

Jockey Tom Queally is pleased with the preparations of **Twice Over (GB)** (Observatory), last out winner of the Mar. 3 G2 Al Maktoum Challenge Round 3, ahead of Saturday's World Cup. "I could not be happier with the way he has gone," Queally said after putting the Juddmonte homebred through his paces at Meydan yesterday. Queally partnered the six-year-old to a 10th-place effort in last year's World Cup and is looking for a better trip Saturday when the duo break from post 12 in the 14-horse field. "He is drawn wide again in the race in stall 12, like he was last time out when he quickened well and put up a nice performance," Queally commented. "In the [Dubai] World Cup last year he was also drawn wide, got a bump going into the first turn and was never happy. Hopefully this time I will be able to get him in a bit and keep him happy."

Gitano Hernando Sitting on Go...

Gitano Hernando (GB) (Hernando {Fr}) is ready for a big effort in Saturday's G1 Dubai World Cup, according to trainer Marco Botti. "He is in good form and had a blowout this morning," Botti said yesterday. "All is going to plan and I could not be happier with him. He should be 100% for the Dubai World Cup. He gave me my first Group 1 when winning in America and also won a Group 3 in Ireland, so he means a lot to me and my staff. I have seen a lot of improvement in him while he has been here and I think there was still improvement in him when he was third to Twice Over (GB) (Observatory) [in the Mar. 3 G2 Al Maktoum Challenge Round 3]. If I am right, then he will be spot-on for the race." Gitano Hernando, who won the 2009 G1 Goodwood S. at Santa Anita, was sold this week and will carry the colors of Ramzan Kadyrov for the first time Saturday. He will be transferred to trainer Herman Brown after the World Cup. "It will be a pity to lose him, but that is the way of racing," Botti added.

Beware the Hong Kong Raiders...

Horses based in Hong Kong are, with the exception of one-time G1 Dubai Sheema Classic favorite Viva Pataca (GB) (Marju {Ire}), routinely disregarded in the World Cup markets. It can be costly to do so, as evidenced last year by the 18-1 upset of Joy and Fun (NZ) (Cullen {Aus}) in the G3 Al Quoz Sprint and a

strong third-place effort at 11-1 from One World (Aus) (Danehill Dancer {Ire}) in the G1 Dubai Golden Shaheen. Joy and Fun became the second Hong Kong-based runner to win on World Cup night, joining Vengeance of Rain (NZ) (Zabeel

{NZ}, 10-1 in the 2007 Sheema Classic), and the island nation is well-represented this year. **Dynamic Blitz (Aus)** (Elusive Quality), a G1 Dubai Golden Shaheen hopeful, is already a winner at the Carnival, having caused an upset in the G3 Al Shindagha Sprint Feb. 3. He and his three compatriots comprise 40 percent of the Shaheen field and look to have Rocket Man (Aus) (Viscount {Aus}) to beat. One that can already lay claim to that accomplishment is **Green Birdie (NZ)** (Catbird {Aus}), a \$200,000 supplement to the Shaheen, who handed Rocket Man a rare defeat on home turf in the G1 KrisFlyer International Sprint on yielding Kranji turf last May. Green Birdie was ticketed for the G1 Takamatsunomiya Kinen later this month in Japan, but had his trip called off by the recent earthquake and tsunami. **Sunny King (Ire)**, by the late Sunline (NZ)'s sire Desert Sun (GB) and **Dim Sum (GB)** (Kyllachy {GB}) look more up against it than the other two. **Beauty Flash (NZ)** (Golan {NZ}) rates a puncher's chance in the G1 Dubai Futy Free S. and carries a three-race winning streak into the 1800-meter event. The 9-1 upsetter of the G1 Cathay Pacific Hong Kong Mile in December, he defeated Sunny King by a nose in the Stewards' Cup the next month. He was at his battling best when coming home a half-length to the good in the Queen's Silver Jubilee Cup last time out Mar. 6, defeating a group of sprinters at their best game over 1400 meters, a trip well short of his best. "Our preparation has gone fine, and he has drawn beautifully in two so I am hoping it's all set up for a big run," his trainer Tony Cruz submitted. Cruz was the conditioner of the legendary Hong Kong sprinter Silent Witness (Aus) (El Moxie).

King Dancer (Ire) (Danehill Dancer {Ire}) rounds out the Hong Kong contingent. Third to the top-class Irian (Ger) (Tertullian) in the International Cup Trial in November, he split the field in the G1 Cathay Pacific Hong Kong Vase the following month. He exits a solid runner-up effort in the Hong Kong Gold Cup Feb. 27, and Ryan Moore, who was lured for that ride, is back in the saddle after the scratching of globetrotting Snow Fairy (Ire) (Intikhab). He drew poorly, however, and will need to overcome the 14 hole and a strong group to take the Sheema back to Hong Kong.

The Word on the Ears...

James and Marilyn Helzer, who own JEH Stallion Station, visited their G1 Dubai Golden Shaheen winner **Euroears** (Langfuhr) yesterday in the quarantine barn at Meydan. The seven-year-old is coming off a win in the Jan. 22 GII Palos Verdes S. and is considered one of the likely favorites in the Shaheen, but much of the speculation surrounding the chestnut has been about his name. When the Helzers first obtained the horse as a yearling, he was suffering from a lingering skin condition which made him sensitive about being touched around his ears. James Helzer would greet the yearling with a, "How are your old ears?" The phrase eventually became condensed and, added to Helzer's Texas accent, became Euroears. Trainer Bob Baffert reported his charge, ears and all, was "doing awesome," Thursday.

GOLDIKOVA IN LINE FOR HONG KONG

FINALE Alain and Gerard Wertheimer's triple GI Breeders' Cup Mile heroine **Goldikova (Ire)** (Anabaa) may make her final career start in December's G1 Hong Kong Mile, according to trainer Freddy Head. France's six-year-old darling will take a familiar path towards an attempt at a fourth Breeders' Cup Mile success, which includes opening her campaign in next month's G1 Prix d'Ispahan at Longchamp. "Goldikova is as well as she's ever been after having a spell at her owners' farm in Normandy," Head told *Racing Post*. "She's a six-year-old and is mature, but she's not an old lady yet. We will try and run in the same races as last year, starting off in the Prix d'Ispahan and then the [G1] Queen Anne at Royal Ascot. One of the big plans is the [G1 Prix] Jacques le Marois again and the Breeders' Cup. If she wins the Breeders' Cup, she could go for the Hong Kong Mile, as she will not run next year."

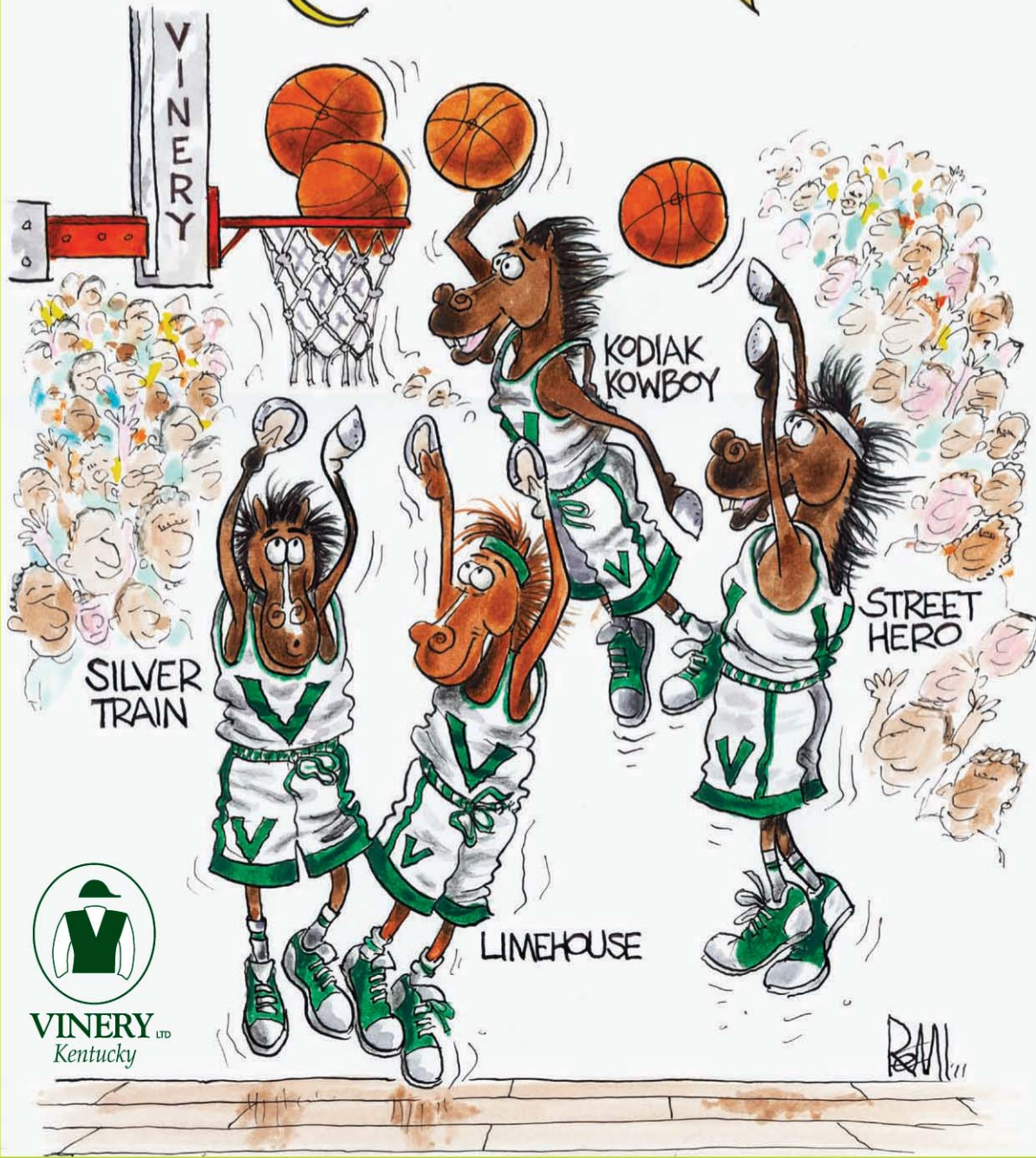

Robert Lapenta's GIII Holy Bull S. hero **Dialed In** (Mineshaft) breezed a half-mile in :47.55 yesterday as he prepares for a start in the GI Florida Derby Apr. 3. Working in company with older stablemate and fellow Lapenta runner Miner's Reserve (Mineshaft), Dialed In broke off in the fog on the backstretch, but rolled past his company and was seven lengths clear at the wire. "This is the most important thing. This is the last eighth," said trainer Nick Zito, proudly holding out his stopwatch with 11:04 digitally displayed. "Did you see how he explodes? You see, he wants to come from behind. He wants to come from out of it. I got a headache from it, I was so excited--knock on wood." Dialed In, a maternal grandson of champion Eliza (Mt. Livermore), enters the Florida Derby off a runner-up effort in a two-turn allowance Mar. 6.

AMERICAN GRADED STAKES COMMITTEE RULING

SAN LUIS REY S.: In accord with American Graded Stakes Committee policy, the March 20, 2011, renewal of the Grade II San Luis Rey S., scheduled for the Santa Anita Park turf course but switched to the main track, was automatically downgraded to Grade III status and was conducted as a Grade III stakes race. The American Graded Stakes Committee has reviewed the off-the-turf renewal and has determined that the original Grade II status will be reinstated for this renewal. The Sunday, March 20, 2011 renewal of the San Luis Rey S., originally scheduled as a Grade II event over the Santa Anita Park turf course but conducted as a Grade III race over the main track, should be recorded as a Grade II race. The winner of the race, JUNIPER PASS (Lemon Drop Kid), is therefore credited with a Grade II win, and the second- (DAHOUD (NZ) (Scaredee Cat {NZ}) and third-place (IMPONENTE PURSE (BRZ) (Public Purse) finishers are credited with Grade II placings.

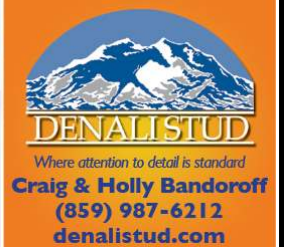

TVG REPORTEDLY CUTS 20 POSITIONS Popular host and successful handicapper Bob Baedeker is among 20 employees of Betfair/TVG to be laid off from the company, according to published reports. 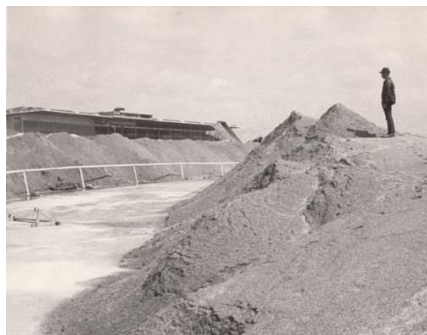

THE WICKED NORTH

The Wicked North (Far North--Wicked Witchcraft, by Good Behaving), the champion older male of 1994, was euthanized Thursday at the Hagyard Equine Medical Center in Lexington due to complications from an

intestinal lipoma strangulation. He was 22. Trained by David Bernstein for owner Phil Hersh, the chestnut developed into a versatile and reliable runner, winning the six-furlong Gill Bing Crosby S. on the main track prior to a victory in the Gill San Francisco H. on the turf. Campaigned exclusively on the dirt during his

championship 5-year-old season, The Wicked North took the GII San Antonio H., the GI Oaklawn H. and the GI Californian. He was controversially disqualified from an apparent success in the GI Santa Anita H. and placed fourth. The Wicked North ended his career with eight wins from 17 starts and earnings approaching \$1.2 million. He entered stud in 1995, and was represented by the multiple stakes winner Red's Lady from his first crop, but nearly lost his life in 2006 after a bout with EPM (equine protozoal myeloencephalitis). That marked the end of his stallion career, and he lived out his days at Old Friends. "He was a great champion," said Old Friends' Founder and President Michael Blowen. "He was fine last night, but Kent Ralstin, our assistant farm manager, discovered his discomfort early this morning. The Wicked North had a ton of class."
