TAKE TWO FOR TWICE OVER

When Khalid Abdulla's **Twice Over (GB)** (Observatory) came to Meydan last year to contest the G1 Dubai World Cup, he had just a few days to acclimate to his surroundings, and he hadn't been out since a third in the GI Breeders' Cup Classic at Santa Anita more than four months prior to that. He was forced to check early on in the race and never found a spot to tuck in, finishing a disappointing 10th, albeit beaten only three lengths. "I thought he would win last year," conditioner Henry Cecil recalled. "But he did get a bad bump, and he couldn't get in. Whether that was the reason I don't know." Cecil has steered his charge along a much different path for a second tilt in tonight's \$10-million event, however, and all indications so far are that the changes in preparation are paying off. The now 6-year-old's 2010 campaign post-World Cup was highlighted by successes in the G1 Eclipse S. at Sandown and the G1 Champion S. at Newmarket, but Twice Over's impressive 2 3/4-length tally last out in the course-and-distance G2 Maktoum Challenge (Round 3) Mar. 3 over four of today's foes seems like the strongest signal that he will be hard to beat. "The idea was to bring him over here and settle him in and get him into a race," Cecil explained. "If he hadn't handled the surface or hadn't settled, I would have brought him right back. He seemed to do everything very nicely. He had a good blow on the backstretch and a good blow afterwards. But he seems to have come on a lot." Cecil was also pleased with the way his charge cantered over the track under Tom Queally Friday morning, and cited Twice Over's post position, number 12 (one out from last year), as the only concern. "Hopefully, now that he has adapted himself to the track, he will cope with it better now. I think he is definitely better than last year... No, I know he is better than last year," he said.

MACHO... AGAIN?

Reeves Thoroughbred Racing and Dream Team One Racing Stable's **Mucho Macho Man** (Macho Uno) looks to repeat his 1 1/2-length GII Risen Star S. success Feb. 19 in this afternoon's \$1-million GII Louisiana Derby back at Fair Grounds. "He's doing great. We're back in town and ready to run," beamed conditioner Kathy Ritvo Thursday. The GII Nashua S. and GII Remsen S. runner-up has enough speed to be on or near the lead, but the presence of lightly raced speedsters **Majestic Harbor** (Rockport Harbor) and **Left (Arch)** could call for rating tactics. "We're going to see how he breaks, and let [jockey] Rajiv [Maragh] make that decision," Ritvo explained. **Elite Alex** (Afleet Alex), who put in a last-to-third run in the Feb. 21 GIII Southwest S. over the Hot Springs oval, would benefit from quick early fractions. Pilot Calvin Borel--rider of three of the last four GI Kentucky Derby winners--has already compared the \$300,000 KEESOP yearling to 2007 Derby hero Street Sense (Street Cry {Ire}). **Cont. p12**

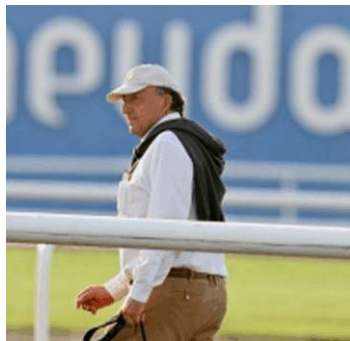

G1 Arima Kinen at Nakayama Dec. 26; and G1 Japan Cup Dirt and G1 February S. hero **Transcend (Jpn)** (Wild Rush) all appear in with a chance to hoist the Cup while uplifting their disaster-stricken homeland. Buena Vista, who was a close second in last year's G1 Sheema Classic over the Meydan sod, has never been off the board in

17 prior attempts, and must only answer questions about the surface to be a major factor. "She is very nice, and I am very happy to have a chance on riding her," said Ryan Moore. "I cannot say how she handles all-weather until she comes in to the final stretch in the race. There are top-class horses in the field and any of them are capable of winning, but if she has a little luck and no one boxes her in, she should win, and I can confirm she has the talent to win. For the Japanese people, who are now having a difficult time, I would like to say that racing is my answer. What is going on is very terrible, and I suppose horse racing could lift them."

REWILDING COULD FOLLOW IN SIS' FOOTSTEPS

Dar Re Mi (GB) (Singspiel {Ire}) captured the G1 Dubai Sheema Classic 12 months ago, and her half-brother **Rewilding (GB)** (Tiger Hill {Ire}) will attempt to do the same for Godolphin tonight. Third in the G1 Epsom Derby last June, the 500,000gns TATOCT purchase captured the G2 Great Voltigeur S. at York in August, but could only manage sixth in the G1 St. Leger S. the

following month, and has been brought along since by trainer Mahmood Al Zarooni with this race in mind. "Rewilding is doing very well, and I think he will run a good race because he likes racing when fresh," Al Zarooni commented. "[He] progressed last year, but did not stay the

distance of the St Leger, which may have come too soon after his Great Voltigeur victory. He is a nice horse with plenty of class, and I hope it is his day on Saturday. He is happy, fit and ready to run." Frankie Dettori has the mount, and the bay colt will carry the first Godolphin colors; the operation's **Calvados Blues (Fr)** (Lando {Ger}) will have the white cap.

Champ and Midge Set for Rematch...

The one-two finishers from the GI Breeders' Cup Turf, **Dangerous Midge** (Lion Heart) and **Champ Pegasus** (Fusaichi Pegasus), are set for a rematch in the Sheema. The British-based Dangerous Midge hasn't faced the starter since his Nov. 6 triumph at Churchill Downs, but has a solid chance to bring home another Sheema Classic trophy for trainer Brian Meehan, who saddled David Junior (Pleasant Tap) to victory in 2006. "He ran a great race in the Breeders' Cup and, after that, we thought about taking him to the Japan Cup before coming here," Meehan explained.

Saturday and prove them wrong, as it pretty much looks his race." Champ Pegasus has had two afternoon appearances this season. He ran second to **Bourbon Bay** (Sligo Bay {Ire}) in the GII San Marcos S. Jan. 18, but turned the tables on that rival in the GII San Luis Obispo S. Feb. 19. "He's a feisty guy," trainer

Richard Mandella told *Racing Post*. "He's mischievous and ornery. He's like a little kid looking for trouble all the time, but he's a good-natured horse. He's got a good post in seven, as you're not committed too far down inside, and it gives you a chance to see what happens. At a mile and a half I don't think it makes a lot of difference where you start from, but, if I had a choice, this is the post I would have wanted."

Free For All...

A jam-packed field of 16 runners will contest the \$5-million G1 Dubai Duty Free, and it's a wide-open affair. The sole American raider, Equilete Stable's **Victor's Cry** (Street Cry {Ire}), will be among the favorites. Winner of the G1 Shoemaker Mile at Hollywood last June, the dark bay captured the GII Citation H. in November, and tuned up for his Dubai adventure with a solid third in the GIII Thunder Road H. at Santa Anita Feb. 6. Trainer Eoin Harty, who saddled Well Armed (Tiznow) to victory in the G1 Dubai World Cup at Nad al Sheba in 2009, is confident about his charge's chances. "Any race here is competitive, especially one with \$5 million in prize money attached, so you have to come with the right horse, and have your 'A-game,' too," Harty acknowledged. "You know you are going to be facing a lot of accomplished horses from Europe and here, but Victor's Cry, I believe, is a genuine Group 1 horse, with a serious turn of foot over the last furlong and a half." Harty added, "Everything has gone according to plan, and I've left no stone unturned."

Presvis (GB) (Sakhee), second in the 2009 Duty Free, scored in the G2 Jebel Hatta last March en route to another tilt at the \$5-million event, but could only manage an 11th-place finish. Put away after an unplaced effort in the G1 Prince of Wales's S. at Royal Ascot, the bay kicked off his 7-year-old season with a win in the G2 Al Rashidiya over this course and distance Jan. 27, and followed that with a close third to **Wigmore Hall (Ire)** (High Chaparral {Ire}) in the Jebel Hatta Mar. 3. Trainer Luca Cumani is hopeful that the third time will be the charm for the veteran. "He looks well and he's at his best weight," Cumani told *Racing Post*. "He has his quirks, but I think we can work around them, because in his races you know exactly what you'll get. It's [rider] Ryan [Moore]'s job to find the gaps and, if he's in the first three, that will be brilliant." Wigmore Hall, runner-up in the G1 Secretariat S. at Arlington last August, closed out his sophomore season with a fifth to Twice Over (GB) (Observatory) in the G1 Champion S. at Newmarket Oct. 16. He opened 2011 by defeating a tough group in the Jebel Hatta, and is coming up well to this contest. Trainer Michael Bell told *Racing Post*, "We hope we've left a fair bit of improvement in him, as he only did two bits of fast work before the Jebel Hatta and, if I've done my job right, he can improve."

international Group 1 company, the bay took Singapore Group 3 events over Polytrack and turf before shipping to Hong Kong, where he dead-heated with the talented One World (Aus) (Danehill Dancer {Ire}) in the Nov. 21 G2 Jockey

Club Sprint, the lead-up event for the G1 Hong Kong Sprint Dec. 12. In the big race itself, Rocket Man also raced close up and had the lead inside the final furlong, but was tagged late by J J the Jet Plane. He has one start under his belt since, a front-running score in a Mar. 6 affair over the all-weather track at Kranji. In last year's race, Rocket Man won the break, but was eased back off the pace, and his late rally fell just a half-length short.

He is expected to be forwardly placed here, but may not be able to out-quick the likes of **Euroears** (Langfuhr), who has experienced a renaissance of sorts with Bob Baffert. The classy 7-year-old won half of his 16 starts for trainer Bret Calhoun, but turned in an eye-catching debut for the silver-haired conditioner in the GII Palos Verdes S. Jan. 22, scoring by 2 3/4 lengths in 1:07 1/5. The synthetic track is a question mark, but, while with Calhoun in 2008, he breezed six panels from the gate in 1:11 flat on the Keeneland Polytrack. Baffert, who sent out Captain Steve (Fly So Free) to take the 2001 World Cup, isn't taking anything for granted. "You need a very good horse to win over here, and you need luck, too," he commented. "I sent over another very fast horse Indian Blessing (Indian Charlie) a couple of years back, and thought she couldn't get beat, but she did. I wish I had come over that year, sometimes you have to change things around a little with their training when you have come half way around the world." **Dynamic Blitz (Aus)** (Elusive Quality) rates a place chance should he run back to his victory in the G3 Al Shindagha Sprint Feb. 3. His outstanding all-weather form in limited opportunities at Sha Tin encouraged connections to try Meydan, and he proved more than equal to the task in the Al Shindagha.

Godolphin; de Kock Look Tough Again in Derby...

Godolphin colorbearers or Mike de Kock trainees have taken every renewal of the G2 UAE Derby since it began in 2000, and this year's running threatens to continue the trend. Of the field's 14 runners, four will race in the Godolphin blue, while an additional three will be saddled by the top South African conditioner. Sheikh Mohammed's operation boasts the morning-line favorite in the American pools in **Xin Xu Lin (Brz)** (Wondertross), thrice a Group 1 winner in Brazil and the G1 Gran Premio Carlos Pellegrini hero last out in Argentina Dec. 11. Piloted by first-call rider Frankie Dettori, this will be the Southern Hemisphere 3-year-old's first attempt for Mahmood Al Zarooni and his new owner. "He's a nice horse--a free-running type who likes to make the running--but he goes there first time out, and I think he'll be a nicer horse next winter," racing manager Simon Crisford told *Racing Post*. "He comes with a big reputation, but it's not going to be easy for him. I can't tell you he's a good thing, because he's not. I do like him, but I'd like to reserve judgement." Godolphin also has G3 UAE 2000 Guineas winner **Splash Point (Street Cry {Ire})**, G3 UAE Oaks victoress **Khawlah (Ire)** (Cape Cross {Ire}), and turfey Meydan Classic winner **Introvert (Ire)** (Iffraaj {GB}). De Kock's

most intriguing entrant is Sheikh Mohammed bin Khalifa al Maktoum's **Reem (Aus)** (Galileo {Ire}), who took the track-and-trip Al Bastakiya S. by 5 1/4 lengths Mar. 3. **Mahbooba (Aus)** (Galileo {Ire}), second in the UAE Oaks, and **Zanzamar (SAf)** (Fort Wood) complete the outfit's charge. "The two fillies probably stand out among mine," the South African told *Racing Post*. "Zanzamar's form is good, but, when Reem beat

the colts, she showed us that the fillies are a lot stronger than the colts. The weight-for age (for Southern Hemisphere horses) is not what it was here, though, so it's getting far tougher every year, and Saeed's filly Khawlah was really smart to beat Mahbooba fair and square like she did in the UAE Oaks. Mahbooba is a tough one, but we were giving Khawlah nine pounds that day, and now we are giving 10 pounds."

Conveyance Stretches Back out to Preferred Trip...

Runners of American origin look to be competitive in Saturday's G2 Godolphin Mile. **Conveyance** (Indian Charlie) garnered the ☆ **"TDN Rising Star"** ☆ tag when annexing a Santa Anita allowance event by seven lengths for Bob Baffert and Thoroughbred Legends Racing Stable in November of 2009. He was purchased by Zabeel International after that eye-catching performance, and remained with Baffert to take the GIII San Rafael S. over the Santa Anita synthetic and the GIII Southwest S. at Oaklawn--both at eight furlongs--the following term. He was upset in the GIII Sunland Derby when second before finishing 15th in the GI Kentucky Derby. Sateesh Seemar took over training duties after that, and Conveyance did not reappear until he finished second in the six-furlong G3 Mahab Al Shimaal here Mar. 3. "He really surprised us on Super Thursday because we felt he was behind fitness-wise, yet he ran a fantastic race to be second to [Duty Free entrant] Bankable. He's got a great draw in stall two as he likes to roll along in front. He's probably my best chance on the card," pilot Richard Mullen told *Racing Post*.

IEAH Stables, et al's **I Want Revenge** (Stephen Got Even) makes the trek from the U.S. following a fourth in the GI Donn H. at Gulfstream Feb. 5. Despite trainer Rick Dutrow's past success in the UAE--he took the G1 Golden Shaheen with Benny the Bull (Lucky Lionel) and this event with Diamond Stripes (Notebook) in 2008--his runner must prove he can muster a top effort over a synthetic track. The 2009 GI Wood Memorial S. hero did not emerge as a sophomore star until he shipped East and away from California's synthetic surfaces while in the hands of Jeff Mullins. Godolphin's **Skysurfers (GB)** (E Dubai) might be harmed by the 13 hole. "I thought he was one of my best rides of the night, but being drawn 13 of 14 is not very kind as he has to travel further than the others," Frankie Dettori admitted to *Racing Post*. "There is nothing we can do but the draw has harmed his chance." The 5-year-old is coming off a win in the Listed Firebreak S. over the trip Feb. 10.

J J Should Be Flying in Al Quoz...

The Hong Kong International Races are always a good pointer to top-class turf events around the world, and last year's G1 Cathay Pacific Hong Kong Sprint has the chance to produce not one, but two winners this evening. **J J the Jet Plane**, a champion sprinter and three-time Group 1 winner in South Africa, broke the local stranglehold on the Sprint Dec. 12, coming from a close-up fourth to post a head victory over the tough-luck Rocket Man (Aus) (Viscount {Aus}) and former world champion Sacred Kingdom (Aus) (Encosta de Lago {Aus}), third at a remarkable 17-1. He flopped as the topweight in a Feb. 17 handicap over the Tapeta, but got back to his winning ways in his latest, a 1200-meter sprint on the turf Mar. 10. Everisto Nyambo, head traveling foreman for trainer Lucky Houdalakis, all but guarantees victory tonight.

"If he doesn't win by three or five lengths on Saturday, then the jockey hasn't ridden him properly given how he feels right now," Nyambo stated candidly. The veteran might be best around a bend and at a slightly longer distance than the Al Quoz, but should prove tough to down. Seven-year-old **Mr Gruff** will make just the 10th start of his career and, on his day, he's as talented a turf sprinter as there is in the U.S. Were this event held on the hillside turf course at Santa Anita, the dark bay would be a near mortal lock, as he has five wins from his six tries, his lone defeat coming by a nose. He was last seen finishing third to G1 Dubai Duty Free hopeful Victor's Cry (Street Cry {Ire}) in the GI Shoemaker Mile last May, but looks fit for this test. **Happy Dubai** has won three of his last four starts sprinting over the straight course at Meydan, including a half-length success from **Monsieur Joe** and **Invincible Ash** in a course-and-distance affair Mar. 3.

James Miller's **Daisy Devine** broke her maiden for a \$30,000 tag sprinting over the track Dec. 2, and followed that up with a solid stretch-out win over allowance foes Dec. 30. The bay was let go at 11-1 in the Silverbulletday S. Jan. 22, and almost pulled off the upset, only to fall a neck short of extremely game GSW Bouquet Booth (Flower Alley). Daisy Devine has shown an upbeat work pattern for red-hot Andrew McKeever since that last effort, highlighted by a five-furlong bullet drill in :59 2/5 over the strip Mar. 16. Donver Stable's **Inglorious** was victorious on debut in the Fanfreluche S. for Ontario-breds at Woodbine Oct. 24, and doubled up with a 5 3/4-length drubbing in the Dec. 4 Ontario Lassie S. The bay returned over track-and-trip in the GIII Rachel Alexandra S. Feb. 19, and came with a nice late run to be second behind consensus divisional leader Kathmanblu (Bluegrass Cat). Inglorious' performance looks more impressive in context of the early pace--or lack there of--in the Rachel Alexandra, which was significantly below par according to the Moss Pace Figures. **Switching Gears** was game to deny **St. John's River** by a neck in an optional claimer here Feb. 25. St. John's River might have slightly more upside, however, as a lightly raced full sister to Panty Raid, a Grade II winner on dirt and Grade I winner on synthetic and turf when she was a sophomore in 2007.

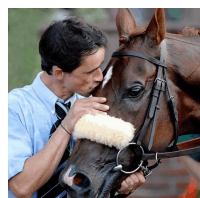
The Virginia H Tarra Trust's **Giant Oak** is in career form at age five, coming into this off a win in the prestigious GI Donn H. Feb. 5 to notch his second consecutive Grade I success after being promoted to first in the GI Clark H. at Churchill Downs Nov. 6. Both races were at this distance, but Giant Oak has only hit the board once here from four tries. "It's a concern," conditioner Chris Block admitted in a story on the track's website. "He certainly has not run his best races there. Last year in the Mineshaft he was coming off a long layoff, and we were really using that race as a prep for the next race. Then, in the New Orleans H., it appeared that the track that day was playing more to the speed, which certainly works against this horse. So yeah, I have those concerns on Saturday--whether it's the surface he isn't fond of, and I'm concerned about the pace, but this race sets up good in our schedule."

Demarcation and **Mission Impazible** were only separated by a head in the local GIII Mineshaft H. Feb. 19 with very different trips. The latter was part of a swift early pace, while the former--DQ'd from fourth to 11th in the roughly run Clark--circled the field from last to nip game Mission Impazible late. While Mission Impazible's speedy Mineshaft adversary Z Humor (Distorted Humor) won't be here to press him early, **El Caballo** and **Birdrun** have plenty of early foot to keep the opening splits lively.

Moryba was visually impressive when scoring by two lengths in his stateside debut for Bill Mott and Correas Thoroughbreds Inc in a stakes-level allowance event over this trip at Gulfstream Jan. 23. The five-year-old G1 Grande Premio Brasil hero broke in a bit of a tangle, but regained his composure to stalk in fourth of five from the outside behind a slow pace before turning on the jets in the lane, getting his last furlong in :11.57 under a clearly confident Kent Desormeaux. "He's a nice little horse," Mott told *Daily Racing Form*. "He beat a field of classy older horses who maybe were not at the top of their game, but I'm happy with the way he did it. He was quite impressive. He ran a real professional race and had a good turn of foot." **Workin For Hops** was a close-up fourth behind **Expansion** and **Sleepless Knight** after setting a glacial pace last out in the course-and-distance GIII Fair Grounds H. Feb. 19, but last term's GII American Derby winner and GI Secretariat S. show horse could be primed for an improved effort. The Fair Grounds was Workin for Hops's first start since finishing second in the GIII Kent S. at Delaware in September, and better conditioning second off the break could be all the 4-year-old needs to keep his foes at bay late in what looks to be another paceless affair. Strawbridge homebred **Smart Bid** came just a nose short of top-level glory when dropping a tough decision to 25-1 Teaks North (Northern Afleet) in the GI Gulfstream Park Turf H. Feb. 5. While Teaks North didn't quite validate that event's form when fifth in last Saturday's GIII Tampa Bay S., Smart Bid should get the first run on Workin for Hops when they turn for home.

Positive Response, winner of the Dec. 11 Gold Rush S. and Jan. 15 California Derby before finishing third in the Feb. 12 GIII El Camino Real Derby--all at his home base Golden Gate--signaled his affinity for this strip when taking the John Battaglia Memorial S. by seven lengths in front-running fashion Mar. 5. The bay should prove tough to down, but will be pressed this time by GIII Delta Jackpot S. runner-up and Jean Laffit S. winner **Decisive Moment**, who led briefly in the GII Risen Star S. last time Feb. 19 before fading to fifth. Crossed Sabres Farm's **Preachintothedevil** took a stake for New York-breds at Aqueduct Jan. 1 before finishing third in the Whirlaway S. back at the Big A, one slot behind subsequent Miracle Wood S. winner J J's Lucky Train (Silver Train) and one in front of recent allowance winner Arthur's Tale (Bernardini). 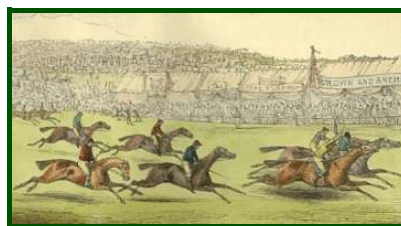

Cecil Ponders Frankel Options...

Trainer Henry Cecil has discussed his thoughts on the campaign of ☆ **"TDN Rising Star"** ☆ and 2010 joint juvenile champion **Frankel (GB)** (Galileo {Ire}) as the British season nears. Khalid Abdullah's homebred, who was unbeaten at two after taking Newmarket's G1 Dewhurst S., is likely to reappear in the G3 Greenham S. over seven furlongs at Newbury Apr. 16 before a tilt at the G1 2000 Guineas at Newmarket two weeks later. "I'm still educating him and he wouldn't have a penalty in the Greenham, whereas he does in the Craven," his conditioner told *PA Sport*. "I don't trust myself in running a horse in one of the first Classics without a race. If you run them straight into the Guineas after a long winter, you have got to do a little bit more with them at home, you've got to be a little bit tougher with them." Of Frankel's Derby prospects, Cecil seems a bit more optimistic this spring compared to how he felt last fall. "I think last year he was immature in a lot of ways and was inclined to be a bit free in his work and when he ran," he offered. "He's grown and lengthened and he settles. Mentally he has matured, he's much more settled and relaxed. I worked him on Wednesday to get him ready for his trial in the middle of April. He was lovely and relaxed. When I asked him to go away he was lolloping along and not taking hold of his bridle as he was inclined to do last year. There is lots of speed on the dam's side. I can, now [that] he's maturing, see him getting a mile and a quarter. Whether he will get a mile and a half, he will tell us. I'm not going to train him for a Derby if he's not going to stay... you've got mile races like the G1 St James's Palace S. [at Royal Ascot June 14] to go for. We'll see what he does in his first two races and assess it. If he looks as if he's going to stay, we could let him go for the G2 Dante S. [at York May 11], and you could still bring him back to a mile if you had to."

DUTROW HEARING POSTPONED The New York State Racing and Wagering Board has postponed the hearing regarding the trainer license held by Rick Dutrow Jr. until May 11-12, *Daily Racing Form* reported. It was previously scheduled for Mar. 30-31. The organization announced earlier in the month that it would examine whether Dutrow should be banned from all New York tracks because he is "a person whose conduct at race tracks in New York state and elsewhere has been improper, obnoxious, unbecoming, and detrimental to the best interests of racing." Dutrow recently received a suspension totalling 90 days for a medication positive, as well as having unlabeled syringes in his barn office at Aqueduct. The postponement came at the request of Dutrow's attorney, Gerard Ronski. "You have to prepare the case, understand the case, do your own investigation," Ronski told *DRF*. "It's all part of due process."
