## SEPOY, SMART MISSILE REMATCH IN SLIPPER

Sheikh Mohammed bin Rashid al Maktoum's **Sepoy (Aus)** (Elusive Quality), winner of the G1 Blue Diamond S. two back, and **Smart Missile (Aus)** (Fastnet Rock {Aus}), who handed the favorite his first career defeat when they squared off last time out in the G2 Todman S. Mar. 19, face a rematch in today's G1 AAMI Golden

Slipper S., the world's richest race for 2-year-olds. Sepoy looked in a different class when storming home to land the Feb. 26 Blue Diamond S. by 4 1/4 lengths ([video](#)), but couldn't repeat the dose in the Todman, when he finished 3/4 of a length adrift of Smart Missile over a rain-affected track at long odds-on. "If you watch the [Todman], he was struggling 600 meters from home and if he were a tired horse or a flat horse he wouldn't have run on again," trainer Peter Snowden told *Herald Sun*. "If we get a decent track he'll be back to his old self again."

The forecast is for dry and mild fall conditions this afternoon at Rosehill as Sepoy tries to become the first horse since Courtza (NZ) (Pompeii Court) in 1989 to complete the Blue Diamond--Slipper double. Undefeated in his two career trips to the post, Smart Missile has been a market darling in the lead-up to the Slipper and is a clear second favorite at \$4.60 (7-2).

## YOU GO, GIRLS!

With the GI Florida Derby shifted to Sunday from its traditional Saturday spot, today's action at Gulfstream will focus on the fair sex. **Unrivaled Belle** (Unbridled's Song), making her first appearance since capturing the GI Breeders' Cup Ladies' Classic in November, will face six rivals in her title defense in today's GIII Rampart H. Trainer Bill Mott cautioned that the grey has a long season ahead of her. "I think she's ready for a race," Mott told *DRF*. "[But] I don't think she's cranked and ready for her best effort by any means." The younger generation will be represented in the GII Gulfstream Park Oaks. **R Heat Lightning** (Trippi) is coming off a sensational score in the GII Davona Dale S. going a one-turn mile at the Hallandale oval Feb. 26. She adds another furlong here, but, in her only previous start at two turns, the Florida-bred was runner-up in the GI BC Juvenile Fillies Nov. 5. Among her six foes here is **It's Tricky** (Mineshaft), who has been perfect in three New York appearances for Darley. The bay is coming off a facile eight-length romp in the Busher S. at the Big A Feb. 20. "It's a big step up in class, but we needed to step up in class to find out if we've got an Oaks filly," said trainer Kiaran McLaughlin. "She was always one of our favorite fillies." **Previews cont. p2**

**Comma to the Top Out of Derby Future Pool...**

**Comma to the Top** (Bwana Charlie) has been taken out of the final pool of the Churchill Downs' Kentucky Derby Future Wager after trainer Peter Miller informed track officials that the gelding would not target the first leg of the Triple Crown. "Peter Miller has confirmed that he and the ownership group have no plans to run Comma to the Top in the Kentucky Derby, although the horse is doing well and is still being pointed toward a run in next week's GI Santa Anita Derby," said John Asher, vice president of racing communications at Churchill Downs. "Although Mr. Miller could not absolutely rule out a change of heart should Comma to the Top run a spectacular race at Santa Anita, a bid for the Kentucky Derby is clearly not in his current plans for the horse."

"Since we did receive this word before the wagering on Kentucky Derby Future Pool 3 opens on Friday, no win or exacta wagering will be accepted on Comma to the Top in Pool 3. But, in this unusual situation, Comma to the Top will go back into the Mutuel Field, or 'All Others,' on the remote chance that he could still compete in the Kentucky Derby. The Derby Future bet carries a higher risk than most pari-mutuel wagers, so this decision to freeze wagering on Comma to the Top is an effort to look out for the best interests of all patrons who support this special wager." Miller indicated that he never had serious designs on the 'Run for the Roses' with his sophomore. "The media had it all 'Derby this and Derby that,'" he stated Friday. "I don't think he's a mile-and-a-quarter horse. His strong suit is speed, and we'll be on the lead [in the GI Santa Anita Derby]." Miller also quipped, "Unless I felt had a real chance in the Kentucky Derby, I don't have to go just for the mint juleps. I can get them at my local bar."

**Dialo In** (Mineshaft), a sharp winner of the Gill Holy Bull S. Jan. 30 ([video](#)), and could be Zito's best chance for success on the first Saturday in May. "He's a gift from God," said Zito. "It's what's inside of them. We're not the answer, trust me. It's the horses.

He's by Mineshaft, out of a good mare. We're just coaching them. Just ask these coaches...if they don't have the players, forget it." Dialo In lost his unbeaten record when second to older stablemate Equestrio (Elusive Quality) in an educational allowance at the Florida Derby distance Mar. 6 ([video](#)), but Zito hasn't lost faith in his charge. "It was no easy race," the conditioner noted. "He ran against 4-year-olds and, if you look at it, it's hard for 3-year-olds to beat 4-year-olds this time of year. The main thing is...he went the last eighth in the race in :12 and change at a mile and an eighth. What's the odds he won't do well if he goes :12 and change in the Florida Derby? None." Zito acknowledged that the Robert LaPenta colorbearer probably needs the right set-up for his strong late kick. "Some people say, 'Oh, he needs a fast pace,'" Zito offered. "So what? That's fine. So he needs a fast pace. He'll get it most of the time. That should be the least of our worries--a fast pace."

Eaton Sales' Reiley McDonald has been a fixture on the sales' circuit for many years, however, the Lexington resident assumed a somewhat unfamiliar role last Saturday when a horse he bred, **Daisy Devine** (Kafwain), scored by 1 3/4 lengths for her owner James Miller in the GII Fair Grounds Oaks.

"I have to give a lot of credit to her trainer Andrew McKeever," said McDonald. "He doesn't have a very big stable, but he's done a wonderful job with this filly."

To be sure, McDonald has already achieved success as a breeder, having mined such gems as Visionaire (Grand Slam), winner of the GI King's Bishop S. and GIII Gotham S., off his farm Athens Woods Farm in Athens, Kentucky. However, the victory

was made all the more satisfying because of the Kentucky-bred's humble background.

The filly was the ninth foal on record produced by Devil's Dispute (Devil's Bag), a daughter of GSW Impetuous Gal (Briartic), and a half-sister to MGISW Banker's Lady (Nijinsky II) and GSW Idabel (Mr. Prospector). Purchased by McDonald for \$23,000 at Keeneland November in 2006, the mare failed to get off the mark in eight career starts on the track. However, the 1989 foal achieved greater success in the breeding shed, producing stakes winners Patent Pending (Conquistador Cielo) and Bargainwiththdevil (Southern Halo). In addition to Daisy Devine, McDonald realized only one other foal out of the mare--an unraced two-year-colt by El Corredor named Senor Peligroso.

Unfortunately, Devil's Dispute was euthanized in the spring of 2010 after sustaining serious injury while turned out in a field.

"It was just one of those things that you could do anything about," said McDonald. "I'd be happier [about Daisy Devine's win] if the mare hadn't developed a problem and had to be put down a year ago, but, other than that, I was very excited for her and for Mr. Miller."

In 2007, McDonald opted to send Devil's Dispute to Kafwain, winner of the GII Norfolk S. and runner-up in the GI Breeders' Cup Juvenile at two before adding a score in the GII San Vicente during his sophomore season. McDonald, who generally buys mares at the middle price point, tries to look for a bargain when shopping for stallions.

"I don't go for the overly expensive stud fees for the most part," offered McDonald. "I bred her to Kafwain, because it was his third crop and he wasn't overly expensive at the time, but I thought his offspring looked good as yearlings and I felt they were very athletic as a group."

While stud fee is a major factor in the selection of a stallion, McDonald also outlined the importance of conformational balance when finding a mate for his mare.

"I would see the Kafwains with these big hips on them and a reasonable size, and this is what this mare needed," explained McDonald. "[Devil's Dispute] just needed some shoulder and hip, and that's what I tried to do, bring these characteristics into the foal at a

modest price. Everybody has a different philosophy in breeding and everybody can't always be right. Basically, my personal philosophy is to breed based on conformation. I just try to breed the better types of each animal into the foal. If one of the parents has a deficit conformationally, I try to address that in the other."

And McDonald was pleased with the resulting foal from the union.

"Daisy Devine was very smooth and had a very good top line," he recalled. "She was a little light of bone, but she was clean on X-ray."

Sent to the Keeneland September sale in 2009, the bay brought \$5,500 from James Miller.

"I met Mr. Miller at that sale," recalled McDonald. "It was late in the sale, and he came up to me and asked if I had any horses that would be inexpensive and that might make good racehorses. So, I pulled out a couple for him, and told him, 'I have one more yearling and I'm going to tell you three things about her. First of all, I own her. Second, she'll be very inexpensive and third, she looks very athletic and she's here to sell.'"

And sell she did, however, her purchase price didn't quite line the coffers.

"She was just the type of filly that fell through the cracks," said McDonald. "Kafwain's offspring didn't run so much [in 2009], and she was out of a little older mare, so she went for only \$5,500. Also, it was right before the big crash, but by that time, the market had already crashed for horses at the bottom."

Despite not capitalizing on the sale of Daisy Devine, McDonald is proud of the success of his farm in Athens, Kentucky. McDonald, who owns shares in several mares in partnership with others, currently has about 11 of his own mares, all of which are boarded at his farm.

"We've been very lucky, because we've had some really nice horses come off that little farm," said McDonald. "It's been fun to do this on a practical level. It is fun to watch a horse you breed become a Grade II winner and become a candidate for some of the bigger races. It's even more fun to have somebody like Mr. Miller ask for your advice, follow it and have some success and watch him have a ball with this filly."

Recently, McDonald announced that he had bought out his partners in Eaton Sales. And despite the changes that will be seen in the upcoming months in McDonald's sales' operation, he confirmed that very little would change in his breeding program.

"I'm pretty much going to stick to what I've been doing, and that is breeding good physical horses," he said. "My philosophy has always been to breed to race and to breed to sell--there is no reason to breed just to be commercial. Whether it's with the sales company or I'm breeding horses, I like to focus on the physical athlete."

With the victory still fresh in his mind, McDonald succinctly placed the experience into perspective.

"These types of stories are really a special part of our business," offered McDonald. "It's nice to see WinStar put millions into a business and do well. But it's nice, in a different vein, to see a little guy in the winner's circle after winning a race like the Oaks and having the time of his life. And that's what helps get new people into our business."--C Bossinakis

DYLAN THOMAS got his stud career off to the perfect start on Friday when his first ever runner, the Jim Bolger-trained Snowflake Dancer, became his first winner with victory over 5f at Dundalk.

The fact that outstanding middle-distance talent Dylan Thomas (pictured left) has got off to such a flyer would not have surprised pedigree students.

His sire Danehill was a top

sprinter-miler and developed into an extraordinarily versatile sire, getting brilliant horses at every distance from champion sprinters such as Mozart to stayers of the calibre of Westerner.

Though his three-parts sister Remember When also stays – she was runner-up in last year's Oaks – another half-sister, Queen's Logic, was an unbeaten champion juvenile filly and has produced top sprinter Lady Of The Desert.

Further speed elements in the pedigree come from his dam's brother, Middle Park Stakes runner-up Pure Genius, and sprint stakes-winning relatives Arctic Feeling, Feet So Fast, Soar and Splice.

Though Dylan Thomas didn't blossom until he tackled 1m2f to 1m4f at three to four – during which time he won six Group 1s over those distances – he was no slouch at two, winning on his debut over 7f in the June and a competitive renewal of the Irish Breeders Foal Levy Stakes.

Breeders sent Dylan Thomas 174 mares during his first season, 27 per cent of whom were black-type performers. Weatherbys lists Aidan O'Brien as training eight of the offspring, including the sire's top-priced yearling, a 300,000gns colt from the family of Oath.

As well as Snowflake Dancer, Bolger also has Thomas Dylan, a colt out of a winning half-sister to Group 2 scorer Highdown.

**KEENELAND TO UNVEIL INTERACTIVE FACEBOOK GAME**

Reaffirming its commitment to technology, innovation and the growth of the Thoroughbred racing fan base, Keeneland, in conjunction with its longtime marketing partner Cornett Integrated Marketing Solutions, will debut a Facebook-based interactive game called "Play Keeneland" for the track's spring meeting Apr. 8-29. The game was soft-tested during the last four days of the 2010 fall meeting and was the subject of universal acceptance and widespread praise from the approximately 120 players who used it. "We got great feedback and we got a good gauge of the interest, and the interest level was high--people were really enthusiastic about it," said Julie Balog, Keeneland's Director of Communications. "We want to educate fans and give them an opportunity to learn more about horse racing and just let them play. It's meant to be fun and interactive." Whereas there was a lot of manual work involved with the start-up last fall, the system is now mostly automated, according to David Coomer, the chief creative officer for Cornett. "We were really just trying to find out what worked best for Keeneland, what worked best for the industry, what's a new way to attract the fans and grow the sport," he explained. "The theory behind it is to make it easy for a new audience to learn about our sport. We just want to take the intimidation out of playing races, make it a very fun and social experience." He continued, "We want it to be fun and competitive, but it also contains descriptions of the various bets, i.e. what is a trifecta box. So, there is a learning aspect, but then there is also the competitive aspect as well." 'Play Keeneland' will challenge the player to select horses to finish first, second or third as well as the exacta and the trifecta. Players will also learn about and eventually be able to make use of exacta and trifecta boxes. Each time a player wins, a trophy is displayed on their Facebook page. Points earned will be transferred to their trophy case, and the daily winners will receive \$100 in Keeneland merchandise. A YouTube tutorial is available on [www.keeneland.com](http://www.keeneland.com). The overall points leader for the meeting will receive a grand prize trip to Lexington for the track's fall meet, with box seats, airfare for two and accommodations.

Keeneland President Nick Nicholson added, "Our goal is to showcase the excitement of Thoroughbred racing and do it in a way that is both fun and educational. We love introducing new fans to the sport and the next generation of fans are tuning in via social mediums like Facebook." There are currently 80,000 Facebook fans for Keeneland. Officials at the track have also announced the unveiling of a new Smartphone-friendly website, designed to provide a variety of information to racegoers. For the first time, Keeneland will offer a self-guided QR Code tour of the track that fans can participate in for discounts and prizes. Additionally, fans of Keeneland on Facebook are entitled to free general admission coupons on Wednesdays and Thursdays.

**STRONACH STEPPING DOWN** Frank Stronach has stepped down from his position as chairman of Magna International, but will retain a spot on the board, according to *reuters.com*. Having served as the company's chairman since 1971, Stronach revealed last August that he would cede his voting block in exchange for \$1 billion in cash and stock, as well as other benefits. "I believe regulators have put in place excessive rules that stifle the market's creative forces," the Austrian native stated in Magna's annual report, which was filed Thursday. "We need to loosen the regulatory straightjacket and create a simpler, more clear-cut regulatory framework." He added, "Going forward, much of my time and energy will be focused on growing Magna E-Car Systems, a partnership between Magna and the Stronach group. Working together with Ford Motor Co., we will launch the all-new Ford Focus Electric within the next 12 months, one of the world's first all-electric vehicles. The Stronach story at Magna is far from finished. I am starting from the beginning all over again, returning to my roots as an entrepreneur, and I look forward to growing Magna E-Car Systems into a company that will play a leading role in shaping and building the cars of the future."
