Nick Zito and Bob LaPenta must have been experiencing some feelings of déjà vu as they made the trip down to the winner's circle following Sunday's GI Florida Derby. The trainer/owner duo took this event last term in last-to-first fashion with GI Kentucky Derby runner-up Ice Box (Pulpit), and their representative **Dialed In** (Mineshaft) got the job done this time after making a similar move from the back of the pack.

Pacesetter **Shackleford** (Forestry)--the longest shot in the eight-horse field at 68-1--did all he could to hold off Dialed In in the stretch, but the outsider succumbed to the relentless charge of his more-fancied foe to fall a head short. "I haven't felt this emotional since [1991 Kentucky Derby winner] Strike the Gold," beamed Zito "He's such a gift to do what he has done."

ANOTHER TRIP TO THE WINNER'S CIRCLE

The momentum from Saturday carried over to Sunday for Todd Pletcher and E P Robsham Stables LLC, as the trainer/owner team added Sunday's GII Swale S. trophy to their mantle after securing the GIII Rampart S. with Awesome Maria (Maria's Mon) and the GII Gulfstream Park Oaks with R Heat Lightning (Trippi) less than 24 hours earlier. **Travelin Man** (Trippi), who debuted a super-impressive 7 1/4-length winner at six furlongs over the Gulfstream strip with a gaudy 106 Beyer Speed Figure Jan. 6, returned to be beaten by the same margin when taking the place slot in the GII Hutcheson S. here Feb. 26 behind Florida Derby contestant Flashpoint (Pomeroy). With the connections of that speedster opting to stretch out, Travelin Man was bet off the board and obliged by two lengths.

Dialing Long Distance...

Dialed In broke his maiden at first asking while overcoming trouble going 6 1/2 furlongs at Churchill Downs Nov. 12, and returned Jan. 30 to annex the GIII Holy Bull S. at a mile over the Gulfstream oval Jan. 30. With Zito concerned about the length of time between the Holy Bull and the Florida Derby, Dialed In was given a track-and-trip tune-up in an allowance Mar. 6. He finished second to older stablemate Equestrio (Elusive Quality) in that paceless affair. Dialed In was reserved well-back in last while glued to the rail as pacesetter Shackelford carved out splits of :23.30, :46.35 and 1:10.35 with **To Honor and Serve** pressing in second on the inside. Shackelford repelled a visibly tiring To Honor and Serve in upper stretch and threatened to blow up the tote as he opened up a clear lead by two lengths. The maroon and gold LaPenta silks were a blur down the center of the track, however, and Dialed In appeared had the longshot leader's measure in the late stages. "It was a solid pace and that definitely helped," said winning rider Julien Leparoux. "I just left him alone out of the gate and started to catch up around the second turn. I think his last race really helped him today. He learned to run between horses and take dirt in his face and it all paid off." LaPenta, whose runners made up the exacta in the GIII Skip Away S. a race earlier (see p5), added, "We've been to the [Kentucky] Derby several times and look forward to doing it again. We almost won it with Ice Box, but it does feel special to finish second. The goal is the Derby, but it certainly is nice to consider [Frank] Stronach's \$5.5 million [Preakness] bonus."

Zito Makes Right Call...

"Julien did what we asked him to." said Zito. "It was a gamble with the speed bias, but I knew he was capable of running this type of race. I knew he could do this if he stayed healthy. He's amazing and I'm blessed...I've thought all along he was one of the top 3-year-olds in country and he proved it today." The Hall of Famer continued, "I've been around long enough to know how special he is with just four races. Even when he got beat by Equestrio, a good 4-year-old, it was like a Grade III race, and then today to beat horses that have won races like the Remsen and Fountain of Youth? You just can't do what he's done."

No Show...

GII Fountain of Youth winner and 3-2 chalk **Soldat** (War Front) was a never-in-contention fifth. "[Rider Alan Garcia] said he just didn't fire his A race today," relayed Kieran McLaughlin. "He didn't have much horse when he pulled him out. He took a lot of dirt, but you're going to have to take dirt, so we'll regroup and look him over."

Bad Beat...

Shackelford's connections and backers were reeling after the 68-1 shot's narrow miss. "That's a real tough beat," said Dale Romans. "He ran super. I'm very proud of him. If \$200,000 is enough to get into the Derby, I think we'll have to go. He's a horse that keeps improving."

Better, But Still Not Enough...

Bill Mott said of GII Remsen and Nashua S. winner To Honor and Serve, "He looked like he was a little anxious on the backside. It looked like they set honest fractions. He was actually in the game when they turned for home today. It was a better race than last time [when he was third in the GII Fountain of Youth] by quite a bit, but we still need to improve."

Content to rate in second behind stablemate Razmataz (Forest Wildcat) through glacial splits of :23.13 and :46.42, Travelin Man took control with ease turning for home and was ridden out to score in hand with no resistance from his foes. "I don't know that he is limited to sprinting," said Pletcher. "He's rateable and can relax. We'll stretch him out at some point. The [Apr. 30 GIII] Derby Trial S. [at Churchill Downs] might be a race that fits. With the inside post last time, he pretty much had to go, but I think he's better sitting off the pace. I'm not saying he was going to beat Flashpoint, but we would have liked to have switched post positions going in." Winning rider John Velazquez added, "Breaking from the outside, we were in perfect position. He was able to sit back and relax and had plenty of kick left for the stretch. He was perfect." Stud El Aguila's Panamanian import Indiano, second here Mar. 20 for Marty Wolfson in his stateside debut behind Pletcher runner Escort (First Samurai), got up narrowly for second over Little Drama, the half-brother to 2010 champion sprinter Big Drama (Montbrook). Indiano's rider Julien Leparoux offered, "We were pretty close to the pace because they were going pretty slow. I had to move a little earlier than I wanted just to keep up with the favorite. There was no real excuse, though. When you're going slow you can move a little pre-mature." On the board in his last six starts, Amazombie followed an optional-claiming win on the Hollywood turf Dec. 5 with a head runner-up finish in a state-bred allowance on the Santa Anita main track Dec. 30. The bay was let go at 11-1 in the Sunshine Millions Sprint Jan. 29, but outran his odds to win by a determined head. He entered this off a half-length second in the Sensational Star H. with a return to the sod Feb. 27. Content to bide his time off an opening half in :43.45, Amazombie angled wide off the turn and lengthened stride.

Captain Cherokee had forged to the front as they approached the eighth pole, but he couldn't hold off Amazombie, who got on top in the last jump. Trainer and co-owner Bill Spawr started out as an assistant blacksmith in 1958, and recorded his first win as a trainer at Bay Meadows in 1977. He has been the leading trainer at tracks

in Southern California six times, most recently at Oak Tree in 2001. "This horse is the real deal," Spawr said. "Nobody believes in him. He came into this just perfect --if you don't understand perfect, just look at his body. Anyway, we're excited. It didn't happen like we wanted out of the gate, but then [Mike Smith] moved him out and he got there. S. S. Stone garnered the **"TDN Rising Star"** tag when he became the first winner for Nick Zito-

trained GI Belmont S. and GI Travers S. hero Birdstone (Grindstone) at Santa Anita way back in 2008. The grey didn't return to the winner's circle in four subsequent tries for Doug O'Neill out West, however, and joined the Zito stable late in 2010. S. S. Stone was later fifth in a 6 1/2-furlong optional claimer Dec. 13, but rediscovered his promise during an eight-length romp here

Jan. 5 at a mile against \$20,000 claimers. The LaPenta colorbearer returned to score by six lengths in a nine-furlong allowance Feb. 3, and was coming off a 3 3/4-length victory in a starter allowance here Mar. 5.

S. S. Stone broke well to prompt the pace from the ten post behind recent Challenger S. winner Colizeo (Distorted Humor) through splits of :23.87, :48.38 and 1:12.49. He put a head in front coming into the lane, and kicked clear to build on his advantage slightly. Jackson Bend, who was under the guidance of Zito for his sophomore campaign last term-- highlighted by a third in the GI Preakness S.--got up for second to complete the LaPenta exacta. The runner-up is co-owned by breeder Jacks or Better farm, and returned to original trainer Stan Gold at the beginning of 2011. "This is a big thing for me," Zito told *Daily Racing Form*. "I'm emotional about this race because my dear friends Marylou Whitney and John [Hendrickson] bred this horse and of course [being] by Birdstone." Little Mike was transformed into a new horse when switched to the sod by Allen Iwinski at Monmouth last August to break his maiden in start number five. The bay reeled off two more wins before finishing second in his stakes debut in the Monarch's Maze S. at Aqueduct Nov. 21. He bounced right back off that defeat to record two more tallies, including his first graded win in the GIII Fort Lauderdale S. here Jan. 9, before being transferred to the Dale Romans barn. The homebred found nine furlongs a bit too long when sixth in the GI Gulfstream Park Turf H. Feb. 5, and was turned back to annex the GIII Canadian Turf S. over course and distance Feb. 27. **Click for the [brisnet.com](http://www.brisnet.com) chart or the [brisnet.com](http://www.brisnet.com) PPs. In his usual spot on the lead through splits of :46.06, :23.25 and 1:09.05 while relatively loose, Little Mike opened up a clear advantage in upper stretch. He grew a bit leg weary in the waning stages, but closing California transplant and recent Kiaran McLaughlin acquisition Riviera Cocktail, who narrowly edged Asphalt, was left with too much to do late. "I've never seen him get tired," said Romans.

"Even though he didn't win the 1 1/8-mile race, he only got beat two lengths and that was a Grade I. He's been just super. He came to me in great condition. It's pretty special for him to win three graded stakes at the meet. We debated running him in this race or the [GI Maker's Mark Mile S.], but decided to stay here. We think he deserves another chance at a mile and an eighth in the [May 7 GI] Woodford Reserve Turf Classic S. [at Churchill Downs], and the timing is better from this race to that one." Little Mike was bred by owner Priscilla Vaccarezza's husband Carlo, a native of Genoa, Italy, who once worked as the limo driver for John Gotti. Vaccarezza moved from New York to Florida in 1993, and now owns a pair of Italian restaurants in the Sunshine State. Little Mike's dam, Hay Jude (Wavering Monarch), is the only mare he owns. Repole Stable's leading 3-year-old **Uncle Mo** (Indian Charlie) put in his final major work before next Saturday's GI Wood Memorial S. at Aqueduct at Palm Meadows Sunday. The ☆ **"TDN Rising Star"** ☆, who worked in company with recent graduate Praetereo (Giant's Causeway) under regular pilot John Velazquez, was credited with four furlongs in :48.20. The spin was the second-fastest of 36 at the distance, and the champion 2-year-old colt was caught galloping out in 1:01.04 and 1:15.79. "[Trainer Todd Pletcher] doesn't use the word perfect too much, but he said perfect," owner Mike Repole told *Daily Racing Form*. Pletcher added, "Last week, we put him behind horses, let him take a little dirt.

Today, I was looking for between :48 and :49 with a good gallop out and we got that. He probably could have went on his own today, but I wanted to make sure he got enough out of it." The red-hot conditioner continued, "I can't say that he's necessarily training any differently out of the race than before; he's always been such an exceptional horse and today was more of the same. He puts enough into his gallops that I don't think we need a demanding work schedule." Uncle Mo will ship north Tuesday.

Fellow Pletcher trainee **Brethren** (Distorted Humor) also worked at Palm Meadows Sunday, getting five furlongs in :59.90, the co-fastest of 22 works at the distance. Older MGSW Rule (Roman Ruler) was along for the work, and finished in 1:02.60. This was the second work for the half-brother to last year's GI Kentucky Derby hero Super Saver (Maria's Mon) since his unbeaten record was snapped with a third-place finish in the Mar. 12 GII Tampa Bay Derby. Both drills have come in recently added blinkers, but Pletcher is considering making adjustments, as Brethren was a bit keen Sunday. "I might try him next week with a little cut-back set of blinkers, maybe had a little too much on him today, and see if there's a happy medium," he told *DRF*. "[I'm] just looking for an improved performance. He seems like he's a tad too lackadaisical without them and a tad too physical with them." Brethren will run next in the GI Arkansas Derby at Oaklawn Apr. 16, while Mill House's GIII Palm Beach S. runner-up **Queen'splatekitten** (Kitten's Joy) is slated to compete in the GI Bluegrass S. at Keeneland on the same day. He went four furlongs Sunday in :49.30.

Jaycito Staying Home...

Zayat Stables LLC's **Jaycito** (Victory Gallop), a distant second behind Premier Pegasus (Fusaichi Pegasus) last out in the GII San Felipe S. Mar. 12, will remain in Southern California to contest next Saturday's GI Santa Anita Derby. The GI Norfolk S. winner was also being considered for the GI Wood Memorial S. at Aqueduct. "I was leery about running him back here, because horses with his style weren't doing that well until recently, with the track favoring speed," trainer Bob Baffert said. "But shipping could take something out of him, we won't have to face Uncle Mo and the weather is good here." Baffert added of his charge, who worked six furlongs in 1:13 4/5 over the strip Saturday, "I think he's got a good chance to win the race. Our main concern is to have him ready for the next one. This should set him up perfect for the Kentucky Derby."

St. George Farm Racing LLC's **Mr. Commons** (Artie Schiller) drilled five furlongs in 1:00.60--the fifth-fastest of 23 works at the distance--at Hollywood Park yesterday in preparation for his stakes debut in the Santa Anita Derby. CHRB Seeking Public Comment on Amendment:
Edited Press Release

The California Horse Racing Board is seeking public comment prior to conducting a public hearing next month on a proposal to allow horses to run for purse money only as non-wagering interests in rare circumstances. The public hearing will be part of the regular monthly Board meeting scheduled for Apr. 28 at Hollywood Park. The amendment to Rule 1974 proposes that on those infrequent occasions when “a horse is removed from the wagering pool due to a totalizator error, or due to any other error, and neither the trainer nor the owner is at fault, the horse shall start in the race as a non-wagering interest for the purse only, and shall be disregarded for pari-mutuel purposes.” Additionally, the amendment states that when such a horse is running for purse money only, “the circumstances shall be announced over the public address system at the time the action is taken and thereafter to adequately inform the public. The racing association shall also inform off-track wagering outlets at the time such action is taken.” The 45-day public comment period for this and related amendments began Mar. 4. Written comments about this proposed regulatory action will be accepted until Apr. 18. Written comments must be submitted to Harold Coburn, regulations analyst, at the California Horse Racing Board, 1010 Hurley Way, Suite 300, Sacramento, California 95825, either by regular mail or by e-mail to HaroldC@chr.ca.gov. The public is also encouraged to comment during the public hearing on Apr. 28. The agenda for that meeting, including the starting time, will be posted on the CHRB Website (www.chrb.ca.gov) on or before Apr. 18. The proposed amendment to allow horses to run only for purse money addresses situations where horses are mistakenly removed from the totalizator system. The current two options for the stewards are either to scratch the horse, which unfairly penalizes the owner and trainer who were not at fault, or to order the horse placed back into the wagering system, which unfairly penalizes anyone who attempted to wager on that horse while it was out of the system.
