CHAMPAGE AND CAVIAR AT INGLIS EASTER

There was much to celebrate at the Inglis complex Wednesday, as the flagship Easter Sale continued to show positive gains during its second session. A total of 251 yearlings have been sold at the Newmarket complex for an average of A\$241,394, up nearly 10 percent on 2010 figures. "To have an average up nearly 10 percent is a very satisfying result at this stage," Inglis Manag-

ing Director Mark Webster said. "The clearance rate today was a little disappointing, but, as yesterday's figures show, it can be expected to improve as post sale negotiations are completed." Webster added, "Buyers should note that there's still a great opportunity to secure a future champion at tomorrow's closing session." A 57-lot first session Thursday will be followed by Session II of the sale. Wednesday's topper, a half-brother to superstar Black Caviar (Aus) (Bel Esprit {Aus}) by Casino Prince (Aus), was hammered down to Hawkes Racing. Bidding on behalf of Nathan Tinkler, they won a spirited bidding duel with Peter Moody. Sold by Rick Jamieson's Gilgai Farm and consignor Makybe as [lot 277](#), he brought A\$1,025,000 (US\$1,069,136). "It seemed like A\$600,000 was going to do it, but the two boys obviously wanted him. I'm thrilled to bid," Jamieson said.

Watched Like A Hawkes...

Hawkes Racing is made up of the trio of dad John and sons Wayne and Michael Hawkes. The Hawkeses train Black Caviar's younger full-brother Moshe (Aus), who has won three of his four career starts, including a handicap at Moonee Valley Mar. 18. Wayne Hawkes said his team had had an eye on the colt for some time.

"We saw him at Makybe six weeks ago and then, when we saw him again last week, he'd just jumped out of the ground," Hawkes said, adding, "We know the family obviously, having Moshe, and everyone knows Black Caviar." Perfect in her 11 starts, Black Caviar picked up her fourth straight Group 1 victory in the Mar. 25 William Reid S. The Hawkeses were also pleased to get a graduate of Tony Santic's Makybe operation.

"Everyone doing form looks at the strike rate of trainers and we do the same when we are looking at vendors," Wayne Hawkes said. John Hawkes started his career as a jockey and trainer in 1971, but opted to hang up his helmet when Australia stopped issuing dual licenses at the end of that season. A year later, he boasted his first champion in distaff Classic winner Toltrice (Aus) (Matrice {Aus}), and he has since conditioned numerous champions, including two Australian Horse of the Year honorees, the great Octagonal (NZ) (Zabeel {NZ}) and his son Lonhro (Aus). Hawkes was elected to Australia's Racing Hall of Fame in 2004, but, according to his website at <http://www.hawkesracing.com.au>, he still gets to the barn at 4 a.m. on a daily basis. His quote was, "Climbing the mountain and getting to the top is difficult, but staying there is much harder." He established a training partnership with his two sons in 2008, but Wayne has worked alongside his father since the mid '90s. Michael handled a string in Brisbane before returning to Sydney three years ago. "I suppose you could say dad is the brains and Wayne and I are the youth," Michael said on the website. "I think it is a pretty good partnership. We are lucky we have each other."

Shock Factor...

Lot 341, a 3/4-brother to 2009 G1 Melbourne Cup hero Shocking (Aus) (Street Cry {Ire}) by Street Sense, brought A\$450,000 at yesterday session at Inglis

Easter. That's 10 times what Shocking brought as a Magic Millions Premier Yearling in 2007. Consigned by Widden Stud, he was purchased by Shocking's trainer, Mark Kavanagh. Kavanagh was taking a gamble on the yearling, as he had not yet determined who would end up as the

owner. "We liked the colt a lot and were prepared to buy him on spec, without a specific order." Kavanagh said, but added, "Some good stable clients watching the sale have already bought in, and there are still a few shares available." The champion stayer in Australia in 2009, Shocking recently picked up the second Group 1 win of his career, taking the Mar. 12 Australian Cup.

Lots to Choose From...

(Edited press release) The grand Zabeel (NZ) mare Champagne (NZ), a champion and dam of stakes winners Martinique (Aus) (Danahill) and Nadege (Aus) (Giant's Causeway), also provided a highlight lot at Easter Wednesday, with James Bester going to A\$850,000 for her Redoute's Choice (Aus) colt out of the Cressfield draft. Chantilly Bloodstock was also on the Redoute's Choice bandwagon, buying the Clean Sweep (NZ) (End Sweep) colt from Arrowfield for A\$750,000. After being beaten on the Black Caviar sibling, Peter Moody spent A\$600,000 on the Redoute's Choice--Lisheenowen (Aus) (Semipalatinsk) half-brother to champion Private Steer (Aus) (Danahill Dancer {Ire}) and MG1SW All Silent (Aus) (Belong to Me).

Ingham Racing continued to lead the buying list, securing 11 yearlings overall for A\$3.27 million, closely followed by Shadwell, who have nine for A\$3.04 million. James Bester was also very active over the two days, securing eight yearlings under his own bloodstock banner for A\$1.83 million and another five in partnership with Demi O'Byrne for A\$2.71 million.

Arrowfield is the leading vendor by aggregate, having sold 24 yearlings for A\$6.95 million, while Coolmore has 27 sold for A\$5.995 million. Widden Stud has sold 16 for A\$3.85million and Yarraman Park have parted with 11 yearlings for A\$3.53 million at an average of A\$320,909.

Other vendors to boast an average above A\$300,000 include Cressfield (two at A\$555,000), Emirates Park (five at A\$525,000), Highgrove Stud (four at A\$415,000), Tyreel (three at A\$376,667), Willow Park (seven at A\$372,857) and Makybe (eight at A\$335,000).

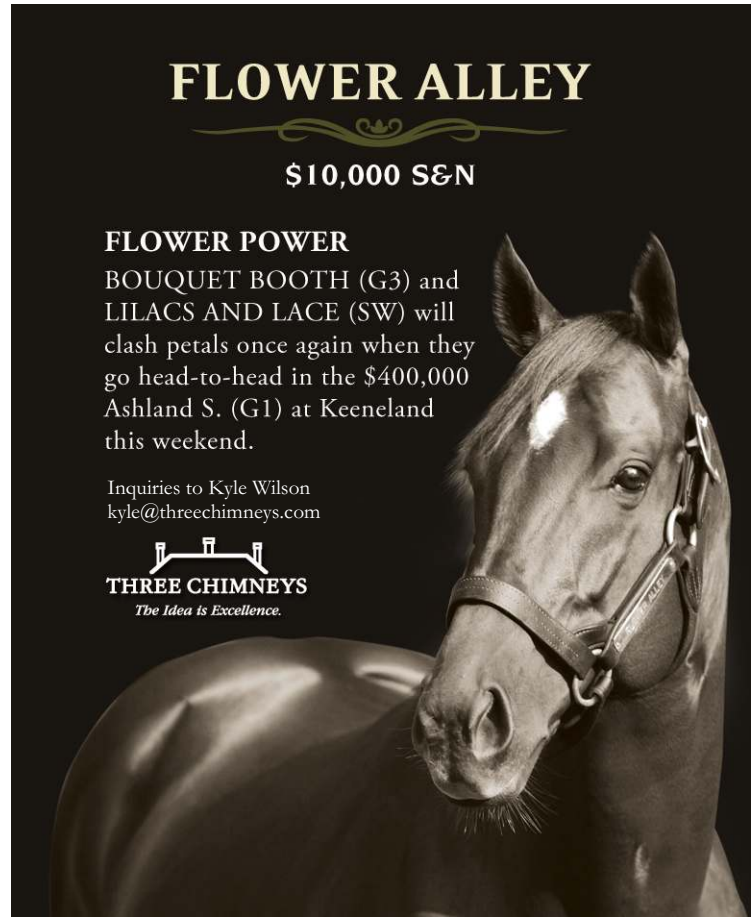

This Guineas prep saw Makfi (GB) (Dubawi {Ire}) emerge from the shadows 12 months ago en route to glory at Newmarket. While it is unlikely that this year's edition contains a similar story, a smart line-up is headed by a pair of Rouget-trained colts, including **Havane Smoker**. Having lost his unbeaten record at the expense of French Navy (GB) (Shamardal) in Longchamp's G3 Prix des Chenes in September--where the re-opposing **Surfrider** was five lengths back in third--he was one of a clutch of highly regarded domestic runners who could never land a blow behind Roderic O'Connor (Ire) (Galileo {Ire}) in the G1 Criterium International at Saint-Cloud late the next month.

Helleborine and **"TDN Rising Star"** **Moonlight Cloud** held high position at the top of the league of domestic juvenile fillies last term and prepare to face-off in this fascinating trial for the Newmarket 1000 Guineas and Longchamp equivalent. The former followed a five-length success in the G3 Prix d'Aumale at Longchamp in September with a length second to Misty For Me (Ire) (Galileo {Ire}) in the G1 Prix Marcel Boussac at Longchamp on Arc day, where the re-opposing G3 Prix du Calvados scorer **Mambia** was three lengths adrift in fourth. On that same card, **Moonlight Cloud** was pitched in against the colts in the G1 Prix Jean-Luc Lagadere and was doing her best work at the finish to be fourth there, having looked potentially special with a six-length conditions win at that track the previous month. Freddy Head has never made any secret of his regard for **Moonlight Cloud**, while that trainer's sister Criquelette Head-Maarek holds a similarly high opinion of **Helleborine**, who would be adding an 11th renewal to her yard's resume here. "She's done well and has been working nicely," Head-Maarek told *PA Sport* yesterday. "I got beat with Hatoof in that race then she won the Guineas, but because you get beat in the first race of the year doesn't mean you can't go to Newmarket. You only get one try in that race. Whatever she does, in principle she is on her way to Newmarket."

New Look for Elite Alex...

Elite Alex (Afleet Alex), third in the GIII Southwest S. Feb. 21 and fourth in the GII Louisiana Derby Mar. 26, was sporting blinkers as he zipped six furlongs from the gate in 1:11 3/5 at Oaklawn Wednesday. The colt was prepping for the Apr. 16 GI Arkansas Derby. Working in company, he was timed through splits of :22 2/5 and :46 2/5 with jockey Calvin Borel in the irons. Elite Alex opened up on his stablemate as he dashed off five-eighths in :58 3/5, and he galloped out seven furlongs in 1:25 3/5. "The blinkers made him jump out of there, but he was still finishing up the way he has the whole time," said Borel, adding, "That's what you want when you're running a mile and a quarter. I think if we can run first or second, he will be the right kind of horse that can fit the way I ride in the Kentucky Derby."

S. S. Stone Injured...

Daily Racing Form reports that **S.S. Stone** (Birdstone), winner of Sunday's GIII Skip Away S., came out of the race with a hairline fracture in his left cannon bone. "It's nothing serious," trainer Nick Zito told *DRF*. "We already did the surgery and he'll be out a few months. He's going to stay with me here at Palm Meadows, and then probably move on to Saratoga when we leave here at the end of the month." Now five, S.S. Stone was making just his 10th career start in the Skip Away, but exited the race a perfect four-for-four on the year. His record stands at 10-5-0-2 with earnings of \$154,130. Zito expects the grey, who missed 13 months after suffering a fracture to his right cannon bone at three, to return to the races. "Now he's got matching bookends, the same injury on both legs," he told *DRF*. "But I know how to deal with that. Commentator (Distorted Humor) had three during his career. [S.S. Stone] will just have to be raced sparingly when he comes back. One thing I do know is that he loves Gulfstream, so one race we'll definitely be pointing for is the [GI] Donn H. in 2012."



Racetrack Round-Up cont.

Champ Pegasus Suffers Ankle Injury...

Champ Pegasus (Fusaichi Pegasus), runner-up in last year's GI Breeders' Cup Turf and most recently a distant 12th in the Mar. 26 G1 Dubai Sheema Classic, has emerged from that race with an ankle injury and will miss six to eight weeks, trainer Richard Mandella told *Daily Racing Form*. "He has an ankle that's jarred up, but it's nothing serious," Mandella said. "We'll give him a couple of months off." Owned by Gerald Ford's Diamond A Racing in partnership with Arturo Vargas, the five-year-old took the GII Del Mar H. and GI Clement L. Hirsch Turf Championship prior to his strong second-place finish in the Breeders' Cup. He added a win in the GII San Luis Obispo S. prior to his effort at Meydan. Champ Pegasus has won five of his 12 career starts for earnings of \$1,018,520.

VELAZQUEZ TO PAY FINE IN LIFE AT TEN MATTER Jockey John Velazquez has entered into an agreement with the Kentucky Horse Racing Commission to pay a \$10,000 fine for charges related to last year's GI Breeders' Cup Ladies' Classic and the performance of Life At Ten (Malibu Moon). The veteran reinsman admitted that he "may have violated" one of three statutes cited by the KHRC's in their final report on the incident in which the well-backed Life At Ten was eased out of the race early on after Velazquez and trainer Todd Pletcher expressed concern on the live television broadcast about the filly's behavior in the paddock and on the track prior to post time. Half of the fine is payable to the Commission, while the other half will go to the Permanently Disabled Jockey's Fund, which Velazquez serves as a board member. The agreement brings the case against Velazquez to an end. "I firmly believe that ending this matter now is in the best interests of racing," said Velazquez. "I have ridden in over 21,000 races, and I can tell you that the safety of every single one of those horses was, and remains, for me foremost. A prolonged legal battle will not serve the Industry well. It will, in fact, distract us from all that is positive and great about this sport. I have not been cited with a single racing rule violation in the past 12 years. While I do not agree with the 'charges' noticed by the Kentucky Horse Racing Commission nor do I concede any guilt, I do believe that this resolution is right for racing."

LONGINES TO SPONSOR DIANE Swiss watchmakers Longines have signed a sponsorship deal for the G1 Prix de Diane with France Galop. At a meeting of France Galop and Swatch Group France and Longines officials on Tuesday, the watchmakers were also announced as the official timekeeper of Longchamp, Chantilly and Deauville racecourses.

DANDINO HAS CUP AIM Trainer James Given is looking at a tilt at the G1 Coronation Cup with **Dandino (GB)** (Dansili {GB}), one of 27 entries unveiled yesterday for the 1 1/2-mile contest at Epsom June 3. Runner-up to Rebel Soldier (Ire) (Danehill Dancer {Ire}) and ahead of the eventual G1 St Leger winner Arctic Cosmos (North Light {Ire}) when second in the G3 Gordon S. at Goodwood in July, the 4-year-old was not beaten far when 11th in the G1 Japan Cup when last seen. "He ran well in the Japan Cup," Given said yesterday. "As a 3-year-old it was a big ask, and we went there to try and get experience for the horse. I was very happy with that run, and I think it did provide him with some valuable education. We might start off in a mile-and-a-half conditions race at Ripon in a couple of weeks time, which could be a nice way to blow away the cobwebs in the lead-up to maybe going to the Jockey Club S. at Newmarket before looking more closely at the Investec Coronation Cup." Given also had news of last year's G2 International Bosphorus Cup winner **Indian Days (GB)** (Daylami {Ire}), whose name also featured in the Coronation Cup entries. "You have to keep your options open, and Indian Days has also been entered for the invitation races in Hong Kong and Singapore."

SENATE PASSES 1099 REPEAL, PRESIDENT EXPECTED TO SIGN

On Tuesday, the Senate voted 87-12 on the House-passed repeal of the 1099 IRS tax form provision in the Patient Protection and Affordable Care Act ("Health Care Bill"). The paperwork mandate was to go into effect in 2012.

Under last year's health care bill, the controversial provision required businesses to file 1099s for any independent contractor, individual or corporation from whom a business purchased a total of \$600 or more worth of goods or services in a given year. Previously, businesses were only required to file such paperwork for independent contractors who met that threshold.

For small businesses everywhere, including those in the Thoroughbred industry, the 1099 provision would have greatly increased administrative duties for both the business filing taxes and its vendors. This potential burden created many critics within the business community and Congress.

The cost of repealing to the federal government is reported to be \$22 billion. President Obama is not expected to veto the bill and may sign into law by the end of the week.
