

GOLDEN ARCHES

With the exception of a disappointing fourth-place effort over a wet track in the Smarty Jones S. in January, Robert and Loyal's **Archarcharch** (Arch) had done very little wrong in his career. But, with the presence of GII Rebel S. hero **The Factor** (War Front) getting

pounded into odds-on favoritism, the Oaklawn faithful allowed the Jinks Fires trainee to go off at an overlaid 25-1. Given a perfect off-the-pace ride by Jon Court, Fires' son-in-law, the colt rallied wide on the final turn, made the front in the final eighth

of a mile and withstood a strong finish from Zayat Stables' **Nehro** (Mineshaft) to take Saturday's GI Arkansas Derby in Hot Springs. The Factor, who had Archarcharch some 6 1/2 lengths back in third when last they met in Rebel S. four weeks back, was outfooted to the lead this time around. He laid third and was in with every chance if good enough when the real running started, but emptied out in the stretch to finish eighth. He was said to have displaced in the race, but the performance casts some doubt on his participation in the GI Kentucky Derby May 7. **Cont. p2**

Live Oak Plantation's **Brilliant Speed** (Dynaformer) looked to have been set a hopeless task by jockey Joel Rosario, as he found himself last with no speed to close into in yesterday's GI Toyota Blue Grass S. at

Keeneland. But the colt rallied inside at the quarter pole, was steered out across the heels of several of his rivals into the middle of the Polytrack and was up in the final stride for a nose victory over **Twinspired** (Harlan's Holiday). The winner's stablemate **King Congie** (Badge of

Silver) was third. "I saw him far back, and I thought maybe he doesn't handle the track," winning trainer Tom Albertrani commented. "I saw him coming down the lane, and he was just making big strides." **Cont. p3**

FRANKED

Sent off an unforgiving 1-4 mortal lock for Saturday's G3 Greenham S., **Frankel** (GB) (Galileo {Ire}) returned to wrap up Newbury's 2000 Guineas prep in straightforward fashion, and presented a watertight case for odds-on favoritism in the Newmarket Classic in two

weeks' time. While it was a surprise that the 25-1 shot **Excelebration** (Ire) (Exceed and Excel {Aus}) could stick with him for so long, the Cartier Award winner eventually had a convincing four-length gap to that rival, and it was a further six back to the third **Shropshire** (Ire)

(Shamardal). Pulling his way up to stable companion and fellow **"TDN Rising Star"** **Picture Editor** (GB) (Dansili {GB}) in the early stages, Juddmonte's impressive bay was in front with 2 1/2 furlongs remaining and, after matching strides with the runner-up for a handful of yards, pulled away to put his customary stamp on the contest. Despite a troubled runner-up effort in a highly rated Churchill maiden in his Nov. 27 debut, Archarcharch made the trip to New Orleans for his next start and graduated in style with a 1 3/4-length success in the six-furlong Sugar Bowl S. Dec. 18. He was the even-money selection for the Smarty Jones S. Jan. 17 which was conducted over a weather-affected main track at Oaklawn which produced times that were routinely 15 lengths below par. His fourth that afternoon to Caleb's Posse (Posse) was one handicappers could and should have put a line through, but he was the forgotten horse at over 14-1 in the Gill Southwest S. Feb. 21.

Archarcharch taught those naysayers an expensive lesson, coming from midpack and overcoming a wide passage for a one-length tally over J P's Gusto (Successful Appeal). The Associated Press reported that owner Robert Yagos had a deal to sell the colt following the win, but when the signed contract was returned 15 minutes past the agreed-upon deadline, he decided to retain the colt. There was no one to go with The Factor in the Rebel and, despite a strong pace, Archarcharch wasn't able to launch his trademark rally and was outfinished by Caleb's Posse for the place spot. The Arkansas Derby would prove another shot at redemption.

The start of the Derby was delayed by a handful of minutes by Dance City, who proved difficult to load. When the gates flew back, it was J P's Gusto from a high draw who was ridden to the lead, while The Factor raced inside Dance City in third, an unusual position for the front-runner. Jon Court had Archarcharch in the latter third of the field, and had to be licking his chops as the pace was demanding. As the field reached the far turn after six furlongs in 1:11.22, J P's Gusto had had enough and was tackled by Dance City, The Factor three wide and a four-deep Sway Away (Afleet Alex). The latter struck to the front and set sail for the wire, but Archarcharch, despite having covered ground throughout, came calling down the middle of the track, hit the lead in the final sixteenth of a mile and just held, as Nehro stormed home to just miss. "This horse is something special," said winning owner Robert Yagos. "Jinks gave us confidence in this horse since day one. We haven't gotten to take a deep breath since he crossed the wire. Jon and Jinks and the whole barn have done a great job with Archarcharch."

Another edition of the Toyota Blue Grass S., another long-odds winner. The betting favorite has now failed in eight consecutive runnings of the spring feature, with **Peace Rules** (**Jules**) the last to succeed in 2003. Of the last eight winners, six have returned mutuels in excess of 8-1, including **Stately Victor** (**Ghostzapper**), who lit up the tote to the tune of 40-1 last April. This time it was 19-1 **Brilliant Speed** to cause the boilover.

Following a pair of unplaced efforts on the main track at Belmont and Saratoga to begin his career, **Brilliant Speed** improved markedly with a switch to the infield, running third over yielding Belmont turf Sept. 18 and Oct. 17, respectively. Shipped south for the winter, the homebred was sent to Tampa for some class relief, and the decision paid dividends, as **Brilliant Speed** strolled to an easy 1 1/2-length victory. He remained on the spinach as he transitioned to stakes company in his last two and showed he was more than equal to the task, nearly overcoming a world of traffic trouble to miss by a nose in the Jan. 16 **Dania Beach S.** and was most recently third-placed second-in the **Hallandale Beach S.** Feb. 6, a race which saw **King Congie** demoted from the victory to third for causing interference in the stretch.

Joes Blazing Aaron (Graeme Hall) and Garrett Gomez showed the way early on from Praetereo (Giant's Causeway) with **Twinspired** enjoying the run of the race from third and just in behind the leaders. Despite a pace that was very slow to develop, Joel Rosario had **Brilliant Speed** under a tight hold at the tail of the field.

Still last with three furlongs to race with the opening three-quarters up in a dawdling 1:14.76, **Brilliant Speed** rode the rails into the stretch and shifted out several paths across heels to launch his rally down the center. **Twinspired** rallied to the front outside **Joes Blazing Aaron** with three-sixteenths of a mile to race and stole what looked to be a winning margin. But **Brilliant Speed**, who was bothered for a fraction of a second by his stablemate **King Congie** inside the final furlong, came with a stinging rally and was just able to get his nose down on the wire. Never Retreat collected three stakes victories last term, including the Lady Canterbury S. at Canterbury in July and the Kentucky Cup Ladies Turf S. at Kentucky Downs in September. The dark bay just missed by a nose to Fantasia in Woodbine's River Memories S. in her 2010 finale Oct. 30. Brought back for a six-year-old campaign, the consistent mare enjoyed a nice winter at Gulfstream Park, placing third in the GIII Marshua's River S. Jan. 9, second in the GIII Suwannee River S. Feb. 5 and delivering as the 3-1 favorite in the GIII Honey Fox S. last time Mar. 5. Seeking her second in a row here, Never Retreat tracked the early leaders in third, hit the gas on the turn for home, and outkicked Fantasia to the line for a career high.

"We had this race scheduled right after the Honey Fox," winning conditioner Chris Block commented. "She trained really well after the Honey Fox. I knew the soft turf would be something she'd be all right on. We ran her at Kentucky Downs last year in a real bog, and she handled it with no trouble. She's at the top of her game right now." Jockey Shaun Bridgmohan added, "I had a great trip. Chris [Block] gave me a free hand to let her run out of there so I was able to establish good position with her. All the credit to Mr. Block. She's a nice filly."

The win was the eighth in graded-stakes company at Keeneland for Cot Campbell's Dogwood Stable, earning the organization a silver platter in recognition of the accomplishment. Nicole H began her career out in California late in 2009 somewhat inauspiciously, recording just one win from eight attempts--mostly routing on synthetics--for David Hofmans and her current owner, Dr. John K. Waken's GEM Racing. The dark bay resurfaced to finish second for Michael Hushion in a sloppy six-furlong allowance at Monmouth Aug. 22, then scored by 10 3/4 lengths in a similar event over a dry strip at Belmont a month later. After a dull seventh-place run in the Dream Supreme S. at Churchill Downs Nov. 6 as the 11-10 favorite, Nicole H paired up stakes wins over the Aqueduct inner in the Dec. 4 Garland of Roses S. and the Jan. 1 Interborough S. She hadn't been seen since. Longshot Wild News set an easy pace through splits of :23.90 and :46.81 while the chalk stalked wide and wound up in third. Nicole H took over with ease swinging for home and won geared down. "She just dragged [rider Channing Hill] up there at the three-eighths pole," said Hushion. "I felt awfully good at that point. She got her big break last time when securing the nine-furlong GII Santa Ana S. Mar. 19. Taking the early lead through an opening quarter in :23.94, Malibu Pier was reigned in by pilot Brice Blanc to defer to Restless Soul and track in third behind splits of :47.97, 1:12.72 and 1:36.75. Blanc tipped his mount out for clear running as they straightened, and she wore down the pacesetter before keeping Cozi Rosie, who was last early, comfortably at bay. "We were fairly confident she could get the distance," said conditioner Carla Gaines of her charge's first 1 1/4-mile try. "She ran so well at a mile and an eighth [in the Santa Ana]. If you pay them, they will come. And that they did, from the west, the south and the Midlantic for the first-ever graded race to be contested at Charles Town. At the end of the three-turn mile and one-eighth, it was Florida raider Duke of Mischief who is leaving the Mountaineer state with the biggest bag of loot. Winner of the GII Oaklawn H., the GIII Philip H. Iselin H. and the GIII Fort Lauderdale S. last term, the Duke, placed fifth in a roughly run GII Clark H. in his final four-year-old appearance, resurfaced in the valuable Sunshine Millions Classic Jan. 29, but had the misfortune of running into an in-form Tackleberry (Montbrook) and was forced to settle for second money. The two locked horns again in their last meeting, and again it was Tackleberry who proved best--with Duke of Mischief fourth--in the GII Gulfstream Park H. Mar. 12 over a one-turn mile. The additional real estate of this event was certainly not going to inconvenience the 5-year-old and he took money from his 8-1 morning line to be off at 9-2. In behind the first flight of runners early on, Duke of Mischief was already mud-splattered as he raced one from the rear passing the stands for the first time. Entering the second turn, Joe Bravo made the decision to take his charge outside of all the kickback, a decision which would prove instrumental in the victory. Duke of Mischief jumped into the bridle once in the clear and tugged his way into third with his familiar foe Tackleberry and GI Santa Anita H. hero Game On Dude to catch. He whisked by to the outside, straightened well in front and splashed home clearly best. Trainer and part-owner David Fawkes was faced with having to choose between a title defense in Hot Springs or the \$1-million of this event. "Coming here, to me, it was a no brainer," the victorious conditioner commented. Betting turnover on the race approached \$800,000, a new track record. We have had to hold him together, and he hasn't really been let off the bit, so I knew he'd improve a lot for the race. It was just a question of whether he was ready enough to get away with it today, and Tom said he was about 80 percent, so, with that race and a couple more bits of work, we'll get there in time. My lead horse couldn't go fast enough, but he settled, and in the end [Queally] could hardly pull him up. He also had a good blow and is not stressed, so everything is very satisfactory, and I think we'll see a better horse in two weeks' time. He does go on soft, but he is better on fast ground, and there was no jar in it today." Kind has a 2-year-old full-brother to Frankel, as well as a yearling colt by Oasis Dream (GB), and recently foaled a filly by that Banstead Manor stallion. The runner-up's trainer Marco Botti told *PA Sport*, "We all know about Frankel, and that wasn't a disgrace for sure. For me, our horse is best at seven furlongs, and I'll have to decide whether we go for the [June 15] G3 Jersey S. at Royal Ascot, or he is entered in the G2 Mehl-Mulhens-Rennen [German 2000 Guineas at Cologne May 22]."

After wrapping up on the set, I headed over to the main building, and from the moment I walked into Oaklawn's doors, every second person I passed offered the same greeting, "Happy Derby day." Custom runs deep here. I hadn't even made it to the elevator which would take me up to my perch on the fifth floor, when I happened to pass a couple of security guards, who were leading (or I should say carrying) out a young man, who was sporting very dark sun glasses, and was seriously intoxicated. And it wasn't even noon. Nice. Soon after I got up to the press box, I had barely begun to get to the task at hand when the party appeared to be in full swing with the reappearance of the Mariachi band from the previous day. In fact, a little later in the day, they made their way into the Oaklawn Club to entertain its members, as well as the connections affiliated with the day's entrants. An interesting side note; all the connections of the Arkansas Derby entrants wore red silk ties with blue horse motifs. Ok, maybe not *all*, just the men, in fact. The ties were gifted to them by Oaklawn officials. Very nice touch.

One of the highlights of the afternoon was when D. Wayne Lukas was led to the winner's enclosure in between races for the presentation of the award for leading trainer for the 2011 Oaklawn meet. Lukas, who won the seventh race of the day with Silver Country (Storm Cat), was collecting his second Oaklawn training title. He accounted for the first one in 1987. He capped off the meeting with 27 wins, three more than his nearest rival Allen Milligan.

I was graciously accepted into the fold by the connections of Sway Away and joined the crew for some libations as the big event drew nearer. Stationed in the fourth floor Oaklawn Club, the group that included one of the colt's principal owners Phil Lebherz, was upbeat heading into the day's final few races. Lebherz is the Chairman and CEO of LISI, which serves thousands of brokers in the Health Care industry. Also in the mix were Mersad Metanovic, who advised on the purchase of the colt along with trainer Jeff Bonde. Bonde ordered a Cabernet as the Arkansas Derby loomed, and he explained that it was to help take the edge off. Also feeling the pressure was Bob Baffert, trainer of favorite The Factor. Baffert was visibly anxious prior to the race and couldn't have been pleased by speed not holding in the earlier races on the card. However, Baffert received the ray of hope he was looking for when his filly May Day Rose (Rockport Harbor) wired the field in the Instant Racing S.

In the saddling area located in the track's infield, the Derby runners' connections turned out in force. Among those on hand to cheer on their charges were George Bolton and David Shimmon (The Factor), WinStar's Kenny Troutt and Elliott Walden (Brethren), Pin Oak's Josephine Abercrombie (Alternation) and Robert Yagos (Archarcharch). As the 3-year-olds headed to the track, the crowd swarmed along the apron in an unbelievable mass. The excitement was simply electric. Loading of the field seemed to take an eternity (it did take longer than usual), the race was over in an instant, with Archarcharch stealing the show at 25-1. While the winning connections celebrated, the others were forced to lick their wounds. While Sway Away appeared to be in position to make some noise at the head of the lane, he weakened late to be fourth, beaten about three lengths. As for The Factor, he rated in third early before fading to seventh. Soon after the race, Baffert looked obviously gutted. He said his biggest disappointment was that his horse didn't have a chance to run his race. He said he knew J P's Gusto (Successful Appeal) and Dance City (City Zip) wanted the lead at any cost, and he wasn't prepared to sacrifice his horse because of it. With nothing set in stone, Baffert indicated they would go back and lick their wounds and figure out a course for the colt, but wouldn't offer any options.

With darkness approaching and the moon emerging in its full glory, the track apron was left empty, littered with losing pari-mutuel tickets. Whether people left the track winners or losers, one thing was for certain, the Arkansas Derby after parties beckoned one and all.

Sacred Choice began her career for trainer Anthony Cummings, but spent some time on the sidelines with an injury, and was later turned over to Joseph Pride. "When she started racing for me, I thought she might win a listed race and, when she did, I thought she had done a good job," Pride added. "To think she has now won two Group 1s, it doesn't get much better. Her preparation might not look good on paper, but I planned it that she had four weeks off going into this race. When I get a plan that works, I like to stick with it."

JET MASTER COLT TOPS SATURDAY

Saturday's session of the Emperors Palace National Yearling Sale was topped by lot 352, a son of Jet Master (SAf) secured by A. Papageorgiou for R3,000,000 (about US\$441,000). Already named Master of My Fate, the bay is out of champion Promisefrommyheart (SAf) (Elliodor {Fr}), and hails from the immediate family of GII Breeders' Cup Juvenile Turf hero Pluck (More Than Ready). He was consigned by Varsfontein Stud. The second-highest price of the day was R1,400,000, paid by Form Bloodstock for lot 304. Consigned by Riverton Stud, the Silvano (Ger) colt is out of Group 3 winner National Vixen (SAf) (National Assembly), making him a half-brother to unbeaten juvenile Trinity House (SAf) (Captain AI {SAf}).

The nation's premier yearling sale has a noteworthy 86% clearance rate after two sessions. The overall aggregate of the sale is R74,265,000, down from last year's aggregate of R102,095,000, but not drastically so. The average for the first two days is R260,579 (about US\$38,000).

Overall, the sale has impressed many buyers. Marsh Shirtliff, owner of the mighty Pocket Power (SAf) and one of South Africa's biggest buyers, said, "I had a longer short list at this sale than any other previous National sale. I think there is a better quality of horse selling, and there are a lot of good sires represented. Although the Cape Premier Sale took horses away from this sale, it did not detract from the high quality of horse offered here." Form Bloodstock has bought six horses thus far, and Jehan Malherbe echoed Shirtliff's sentiments. "The Cape Premier Sale definitely had an impact on this sale. There were, however, plenty of nice horses, which sold for good money. I was very impressed by the quality of horses on offer."
