Robert Sahn and Stan Hough's **Adios Charlie** (Indian Charlie) was coming off just a second-start maiden win, and was stretching out while running in the slop for the first time, but the lightly raced bay showed great

determination and promise to battle back and take Saturday's GII Jerome S. at Aqueduct by 2 1/2 lengths over **Astrology** (A.P. Indy). **Justin Phillip** (First Samurai) appeared that he would win by whatever margin he wanted when he ranged up

to take over at the top of the lane, but Adios Charlie dove to the inside and came with a resolute rally to win going away. "That was a big thrill," said Hough. "I thought he ran great. The timing worked out. As for what's next, we'll have to talk about it. I didn't nominate him to the Triple Crown, but obviously the [May 21] GI Preakness S. is a thought. There are a lot of options for 3-year-olds. We'll try to make the right decision. Obviously he's got some talent and hopefully he'll move forward." **Cont. p2**

## DERBY KITTEN TOPS BIG DAY FOR RAMSEYS

**Derby Kitten** (Kitten's Joy)'s last-to-first rally in yesterday's GIII Lexington S. capped a big day for owner/breeders Ken and Sarah Ramsey and their stallion, Kitten's Joy (El Prado {Ire}) at Keeneland. They annexed the Giant's

Causeway S. one race prior with **Holiday for Kitten** (Kitten's Joy) (see *Keeneland report*) and ran second with **Dean's Kitten** (Kitten's Joy) in the GIII Ben Ali S. a race before that. **Derby Kitten** finished 1 1/2 lengths to the good of well-regarded **Prime Cut** (Bernstein) in the Lexington, while **Silver**

**Medallion** (Badge of Silver), the only runner in the field who could amass the graded

earnings necessary to make it into the starting gate for the May 7 GI Kentucky Derby with a good showing here, was a dull fourth. "He's been his own worst enemy," conditioner Mike Maker, who also sent out the other Ramsey runners, said of **Derby Kitten**. "I'm glad he's maturing." As for a next start and a potential try in the second or third legs of the Triple Crown, Maker said, "I'll talk to Mr. Ramsey. This was the day we were pointed toward." **Cont. p3**

Adios Charlie was second on debut going seven furlongs at Belmont Oct. 7, but was forced to the sidelines with a stress fracture. He resurfaced in a 6 1/2-furlong event at Gulfstream Mar. 30, and romped by 6 3/4 lengths. The bay broke best of all and could have had the lead in this one if he wanted it, but pilot Rajiv Maragh opted to defer pacesetting duties to favored **Cal Nation** (Distorted Humor) while sitting off that one's right flank through splits of :23.31 and :47.12. Justin Phillip ranged up three wide along the bend and opened up a clear advantage down the center of the track, but Adios Charlie was game to re-rally and run down the leader. Astrology, who enjoyed a pocket trip, also outkicked Justin Phillip late, but never threatened for the top slot.

Adios Charlie's co-owner Robert Sahn, a retired oil trader who divides his time between New York and Florida, had horses with Bruce Levine back in the 1990s, but had been out of the game for around 15 years. But his golfing buddy, veteran conditioner Hough, convinced him to jump back in. The duo's first purchase at a sale was last March at OBS, and Adios Charlie was the second horse they bought. "Stanley did a great job training him," said Sahn. "I thought he'd run well, but I didn't know if he'd handle the slop. Rajiv Maragh rode him down at Gulfstream, and he did a great job getting him settled in." Adios Charlie's stakes-winning dam Teak Totem is full to this year's GI Gulfstream Park Turf H. winner Teaks North and a half to MGSW and GISP Wooden Phone (Pick Up The Phone). Dick Turpin was runner-up in both the G1 English 2000 Guineas and G1 Poule d'Essai des Poulains last May and also in the G1 St James's Palace S. the following month before turning his fortunes around with an impressive success on his favored soft ground in Longchamp's G1 Prix Jean Prat in July. Supplemented for the G1 Juddmonte International at York in August, he failed to fire when only fifth, but was back to form with a fine third behind Goldikova (Ire) (Anabaa) from a poor draw in the G1 Prix de la Foret back at Longchamp on Arc day. Sent off a hot favorite to extend the record of five wins since 2004 for the Richard Hannon stable, the dark bay was anchored in third under cover early. Left in front with a quarter-mile remaining, he was held on to for a few strides by Richard Hughes, but once Cityscape threatened out wide, was given the command and duly swamped that rival from the furlong marker. "He's a very good horse, and we have left a bit behind us today too, as this is a stepping stone to the G1 Juddmonte Lockinge S. [at Newbury May 14]," Hannon said. "We've also got Canford Cliffs (Ire) (Tagula {Ire}) in that, and there isn't much between them--they are the two best milers I have had the chance to train. Derby Kitten needed six starts to break his maiden, doing so when dropped down to a \$75,000 seller over the Gulfstream turf Jan. 5. The bay finished second in a Tampa Bay handicap exactly a month later, and was last seen taking show honors in the grassy Alligator Alley S. back in Hallandale Beach Apr. 2. Unhurried from the gate behind fractions of :23.96, :47.17 and 1:12.11 posted by Casper's Touch, Derby Kitten was tipped out for the stretch drive by Julien Leparoux and quickly gobbled up ground. Prime Cut, who was second throughout, could offer no resistance to Derby Kitten's momentum, and the winner edged clear late. "We circled the field, but we saved ground on the second turn," recounted Leparoux. "We had a good trip. I had a lot of horse and I knew I was going to get there." Pilot Javier Castellano offered of Silver Medallion's disappointing run, "I had a perfect trip right behind two speed horses." He continued, "The goal today was to get him to relax and he did. Thiskyhasnolimit, winner of the GIII Iroquois S. at two, went 7-2-2-0 as a sophomore. He captured Churchill's Matt Winn S. and the Smarty Jones S. at Philly Park, and registered runner-up efforts in the GIII Iowa Derby and GII Indiana Derby.

However, Thiskyhasnolimit was unplaced in his final two outings of 2010, finishing seventh in the GI Breeders' Cup Dirt Mile at Churchill Nov. 6 and sixth in the GI Malibu S. at Santa Anita Dec. 26. After finishing fourth as the favorite in the GII San Fernando S. at that track Jan. 15, the dark bay was second by a half-length in the GIII Razorback H. at Oaklawn Mar. 12, and was favored in this short field.

Thiskyhasnolimit was caught a bit wide on the first turn as California shipper Gladding set the pace. The favorite looked to have things sewn up as he loomed boldly on turning for home, but Gladding dug in admirably, and the Lone Star faithful were treated to a thriller before Thiskyhasnolimit finally got on top late. The 4-year-old, produced by a half-sister to champion and leading young sire Bernardini (A.P. Indy), is co-owned by Dallas residents Cathy and Bob Zollars. Exhi had a very good under-the-radar year in 2010. The Wertheimer and Frere homebred took the Rushaway S. at Turfway in March and the GII Lexington S. here in April, but conditioner Todd Pletcher opted to bypass the Triple Crown series due to his charge's apparent affinity for synthetic surfaces. With that surface preference in mind, the bay was sent up to Woodbine to easily annex the Marine S. in May and Victoria Park S. in June, but a second in the GII West Virginia Derby back on the dirt in August snapped Exhi's four-race win streak. Exhi remained on the dirt to run fourth in the GII Pennsylvania Derby Sept. 25, and finished off his campaign with a second in the GII Fayette S. over track and trip Oct. 30. He hadn't been seen since. Heavily bet with a decided pace edge, Exhi bounded clear early and loped along through splits of :25.17, :49.25 and 1:12.82. Dean's Kitten, last year's GII Lane's End S. winner over this trip at Turfway, came to challenge the leader leaving the turn, but Exhi held him at bay to win clear and increase his Polytrack record to 6-5-1-0. "It was one of those rare occasions when things worked out the way you want it," offered Pletcher. "The race shaped up just the way it looked on paper. We were able to get the pace we wanted. It was just another big effort from him." He added, "We will probably try to stay on the synthetics. Maybe look at something at Woodbine." Multiple Grade I winner **The Usual Q. T.** was last seen finishing second by a half-length in the Sunshine Millions Turf at Santa Anita Jan. 29. "It's definitely close," said the Hall of Famer. "We're looking at the [G3] San Francisco Mile [at Golden Gate Apr. 30] as well." Ryehill Dreamer, a stakes winner and Group 2-placed in his native Ireland as a juvenile in 2008 and third in the 2009 GIII San Rafael S., has won twice since resurfacing stateside. He took an optional claimer by 3 1/4 lengths gate to wire over this course last October and annexed an 'N3X' allowance last out at Santa Anita Mar. 11 by 4 1/2 lengths while employing similar tactics.

## Shackleford Works; Hopes for Derby Spot...

GI Florida Derby runner-up **Shackleford** (Forestry) earned a bullet for his five-panel drill in 1:00.20 under the Twin Spires Saturday. Owned by Michael Lauffer and W.D. Cubbedge, the chestnut went in splits of :12, :23.80, :35.60 and :47.80 before galloping out six furlongs in 1:14. "I thought he worked as good as he could possibly work," said trainer Dale Romans, whose wife Tammy Fox was aboard for the move. "Now we've just got one more work next Saturday, and hope we get in." Shackleford has \$212,000 in graded earnings, which currently has him 22nd on the list. The [GIII] \$200,000 The Cliff's Edge Derby Trial S. kicks off Churchill's meet next Saturday, but Romans confirmed that race was not under consideration for his charge. "We're not going to do anything crazy," the conditioner said. "If it's going to compromise our chances of winning [the Derby], we don't want to be in there. If we don't get in, we'll wait for the Preakness." He added, "It's frustrating because I think a lot of people are going to run because they have the earnings and they can get in, whether they should or shouldn't. I think we're a legitimate contender if we get in." Prior to his Florida Derby effort, Shackleford finished a distant fifth in the GII Fasig-Tipton Fountain of Youth S. Feb. 26.

## On to the Oaks...

GI Kentucky Oaks hopefuls **R Heat Lightning** (Trippi) and **Kathmanblu** (Bluegrass Cat) turned in workouts at Churchill Downs yesterday ahead of their engagements in the \$1-million event May 6. R Heat Lightning, coming off a huge win in the GII Gulfstream Oaks Apr. 2, went a half-mile in :49.80 over the sloppy track. She galloped out an extra panel in 1:03.40. "I thought she handled it pretty well," said trainer Todd Pletcher. "She looked a little unsure when she first went off; she was kind of pricking her ears and looking at it [the track] a little bit. But, once she settled in, she went fine, and I thought her gallop-out was particularly good. You're always a little concerned when you go out in conditions like that, but I think Churchill is one of the few places where you can kind of feel okay about it. It seems to handle bad weather well." MGSW Kathmanblu, most recently a close third in the GI Ashland S. Apr. 9, went five-eighths in 1:02.80 in company with her elder stablemate Noble's Promise (Cuvee). "We just wanted her to stretch out," trainer Ken McPeck explained. "Noble's Promise needed a workmate and she needed to do something over it, and it was good. We let him gallop out because he hadn't run in four or five months."

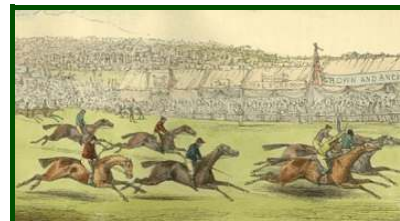
**Lilacs And Lace Keeps Moving Forward...**

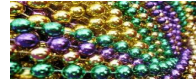
