JAYCITO NOT A GO

Zayat Stables LLC's **Jaycito** (Victory Gallop), hero of last year's GI Norfolk S., has officially been declared from the GI Kentucky Derby. An eventful seventh in the GI Breeders' Cup Juvenile in his final start for trainer Mike Mitchell, the bay made one start at three for Hall of Famer Bob Baffert, a distant second as the 2-1 favorite in the GII San Felipe S. Mar. 12.

He was forced to miss the GI Santa Anita Derby with a foot bruise, and hasn't posted a workout since a six-furlong move in 1:13 2/5 at Santa Anita Apr. 2. "You've got the super-duper official word," Baffert told *Daily Racing Form*. Zayat's **Nehro** (Mineshaft), second in the GII Louisiana Derby Mar. 26 and GI Arkansas Derby Apr. 16, remains on target for the May 7 Classic for trainer Steve Asmussen.

DERBY DUO BRAVE WET WEATHER

Kentucky Derby candidates **Stay Thirsty** (Bernardini) and **Mucho Macho Man** (Macho Uno) posted workouts over a sloppy Churchill Downs main track Sunday. Stay Thirsty, hero of the GIII Gotham S., fired a five-furlong bullet in company with stablemate Bridgetown (Speightstown) beneath Calvin Borel in 1:00 flat. "I thought he breezed really well," trainer Todd Pletcher said. "The time was solid and he got over the off going well. He finished up with a good last quarter and galloped out strongly. So overall I was really pleased." The Mike Repole colorbearer was last seen finishing a well-beaten seventh in the GI Florida Derby Apr. 3. A rider hasn't been selected yet for Stay Thirsty in the Derby. Reeves Thoroughbred Racing and Dream Team One Racing Stable's Mucho Macho Man splashed through seven furlongs beneath regular pilot Rajiv Maragh in an easy 1:29.20. "He worked good and I was very happy with it and Rajiv also seemed to be," trainer Kathy Ritvo said. Mucho Macho Man finished third as the 3-2 chalk in the GII Louisiana Derby Mar. 26.

Uncle Mo to Work Tuesday...

Repole Stable's champion **Uncle Mo** (Indian Charlie) is scheduled to work for the first time Tuesday since exiting the GI Wood Memorial with a gastrointestinal infection. He has been treated with antibiotics since his third-place finish at the Big A Apr. 9. "I think he's really responding well to treatment--his last 48 hours in particular," trainer Todd Pletcher said. "His appetite is the best it's been since the Wood, and I'm feeling really good about the direction we're heading. Like I said when we got here, we need to have a really good 19 days and, so far, we've had a really good five here. We need to have 13 more, but we're really, really pleased with the progress we're making at the moment." Pletcher was represented by his first GI Kentucky Derby winner last year with Super Saver (Maria's Mon). "Winning the Derby is awesome--it's great," Pletcher continued. "It doesn't change your life in a lot of ways. The feed man still wants to get paid, your wife still thinks you work too much and if you get beat in the Wood Memorial everybody wants to know why. I don't have to answer that specific question, but a lot of the other ones are still there."

Lady Gets the Green Light...

Norman Steel's **Barefoot Lady (Ire)** (Footstepsinthesand {GB}) will be supplemented for Sunday's G1 1000 Guineas at Newmarket, trainer Richard Fahey announced yesterday. Successful in the Apr. 13 G3 Nell Gwyn S. over seven furlongs at the track, she was finally committed to the mile Classic after deliberation. "She's in absolutely fantastic form at home, 100 percent," Fahey told *sportinglife.com*. "There are a few question marks about the ground with one or two of the fancied ones, so we've decided to give it a shot." He continued, "Before the Nell Gwyn, I warned she was a bit backward in her coat but she's there now so we're having a punt. Put it this way: no other filly will be in better form in themselves than she is going into the race."

PRESVIS TAKES CENTER STAGE

All eyes will be on **Presvis (GB)** (Sakhee) in today's G1 BMW Champions Mile S. as he cuts back in trip following a victory in the G1 Dubai Duty Free at Meydan Mar. 26. "People may be querying Presvis back to the mile but how can you question the boss [trainer Luca Cumani]," assistant trainer Charlie Henson said. "He did it here with Falbrav [in the G1 Hong Kong Cup] and he does have an uncanny knack when it comes to these major

Field, p4 races." Nine-year-old fan favorite **Good Ba Ba** (Lear Fan) has pleased connections with his preparations since a seventh-place finish in the Queen's Silver Jubilee Mar. 6. "I'm very happy with him," trainer Michael Chang said. "He's certainly as good as I'm able to get him. He's an old man now and you don't give a man of 50 the same training regime as a man of 20. But his last two runs have been definite improvements as he's been beaten only just over two lengths. I'd be thrilled if he could finish in the first four." **Musir (Aus)** (Redoute's Choice {Aus}) enters off a close seventh in the G1 Dubai World Cup. He made his last six starts over Meydan's Tapeta surface. "I think he might be better over the mile in fact, because he's got that good acceleration," trainer Mike de Kock said. "Going to the turf shouldn't be any problem either as he goes very well on Tapeta, and Tapeta is very similar to turf."

Turpin May Switch Target...

Trainer Richard Hannon yesterday suggested that **Dick Turpin (Ire)** (Arakan) could be asked to tackle 10 furlongs again in Royal Ascot's G1 Prince of Wales's S. June 15. Impressive when making a successful seasonal return in Saturday's G2 Sandown Mile, John Hanley's 4-year-old looks set to tackle stable companion **Canford Cliffs (Ire)** (Tagula {Ire}) in the G1 Juddmonte Lockinge S. at Newbury May 14 before stepping up to the trip over which he was off the board in last year's G1 Juddmonte International S. at York. "While a clash with Canford Cliffs in the Lockinge S. at Newbury looks inevitable, we might then have a look at the Prince of Wales's S. at Royal Ascot," Hannon said yesterday. "Both Dick Turpin and Canford Cliffs are top-class milers, but if we can stretch them out in distance, it not only increases our options, but also raises their profile as potential stallion prospects. Now we have got Canford Cliffs to settle that much better, we can also look at a mile and a quarter with him, which brings in both the Juddmonte International and the English and Irish Champion S. We are very lucky to have two top-class horses in our yard, but while they are in different ownership, I obviously would rather not pit them against each other too often, so if we can shuffle the back on occasions all the better."

Fourth in a seven-furlong newcomers' event at Compiègne on debut in July, Grand Vent bagged a one-mile Maisons-Laffitte conditions heat Sept. 13, and closed his freshman campaign with a third in the Oct. 7 G3 Prix Thomas Bryon at Saint-Cloud. He returned this term with another third at Saint-Cloud, in the Listed Prix Francois Mathet Apr. 3, and prevailed in game fashion here to provide conditioner Andre Fabre with an unprecedented ninth renewal of this Classic trial. Positioned in fifth for most of the contest, the eventual winner came under increasing urging to challenge inside the final quarter mile and was punched out in the latter stages to register a career best. "Grand Vent won this trial quite nicely, but I've yet to decide where he will run next," explained Fabre. "I won't make any decision until I've discussed plans with Sheikh Mohammed." The homebred sophomore retains entries in the May 15 G1 Poule d'Essai des Poulains, the June 5 G1 Prix du Jockey Club and the July 14 G1 Juddmonte Grand Prix de Paris. With last month's devastating earthquake and tsunami still affecting large portions of the country, Japan held its first Classic race of the year, the Satsuki Sho (Japanese 2000 Guineas), on Sunday. The 10-furlong event had been pushed back a week and moved from its traditional home at Nakayama Racecourse to Tokyo, which last hosted the event in 1988. The bettors pegged Sadamu Patek the horse to beat after consecutive wins in the G2 Yayoi Sho and G3 Tokyo Sports Hai Nisai S., but the Fuji Kiseki colt had to settle for place honors as fourth choice Orfevre, coming off a win in the G2 Spring S., stormed clear by three lengths. The full-brother to MG1SW Dream Journey, an earner of over \$8.5 million, hugged the rail in mid-pack early as Eishin Osman (Jpn) (Rock of Gibraltar {Ire}) lengthened away to lead by as much as seven lengths. As the field began to close in, jockey Kenichi Ikezoe tipped Orfevre wide for running room, and the colt burst away with an impressive turn of foot. Sadamu Patek emerged from traffic at the 200-meter pole, but had too much to do despite giving game chase. Winning trainer Yasutoshi Ikee was registering the Satsuki Sho triple for his family, as his father had won the race with No Reason (Jpn) (Brian's Time) and Deep Impact (Jpn) (Sunday Silence) in 2002 and 2005, respectively. Connections of last year's champion 2-year-old colt Grand Prix Boss (Jpn) (Sakura Bakushin O {Jpn}) opted to bypass the Satsuki Sho, instead aiming toward the G1 NHK Mile Cup at Tokyo May 8. Jockey Cornelio Velasquez won the fifth race at Aqueduct Saturday afternoon to earn his second career riding title on The New York Racing Association Inc. circuit, while Linda Rice and David Jacobson dead-heated atop the trainer standings at the conclusion of the Big A's 18-day spring meet. Velasquez was able to hold onto his narrow lead over Ramon Dominguez, who had a pair of winners Saturday, and finish the meet with 25 victories to Dominguez's 24. Rice, who became the first woman trainer to win a NYRA meet in 2010 at Saratoga, and Jacobson, who returned to training in 2007 after a 25-year absence, each saddled nine winners. Michael Dubb, New York's leading owner in 2010, was the meet's leading owner with five victories. With the conclusion of Aqueduct's spring meet, racing moves to Belmont Park beginning Friday, Apr. 29, for the 56-day spring/summer meet that runs through July 17.
