**SADLER'S WELLS DIES**

**Sadler's Wells** (Northern Dancer--Fairy Bridge, by Bold Reason), a perennial champion stallion and prodigious

sire of sires in Europe, died Tuesday afternoon of natural causes at Coolmore, where he had resided since entering stud in 1985. He was 30 years old. Coolmore manager Christy Grassick said, "He was undoubtedly the best sire Europe has ever seen, and through his sons Galileo, Montjeu, High Chaparral and Yeats, along with grandsons Hurricane Run and Rip Van Winkle, he has left a wonderful legacy at Coolmore, and his influence looks set to continue for many years to come. We all feel privileged to have been

involved with such a special horse." Sadler's Wells captured both of his starts at two, including the G2 Beresford S., but was overshadowed by the brilliance of stablemate and fellow Northern Dancer scion El Gran Senor, who ended 1983 as the champion 2-year-old in England and Ireland. At three, Sadler's

Wells won the G2 Derrinstown Stud Derby Trial S. before earning Classic glory in the G1 Irish 2000 Guineas. He followed with a runner-up finish in the G1 Prix du Jockey-Club, splitting future top sires Darshaan (GB) and Rainbow Quest. The blaze-faced bay established himself as one of the toughest

members of his generation thereafter, winning the G1 Coral-Eclipse S. and G1 Irish Champion S., as well as finishing second in the G1 King George VI and Queen Elizabeth Diamond S. Northern Dancer, represented by dual Classic winner El Gran Senor (2000 Guineas & Irish Derby) as well as Epsom Derby hero Secreta in addition to Sadler's Wells, set record earnings figures in Britain and Ireland in 1984, becoming the first stallion to pass the £1-million mark (the previous best was £559,999). **Cont. p5-7**

**NO FACTOR IN DERBY**

George Bolton and Fog City Stable's **The Factor** (War Front) will not take part in the May 7 GI Kentucky Derby. The colt, who reportedly displaced his palate when seventh as the favorite in the GI Arkansas Derby, recently underwent a myectomy to resolve those breathing issues, and was back to galloping at Churchill Downs. Despite the successful procedure, trainer Bob Baffert was taking it one day at a time. "We don't want to run a horse that isn't right," the Hall of Famer explained. "He's [a horse with a] basically miler pedigree that is good enough to go further.

The right thing for The Factor is to wait and go either to Preakness, Met Mile, Woody Stephens or something like that." The **"TDN Rising Star"** was slated to breeze Wednesday. "We did the right thing today," said Bolton. "Bob and I talked and we said get out today, give our spot to someone else who can work a horse and get ready for it, and we're doing the right thing to announce it now, and not wait." Bolton is set to be represented in the May 21 GI Preakness with **Astrology** (A.P. Indy), runner-up in last Saturday's GI Jerome S. at Aqueduct, whom he co-owns with Stonestreet Stables.

**Solid Move For Uncle Mo...**

**Uncle Mo** (Indian Charlie) was back on the work tab for the first time since the Apr. 9 GI Wood Memorial S., going five-eighths in 1:01 3/5 on a sloppy strip at Churchill Downs Tuesday morning. Trainer Todd Pletcher had originally planned to work the Eclipse winner during the Derby/Oaks training session after the 8:15 a.m. renovation break, but changed plans after taking a look at the Doppler and talking it over with owner Mike Repole. "I started talking to Mike at 4:30 [a.m.], and I just got off the phone with him," Pletcher quipped during a press conference on the Churchill backstretch at about 9:45 a.m. Tuesday. "I got an e-mail from Mike at 1:30 [a.m.]--he was watching the radar in New York, and wanted to make sure I was, too." With Pletcher keeping a watchful eye from the second floor of the darkened grandstand, Uncle Mo and jockey John Velazquez went to the track at 5:45 a.m., accompanied by stablemate and GIII Tom Fool S. and GIII Gravesend S. winner **Calibrachoa** (Southern Image). The two backed up just past the wire, then turned around and galloped to the five-eighths pole. They cruised through an opening three furlongs in :37 1/5 before Uncle Mo, on the outside, edged ahead. The 3-year-old galloped out six furlongs in 1:15 2/5. Pletcher was very encouraged with the move. "I thought he worked very well," he said. "I was particularly pleased with the way he finished--he didn't need to be asked at all." The conditioner added that he is hopeful Uncle Mo will be on top of his game for the May 7 GI Kentucky Derby. "I feel like, over the last 96 hours, the signs he has been giving us around the barn show that he is back to his old self," he said. "After the Wood, he was depressed, he wasn't eating well. But now he appears to be back on track. This morning's work was a key ingredient and, if his appetite continues to go the right way, I'm optimistic [about his prospects for running in the Derby.]" Uncle Mo will continue to undergo treatment for the gastrointestinal infection diagnosed after he suffered his first career defeat when third in the Wood. "We will adjust as we get closer to the race, but he still will be treated," Pletcher confirmed. He added, "I said after the Wood that Uncle Mo would need to have 19 really good days [to make it to the Derby], and, so far, we have. Each day has been a little better. I've been pleased every day we've had here."

But, Pletcher cautioned, "We're getting closer, but we still have a long way to go to the race." Uncle Mo, as well as fellow Repole/Pletcher Derby hopeful **Stay Thirsty** (Bernardini), will likely have their final preps Sunday. For Uncle Mo, Pletcher said, "The work is critical--but it's critical for every horse here."

**J P's Gusto Also Off the Derby Trail...**

GEM Inc.'s Grade I winner **J P's Gusto** (Successful Appeal) has officially been taken out of consideration for the Kentucky Derby. Winner of the GI Del Mar Futurity last summer, the bay was second in the GIII Southwest S. in February for trainer Joe Petalino, but was most recently eighth after setting the pace in the GI Arkansas Derby Apr. 16. He will now join trainer Mike Hushion in New York, where fellow GEM colorbearers Harissa (Afleet Alex) and Nicole H (Mr. Greeley) are based. "We're not running," owner Dr. John Waken told *Daily Racing Form*. "As far as I know, he leaves for New York today or tomorrow."

**Repole Sets the Record Straight ...**

Mike Repole stood his ground during a national teleconference yesterday as the media launched hard-hitting questions about treatments **Uncle Mo** (Indian Charlie) was rumored to have received last winter. While not offering any specifics, Repole stated in no uncertain terms that the defending 2-year-old champion, who has been undergoing treatment for a gastro-intestinal inflammation since a third in the GI Wood Memorial Apr. 9, appears to be in fine form and moving forward since the setback.

"We have a healthy, sound and happy horse," Repole confirmed yesterday.

Underscoring that claim, Uncle Mo worked five furlongs in a handy 1:01 3/5 Tuesday morning at Churchill Downs.

"It was smooth and easy, and [jockey] Johnny [Velazquez] was like a statue in the saddle," Repole said of the work. "It was a big step in getting to the starting gate on the first Saturday in May."

According to Repole, Uncle Mo is expected to put in his final major Kentucky Derby work Sunday or Monday.

"From where we were two weeks ago, we couldn't be happier than we are right now," affirmed Repole. "He's been eating up a storm and training very well."

With plenty of speculation circulating around Uncle Mo's health and racing future over the last two weeks, Repole dispelled any allegations of unsoundness.

"If the horse needs time off, he will get time off," Repole said. "I will never sacrifice a horse's health to satisfy my ego."

As for Uncle Mo's chances to make it to the first jewel in the Triple Crown, Repole said, "I think it's a 50-50 chance to get to the Derby right now. But so is everyone else. So much can happen between now and then."

Soon after the colt's first career defeat in the Wood, trainer Todd Pletcher confirmed that Uncle Mo would need to have '19 really good days to make it to the Derby.' Repole offered an update yesterday.

"We've had seven really good days, and now we need 12 more," he said.

"The last four days have been amazing, and we hope that continues and he will peak on Kentucky Derby day."

Also being primed for the Kentucky Derby by the Repole/Pletcher team is GIII Gotham S. winner **Stay Thirsty** (Bernardini), who needs to improve on a seventh-place finish in the Apr. 3 GI Florida Derby. Repole blamed that loss on the colt's failure to make the adjustment to the hot Florida heat after shipping south following his New York score, and that Stay Thirsty didn't react well to the blinkers added for the Florida Derby. Repole confirmed that the \$500,000 FTFEB purchase, who will be ridden in the Derby by jockey Ramon Dominguez, will not be sporting the equipment for his next start.

"If Uncle Mo wasn't around, he'd be getting more attention than he has," conceded Repole.

**Dialed In On Track...**

Owner Bob LaPenta couldn't be more pleased, or more nervous, in the final days ahead of next week's Kentucky Derby. This year, LaPenta's Derby hopes rest with **Dialed In** (Mineshaft), winner of the GI Florida Derby. Victorious in the Jan. 30 GIII Holy Bull S., the \$475,000 FTSAUG purchase was a narrow second behind 4-year-old Equestrio (Elusive Quality) in a nine-furlong allowance at Gulfstream Mar. 6.

"He's had more experience than some horses that have run seven or eight times," LaPenta said. "He's had a lot of dirt in his face and has been through a lot. There's very little that bothers him."

Aboard for all four prior lifetime starts, Dialed In is will be ridden by Julien Laparoux next Saturday.

"Julien is the perfect match for this horse," LaPenta said. "He's the right rider for Dialed In and his racing style. Julien is riding very well at the moment, and we would like to see him get his first Derby win."

According to LaPenta, the colt will remain at Palm Meadows with the bulk of Nick Zito's string to avoid Kentucky's often inconsistent spring weather.

"We have a great horse going into the race," said LaPenta. "I think his best races are ahead of him."

**Durkin Not Renewing Triple Crown Contract...**

Famed racecaller Tom Durkin revealed Tuesday that he is not renewing his contract to call the 2011 Triple Crown races for NBC Sports. "The experience I've had working with NBC Sports over the last 27 years has been the most satisfying and rewarding of my professional life," Durkin said in a statement. "And so, it is with deep regret that I have made the decision not to renew my contract as NBC's Triple Crown announcer. It was an extremely difficult decision to make, and one that came after almost a year of reflection. Because of the stress of the event, I felt it was not in the interest of my best health. My biggest disappointment, though, is not being able to work with my NBC colleagues, many of whom have become some of my dearest friends." Ken Schanzer, president of NBC Sports, said, "Tom Durkin is a legend. He is not only one of the great racecallers of all time, but I have been honored to call him my friend for more than a quarter-century. While I regret that he has made the decision to not call the Triple Crown for us, I understand it and wish him nothing but the best." Dick Ebersol, chairman of NBC Sports Group, added, "It's rare in this business that you find someone who has such extraordinary talent, who works relentlessly, and never ceases to be the nicest person in any room he is in. We will truly miss Tom on our Triple Crown broadcasts."

**Gilded Gem Euthanized...**

Graded stakes winner **Gilded Gem** (Smarty Jones--Golden Jewel Box, by Slew O'Gold) broke down after breezing in company with stablemate Plum Pretty (Medaglia d'Oro) at Churchill Downs yesterday morning and was euthanized. The 5-year-old mare was prepping for an engagement in the GI Humana Distaff S. on the Kentucky Derby undercard. Campaigned by Gaines-Gentry Thoroughbreds and Serengeti Stable and trained by Bob Baffert, the half-sister to MGISW Golden Ballet (Moscow Ballet) was coming off a career-best win in the GIII Las Flores H. Apr. 2. The bay mare had a record of 10-4-4-0, and earned \$223,800.

"He was a hell of a good racehorse," former jockey Pat Eddery told *PA Sport*. "I won the Eclipse and the Irish Champion on him, and also finished second in the King George. He was a very tough horse with a great pedigree. He probably was the best sire of them all."

Rated at 132 by Timeform, Sadler's Wells entered stud in 1985 at Coolmore as one of the most desirable stallion prospects in years, with El Gran Senor and Secreto heading across the Atlantic, and his 3/4-brother Nureyev (Northern Dancer--Special) departing France for Kentucky after one breeding season. Expectations were understandably high for Sadler's Wells with his initial \$125,000 stud fee, but the robust bay managed to exceed even the highest hopes. The tone for his stud career was set when a pair of colts from his first crop--Prince of Dance (GB) and Scenic (Ire)--dead-heated for victory in the 1988 G1 Dewhurst S. They were joined by Old Vic (GB), who doubled up in the G1 Prix du Jockey-Club and G1 Irish Derby; and In the Wings (GB), who captured the 1990 GI Breeders' Cup Turf. These early successes kept breeders clamoring for his services, and Sadler's Wells continued to deliver while covering big books of well-bred mares. The services of his Classic-winning sons Galileo (Ire) and Montjeu (Ire) are in high demand. Another son, El Prado (Ire), led the U.S. sire list in 2002, and is responsible for MGISW Medaglia d'Oro, who has gotten off to a tremendous start at stud.

"It's the end of an era," Robert Sangster's son Ben told *PA Sport*. "It is the most phenomenal record for any horse to be champion sire 14 times--a record that is likely to remain unequalled. His legacy will live on through his sons and daughters and their sons and daughters."

**Hills Pleased with Guineas Duo**

Trainer Barry Hills yesterday gave the lowdown on his two weekend hopes for the G1 2000 and G1 1000 Guineas at Newmarket. In the former race, the Lambourn conditioner has Khalid Abdullah's **Rerouted** (Stormy Atlantic), who took the G3 Somerville Tattersall S. at the track last September and was runner-up in the Listed European Free H. back there Apr. 13. While his presence will ensure a strong pace for Frankel (GB) (Galileo {Ire}), Hills is hoping he can shine in his own right. "Rerouted will be there to help ensure there is a true and sensible pace for Frankel in the 2000 Guineas," he said. "However, these kind of tactics suit his running style and he will be running on his merits. We could possibly put blinkers on him to make sure he concentrates, as he was looking around in the Free Handicap and pricking his ears. He has been working really well with good horses at home, such as Prime Defender, and although it looks unlikely we'll beat Frankel, hopefully we can play for a place." Hills saddles the recent 1000 Guineas gamble **Make a Dance** (Empire Maker) for the Juddmonte establishment 24 hours later. "She was very impressive when she won her maiden at the end of last season at Newmarket and she has matured nicely over the winter," Hills added. "It is never easy to tell where you stand when it's your first run of the year, but, if her home work is anything to go by, she should have a good chance."

**Frankel Ready for Big Test**

Khalid Abdullah's **Frankel (GB)** (Galileo {Ire}) was wrapping up his preparatory work for Saturday's G1 2000 Guineas on the Newmarket gallops yesterday. Watched by Henry Cecil, the unbeaten homebred came through his latest exercise with flying colors and his trainer told *PA Sport*, "He did his final quiet piece of work this morning. I'm delighted with him, but we've still got four days to go. It was just with a lead horse, a nice canter, and we let him go on for the last furlong. He was relaxed and settled well. He's in good form and I'll be surprised if he's not a better horse now than when he ran at Newbury."

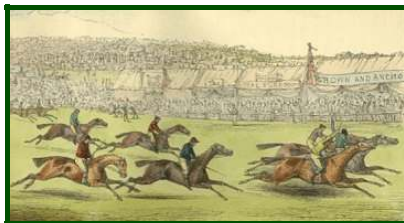

## World Domination Could Go to Lingfield

⊛ **"TDN Rising Star"** ⊛ **World Domination** (Empire Maker) could tackle the May 7 G3 Lingfield Derby Trial, trainer Henry Cecil suggested yesterday. Highly impressive when a 3 3/4-length winner on debut at Newbury 11 days ago, Khalid Abdullah's son of Reams of Verse (Nureyev) has already drawn comparisons with the stable's former Derby winner Commander In Chief (GB), who was also

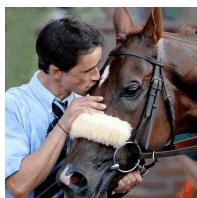

unraced at two. "He is potentially a nice horse," Cecil told *PA Sport*. "The problem is that, if he is a Derby horse, he never ran as a 2-year-old, and you really like to give them three races before the Derby. It's asking a lot to go from a maiden straight to a trial for the Derby, but, of course, some horses can do it. Commander In Chief did it, but he was a very big, robust horse--this one is a slightly more immature horse. So I can only give him two runs, and if I am thinking of the Derby, I have got to go for a trial. Obviously we would love to go for the [May 12] Dante, but then I question whether maybe he may learn a bit more at Lingfield. I'm just thinking about it."

**THE 'ALL' BUTTON**

The Beyer Speed Figures made their debut in the *Daily Racing Form* 19 years ago this month in April 1992. Certainly since then (and maybe ever), there has never been a GI Kentucky Derby where the favorite--and all the other runners--went in to the race with a last-out Beyer number below 100; not until this year. It's happening for sure this year, because all the winners of the Grade I, nine-furlong preps won their races with Beyer numbers in the 90's. It's no wonder Aidan O'Brien is sending over G2 UAE Derby second Master of Hounds (Kingmambo) to contest the race; his Racing Post Rating (RPR) of 115 (should be roughly equivalent to a Beyer 99-103) might be good enough to win it, if he can reproduce his Tapeta figure from Meydan on the dirt.

Speed figures have two principal applications: to assist in handicapping, and as a historical record of a horse's intrinsic ability. The latter application is of more interest to breeders, although a big cautionary disclaimer constantly flashes that, although there is a correlation between racing ability and production, it is by no means a direct one. However, historically it has been unusual for top American sires to have run Beyers much below 110. Distorted Humor, for example, ran consecutive Beyers of 116-117 in the spring of his 5-year-old year (1998), when he won his two seven-furlong Grade IIs, the Commonwealth Breeders' Cup at Keeneland, and the Churchill Downs H.; and Giant's Causeway ran a 116 Beyer in his only start in North America, when going down by a neck to Tiznow in the 2000 GI Breeders' Cup Classic. So, even though 3-year-olds normally improve by about six points in the second halves of the year (which is why a 'fig' of 107-108 is perfectly fine for a GI Kentucky Derby winner), you can see why it's a concern when none of the leading contenders going into the race have run as much as 100 in the key nine-furlong preps. **Cont. p11**

But history will take care of itself. The Beyers are more important now to help us try to handicap the race. They may be slow 3-year-olds, relatively speaking, so far, but five nine-furlong Grade I winners, two nine-furlong Grade II winners, and two 3-year-olds placed in last-start nine-furlong Grade I's have all advanced their claims in what at least looks a competitive race. These are:

- **Dialed In** (Mineshaft): winner of the GI Florida Derby; time 1:50:0; Beyer 93. Favorite, showed good late kick to win over what looked beforehand like the best trial field.
- **Uncle Mo** (Indian Charlie): second favorite in spite of having run Beyers of 89 and 92 this year. Third to Toby's Corner in GI Wood at 1-10.
- **Toby's Corner** (Bellamy Road, 1st crop): winner of the GI Wood Memorial; time 1:49:4/5; Beyer 94.
- **Archarcharch** (Arch): winner of the GI Arkansas Derby; time 1:49:1/5; Beyer 98.
- **Midnight Interlude** (War Chant): winner of the GI Santa Anita Derby; time 1:48:3/5; Beyer 97.
- **Brilliant Speed** (Dynaformer): winner of the GI Blue Grass S.; time 1:50:4/5; Beyer 93.
- **Pants on Fire** (Jump Start): winner of the GII Louisiana Derby; time 1:49:4/5; Beyer 94.
- **Soldat** (War Front, 1st crop): winner of the GII Fountain of Youth; time 1:50:1/5; Beyer 96. Subsequently fifth in the GI Florida Derby.
- **Nehro** (Mineshaft): fast-closing 2nd in the GII Louisiana Derby (Beyer 94), fast-closing 2nd in the GI Arkansas Derby (Beyer 98).

Also under 20-1 on the betting exchange, Betfair, is **Mucho Macho Man** (Macho Uno), winner of the GII Risen Star and third in the GII Louisiana Derby (Beyer 93).

It's always important to remember that, no matter what they've done at nine furlongs, they don't run the Kentucky Derby at nine furlongs, but at 10. That can be a very long eighth of a mile unless the horse really wants to go that extra furlong. Mineshaft looks to have two good shots in that regard: Dialed In (Robert LaPenta; Nick Zito, trainer) had to come and get horses to win the GI Florida Derby; and Nehro (Zayat Stables; Steve Asmussen, trainer) is just about third favorite now, behind Dialed In and Uncle Mo, off consecutive eye-catching seconds in the Louisiana and Arkansas versions

Personally, I thought Midnight Interlude's win in the GI Santa Anita Derby was about as impressive as any of them; he looked like he would actually improve for another furlong, but I'm at a loss why he's 25-1. That worries me; he should be shorter. Then you have to look at the GI Wood Memorial form: Toby's Corner might well go another furlong, and Uncle Mo was 10 lengths the best of these as a 2-year-old. **Cont. p12**

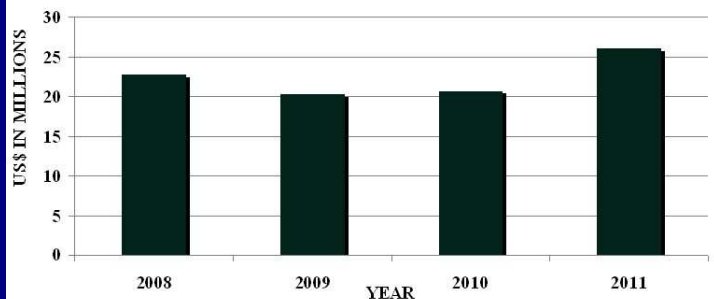

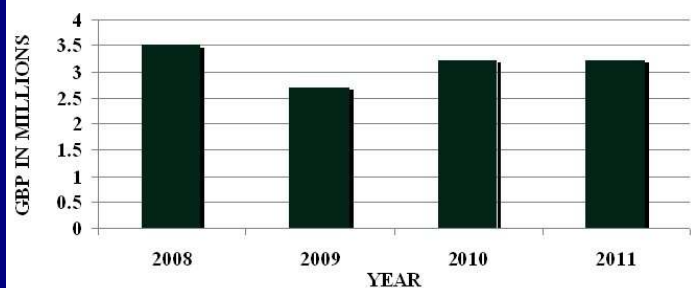

If they get him cured and he runs back to his 2-year-old form, there's only one winner; but, for the moment, you have to say you couldn't be confident about him getting 10 furlongs. If you like Nehro, then you have to pay some attention to the two that beat him, Pants On Fire in Louisiana and Archarcharch in Arkansas. Sure, Nehro looks to be a rapidly improving 3-year-old at the right time, but, still, these other two horses did beat him at nine furlongs.

Soldat flopped in his most recent assignment at nine furlongs, but connections were trying to see if he'd rate. Soldat is a natural front-runner and is an intended starter. Throw in the Euro raider, Master of Hounds--lots of question marks. Too many question marks.

That's why I'm going to hit the 'All' button in at least one of my bets for the May 7 GI Kentucky Derby. The first time I really got it right by hitting the 'all' button was in the 1993 GI Breeders' Cup Classic, won by 100-1 shot Arcangues. I was pretty sure Bertrando, the hot favorite, wouldn't stay--he never had before, though he was top-class at nine furlongs--but I didn't really know what would happen, other than a conviction Bertrando wouldn't win. I guess now you'd lay Bertrando to the moon, but at the time, I played a Pick 3 and just hit the "all" button. Luckily, I hit the first two legs, and cashed a \$10,000 ticket on a \$192 Pick 3 bet. I should have done it again, when Mine That Bird won the 2009 GI Kentucky Derby. I was live with 14 of 18 horses in a Pick 4--not including, of course, Mine That Bird. So this time, I will be hitting the all button once again, for sure. Of course, you still have to be live going into the Derby, so I'll need to work on that aspect of it, too.

### *Newmarket Guineas...*

Usually the first European Classic, the one-mile G1 English 2000 Guineas is run earlier the same day as the GI Kentucky Derby, but this year the two Guineas races (the 1000 for fillies, is run on Sunday) come a week earlier. Prince Khalid Abdullah's unbeaten **Frankel**, by Galileo out of a Danehill mare and trained by the incomparable Henry Cecil, is liable to go off at something like 1-2 in the 2000. The only other two colts priced under 10-1 are both Irish trained: the unbeaten U.S.-bred **Pathfork** (Distorted Humor), trained by Jessie Harrington and winner of Ireland's best 2-year-old race last year, the G1 National S.; and the top Aidan O'Brien hope, **Roderic O'Connor**, also by Galileo out of a Danehill mare. He was second to Frankel in the G1 Dewhurst S., then came back to win the G1 Criterium International at Saint-Cloud over a mile. The fillies' race, on the other hand, looks wide open.

### *Sadler's Wells...*

We've just heard the sad news that the incomparable Sadler's Wells has died, age 30. It would be impossible to overestimate his influence on European breeding. Following at least two decades when American sires dominated the international marketplace almost to exclusion, the retirement of Sadler's Wells to Coolmore in 1985 marked the beginning of a re-balancing of the community of top-class international stallions towards Europe, to the point where now Europe arguably has the upper hand. He was always a top-class sire, but it wasn't until Montjeu's first foals raced in 2004, followed by Galileo's in 2005, that Sadler's Wells really took his place alongside Danzig as one of Northern Dancer's two greatest sire sons. In APEX terms, he is the sire of 241 'unique' A Runners, and the damsire of 187, through the end of 2010, all-time highs in both categories. He was the greatest, that's all you can say.
