## 'LUNA' LOOKS FOR THIRD U.S. WIN IN BEWITCH

R & B International's La Luna de Miel (Ger) (Monsun {Ger}) looks to add to her two-for-two record in the U.S. in today's GIII Grey Goose Bewitch S. at Keeneland. The dark bay broke her maiden first out for

Andreas Wohler at Hannover in her native Germany last April and finished eighth in a listed event in June. La Luna de Miel resurfaced for Graham Motion at Gulfstream Feb. 18, and called on her stout bloodlines to annex an allowance at 1 7/16

miles. She was stepped up into the GIII Orchid S. back in Hallandale Beach at today's 1 1/2-mile distance Mar. 20, and defeated **Endless Expanse (Ire)** (Red Ransom) by a length for the top spot. Headliner **Keertana (Johar)** has never gone this far despite being a multiple Grade III winner on the sod and having finished third, beaten just a half-length in last year's GI Breeders' Cup Filly and Mare Turf. She was last seen closing to be third behind a slow pace in the GIII Hillsborough S. at Tampa Bay Mar. 12. Keertana's trainer, Tom Proctor, expects his charge to appreciate the added ground, but cited turf that is likely to be soft as a minor concern.

"The mare can run on soft turf," Proctor told *Daily Racing Form*. "Although, she does prefer it firm. She still ought to run okay. What she really likes is the three turns, and coming off the shorter race at Tampa, I think she might be pretty tough in there." **Honimiere (Fasliyev)** has been off since finishing a well-beaten 10th at Yarmouth for Alan Swinbank last September, but the 5-year-old shows upbeat works for new conditioner, Roger Attfield. The bay has been running against formidable competition in Great Britain, finishing close to next-out Group 2 winners Strawberrydaiquiri (GB) (Dansili {GB}) and Eastern Aria (UAE) (Halling) last season. **Field p3**

## BOREL TO RIDE TWICE THE APPEAL

Calvin Borel, who has ridden three of the last four GI Kentucky Derby winners, will pilot Edward Brown Jr. and Victor Flores' GIII Sunland Derby winner **Twice the Appeal** (Successful Appeal) in the May 7 Classic. "I called [Borel's agent Jerry Hissam Tuesday] and asked if they would take our horse into consideration," trainer Jeff Bonde's racing and bloodstock manager Mersad Metanovic explained. "My owners wanted an experienced rider and Calvin was the best available who already had a lot of success in the Derby. He called us back [Wednesday] to tell us Calvin would take the mount." Metanovic continued, "We didn't necessarily want to make the change because we felt a sense of loyalty [to previous rider Christian Santiago Reyes], but we thought this is a once in a lifetime opportunity and we want to seize it now and not have any excuses later." Borel, a first-time finalist for induction into the Hall of Fame this year, won the 2007 Derby with Street Sense (Street Cry {Ire}), the 2009 Derby with Mine That Bird (Birdstone) and last year's "Run for the Roses" with Super Saver (Maria's Mon). "I think Borel fits this horse perfectly," Metanovic beamed. "We're really excited." **Derby coverage cont. p4**

Askar Tau bagged the 2009 G2 Lonsdale and G2 Doncaster Cups, but was on the shelf after running eighth in this contest last year. Seventh when defending the Sept. 10 G2 Doncaster Cup, he ran fifth in the Oct. 3 G1 Prix du Cadran at Longchamp and was a last-out third in the Listed Further Flight S. at Nottingham Apr. 6. Anchored in rear until easing into third with a half mile remaining, he made continued headway in the straight to challenge approaching the final furlong and was driven out late to regain the winning thread. "For whatever reason, it just didn't go right for Askar Tau last season and it was disappointing, but we're absolutely delighted with this," said trainer Marcus Tregoning. "This year couldn't have gone better. He has had a really good winter and I started him off in January so I could build him up gradually. We'll come back here for the [June 18 G1] Gold Cup, but the key to him is top of the ground. He needs fast ground and I'd be cautious about him on soft ground as he doesn't like it." 

# Triple Threats

## Silver Medallion Out of Derby Consideration...

Mike Ryan and Black Rock Stables LLC's **Silver Medallion** (Badge of Silver) will not contest the GI Kentucky Derby even if a defection from the current field were to allow him to get in, according to the *Daily Racing Form*. The GIII El Camino Real Derby winner, who was 21st on the graded earnings list, will instead get a freshening. Silver Medallion was fourth in Saturday's GIII Coolmore Lexington S. at Keeneland, just two weeks after filling the same slot in the GI Santa Anita Derby. **Anthony's Cross** (Indian Charlie), winner of the GII Robert B. Lewis S. at Santa Anita in February, now inherits the 21st spot on the graded earnings list. Owned by A D K Racing, the Eoin Harty trainee is stabled at Hollywood Park, and will drill there Sunday in preparation for a potential start in the May 7 Derby.

## Larry Collmus to Call the Triple Crown...

Track announcer Larry Collmus has been tabbed to replace Tom Durkin as the voice of the Triple Crown. The 44-year-old Baltimore native got his start at Bowie in 1985, and went on to call the races at Birmingham Turf Club in Alabama, Golden Gate Fields and Suffolk Downs. He was named the announcer at Monmouth Park in 1994, served a two-year stint at the Aqueduct winter meet, and joined the team at Gulfstream in 2007. He will call the GI Kentucky Derby, GI Preakness S. and GI Belmont S. for NBC Sports. "I've been calling the races since I was 18 years old, and it's all I've ever dreamed about," Collmus told *Daily Racing Form*. "It's incredibly exciting." But, he added, "Following Tom is going to be a daunting task. He's a legend. I have big shoes to fill."

Celebrity Chef Bobby Flay has purchased GIII Comely S. runner-up **Her Smile** (Include) from owner/breeder William Backer for an undisclosed sum and will turn her over to conditioner Todd Pletcher for a tilt at the May 6 GI Kentucky Oaks. With \$30,000 in graded earnings from the Comely, the Virginia-bred currently sits in the 14th spot among likely Oaks entrants. The Oaks field is limited to 14 runners. Previously trained by Leigh Delacour, Her Smile took the Donna Freyer S. at Philadelphia Park last November. She was third, beaten a length in the productive Suncoast S. at Tampa Bay Mar. 12 prior to the Apr. 9 Comely and will join the Pletcher stable at Churchill Downs on Thursday. Pletcher also conditions likely Oaks favorite **R Heat Lightning** (Trippi), who will have her final Oaks work Saturday, for the E Paul Robsham Stables.

Sheikh Hamdan bin Rashid Al Maktoum's **Maqaasid (GB)** (Green Desert) will run in Sunday's G1 Qipco 1000 Guineas at Newmarket despite her connections' stamina concerns. Last year's G2 Queen Mary S. winner, who was third on her return in the G3 Nell Gwyn S. at the track last time Apr. 13, will be tackling an extra furlong. "I would think it's hard for anything that's had the speed to win a Queen Mary to stay a Classic mile, but having said that, we saw the other day at Newmarket what a good job the John Gosden stable has done at settling her down," the owner/breeder's Racing Manager Angus Gold said yesterday. "John hadn't wound her up by any means and she ran a good third with a penalty, so if she behaves like that she'll give herself every chance of getting the mile."

**Murtagh Booked for Fury...**

Johnny Murtagh will partner Cheveley Park Stud's unbeaten Tattersalls Millions 2YO Trophy winner **Fury (GB)** (Invincible Spirit {Ire}) in Saturday's G1 Qipco 2000 Guineas at Newmarket. Trainer William Haggas and the twice Guineas-winning jockey had teamed up for last year's Lincoln H. winner Penitent (GB) (Kyllachy {GB}) and the trainer told the *Racing Post*, "Johnny Murtagh is now confirmed to ride Fury. He has ridden a good few winners for me from not many rides, including Penitent."

## *Xtension Returning to the Royal Meeting...*

**Xtension (Ire)** (Xaar {GB}), who splashed onto the international racing radar with his victory in Monday's G1 BMW Champions Mile at Sha Tin, will make his next appearance in the G1 Queen Anne S. during the Royal Ascot meeting, South China *Morning Post* reports.

"He's entered for the Queen Anne at Ascot, and I know that taking on horses like Goldikova (Ire) (Anabaa) and Canford Cliffs (Ire) (Tagula {Ire}) there is another step up from this today, but [owner] Steven [Lo Kit-sing] said he would love to go," trainer John Moore told the newspaper. The trip will mark a homecoming of sorts for Xtension, who finished runner-up to Canford Cliffs in the 2009 G2 Coventry S. Moore continued, "It's the aura of the event that we want to participate in, and I think Xtension is going to prove a solid horse on the Group 1

world stage. He may be a better horse next season when he has had a little more time here but, if he can hold this level for Ascot, he is a place chance." Joining Xtension on the trip to England will be **Sunny King (Ire)** (Desert Sun {GB}), who was third in the G1 Dubai Golden Shaheen two back, but only ninth in the Champions Mile. He'll cut back in distance for the G1 Golden Jubilee S.

## GULFSTREAM FINDS THE POT OF GOLD

Could the tide be turning? Oaklawn Park showed slight gains in daily average attendance and handle, boasted its highest-ever purse structure and attracted an overflow crowd of 62,364 for Arkansas Derby day. Tampa Bay Downs, which has enjoyed steadily increasing handle figures, is again up this year, with fields averaging 9.14 horses. And Gulfstream Park announced Sunday that its 79-day meet generated record total handle of \$595,369,127, up 8.9% from 2010; and record on-track handle of \$47,497,632, up 14.1% from a year ago.

The record-breaking season was given a boost by a change of schedule--the GI Florida Derby was moved to Sunday, with Saturday devoted to the distaffers, and the weekend handle figures were up an eye-catching 29% to a new high of \$33.6 million.

The meet also ended on a major high, with the Rainbow 6 generating more than \$3.6 million in handle the day before Sunday's finale. The Rainbow 6 is a Pick 6 with a twist...the jackpot is paid out only if there is just one unique winning ticket, with 40% of the handle carried over if the jackpot is not hit, and the remaining 60% going to those who had the most winners. First hit Jan. 27, when the payoff was \$221,677.41, the Rainbow 6 pool had been growing daily since Feb. 16.

It had to be distributed before the end of the meet, and Gulfstream officials announced the mandatory payout would be Saturday. By the time the horses were loaded into the gate for the first leg, the pot had grown to \$5.1 million--in 10-cent increments.

"We think microbets might be the thing of the future," said Tim Ritvo,

who was named Gulfstream's vice president of racing last October. "It gets more people involved, because they have to invest so much less. They can really spread their money around."

Ritvo was behind the idea to offer the Rainbow 6. He worked with the track's marketing crew to tweak Gulfstream's wagering menu for the 2011 meet.

"We try to be very customer-oriented, to give customers what they want," Ritvo said. "We saw that the Pick 5 was successful at Monmouth Park, so we introduced it at the low takeout rate of 15%.

"Last year, our \$2 Pick 6 only generated \$1.7 million in bets, so we decided to drop that, add the Pick 5 and then come up with a gimmick Pick 6. We thought about offering one where the most you could bet was \$100 in combinations, but then we looked at what Beulah had done with its Rainbow 6 bet, and modified it."

There were a couple of fundamental differences in Beulah's bet and Gulfstream's.

"At Beulah, the minimum bet was 25 cents, ours was a dime," Ritvo explained. "And if you had a horse scratched at Beulah, they just refunded your ticket. We didn't like that, so we gave you the post-time favorite."

There was a wrinkle to that plan--if you already had the post-time favorite on your ticket, the last-minute change could mean you'd end up with more than one winning ticket on the Rainbow 6, and then you wouldn't get the jackpot. But the team at Gulfstream found a way to address that.

"Amtote was able to come up with software so that, if we put you on the post-time favorite, we could run a scan that took about 15 minutes, to determine if this would give you multiples [of the winning combination] on the same ticket," Ritvo said. "If that happened, we'd pay you the jackpot. It was much more customer friendly."

Interest in the bet grew steadily through the meet, and caught fire on the day of the mandatory payout. Not only were more people playing it, but the phones started ringing with tracks that wanted to offer their bettors the chance at Gulfstream's jackpot.

"At first, there were tracks that weren't sure they wanted to get into it," Ritvo remarked. "But, on the last day, almost every track in the country wanted in, and we saw no reason not to let them in."

The buzz in-house was also infectious.

"We had \$196,000 bet right here at Gulfstream, and you could feel the intensity building race by race," Ritvo added. "It was thrilling. There were a lot of people alive, and it generated so much excitement."

The Rainbow 6 wouldn't have worked as well without another key ingredient to Gulfstream's record-breaking meeting--increased field size. The track averaged a record 9.53 horses per race this year.

Ritvo attributed the growth to several factors.

"We added more grass races," he said. "The weather definitely cooperated, but we also introduced new rail movements--we moved it a lot more, and it was strategically placed, so that it gave us a more durable turf course."

"Also, there has been an infusion of slots money into our purses, and there is our 3-year-old program that leads into the \$1-million Florida Derby, and into the Triple Crown. I think that brings a lot of horses to our meet that might have gone elsewhere."

Despite its rousing success, Gulfstream will not be resting on its laurels.

"We will be looking at everything, watching what happens around the country," Ritvo offered. "And we will definitely have the Rainbow 6 again. People get more for their money with that bet. It was a huge success with limited distribution, and we think we can build on that success."

The biggest change for Gulfstream next season will be the new set of dates. The meet starts early, opening Dec. 3, and runs through Apr. 8.

"We are excited about that," Ritvo said. "This is the first time we've started so early. We will have a whole realignment of the stakes schedule, and we think the timing of the meet fits better for the horsemen who ship in to run here. We'll end a week after the Florida Derby, and then people can ship to Keeneland. We are looking forward to meet."

The Wire Act applies to illegal bookmaking. Such legislation would go through the House Judiciary Committee. Given horseracing's heavy reliance on simulcast and advanced deposit wagering, this issue remains the NTRA's top legislative priority. A similar bill was introduced in the last Congress but did not pass.

Mystical Star required every last yard of the ninth furlong of yesterday's featured eighth race at Keeneland to score for Everett Dobson's Cheyenne Stables. As of 6 p.m. Eastern time yesterday, Dobson was in search of a bit more luck, namely enough weather clearance to get from Lexington back to Oklahoma City in order to complete the 'ultimate' daily double.

Dobson, a former telecommunications executive who sold his company to AT&T for \$2.8 billion in 2007, was

on hand to see his \$45,000 Keeneland September acquisition just find the wire, then high-tailed it across the street to Blue Grass Airport. It's normally a 2-hour flight from Central Kentucky to Oklahoma, but rains which have pelted the area threatened to delay his flight. And, possibly, Dobson's arrival to the Oklahoma City Arena where the OKC Thunder, a National Basketball Association franchise in which Dobson has an ownership stake, was on the verge of its first-ever playoff

series victory, holding a 3-1 advantage over the Denver Nuggets.

But first things first--a day at the races. Dobson, and his partners Jim Wells and Randy Bradshaw, selected Mystical Star out of the 2009 September sale, and she was bought on the cheap.

"She is one of the more less-expensive fillies I purchased that year, but she's just a good, correct, scopy filly that may have fallen through the cracks a bit," he explained. "We're pleased to have her. She's just been great since the very first day we've had her and we've had no issues with her."

Dobson was taking little for granted, especially at the head of the lane yesterday, when things looked about as grim as the skies overhead.

"We were very pleased with the way she ran," Dobson commented. "I thought she was beat, but she's got a big old long stride. Somebody told me they came home in :12 flat. She really ran a nice race."

Dobson was not dismayed and in fact welcomed the fact that the race was rained onto the synthetic track.

"We thought she'd run well on the Polytrack, and that was something we'd been thinking about trying here during the meet, so we were not disappointed when it came off the turf," he offered.

"I think she's probably still a grass horse, but she ran very well on the Poly. We'll look to the East Coast for her and go from there, but the [1 1/16-mile GII] Sands Point [Belmont Park, May 30] is definitely an option, although we think she's slightly more effective at a mile and an eighth.]"

Well-versed though he is in the Thoroughbred business, Dobson was squarely focused on another 'Thunder's'torm, the one he hoped would result in a series-clinching victory later Wednesday night. A win would mean a berth in the Western Conference semi-finals against the winner of the series between the Memphis Grizzlies and San Antonio Spurs. The Grizzlies hold a surprising 3-1 advantage over the number one seed in that series.

"It'd be an historic event for Oklahoma City and the Thunder," Dobson admitted. "We feel pretty good, up 3-1. I am a fan first and I go root with the other 18,000 that are going to be there and enjoy every minute of it."

He concedes that not in his wildest dreams would the Thunder be on the cusp of this milestone just three years after its move from Seattle.

"I think we had a game plan that obviously has proved successful, albeit a lot sooner than any one of us anticipated," he stated. "We got lucky in the first draft in being able to draft Kevin Durant (27.7 ppg regular season, 30.3 ppg playoffs), and he has turned into one of the superstars in the league. You don't anticipate greatness, but you certainly hope for it."

Three of Britain's top contests will change titles this year as a result of the QIPCO British Champions Series initiative. The trio of races to be staged on Champions Day at Ascot Oct. 15 are the Diadem S., which will be known as the British Champions Sprint S., the Jockey Club Cup, now the British Champions Long Distance Cup and the Pride S., which will carry the moniker of British Champions Fillies & Mares S. Chris McFadden, Chairman of British Champions Series Limited, said, "If we are to position QIPCO British Champions Day with maximum impact as the new climax to the British flat racing season and a major event in international flat racing, we felt it was important for the race titles to reflect this. These three races are in any case very different to the ones whose place they have taken, so we felt that re-naming them was appropriate from this point of view as well. Quite apart from the fact that they are either being run at a different time of year or at a different racecourse, none now has a penalty structure in its conditions, and all have much higher prize money, combining to make them Group 1 contests in all but name."
