## ANIMAL INSTINCT

"It was meant to be." Jockey John Velazquez, the regular rider of Uncle Mo (Indian Charlie), uttered those words shortly after crossing the wire first in the GI Kentucky Derby on the ultimate pick-up mount, Team Valor's **Animal Kingdom** (Leroidesanimaux {Brz}). Uncle Mo was scratched Friday morning, and Robby Albarado, who had been named aboard Animal Kingdom, sustained minor injuries in a spill Wednesday. "I feel bad for Robby, but this one's for both

## Glory in Motion...

Trainer Graham Motion, whose main GI Kentucky Derby hope Toby's Corner (Bellamy Road) was withdrawn Tuesday with an injury, provided a more-able-deputy in the form of the Gill Vinery Spiral S. winner. "It's just extraordinary," said Motion, who is based at Fair Hill in Maryland. "He's a special horse.

Johnny gave him a great ride." In winning the Derby in just his fifth career start, Animal Kingdom is the most lightly raced winner of the Classic since Exterminator in 1918. "I've only

won a couple of the big ones and, when it happens, it's surreal," said Team Valor founder and CEO Barry Irwin. "I couldn't see a whole lot from where I was sitting. I picked him up at the eighth pole and he was on the move--my wife was going crazy." Churchill Downs announced that a record crowd of 164,858 was on hand for the 137th renewal of the "Run for the Roses." The previous mark was 163,628, achieved during the centennial running in 1974. **Regal Trip...**

When they sprung the latch on the 137th Kentucky Derby, Animal Kingdom came away cleanly from his auxiliary gate post, and settled kindly for Velazquez well behind the honest pace set by **Shackleford** (Forestry). That blaze-faced chestnut, who had been training up a storm under the Twin Spires, lived up to that reputation by getting his first quarter in :23.24 and :48.63, and was tracked by **Comma to the Top** (Bwana Charlie) and **Decisive Moment** (With Distinction). Meanwhile, favored **Dialed In** (Mineshaft) was a long way last. For a 19-horse field, there appeared to be a minimum of rough trips, and Animal Kingdom raced in the three path down the backstretch.

"We were between horses and he was going well," said his rider.

As Velazquez began to gather his mount approaching the three-eighths pole, Animal Kingdom's engine roared to life, and the chestnut avoided a potential problem by accelerating through a seam with **Santiva** (Giant's Causeway) to his outside.

"When we got clear, he gave me the feeling that he had it in him [to win]," said Velazquez.


Guided a bit further out, the lightly raced chestnut accelerated smartly, reeling in **Nehro** (Mineshaft) and surging clear in the final strides. Shackleford stayed on bravely, but succumbed late to **Mucho Macho Man** (Macho Uno) to lose third.

It was lucky Derby ride 13 for Velazquez, who had been the regular rider for prime Classic contenders Quality Road (Elusive Quality) and Eskendereya in 2009 and 2010 when both colts missed out on running in the Derby.

"I guess it was meant to be; things happen for a reason," said the Eclipse Award-winning reinsman. "When it's meant to be for you, it's meant to be for you, no matter what. He just handled everything so good. He was going good the whole way and, when I asked him to run, he was there for me. I can't describe it--it was amazing."

**Kentucky Derby cont.**

It was the second big Churchill score in six months for Team Valor. The syndicate secured the GII Breeders' Cup Juvenile Turf in November with Pluck (More Than Ready), who was trained by Todd Pletcher at the time. Soon afterwards, Irwin revealed that all of Team Valor's horses would be transferred to Graham Motion, and that Pluck would target a European Classic.

Asked why he decided to give the entire Team Valor International string to Motion, Irwin told NBC, "I was tired of all the trainers lying to me, and I wanted an honest guy."

Pluck's trans-Atlantic hopes were dashed by a pair of sub-par performances this spring, but Animal Kingdom's success probably makes up for it.

"He's been an extraordinary horse to train," said Motion. "When Barry sent Pluck to me, Animal Kingdom was breezing, and I told him, 'I like Pluck, but this horse is special.'"

**He's an Animal...**

Animal Kingdom began his career for trainer Wayne Catalano, finishing second to Willcox Inn (Harlan's Holiday) in an Arlington maiden washed onto the Polytrack Sept. 18 ([video](#)). The word was out on the colt thereafter, and he donned cap and gown as the 3-5 chalk in an all-weather route at Keeneland Oct. 23 ([video](#)). When Team Valor named Graham Motion as their lone trainer at the end of the season, Animal Kingdom joined the Englishman's string in Florida. The rangy colt's rally fell a head short to Powhatan County (Fusaichi Pegasus) in a one-mile optional claimer on the Gulfstream grass Mar. 3 ([video](#)), but his connections were undeterred, and sent him to Turfway for the GIII Vinery Racing Spiral S. Mar. 26. Well back early, Animal Kingdom unleashed a strong run to claim that \$500,000 event ([video](#)). He looked like a monster during his Apr. 30 drill on the dirt at Churchill, and that impression was confirmed yesterday. In winning the Derby off a six-week layoff, Animal Kingdom was coming off the longest break since Needles accomplished the feat in 1956.

**Kingdom Come...**

Animal Kingdom's dam Dalicia, a Group 3 winner in her native Germany, was secured by Team Valor as a horse in training for €400,000 at Baden-Baden in 2005. The bay mare failed to win in the U.S. while under the care of trainer Neil Drysdale, and was bred to turf champion Leroidesanimaux. Animal Kingdom was foaled in March 2008, and was offered as a yearling at Keeneland to be part of a new Team Valor partnership. He sold for \$100,000, and the mare's 2009 colt, a son of Mr. Greeley, also sold to Team Valor for \$80,000 at the same venue in September. Dalicia, meanwhile, sold at Tattersalls December in 2009 to Shadai Farm for 230,000gns (US\$401,783) while in foal to Mr. Greeley. It was quite a "D" day for Team Valor. Daveron (Ger) (Black Sam Bellamy {Ire}), produced by a full-sister to Derby winner, captured the GIII Beaugay H. at Belmont earlier in the afternoon (*see p11*).

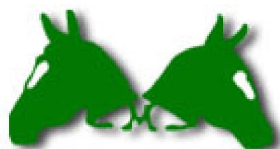
**Archarcharch Injured...**

Robert and Loval Yagos' GI Arkansas Derby winner Archarcharch (Arch) stumbled coming out of the gate. The saddle slipped soon after, and jockey Jon Court had trouble controlling his mount. Archarcharch pulled up short after crossing the wire and was vanned back to this stall; X-rays taken later revealed a lateral condylar fracture in his right foreleg. He will undergo surgery.

# SAY WHAT?

**STEVE ASMUSSEN (Nehro, second)** – "The little horse just ran unbelievable. I'm very proud of him. Congratulations to the winner, but, for Mr. Zayat and his family, I sure would've loved to have won it, but I was very excited he ran second. There was way less pace than I thought there would be and thank goodness Corey [Nakatani] was smart enough to take advantage of that."

**KATHY RITVO (Mucho Macho Man, third)** – "He's only going to get better, he's a June 15 foal. He'll come back hopefully in a couple weeks if he comes back good, and we're ready to go. He was fabulous today. It went just the way we thought it would be. He gave it his all. He finished up well. Rajiv [Maragh] said he finished up well. It was really exciting. When I saw him turn for home and he was running, I was jumping around and cheering him on."

**DALE ROMANS (Shackleford, fourth)** – "I've been talking all week that when a race is packed with speed, people often end up taking back and not wanting to go. We thought it might play out like it did. He fought. He tried to fight down the lane. I'm very proud of him. I'm not saying we can't run a mile and a quarter some time, because we ran a mile and a quarter today faster than all but three horses. I'd love to go to the Preakness. We'll talk to the owners."

**AIDAN O'BRIEN (Master of Hounds, fifth)** – "It was a great race for his first time on dirt. We're delighted."

**EDDIE KENNEALLY (Santiva, sixth)** – "He had a decent trip and didn't get beat that far. Shaun [Bridgmohan] was happy. He tried hard, so no real excuses."

**TOM ALBERTRANI (Brilliant Speed, seventh)** – "He's come back fine so far. He's in a good shape. He ran good."

**NICK ZITO (Dialed In, eighth)** – "He was in the back of the pack. He was dead last and they just never came back. They went 1:13 and never came back."

**KELLY BREEN (Pants On Fire, ninth)** – "He never stopped running. He never stopped trying."

## Derby Trainer Quotes cont.

**JEFF BONDE (Twice the Appeal, 10th)** – "We wound up splitting them. We broke pretty good, lay on the fence, came out for a run and then just couldn't get there. It wasn't our day."

**KIARAN MCLAUGHLIN (Soldat, 11th)** – "He came back from the race in good shape, he just was flat the last part. Congratulations to the winners, John Velazquez and Graham Motion, who are great people and very deserving."

**TODD PLETCHER (Stay Thirsty, 12th)** – "I thought we had a real good trip. He just didn't have that big punch. We didn't have any visible excuses."

**MIKE MAKER (Derby Kitten, 13th/Twinspired, 17th)** – "Our two just got outrun from what I could see. Not our day."

**JUAN ARIAS (Decisive Moment, 14th)** – "I'm very pleased. We had to change the way he runs, but there's nothing we can do about it."

**JINKS FIRES (Archarcharch, 15th)** – "I just don't know. I need to talk to [jockey] Jon [Court]. All I could see was that he got shuffled back, but that's what we were afraid would happen."

**BOB BAFFERT (Midnight Interlude, 16th)** – "He broke well, but then he got pinched back, and after that, he never got to running. Victor [Espinoza] said he was out of horse early. Just one of those things. It wasn't his day, maybe the inexperience and the big crowd got to him."

**KATHLEEN O'CONNELL (Watch Me Go, 18th)** – "When the 19 [Nehro] broke out we should have been able to save ground but instead we went up there on the outside. It's unfortunate, but we'll live to fight another day. Look what happened to Archarcharch. My heart bleeds for [his connections]."

**PETER MILLER (Comma to the Top, 19th)** – "It appears my horse chipped his left ankle. We could see it when we brought him back. I believe we will have Dr. [Wayne] McIlwrath from Colorado State University take it out in the next little while. Then he's got to go on the sidelines for at least 60 days. This isn't the end of the world and hopefully it won't be too bad. My horse tried; he always tries and for the first mile of the race he was right there. In the end it looks like we do have a real good miler or mile and a sixteenth horse. We got to run in the Kentucky Derby. How special is that?"

Get Stormy, winner of the GIII Commonwealth Turf S. over this course in his 3-year-old finale, paired up wins at Saratoga last summer in the GII Fourstardave H. and GII Bernard Baruch H. He was unplaced in his next three outings, but began to show his old form when third by a length in the GI Gulfstream Park Turf H. Feb. 5, and returned to his winning ways when he was allowed to bowl along on the front end in the GI Maker's Mark Mile at Keeneland Apr. 15. Available at a generous 7-1 here, the blaze-faced bay was allowed to dictate matters, and put up a :50.67 opening half before hitting six furlongs in 1:15.21. There would be no catching him after that, and the 5-year-old held sway late when Smart Bid and Doubles Partner came after him. MGSW Battle of Hastings (GB) (Royal Applause {GB}) took a bad step heading into the first turn and was pulled up.

"We were kind of worried about him [last year], but we're glad he didn't lose his confidence," said winning trainer Tom Bush. "We think we've got him back where he was, and I think he's probably a better horse than he was when he was a 4-year-old. Hopefully, there's more ahead, but these are two big races he's won this spring." Though Get Stormy was well-beaten in the 2010 GI Breeders' Cup Mile at Churchill, Bush has his eye on another run at the November event. "You've got Frankel and Goldikova and Gio Ponti, but other than that, sure," the horseman quipped.

Mary Sullivan, who bred Get Stormy in Kentucky and campaigns him under the nom-de-course Sullimar Stable,

bought her first horse in partnership in 1983. She enlisted late Hall of Fame conditioner P.G. Johnson to train her horses for over 20 years, and Grade I winners owned or co-owned by Sullivan and trained by Johnson were Highland Talk (1990 Gazelle H.), Far Out Beast (1993 Flower Bowl H.) and Kiri's Clown (1995 Sword Dancer H.). Sullivan purchased Galaxy North, the dam of Get Stormy's dam Foolish Gal, for \$100,000 as a 2-year-old at Fasig-Tipton February in 1988. She never raced, and Galaxy North did not enjoy much success with eight previous foals. Sullivan bred Galaxy North to Kiri's Clown in his third year at stud in 1999 and, while the resulting Foolish Gal was winless in four tries for Ronald Spatz, her second foal and first to race is Get Stormy. Foolish Gal recently foaled an unnamed full-brother to the Maker's Mark hero. Sullivan, who grew up in New Jersey, currently resides in Vero Beach, Florida with her husband Robert. She has about eight horses currently in training, and employs Jane Cibelli, Barclay Tagg and Jimmy McMullen in addition to Tom Bush.

Sassy Image looked to be on her way to big things during her 2-year-old season in 2009, pairing up wins in the GIII Pocahontas S. and GII Golden Rod S. over this track, but she has taken the long time to fulfill that promise. After kicking off 2010 with a win in the off-the-turf Sweetest Chant S. at Gulfstream, the chestnut faded to fifth behind Amen Hallelujah in the GII Davona Dale S. in February, and was shelved for nearly 11 months. She finished second in her return, a Jan. 14 Gulfstream optional claimer, but packed it in in the GIII Sabin S. Feb. 19, and finished seventh.

She reportedly had throat surgery afterwards, and was the longest shot on the board here. The prohibitive chalk Hilda's Passion, coming off a track-record-setting performance at Gulfstream, was on the engine through splits of :22.29 and :44.68, while Sassy Image bided her time in fifth. Rider Robby Albarado sent her six wide on the turn and the longshot responded, putting away Hilda's Passion inside the final furlong, and edged clear for a hometown victory. "I just want to thank Dale [Romans] for sticking with me," the reinsman said. "It's unfortunate I got taken off the horse in the Derby, but that's horse racing, you know, it happens. Down the road, I'll be happy to get on any horse for [Team Valor's] Mr.

Irwin or [trainer] Mr. Graham [Motion]." Dale Romans trains the filly on behalf of his brother Jerry. "She loves it here; she loves Churchill," said Dale Romans. "Robby rode her perfect. The race was quick enough up front that it set up just right for us. When he took her off the turn, she just exploded. Yes, the Breeders' Cup here in the fall is something to think about, for sure." Sassy Image's 3-year-old brother by Roman Ruler, Sandys Diamond, broke his maiden Friday night at Arlington Park. Her dam, Ideal Image, sold for \$170,000 at KEENOV in 2010 to Barry and Judith Becker's South Point Bloodstock while in foal to Unbridled's Song.

Regally Ready started his career on dirt and synthetic, and did break his maiden and take an allowance test on the Woodbine Poly last year, but he has been nearly unbeatable since switching to the turf. Stakes-placed in France, she produced four foals for the operation, and was sold for \$25,000, carrying to Kodiak Kowboy (Posse), to Glen Oak, agent, at Keeneland November 2010. Crown of Thorns, who had competed admirably at the highest level during a stop-start career, had his picture taken for the first time since taking the 2008 GII Robert B. Lewis S. Sidelined for 19 months, the Florida-bred came back to post runner-up finishes in both the GI Ancient Title BC S. and GI Breeders' Cup Sprint in 2009, but was benched once more. Though he came back to complete the exacta by a half-length in both the GI Pat O'Brien S. and GI Goodwood S. in 2010, the fragile runner's streak of seconds came to an end when he ran seventh in the GII Potrero Grande H. at Santa Anita Apr. 3; that was his first start on conventional dirt. He's fast enough to sprint and he can run on turf or anything we want, but I think two turns is better for him. With his half-brother Jakkalberry (Ire) (Storming Home {GB}) taking the G3 Premio Carlo d'Alessio earlier on the card for ex-jockey Endo Botti, the unbeaten grey heaped further glory on the Zanocchio Family-raised Claba di San Jore (Ire) (Barathea {Ire}), who had already produced the 2007 Derby hero Awelmarduk (Ire) (Almutawakel {GB}). Three-for-three entering this renewal, last year's Listed Premio Campbello winner warmed up with a 10-furlong conditions win at the San Siro Mar. 31 and traveled with ominous ease throughout, while settled towards the rail in mid-division. Allowing others first run in early stretch, the ice-cool Fabio Branca let his mount move smoothly between rivals to head Cazals with a quarter-mile remaining. From there, the result was academic, and he was always firmly in control of that rival, with daylight back to the German challenger Danedream.

Off the mark in a nine-furlong contest at Longchamp in October, Pour Moi was too headstrong for his own good when third on his return in the G3 Prix la Force over 1 5/16 miles back at that track Apr. 10. "He is the bridesmaid every time, but it is nice to see him run well each time, and we will bring him back for the Prix du Jockey-Club," the stable's representative Alessandro Botti commented. Vadamar's jockey Christophe-Patrice Lemaire was ruing his mount's fortunes afterwards. "He had a very good trip, traveled well and the ground was not an excuse, but I don't know why he hung in like that in the straight," Lemaire said. "We will have to try and find out the reason, as, if he hadn't done that, he would have given the front two more of a battle. Even so, he was slightly disappointing." **PLUM PRETTY 'SUPER GOOD' SATURDAY**

G1 Kentucky Oaks winner **Plum Pretty** (Medaglia d'Oro) came back from Friday's victory in "super good" form, according to Bob Baffert's assistant trainer Jim Barnes. Future plans for the Peach Tree runner are still up in the air. "Bob will be making that call at some point soon," Barnes said. **St. John's River** (Include) was bucking and playing in her stall Saturday morning after her runner-up effort in the Oaks. Andy Leggio, Jr. is already thinking Breeders' Cup with his filly, but for now, "She'll get two weeks of just walking and she'll probably get six weeks off," the trainer said. Jerry and Ann Moss's **Zazu** (Tapit) was fine after her third-place effort in the Oaks. The gray filly is expected to return to Southern California Sunday. Trainer Larry Jones joked he would be changing the name of his Oaks runner. "Well, we didn't have a joyful victory, we had a joyful fourth-place finish," Jones said. Jones added that **Joyful Victory** (Tapit) could be seen next in the June 25 G1 Mother Goose S. at Belmont or the July 9 GII Delaware Oaks.

**KENTUCKY OAKS HANDLE SETS RECORD**

All-sources handle on Friday's Kentucky Oaks card set a record of \$37.5 million, an increase of 4.2% over last year's figure of \$36 million. All-sources wagering on the Oaks itself was \$11.4 million--up 8.2% over the corresponding 2010 figure of \$10.6 million. Churchill Downs returned \$30.6 million, or 81.6% of total wagers, to bettors. On-track, Friday's crowd of 110,122 was the third-highest Kentucky Oaks attendance in history. On-track handle of \$12.1 million was an increase of 2.1% from a year ago, while on-track wagering on the Oaks was \$3 million--up 7.4% from 2010. Churchill Downs will donate \$1 for every Oaks attendee to the Susan G. Komen for the Cure and \$1 for every Oaks Lily cocktail sold to Horses and Hope.

**Texans Closer to Voting on Slot Machines:**

House Joint Resolution 111, which would allow Texans to vote on placing slot machines at licensed racetracks and federally recognized Indian reservations in Texas, passed out of committee this weekend. "Right now, Texas dollars are helping to fund schools in Louisiana, Oklahoma and New Mexico," State Representative and Speaker Pro-Tempore Beverly Woolley, who authored the bill, commented. "We have an opportunity to keep a huge chunk of that money here. We can generate revenue, create more than 77,000 jobs and spur economic growth all without expanding the footprint of gambling in the state and without raising taxes." Companion legislation filed in the Texas Senate has bi-partisan support; SJR 33 is authored by Senator Juan Hinojosa and Jeff Wentworth. Mike Lavigne, spokesperson for Win For Texas, said, "Once approved, the impact would be almost immediate, as it would raise \$548.2 million for the next budget cycle and create 77,000 new, permanent Texas jobs."

The California Horse Racing Board has ruled trainer Jeff Mullins must serve the remaining 70 days of a 90-day suspension originally handed down for a 2006 violation. Mullins served 20 days of the original suspension issued for a mepivacaine positive, but the remaining days were stayed provided the trainer committed no further Class 1, 2 or 3 violations during a one-year probationary period. But Mullins did have another violation, prompting the CHRB to seek to reinstate the remaining 70 days of the original ban.
