## ANIMAL KINGDOM ON TO PREAKNESS

Team Valor's GI Kentucky Derby winner **Animal Kingdom** (Leroidesanimaux {Brz}) came out of Saturday's race in fine shape, trainer Graham Motion confirmed yesterday. Team Valor CEO Barry Irwin said the chestnut colt would likely be headed to Baltimore for the May 21

GI Preakness S. "I'm pretty sure we're going to do it, but I want to talk about it," Irwin said yesterday. "I'm a careful guy, so let's see how he's doing. I think if you've got a horse that's amazing, you can go for the Preakness. But your regular, average

Derby winner has a real tough time coming back."

Meanwhile, Motion was still trying to process Saturday's events. "I don't know what happened between 6:30 and 9 o'clock," Motion said. "Somebody said to me it was 9 o'clock and I said, 'What happened to the last two and a half hours? It was extraordinary.'" The English-born trainer had nothing but praise for his first Kentucky Derby winner. "I have a lot of confidence in this horse," he said. "He's the whole package, I guess, to use a term that's probably overused. He's got a tremendous disposition and is just a really brilliant horse. He handled everything so well yesterday. Johnny [Velazquez] said he was so relaxed that it made him relax. He said he'd never been so relaxed in a race like this before as he was on this horse yesterday." Animal Kingdom is expected to leave Churchill Downs Tuesday morning and return to Motion's base at Fair Hill training center in Maryland.

## RECITAL SHINES IN DERBY DRESS REHEARSAL

**Recital** (Fr) (Montjeu {Ire}), hammered to 1-2, overcame one or two anxious moments late on to record a 1 1/2-length victory in yesterday's G2 Derrinstown Stud Derby Trial at Leopardstown. The

colt was representing the Ballydoyle team which has won this G1 Epsom Derby prep seven times since 2001. Settled in third early by Kieren Fallon behind the strong pace carved out by stable companions **Regent Street** (Ire) (Galileo {Ire}) and **Memphis Tennessee** (Ire) (Hurricane Run {Ire}), Recital was allowed to stride to the front with a quarter-

mile remaining. But no sooner had he hit the front than he veered left into the rail. Unbalanced temporarily, he was straightened up as Memphis Tennessee found a second wind, and the winning margin may have ultimately flattered the runner-up as Recital was being eased down in the final yards. "He has a lot of speed, but is lazy in front," trainer Aidan O'Brien said. "The plan is to go to the [June 4] G1 Epsom Derby." Successful on both occasions at two-in a mile Navan maiden in October and G1 Criterium de Saint-Cloud--Recital gave the impression that there was a lot more to come. He was coming off a third-place effort last time in the course-and-distance G3 Ballysax S. Apr. 10.

### *Surgery for Archarcharch*

**Archarcharch** (Arch) was scheduled to undergo surgery yesterday at Rood & Riddle Equine Clinic in Lexington to repair a condylar fracture to his left front leg. The GI Arkansas Derby winner was bumped coming out of the gate and trainer Jinks Fires suspects that is where the injury occurred. "He got banged coming out of the gate and kind of knuckled over there at the crown of the track," Fires said. "I told my wife that I didn't like the way he was moving when he passed us the first time, and you hope you are wrong about that." Jockey Jon Court admitted his first Derby experience was disappointing. "I'm just heart-broken," Court said. "You are not supposed to get attached to the horses, but come on, this horse, with the owners and everybody. It feels like a knife to the gut. My saddle slipped coming out of the gate and then, maybe 30 yards from the wire, I got bumped hard and I have no idea who it was." Fires added, "You have the highest of the highs and the lowest of the lows. I was never more confident leading a horse over there. I thought I had the horse to beat. He had trained well, was doing well and was very comfortable in his surroundings."

### *Belmont Likely Next for Nehro*

While the Preakness is a possibility for Derby runner-up **Nehro** (Mineshaft), the Zayat Stables colorbearer is more likely to start next in the June 11 GI Belmont S. "Let's put it this way," said owner Ahmed Zayat. "If you looked at him right now, you'd think you'd be out of your mind not to run in Baltimore. It's more probable we'd aim for the Belmont, but I guess we are still possible for the Preakness." A Preakness start would be Nehro's fourth race in eight weeks.

### *Mucho Macho Man on to Preakness*

**Mucho Macho Man** (Macho Uno) shipped to Belmont Park Sunday morning and trainer Kathy Ritvo is hopeful the Kentucky Derby third-place finisher will be headed to Baltimore. "We'll have to see him the next couple days--how he's eating, how his legs are and what his attitude is," Ritvo explained. "He looks good so far. We're strongly thinking about [the Preakness] as long as everything is good."

### *A Derby Decision for One Team Valor Member...*

Sometimes in this business, mistakes reveal themselves in minutes and seconds. Last November, on Breeders' Cup Saturday, it took Craig and Holly Bandoroff 1:36 4/5 to realize that they had made the wrong call selling their interest in Pluck, a dark bay son of More Than Ready who was in the process of winning the GII Breeders' Cup Juvenile Turf. The Bandoroffs had owned a small percentage of the colt's dam, Secret Heart (SAf) (Fort Wood), as members of a Team Valor International syndicate. They foaled and raised him at their Denali Stud, but when it came time to put Pluck into training, they opted out of the syndicate.

"[Team Valor President] Barry Irwin came to me and said, 'Hey, I know you don't like owning colts. I've got somebody who'll take your interest, valued at X,'" explained Bandoroff. "And I said, 'That's a fair price. I'll do it.' Now I tease him all the time--'Please, don't make me any more offers.'"

It was a tough break for the Bandoroffs, but luckily for them, they stayed in on another homebred from the same Team Valor crop, and on Saturday, they watched the horse, Animal Kingdom (Leroidesanimaux {Brz}), win the 137th running of the GI Kentucky Derby. Graham Motion trains Animal Kingdom for Irwin's Team Valor, which earlier this year announced it was entering into a strategic alliance with Denali. Among other things, Denali will board all of Team Valor's broodmares and consign its stock at public auction.

"Barry and I have done business for 10 years or more, and on occasion, I buy into some of the fillies he syndicates," explained Bandoroff.

Animal Kingdom's dam, Dalicia (Ger) (Acatenango {Ger}), was one such filly. Irwin acquired her as racing prospect for €400,000 at the 2005 BBAOCT sale. Brought to the States, she won one race with Neil Drysdale and finished a good fourth in the 2006 GII Beverly Hills H. Retired to the broodmare shed at Denali, the mare was sent to Leroidesanimaux in her first season and produced Animal Kingdom.

He was a standout from the start, said Bandoroff.

"I keep notes on these babies from the time they're born, and I went back and looked at my notes earlier this week--you know, just in case," he said. "He was a really nice colt from the time he was born. My notes kept saying 'nice colt...nice colt...,' and I have a system where if I underline it, it's a really nice colt. He was one of those horses that was nice from the get-go, and he really never changed. And he's turned into an absolutely beautiful horse now. That's the way a lot of the good ones are a lot of times. They're born good, and they stay good."

Denali consigned Animal Kingdom to the 2009 Keeneland September Yearling Sale for Team Valor, where Irwin's organization essentially bought him back for \$100,000. Irwin said Sunday that he puts the Team Valor homebreds through the sales to help establish a value on them,

necessary when syndicating horses.

"He was always a quiet colt, one of those where you never really notice that they're around," remembered Bandoroff. "Even when I went back to the barn before the Derby, he was the same--really quiet and composed. Graham said later that he never turned a hair in the paddock, and you'd like to think that some of that foundation you gave them is going to pay off down the road."

In the weeks leading up to the Derby, Animal Kingdom was considered a longshot for the Derby, and Bandoroff said he was just looking to enjoy the experience. "That was the great thing about it--we had no expectations," he said. "I never got nervous; I guess I just refused to believe it could happen, I guess. Everybody had told me he was training great. I didn't see his work on Saturday before the Derby, but a bunch of people called me and told me he had just worked like a beast. But you just block it out. It's that old phrase I like to use: Keep your expectations low and your hopes high."

Bandoroff was all smiles making the famous walk over to the Derby paddock from Churchill's backside, but he said the most important thing to him was being able to watch the race with his family--wife Holly, daughters Katherine and Isabel, and son Conrad.

"My children had been bugging me forever to go to the Derby, and we had never taken them," he explained. "My oldest daughter is graduating college and my son is graduating high school, so we said, 'Okay, we'll go this year.' And thank God we did. I couldn't imagine doing this and they weren't there. It was a great family affair. I feel bad now I didn't take some of the farm crew--the people that make that thing run everyday. Again, you just don't expect it, but I'm really proud of my people--Gary Bush, my farm manager, Donnie Snellings, the yearling manager, and Theresa Moore, the assistant farm manager."

Trakus, and I thought I saw his number, but I wasn't sure," he said. "Then, at the head of the stretch, my daughter Katherine said, 'Dad, I think that's him! I think that's him!' When he came past us, there was no doubt. You've heard that expression to get weak at

your knees? I did, and had to sit down--it was crazy. The emotion just comes right out of you."

Bandoroff declined to say what percentage he owns in Animal Kingdom, but laughed, "It's enough to make it fun, but probably not enough to change my life."

There are 19 other partners in Animal Kingdom, and Bandoroff gives credit to the man who brought them all together. "I have the utmost respect for Barry Irwin," said Bandoroff. "He's the one that gets all the credit for this. He does the matings, he picks out the horses, he makes the decisions. He's so talented and good at what he does. This is about the horse, Graham, Barry and [jockey] Johnny Velazquez. We were just happy to be supporting actors." -L Marquardt

**GERLING-PREIS-G2 result cont.**

The eagerly awaited return of last year's champion 3-year-old Scalo did not disappoint as Germany's Horse of the Year oozed class to comfortably land this seasonal return. Ninth in the July 18 G1 Deutsches Derby at Hamburg, one of only two career defeats, he garnered the Aug. 15 G2 Prix Guillaume d'Ornano at Deauville in impressive fashion, and closed his sophomore campaign with an equally taking score in the G1 Preis von Europa over course and distance last time Sept. 26. Hidden away four lengths behind the pace along the rail in fifth from the bell here, Scalo angled off the fence for his bid approaching the final eighth and quickened smartly under whipless coaxing to swamp his rivals nearing the line, leading home a trifecta for his sire (by Acatenango {Ger}). The 2009 G1 Preis der Diana and 2010 G1 Grosser Preis von Baden victress Night Magic (Ger) (Sholokhov {Ire}), who ran second to Scalo in the Preis von Europa, held every chance entering the final furlong, but was not unduly punished once her chance had gone and finished a creditable fourth in her seasonal return. Trainer Andreas Wohler said of Scalo, "It was a surprise that he left it so late. We want to celebrate first and will make decisions on Scalo's future later." A disappointed Wolfgang Figge said of last year's G1 Grosser Preis von Baden winner Night Magic (Ger) (Sholokhov {Ire}), "We wanted her to make all, but then we heard that Lamool (Ger) (Mamool {Ire}) would opt for the lead. When her breakthrough did come, it was over six furlongs on [Dundalk's Polytrack](#) in September and she was impressive from the front there. Only sixth after blowing the start in a mile conditions race back there last time Apr. 8, she put that firmly behind her under an aggressive ride from [Fran Berry](#). Shadowing the leader [Gemstone \(Ire\)](#) ([Galileo \(Ire\)](#)) throughout, she took over with a quarter mile remaining and was beyond reach as [Sapphire Pendant](#) found her stride. **NYRA Figures Soar on Derby Day:**

The attendance, on-track handle and account wagering activity at New York Racing Association all registered increases on Saturday's Kentucky Derby day. A combined crowd of 14,501 was in attendance at Aqueduct and Belmont. This is the first year Aqueduct is open year-round for simulcasting and last year's Belmont attendance on Derby day was 9,405. NYRA simulcast wagering Saturday totaled \$4,465,743, a 115% increase over the 2010 figure of \$2,077,461. The simulcast total includes \$840,483 wagered via the NYRA Rewards internet platform (up 224% from a year ago) and \$446,773 from NYRA Rewards telephone wagering (up 91% from 2010). NYRA wagering just on the Churchill card was \$3,276,396--up 106 percent. Wagering on the Derby alone was \$2,082,000--up 119%. Both figures are new records for NYRA wagering activity on the Churchill card and Derby. Saturday's crowd at Aqueduct bet a total of \$1,093,060. On-track handle on the Belmont card was \$1,918,899, up 24%. Total on-track handle was \$6,384,642--up 76%. All-sources handle for Saturday was \$17,431,795--up 3.5%.
