HALL OF FAME CLASS ANNOUNCED

The 2011 National Museum of Racing's Hall of Fame contemporary inductees were announced Friday, with trainer Jerry Hollendorfer, as well as the champion fillies Open Mind, Safely Kept and Sky Beauty getting nods.

Hollendorfer has dominated racing in Northern California since the mid-1980s: he won every major training title at Bay Area tracks from 1986 through 2008, recording 37 straight titles at Bay Meadows and 32 Golden Gate Fields. He has also done very well in Southern California, and won the Arlington Park training title in 2001.

Hollendorfer won five Grade I races in 2010, and sent out Blind Luck (Pollard's Vision) to champion 3-year-old filly honors.

The Akron, Ohio, native has cracked the top 10 in U.S. wins for the last 24 years and has been in the top 10 in earnings 12 times. He has the fourth-most wins all time by a trainer with 5,863, and ranks eighth on the North American earnings list with \$119,141,280.

"[Getting into the Hall of Fame] is something you can never expect in life--to be listed with some great people," said Hollendorfer. "I can only say how grateful I am to get up every morning and do what I love for all these years. I'm going to continue to do those things and live up to being in the Hall of Fame."

Hollendorfer gave credit to his wife, Janet, for much of his success. "Janet's been the glue that holds the stable together--she's the catalyst that makes everything go," he reflected.

Eugene Klein's Open Mind (Deputy Minister--Stage Luck, by Stage Door Johnny) took the 1998 GI Breeders' Cup Juvenile Fillies en route to champion 2-year-old filly honors. Trained by

a Hall of Famer himself in D. Wayne Lukas, Open Mind swept the Filly Triple Crown (GI Acorn S., GI Mother Goose S. and GI Coaching Club American Oaks) the following year, and also annexed the GI Kentucky Oaks and GI Demoiselle S. Bred in New Jersey by Due Process Stable, Open Mind retired with a record of 19-12-2-2 with career earnings of \$1,844,372. **Cont. p2**

DOUBLE TROUBLE

Like past-masters Jim Bolger and Henry Cecil, trainer Richard Hannon is enjoying a vintage twilight in a career that has spanned the decades, thanks to the presence of his stable's star milers **Canford Cliffs (Ire)** (Tagula {Ire}) and **Dick Turpin (Ire)** (Arakan), who clash swords once more in today's G1 Lockinge S. at Newbury. As the website of the master of Everleigh House states, the yard is "split down the middle" regarding their chances as they bid to secure back-to-back renewals following the success of Paco Boy (Ire) (Desert Style {Ire}) 12 months ago. They first met at this track in the G3 Greenham S. last April, where John Manley's Dick Turpin came out on top, and that was the case again in the G1 2000 Guineas the following month as they filled the trifecta positions behind Makfi (GB) (Dubawi {Ire}). Robin Heffer's Canford Cliffs, who is co part-owned by Coolmore, finally reversed the placings in the G1 St James's Palace S. at Royal Ascot in June, and subsequent efforts from the pair in different avenues make for a tantalising clash in this contest on which they appear to have a stranglehold. "It is a Group 1 and we are taking nothing for granted, as there are other good horses in this race, but I could not be happier with my two," Hannon commented. "Canford Cliffs is as good a horse as we have had here in 40 years. Dick Turpin looks magnificent, as does Canford Cliffs, and we cannot wait for the rematch." **Cont. p7**

Bred in Maryland by Mr. and Mrs. David Hayden, Safely Kept (Horatius--Safely Home, by Winning Hit) was campaigned by TDN publisher Barry Weisbord and Richard Santulli's Jayeff B Stable and conditioned by Alan Goldberg. The bay won two stakes at two, and won eight of nine starts at three, including the GI Test S., GII Genuine Risk S. and GII Prioress S. to be named champion sprinter.

Her only defeat came after setting a fast pace against older males in the GI Breeders' Cup Sprint--she dropped the decision by a neck to Dancing Spree (Nijinsky II) in a game performance. Safely Kept avenged her narrow Breeders' Cup defeat the following season against a star-studded group, scoring by a 1/4 length from European champion Dayjur (Danzig). Safely Kept won five stakes races the following year, and retired with career earnings of \$2,194,206 and a record of 31-24-2-3.

"We are honored and excited," said Santulli. "We always thought she was one of the greatest sprinting fillies in the world and, though we had to wait a while for her to get in, we couldn't be happier with where she is now. The relationship between myself, Al, Barry and our families has been special, and she brought us all together."

Weisbord added, "To me, she represents the best things about horse racing. From the people side, she helped create lasting friendships that still exist today. From the horse side, she had championship quality and a competitive nature. She raced at two, three, four and five and won 20 stakes races in a row sprinting against fillies. She didn't need to take her track or rider with her--she won at 11 different tracks and with several jockeys, although, [regular rider] Craig Perret did a great job with her."

Sky Beauty (Blushing Groom {Fr})--Maplejinsky, by Nijinsky II) was campaigned for Georgia Hoffman by Hall of Famer H. Allen Jerkens. Bred in Kentucky by Sugar Maple Farm, she took the GI Spinaway S. and GI Matron S. to complete a perfect five-race record in 1992 at two. She swept the "Triple Tiara" at three, and also annexed the GI Alabama S. and GII Rare Perfume S. to complete another five-race win streak. Sky Beauty garnered champion older mare honors in 1994, winning the GIII Vagrancy H., GI Shuvee H., GI Hempstead H., GI Go For Wand S. (by 10 1/2 lengths) and the GI Ruffian H.

Her only loss that year came when she finished ninth in the GI Breeders' Cup Distaff at Churchill. She repeated in the Vagrancy, finished second in the Shuvee and third in the Hempstead the following year before being retired with a record of 21-15-2-2 with earnings of \$1,336,000.

"She was very special," recalled Jerkens. "It was just too bad she couldn't do it in the Breeders' Cup, but she won everything else." The conditioner added, "She would work as fast as you wanted or as easy as you wanted--she was very tractable. Some are just born to be great, and I was just glad to be along for the ride."

The four contemporary inductees will be joined by four inductees chosen by the historic review committee, who will announce their selections in June, to complete the 2011 Hall of Fame class. A 183-member panel selected the contemporary inductees from a group of 10 finalists that also included jockeys Calvin Borel, John Velazquez, Garret Gomez and Alex Solis, as well as trainers Gary Jones and Robert Wheeler. The induction will take place Friday, Aug. 12 at 10:30 am at the Fasig-Tipton sales pavilion in Saratoga. HRTV will provide live coverage.

DUO GEAR UP FOR PREAKNESS

Norman Asbjornson (Real Quiet), second in the Gill Gotham S. and fourth in the GI Wood Memorial, and GI Santa Anita Derby third-place finisher **Mr. Commons** (Artie Schiller) both stretched their legs for engagements in the GI Preakness S. The former, owned by Thomas McClay and Harry Nye, breezed five furlongs at Pimlico in 1:02 1/5. Jockey Julian Pimentel was aboard. "He'd didn't have any company," trainer Chris Grove offered. "It was educational for him. He got more out of last week's work. This was more of a maintenance work to keep him in form." Pimentel added, "He went well and handled the track good. He

did it pretty easily. He finished up good." Norman Asbjornson will remain at Grove's nearby Bowie Training Center until the morning of the Preakness. St. George Farm homebred Mr. Commons punched his ticket to the second jewel of the Triple Crown after working seven furlongs beneath jockey Victor Espinoza in 1:24 2/5 at Hollywood Park. "He did it very well, except he was a little strong in the middle part of the work," trainer John Shirreffs said. "The horse couldn't have blown a candle out when he got back to the barn. He's very fit. It was Victor's first time on him, so I just attribute that to Victor not knowing him."

"We're drawn on the outside and I'd prefer to be a bit lower, but it's not a disaster," Fahey said yesterday. "He's in top shape now. Although he was working well before the [G1] 2000 Guineas, he was blowing hard, and we were rushing him. I've never seen a horse come up my gallop as fast." Drawn more favorably in five is Susan Magnier, Michael Tabor and Derrick Smith's **Imperial Rome**, who steps up a panel following a latest battling success in The Curragh's Listed Tetrarch S. May 2. "It's a step up for him, but we'll give it a go and see what happens," trainer David Wachman told *PA Sport*. "We've always thought he was a nice horse, and hoped he might be capable of stepping forward to this level. I think it's good, fast ground, which will suit our horse. We have a good draw and a good jockey, so we'll see what happens."

A total of 16 fillies will line up for tomorrow's Classic, and the all-important draw has not been kind to one of the leading candidates **Maqaasid**. Sheikh Hamdan bin Rashid Al Maktoum's homebred was third in the G1 1000 Guineas at Newmarket May 1, where the reopposing **Nova Hawk** was a further 3 1/4 lengths behind in fourth. The owner/breeder's Racing Manager Angus Gold told *PA Sport*, "John [Gosden] is obviously happy with her to be running her again so quickly. She seems in good form. She's drawn 14 of 16, which probably won't be ideal, but you've got to take what you get. She's quite a tough filly."

He added, "With a bit of luck in running, she should go close." Another who will have to overcome a disadvantageous post position is Khalid Abdullah's **Helleborine**, who has been second on her last two starts, the course-and-distance G1 Prix Marcel Boussac on Arc day and Maisons-Laffitte's G3 Prix Imprudence Apr. 7. On both occasions, it was hard to ignore the feeling of disappointment from Criquelette Head-Maarek, and that speaks volumes from the trainer of seven previous Pouliches heroines. "She is in very good form, and the only worry is the draw," Head-Maarek told *PA Sport*. "Stall 11 is a bad draw. Stall 16 would be worse, though, and if the horse is good enough, they can overcome it. She has improved quite a lot physically since Maisons-Laffitte, and the faster ground will suit her." There was a notable withdrawal yesterday after last year's G2 Cherry Hinton S. heroine **Memory (Ire)** (Daneshill Dancer {Ire}) was reported to have come into season. Highclere Thoroughbred Racing issued a statement on their official website, which read, "Richard Hughes rode her on Thursday morning, and it was clear from her work that she had none of her usual zest. The vets examined her and confirmed that she is in season and, as a result, there is no point in sending her to France. She is also likely to bypass the Irish equivalent on May 22, and head straight to Royal Ascot for the G1 Coronation S. [at Royal Ascot June 17]."

Taken wide away from the other rivals early, he was brought back over to join the remainder after the initial furlongs and was first to make the favored stand's side at the top of the home straight. Tackled by Manighar inside the final quarter and Blue Bajan out wide as Native Ruler (GB) (Cape Cross {Ire}) struggled for room in behind, he kept digging in and stayed honest and true with the rail to guide him. "He's very tough and turned a corner at the end of last year," jockey William Buick explained. "He improved a lot and has carried that on this year, with a lot more to come, now that his mind is on one thing." Trainer John Gosden is considering a tilt at the G1 Gold Cup at Royal Ascot June 16 and added, "He is an enigmatic character, but has got a ton of talent, and it's been a little hard to wrinkle it out of him sometimes. He's got into a bit of a groove more recently and, although he was a little effervescent and fresh today, I'm sure now that he's got that out of his system, he will be able to go further. William said he had a lot of trouble pulling him up, so we'll give the Gold Cup a little thought. He's got a good turn-of-foot and, if he switches off a bit more, that will give him every chance of staying."

SAL GROSSO HIGHLIGHTS BIG WEEKEND

Cidade Jardim plays host to five Group 1 races this weekend, highlighted by Sunday's G1 Grande Premio Sao Paulo. Back to try and defend his title is reigning Brazilian Horse of the Year **Sal Grosso (Brz)** (Our Emblem), who gave owner-breeder Gonzalo Torrealba's Stud TNT and jockey Luiz Duarte their third victories in last year's edition of the race, and the team hopes to add another in 2011. Winner of last season's G1 Grande Premio Estado do Rio de Janeiro-Haras das Estrellas, the son of Group 3 winner Ken de Saron (Kenmare {Fr}) also earned the 3-year-old title in 2010. In three starts this term, the 4-year-old hit the board twice, including a third-place finish in the Apr. 10 G2 Grande Premio Joao Borges Filho. First across the wire that day was **Another Xhow (Brz)** (Suspicious Mind {Brz}), who previously was runner-up in the G2 Grande Premio Almirante Marques de Tamandare in December.

Saturday's 12-race card features a pair of Group 1 events for 3-year-olds and up, including the G1 Grande Premio Associacao Brasileira de Criadores e Proprietarios do Cavalo de Corrida. The 1000-meter event was used by Leroidesanimaux (Brz) (Candy Stripes) to launch his U.S. campaign, which included six graded stakes victories--three at the Grade I level. The flashy chestnut gained recent acclaim as the sire of last week's GI Kentucky Derby winner Animal Kingdom. Likely to gather plenty of support in this year's feature is **Quasi Moda (Brz)** (Christine's Outlaw), who was second most recently in last month's G3 Grande Premio Associacao dos Criadores E Proprietarios de Cavalos de Corrida do Rio de Janeiro at Gavea.

GOVERNOR SIGNS OFF ON MONMOUTH DEAL

After negotiations that lasted late into Thursday evening, Gov. Chris Christie signed off on the lease that will turn the operation of Monmouth Park over to Morris Bailey.

Bailey still needs to finalize contracts with the unions and the horsemen before the deal becomes official. John Forbes, president of the New Jersey Thoroughbred Horsemen's Association, confirmed, "We have an agreement in principal, which is subject to contract and board approval." Bailey, a real estate developer who

purchased Resorts Casino last year, has owned racehorses for a number of years. "I'm excited by the fact that we are completing a transaction that will bring about a new era for horse racing in New Jersey and Monmouth Park," Bailey said in a statement. "I want to thank all of the parties involved, especially Governor Christie and his staff and the Thoroughbred horsemen, for working so diligently to meet the challenges we confronted. With what we are accomplishing, we are creating one of the premier race tracks in the country that will provide an attractive and exciting atmosphere to appeal to established horse racing fans and, I believe, the broader public." Gov. Christie also signed off on Jeff Gural's lease of the Meadowlands Thursday night. This marks the latest chapter in a saga involving New Jersey tracks that began last year when a gaming panel recommended to Christie that the state cease operating the financially struggling ovals. "I was determined to bring this deal home," Christie stated. "There are many beneficiaries: we're saving a New Jersey tradition with the continuation of live horse racing at the Meadowlands and Monmouth Park; we are saving and creating jobs; and we are helping to preserve New Jersey farmland and a way of life for many people, from horse farm owners and employees, to jockeys, to racing enthusiasts. I want to thank all involved, from staff in the Governor's Counsel's Office, to the executive staff of the New Jersey Sports and Exposition Authority, to Mr. Gural and Mr. Bailey, as well as representatives of the Thoroughbred and Standardbred horsemen." The Monmouth meeting starts Saturday, and a finalized racing schedule is expected to be announced that mirrors the three-day-a-week "Elite Meet" held last year, albeit with purses of about \$400,000 a day.

SANTA ANITA MEET TO KICK OFF IN SEPTEMBER (Edited Press Release) Live racing will return to the "Great Race Place" in late September with the inaugural Santa Anita Autumn Meet, pending California Horse Racing Board approval. The meet will be held over a six-week period and conclude Nov. 6.

"We're very excited to be able to let our fans, employees and horsemen know that live Thoroughbred racing will return to Santa Anita this

autumn," Santa Anita President George Haines said. "Our inaugural Autumn Meet will provide the kind of world class racing and economic opportunity that our sport and community have come to expect at Santa Anita." Santa Anita's Autumn Meet will also provide horsemen with a total of six Breeders' Cup Challenge qualifying races. "We'll be offering the same traditional series of graded Breeders' Cup Challenge races as have previously been run by the Oak Tree Racing Association, including the prestigious Lady's Secret, the Goodwood, the Norfolk, the Oak Leaf, the Yellow Ribbon and the Ancient Title," Santa Anita's Director of Racing Mike Harlow added.

MI Developments Chairman Frank Stronach will oversee the formation of the Santa Anita Park After-Care Program, it was announced Friday. Stronach said that Santa Anita's After-Care Program will help match horses with owners who will make a lifelong commitment to their health, safety and well being. According to Stronach, Santa Anita would support the After-Care Program by matching the money currently taken from purses (one third of 1%) at Santa Anita. The monies will be distributed to retirement programs throughout California by the California Retirement Management Account. "This is not a solution to the problem, but we feel it is another step in the right direction," Stronach said.
