SURF'S UP

It has been 18 years since Kingmambo completed the G3 Prix Djebel/G1 Poule d'Essai des Poulains double, but **Surfrider (Ire)** (Dansili {GB}) will try to reverse that trend at Longchamp this afternoon. Owned by a partnership involving Michel Delaunay, Pegasus Farms Eric Libaud and Andre Berthol, he beat Gerard Augustin-Normand and Daniel-Yves Treves' **Havane Smoker (GB)** (Dubawi {Ire}) by a head in that Apr. 7 test at Maisons-Laffitte, and is open to improvement with Christophe-Patrice Lemaire in the saddle. "It was always the intention to send him directly for the Poulains after his win in the Djebel," conditioner Eric Libaud told the *Racing Post*. "He has certainly come on since that race and is in great shape. The colt is ready, at the top of his game, and the good ground will be perfect." **Cont. p6**

Hyped to the moon after winning the G2 Coventry S. as a 2-year-old, Canford Cliffs was starting to look a little disappointing at this point in the 2010 calendar despite two fine efforts when second in the

G3 Greenham S. over seven furlongs here and third in the G1 2000 Guineas at Newmarket. He turned all that on its head with a fluent success in the Irish equivalent at The Curragh in late May before proving the fuss was deserved

when following up in the G1 St James's Palace S. at the Royal meeting in June. Off until the Sussex, he recorded a snug win from Rip Van Winkle (Ire) (Galileo {Ire}) there, and only a bad scope denied him the chance to build on that in the G1 Queen Elizabeth II S. at Ascot in September. Settled in fifth early and traveling strongly as Twice Over (GB) (Observatory) pressed the pace set by Worthadd, Canford Cliffs needed minimal encouragement to close on the latter inside the final quarter. By the time he reached the furlong pole, he already had that rival's measure, and Richard Hughes only needed to wave the stick on the run to the line.

"This time last year, he was very lethargic and even today I'd have liked to see a little more fire," Hughes said. "He's going to be better the next day and it's good that he's settling so well now. I'm relieved, with all the hype beforehand, and I wasn't quite sure we had him 100% fit, as these talented horses take a bit of graft, but he's very clear-winded and we got away with it. I relish a clash with Goldikova (Ire) (Anabaa) in the G1 Queen Anne S. [at Royal Ascot June 14] and with Frankel (GB) (Galileo {Ire}) somewhere down the line." Trainer Richard Hannon added, "He's a horse who has a good cruising speed and can pick up. He'd been off since July and, although he has had a couple of racehorse gallops and has done everything very well, he looked a little bit burly, so he'll come on for it. He ran too free in the Guineas last year, but since we've got him organized he's floated along, and he'll go to the Queen Anne next. You can run, but you can't hide, and he will be there to take on all-comers." Of the second favorite **Dick Turpin (Ire)** (Anabaa), who was never traveling with his usual fluency and stayed on into fourth, he added, "He needs a bit of give and a better gallop--it was against him." His owner John Manley revealed that he will run in Sunday's G1 Prix d'Isphahan at Longchamp.

He had a three-race winning streak snapped when fifth in the Apr. 16 GI Arkansas Derby, but Alternation got back on track with this game score. The dark bay broke his maiden by seven lengths when making his second start--but his first at two turns--at Remington Park Dec. 9, and added an optional-claiming success going a mile at Oaklawn Jan. 15. The Pin Oak homebred was deemed a **★ "TDN Rising Star" ★** after making it three in a row in an allowance test at 1 1/16 miles Feb. 21, but had his Kentucky Derby hopes derailed soon after. Alternation went to the gate for the GII Rebel S. Mar. 19, but flipped in the starting gate and had to be scratched. Off at 17-1 in the

Arkansas Derby, he broke slowly and trailed the field until they hit the lane, then closed some ground to be fifth.

Alternation was the second choice in the Peter Pan. Longshot Bold Deed (Anasheed) took them along through a half in :47.14 and three-quarters in 1:11.90, with Alternation rating off the pace after stumbling slightly at the start. Adios Charlie, flanked by Joe Vann (Silver Deputy), collared the pacesetter as they neared the stretch and set sail for home, but Alternation closed relentlessly on the outside to get his head in front at the wire. "[Adios Charlie] wasn't really coming back at all and my horse just kept grinding and tried pretty hard," jockey Ramon Dominguez said. "I was very impressed. He's a beautiful, big animal and they told me before the race, 'you'll be surprised--when you ask him, you'll get horse right away. It's not like he takes a couple strides.' Sure enough, around the half-mile I had to kind of smooch at him to get through on the rail--and then I had to kind of slam on the brakes because I had nowhere to go once I got through. It was good to see that, as big as he is, he's also got tactical speed and more than one gear."

Acclamation captured the 2010 edition of the Jim Murray by 7 1/2 lengths, and it was deja vu all over again yesterday. The bay came back to take the GI Charlie Whittingham H. going 10 panels on the Hollywood turf in June, but had failed to hit the board in his four starts since. Last in the July 3 GI United Nations S. after a trip to Monmouth Park, he faded to sixth in the GI Eddie Read S. at Del Mar three weeks later and was done for the year. The Calbred came back in the GI Frank E. Kilroe Mile H. at Santa Anita Mar. 5 and cut out the pace before tiring to fifth. Connections opted to give the main track a try for the Apr. 16 Charles Town Classic, but Acclamation did not take to the sloppy strip and finished 10th. He was back in his element here. All Saint (Skimming) went winging away on the front end, leading by as many as six lengths as he reeled off a half in :48.64 and six furlongs in 1:13.67. He was still five in front after a mile in 1:37.67, but Acclamation, second in the opening exchanges, inhaled the frontrunner before they hit the quarter pole and galloped away down the lane to win as much the best.

Tabbed a ☆ **"TDN Rising Star"** ☆ after making it two-for-two with a two-turn allowance win over this track last May, Embur's Song followed up with a third in the June 13 Woodbine Oaks and a second in the July 11 Bison City S. The bay was sidelined after that test, and faded to last when making her return in a main-track optional claimer at Gulfstream Feb. 6, but she has been on the improve since. Fourth, beaten just a length and a quarter, in a Gulfstream grass allowance Apr. 2, she was let go at 9-1 in the GIII Doubledogdare S. on the Keeneland Poly 20 days later, and set all the pace before holding on to score by a neck in track-record time. Embur's Song changed tactics to good advantage here. Held up in third as Wildcat Marie dashed off an opening half in :44 4/5, she collared the leader when they straightened for home and pulled away to win handily. "Looking at the *Daily Racing Form*, she showed that she's actually a speed horse," said winning jockey Patrick Husbands. "This morning when I spoke with Todd [Pletcher], I asked if she had to be on the lead. He said, 'I don't think so. Just play it by ear.' As we left the gate, in the first three strides, she relaxed."

A Font of Information...

The G3 Prix de Fontainebleau long has been the prime pointer to this Classic, which is no surprise as it is the ideal course-and-distance warm-up. Since the start of the 1980s, no fewer than 13 colts have recorded the double, including Aussie Rules (Danehill), Astronomer Royal (Danzig) and Lope de Vega (Ire) (Shamardal). This year's renewal produced a bunch finish off a slow pace. The field was led home by Khalid Abdullah's **Glaswegian (GB)** (Selkirk), who enjoyed a clearer passage through than the third **Tin Horse (Ire)** (Sakhee) in that Apr. 24 contest. Beaten less than a length, the Marquesa de Moratalla's homebred has always promised to secure a major prize, and was doing his best work late on when second on both his previous starts in the G1 Prix Morny over six furlongs at Deauville in August and G1 Prix Jean-Luc Lagardere-- where he dead-heated for that spot--over an extra panel here on Arc day. Ecurie Wildenstein's **Barocci (Jpn)** (Deep Impact {Jpn}) appeared to have less of a bad-luck story in fourth in the Fontainebleau, but tries again along with the sixth-placed **Salto (Ire)** (Pivotal {GB}).

Wertheimer homebred Salto showed that he possessed the class for this test when second to Roderic O'Connor (Ire) (Danehill) in the G1 Criterium International at Saint-Cloud in late October. "I am very happy with the colt and he has done really well since the reappearance," trainer Freddy Head told the *Racing Post*. Godolphin, who scored with Vettori (Ire) in 1995, Bachir (Ire) in 2000 and Shamardal six years ago, have a duo to go to war with this time. **Modern History (Ire)**, who is by the 2005 winner, has to command respect as the sole Andre Fabre representative from a stable that has enjoyed five winners. He took Toulouse's Listed Prix Aymeri de Mauleon on his latest start Apr. 29. His running mate, the supplemented **Midsummer Fair** (Medaglia d'Oro), beat the well-regarded Air Traffic (GB) (Dansili {GB}) in Newmarket's Wood Ditton S. on his only start Apr. 14. His trainer Mahmood Al Zarooni commented, "This is a very big step up for Midsummer Fair, but he won a good maiden and he shows class in his work. We could have decided to give him a run in a conditions race and take things step by step, but we wanted to give him a chance in a group contest. I am hopeful that Midsummer Fair can run a good race, and I will be very happy if he finishes in the first four."

"Ta Rib gave me my first big win in this race, and it would be nice to think that we could get a similar result, but we are under no illusions about the task in hand." The draw could have been kinder to Godolphin's unbeaten **Zoowraa (GB)** (Azamour {Ire}), who was an impressive winner of the seven-furlong Listed Radley S. when last seen at Newbury in October. "Zoowraa is in good form and her final piece of work went very well," trainer Mahmood Al Zarooni said. "She is not the biggest, but it is the engine inside that is more important."

"He chipped a knee last summer in the Best Pal," co-owner Lebherz explained. The colt opened 2011 with a runner-up finish behind The Factor (War Front) in the Feb. 20 GII San Vicente S. "We had to rush to get to the San Vicente, and he was one work short," Lebherz said. Sixth behind The Factor in the Mar. 19 GII Rebel S. at Oaklawn, he was equipped with blinkers for the Apr. 16 GI Arkansas Derby, but finished fourth after making a middle move. He was sporting the hood again for yesterday's breeze. "We put the blinkers on him for the first time in the Arkansas Derby, and they have been on for all of his works here to make him focus better," Miguel Carranza, assistant to trainer Jeff Bonde, said. "This was a good work and I got him in 1:26 1/5 to the seven-eighths pole." The official splits were 13.80, :26.80, :39, :50.40 and 1:02.20; he was clocked galloped out seven furlongs in 1:27.20. 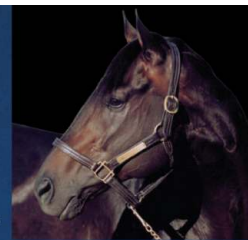

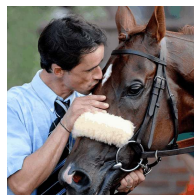

RECORDS FALL AGAIN AT ARQANA

There were increases across the board after yesterday's Arqana Breeze-Up Sale, with a record average, median and aggregate hand-in-hand with an impressive 80% clearance rate. Confidence was high following a set of smart breezes from some striking individuals, and the resulting session did not disappoint. Although last year's record high-price of €300,000 was not matched, the sale topper was not far adrift at €260,000. The topper, hip **68**, is a full-sister to the top-class Naissance Royale (Ire) (Giant's Causeway), who was successful in the GII Nassau S. and GII Lake Placid S. five years ago and the GII Las Palmas H. in 2007. She is also a half to the 2002 G3 Musidora S. runner-up and G2 Sun Chariot S. third Spinnette (Ire) (Spinning World). Spinnette in turn has produced two smart stateside runners in the Green Desert pair Green Lyons (Ire) and Tarrip, who was third in the GIII La Prevoyante H. at the start of the year. Charlie Gordon-Watson prevailed for the jewel of the customarily strong Mocklershill draft, who had been led out unsold at 100,000 guineas at Tattersalls in October, having cost \$280,000 as a weanling at Keeneland. Her sale provided more advertisement for Willie Browne's consigning skills, as he has now sold the top lots at all British, Irish and French breeze-ups bar Fairyhouse.

Two juveniles sold for €200,000. The first of these was the top-priced colt of the session, from Con Marnane's Bansha House Stables. Hip **70** is by Exceed and Excel (Aus) and is a grandson of the listed winner Lady of Kildare (Ire) (Mujadil) who was knocked down to the Sale's leading buyers Prime Equestrian. He proved a particular pinhooking success, having cost a mere €30,000 at Deauville in August. Also selling for that tag was Hawthorn Villa Stud's hip **112**, the sole Galileo (Ire) in the catalogue, and it was Gerard Larrieu's Chantilly Bloodstock Agency who snapped up the daughter of the 2004 G1 Prix Vermeille heroine Sweet Stream (Ity) (Shantou). She will enter training with Freddy Head and race in the colors of Saeed Nasser Al Romaithi. Trainer David Smaga had earlier paid €185,000 for hip **45**, a son of Pivotal (GB) from Kilminfoyle House Stud. Out of a half to the champion Pride (Fr) (Peintre Celebre), the February-foaled chestnut is also a relative of the 2006 G1 1000 Guineas heroine Speciosa (Ire) (Danehill Dancer {Ire}) and was bought on behalf of Jean-Michel Hegesippe, owner of the smart Belle Masquee (Ire) (Oratorio {Ire}).

As usual, Anthony Stroud was making his presence felt at Saint-Cloud and he was responsible for the purchase of two highlights. First up was Powerstown Stud's hip **13**, an Iffraaj (GB) colt who is out of a half to the triple group winner Hurricane Alan (Ire) (Mukaddamah), who cost €170,000, and was purchased on behalf of Hong Kong-based trainer John Size. Stroud later paid €160,000 for hip **92**, a colt by Verglas (Ire), also from Mocklershill. From a proven family of Lord and Lady O'Reilly, the February-foaled grey has last year's G1 Prix de Diane third Sandbar (GB) (Oasis Dream {GB}) on her page. **Cont. p6**

Also selling for €160,000 was Yeomanstown Stud's hip 123, an Acclamation (GB) colt whose dam is the listed-placed Toujours Amour (Ire) (Croco Rouge {Ire}), and she was another secured by Prime Equestrian. Three years ago on this weekend, River Proud (Proud Citizen) finished third in the G1 Poule d'Essai des Poulains, and his full-sister, from leading vendors Haras du Saubouas, proved popular yesterday. From the immediate family of Da Hoss, the page of hip 9 also features Tagula (Ire), whose son Canford Cliffs (Ire) took yesterday's G1 Lockinge S. She sold to Tranford Limited for €150,000.

Moments earlier, the sale of Haras du Saubouas' hip 4 for €125,000 had set the tone of the session when providing the initial fireworks. From the first crop of the Irish National Stud's Lawman (Fr), the March-foaled filly is a close relative of the recent G2 Cape Verdi runner-up Thai Haku (Ire) (Oasis Dream {GB}), who was knocked down to the MAB Agency. Sir Robert Ogden is a regular buyer at these sales, and his name was on the docket for hip 63, a son of Dashing Blade (GB) whose half-sister Alsace Lorraine (Ire) (Giant's Causeway) is a listed winner and was also fourth in last year's G2 Windsor Forest S. From Paddy Twomey's Hawthorn Villa Stud, he was sold for €140,000.

Bobby O'Ryan paid €130,000 for hip 56, a Shirocco (Ger) half-brother to the sire Leadership (GB) (Selkirk) and top sophomore Havant (GB) (Halling), from Lynn Lodge Stud. That price was later matched by David Redvers for hip 89, Mocklershill's son of Shamardal and the listed-winning Relais d'Aumale (GB) (Rainbow Quest).

For the sixth consecutive year, the statistics told of increases, with the average of €62,246 and median of €50,000 representing hikes of 20% and 25%, respectively, while 20 lots sold for €100,000 or more, against 13 in 2010. Reflecting on this success, Arqana's President Eric Hoyeau commented, "The regular increase in the results reflects the upgrade in the quality of the catalogue, and of the juveniles' preparation. Our most sincere thanks go to our faithful vendors, who have made the choice to support this sale for several years and keep upgrading the standard of horses they bring to Saint-Cloud year on year, as well as to the buyers who traveled from as far afield as Hong Kong. I wish to pay a specific tribute to Prime Equestrian, an organisation that has chosen France as the base for its racing enterprise. 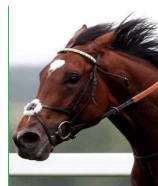

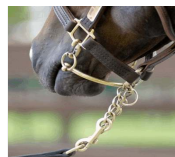
