## GOOD AS GOLD

Sent off the 6-4 favorite to maintain her unbeaten tally after a smooth warm-up in the G3 Prix de la Grotte

Apr. 24, Gestut Ammerland's **Golden Lilac (Ire)** (Galileo {Ire}) barely had to break sweat to turn yesterday's G1 Poule d'Essai des Pouliches into a procession at Longchamp. Settled in second behind the pace-setter **Glorious Sight (Ire)** (Singspiel {Ire}) early, the unbeaten bay took over with 1 1/2 furlongs remaining and was not shown the whip by Olivier Peslier en route to an easy three-length success. "I am thrilled and she is a really nice filly," owner Dietrich von Boetticher commented. "She was a bit keen

early on, but Olivier Peslier made the right decision to let her run. I will talk to the trainer about the next step and if he wants to go for the G1 Prix de Diane [at Chantilly June 12], I will also." That is where trainer Andre Fabre wants to go--he said, "She has fulfilled all our expectations today and won like a really classy filly. She will have no problem staying further and if all goes well will run in the Diane." Cont. p3

Having knocked on the door in the major races at two and been virtually knocked over in the Apr. 24 G3 Prix de Fontainebleau, Marquise de Moratalla's homebred **Tin Horse (Ire)**

(Sakhee) pulled it all together for the big occasion yesterday to storm Longchamp's G1 Poule d'Essai des Poulains.

Settled in a prominent fourth early, the 8-1 chance found the gaps in time to

inhale **Havane Smoker (GB)** (Dubawi {Ire}) in impressive fashion with 100 yards to race before dashing to a two-length success under Thierry Jarnet. "This horse deserves a big one and was one of the best, if not the best, 2-year-olds in France last year," trainer Didier Guillemin commented. "He was unlucky on his first run back in the Fontainebleau and had come on a lot for it, so we expected a good performance and Thierry gave him a lovely ride." Cont. p2

Introduced over five furlongs at Chantilly in May, Tin Horse demonstrated raw speed to win by three lengths and further underlined his precocity when following up with a four-length score in a 5 1/2-furlong conditions event at Maisons-Laffitte in June. That served as an ideal prep for the course-and-distance G2 Prix Robert Papin at the end of July, but the grey flopped when only fifth there. Rebounding with a strong-finishing second after meeting traffic behind Dream Ahead (Diktat {GB}) in the G1 Prix Morny over six furlongs at Deauville in August, he looked in need of a step up in trip and was duly put forward for the G1 Prix Jean-Luc Lagardere over an extra panel on Arc day.

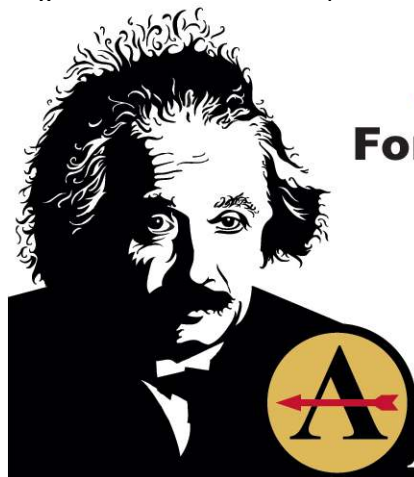
Again short of racing room at a vital stage in that contest, he stayed on to share the runner-up spot with **Maiguri (Ire)** (Panis) as **Wootton Bassett (GB)** (Iffraaj {GB}) dominated from the front. As far as his fortunes were concerned, a new season did not immediately represent a change for the better with his comeback in the Prix de Fontainebleau over this track and trip again marred by a troubled trip. In the event, he performed with credit to overcome some hefty bumps during the bunch sprint in the latter stages and was an eyecatcher as he chased home **Glaswegian (GB)** (Selkirk) in third there. With that past history in mind, Thierry Jarnet was keen to chase him up from the outset to hold a prominent position from his inside draw. With Wootton Bassett again shooting off in the lead and setting strong fractions, Tin Horse was able to draft in behind him and the stalker Havane Smoker with **Modern History (Ire)** (Shamardal) keeping him boxed in against the fence. The latter failed to pick up on his outside inside the final quarter, and the winner was granted vital racing room to chase down the faltering long-time leader and the eventual runner-up who had taken over with a furlong remaining. Given two flicks with the whip, he responded with an irresistible surge to overwhelm Havane Smoker and Ioritz Mendizabal as **Venomous (GB)** (Red Ransom) closed with effect out wide. Trainer Didier Guillemin, who is based at Mont-de-Marsan in the South-West of France, has a dilemma regarding the winner's next target. "The G1 Prix du Jockey-Club is in three weeks and traveling horses back and forth from my stable takes a lot out of them, so we will have to see," he explained. "He is also not certain to stay, so we will see how he comes out of this but I would say at this stage that it is doubtful he will go to Chantilly."

Connections of runner-up Havane Smoker are looking at the G3 Jersey S. over seven furlongs at Royal Ascot June 15, while David Powell, Racing Manager for Venomous' owner Magalen Bryant said, "I thought he was second when I was watching from the stands, so I was disappointed that he was actually third, but he has run a great race. A mile is as far as he wants to go and the ground was excellent, but he would be even better on firmer, so we'll see where we go with him now." Robin O'Ryan, assistant to Wootton Bassett's trainer Richard Fahey, told *PA Sport*, "[Jockey] Paul [Hanagan] felt he ran a bit fresh and a bit free. He had no prep race and it was always the worry. He had to bounce him out to get a position and he just didn't get home."

Golden Lilac, whose dam Grey Lilas (Ire) (Danehill) was runner-up to Torrestrella (Ire) (Orpen) in this race seven years ago, was given a gentle education in two mile conditions events at Saint-Cloud in the Fall. Passing those early tests in textbook fashion, she was back for the Prix de la Grotte, and duly set herself up for another slice of Classic glory for the Gestut Ammerland-Andre Fabre connection in that all-important course-and-distance prep. Unlike that partnership's 2010 G1 Poulains hero Lope de Vega (Ire) (Shamardal), Golden Lilac was handed a favorable draw in six and, as ever over this mile, that proved a major advantage. Keen early with only the habitual front-runner Glorious Sight in front and eventual third **Wild Wind (Ger)** (Danehill Dancer {Ire}) alongside, the imposing bay had a perfect lead all the way down Longchamp's "false straight" and into the early part of the home stretch. With nothing in behind picking up steam, the homebred was caressed to quicken in Olivier Peslier's inimitable style and responded by sweeping by the long-time leader as if it was a strong piece of work on the 'Les Aigles' gallop.

The winner of the G1 Premio Roma over this course and distance in November 2008, Estejo's last victory was in the Sept. 19 Listed Premio Del Piazzale at Milan and, following a disappointing 10th in the G1 Premio Vittorio di Capua back at that venue Oct. 9, the German raider returned here to place third in the Premio Roma Nov. 7. Marking his seasonal return with a Mar. 22 conditions score at Milan once more, he was narrowly defeated by Cima de Pluie (GB) (Singspiel {Ire}) in the G3 Premio Ambrosiano at back there Apr. 24, and tracked the sound early pace set by stable bunny Russian King (Ger) (Tertullian) in third here. Pushed along at the three-furlong marker, Estejo was angled off the rail at the quarter pole and finished powerfully under a drive to hit the front 150 yards from the post, comfortably holding the staying-on Voila Ici.

Prairie Star prevailed by a neck from Bubble Chic (Fr) (Chichicastenango {Fr}) in the G3 Prix de Conde over 1 1/8 miles here in October before trailing that rival and the impressive winner Recital (Fr) (Montjeu {Ire}) when third in the following month's G1 Criterium de Saint-Cloud. Splitting Baraan (Fr) (Dalakhani {Ire}) and the subsequent G2 Prix Greffulhe scorer Pour Moi (Ire) (Montjeu {Ire}) in the G3 Prix la Force back at this venue last time Apr. 10, the homebred built on that effort with a gutsy score in this Prix du Jockey-Club trial. Settled in second early as Frankie Dettori took up pace-setting duties on Genius Beast, the bay traveled with ease to his quarters at the top of the straight and went by as the long-time leader started to tread water passing the quarter pole. Tackled wide by the hold-up merchant Grand Vent, he dug in to hold on to a slender advantage. the horse beat, but he never disgraced himself. Now we're back where he's best. We'll keep him sprinting. We have no plans right now... [but] I'm pretty excited about his prospects." Bench Points was bred by former trainer Gary Rocks, who sold his interest in the colt privately before he debuted. The gelding's ownership group includes Donnie Crevier, who co-owns Crevier BMW/Mini in Santa Ana, CA and also founded Crevier Classic Cars in Costa Mesa, CA; and Linda Mariani, whose husband, Frank, is CEO of the LA Lakers basketball team.

## SO. HEMISPHERE RESULTS

**TIMEO TOPS IN SAN PAULO** Despite the overwhelming backing bestowed upon last year's Horse of the Year **Sal Grosso (Brz)** (Our Emblem), it was **Timeo (Brz)** (First American) who walked away with the lion's share of the prize in Sunday's G1 Grande Premio Sao Paulo at Cidade Jardim Racecourse in Sao Paulo. Contested over 2400 meters on turf, the 4-year-old bested **Jeca (Brz)** (Inexplicable) by half a length, with the favorite back in third. Campaigned by Stud Yatasto, Timeo settled in mid-pack early and launched his bid late to nail Jeca in the final strides. Timeo, who is trained by Dulcino Guignoni, won the G3 Grande Premio Presidente Arthur da Costa e Silva last time out. Earlier in his career, he accounted for a pair of Group 1 wins--G1 Grande Premio Joao Adhemar de Almeida Prado and G1 Grande Premio Linneo de Paula Machado.

Also on yesterday card, 3-year-old Equitana (Brz) (Romarin {Brz})--became the first filly in 15 years to take the G1 Grande Premio Presidente da Republica. On the lead early, she had enough energy late to hold off the charge of favorite **Salute (Arg)** (Pure Prize). Bred and owned by Haras Europa, Equitana completed the mile in 1:33.020 for trainer Alexandre Garcia Saldanha Correa. Equitana had previously annexed G1 Grande Premio Joao Cecilio Ferraz..

Sao Paulo's Day also featured the G1 Grande Premio Juliano Martins, in which juvenile **Veraneio (Brz)** (Signal Tap) stamped himself the leader of his division with his narrow victory. Ridden by Vagner Leal, the bay took the lead from favored **Iaquinta (Brz)** (Romarin) with 50 meters to go and had enough left to hand his rival a 3/4 of a length defeat. Foaled at Haras Santa Maria de Araras and owned by Stud Power Five, the colt is trained by Estanislau Petrochinski, who also saddled last year's winner of the Argentine G1 GP Carlos Pellegrini, Xu Xin Lin (Brz) (Wondetross).

Apanane, winner of the Triple Crown for fillies in Japan last term, returned from a five-month hiatus to be fourth in her 2011 debut in the G2 Milers Cup last month. Forced to stand in the shadow of last year's Horse of the Year Buena Vista, the 4-year-old was sent off the well-supported second choice behind the winner of last season's G1 Tenno Sho and runner-up in the G1 Japan Cup and G1 Arima Kinen. Breaking smoothly from the 16 hole, Apanane settled in mid-division early, while Buena Vista trailed near the back of the pack. Third choice Lady Alba Rosa assumed control at the 400-meter marker, while Apanane mounted her challenge from the outside. Up to take command 50 meters out, Apanane battled with the leader late and appeared en route to victory. Buena Vista closed stoutly from the outside and, despite displaying a powerful rally, found herself a neck behind her younger rival at the wire.

**Dance City Drills at Churchill...**

The Estate of Edward P Evans' **Dance City** (City Zip) worked five furlongs in company with stablemate Escort (First Samurai) at Churchill Downs Sunday morning in preparation for Saturday's GI Preakness S. With Fernando Espinoza up, the GI Arkansas Derby show horse broke a half-length behind his workmate, and traveled in splits of :11.80, :23.20, :34.80 and :46.60 en route to a published five-furlong drill in 1:00.20. That tied for the fastest of five works that took place after the renovation break, when the track was upgraded from "muddy" to "good." Dance City had a five-length edge on Escort by the end of the work, and he galloped out six furlongs in 1:14.20. "We waited on purpose because we wanted a harrowed track," Todd Pletcher's assistant Mike McCarthy explained of the decision to wait until after the renovation break. "I like what I see from him here and I was very pleased with his work today." McCarthy also noted the boost the Arkansas Derby got when fifth-place finisher and ☆ **"TDN Rising Star"** ☆ Alternation (Distorted Humor) scored in Saturday's GII Peter Pan S., adding to runner-up Nehro (Mineshaft)'s second in the GI Kentucky Derby. "The Arkansas Derby has turned out to be a very live race," noted McCarthy.

**Nehro Decision Expected Today...**

A decision as to whether or not GI Kentucky Derby runner-up **Nehro** (Mineshaft) will run in the Preakness will be made this morning, pending a scheduled drill at Churchill Downs. "I am leaving for Louisville in a few hours and I will be there to watch the horse breeze at Churchill Downs at 6 a.m. Monday," owner Ahmed Zayat said Sunday. "Right now I am 70-30 to run in the [June 11 GI] Belmont S. and 50-50 to run in the Preakness. He's had three good races in six weeks; if he goes in the Preakness, it will be four races in eight weeks." Zayat continued, "However, he is doing very well. His coat, his energy level, his demeanor have all been excellent since the Derby. After he breezes Monday, I will sit down with [trainer] Steve Asmussen and make a decision as to where we go." Zayat also has the Bob Baffert-trained **Jaycito** (Victory Gallop) pointing to the Belmont. "We are hoping he will have enough fitness in him," Zayat said of last year's GI Norfolk S. hero, who was last seen finishing second in the GII San Felipe S. at Santa Anita Mar. 12.





**King Congie Works Slowly, but Effectively...**

West Point Thoroughbreds LLC's **King Congie** (Badge of Silver), who was third, beaten a head by stablemate Brilliant Speed (Dynaformer) in the Apr. 16 GI Blue Grass S., prepped for the Preakness on Belmont's main track with the dogs up yesterday morning. The dark bay was credited with a five-furlong drill in 1:04.65, the slowest of four workouts recorded at the distance while the track was deemed sloppy. "He worked really good," trainer Tom Albertrani told *Daily Racing Form*. "I basically was looking for an easy work today--he did enough last week. I was looking for a 1:02 and, compensating for the dogs being up, I got what I was looking for. I thought he was finishing strong and he had a nice gallop out." Robby Albarado has the mount on King Congie in the Preakness.

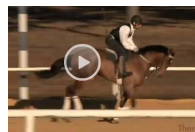
