ASMUSSEN'S PREAKNESS POSSIBLES WORK

The Steve Asmussen-trained duo of **Astrology** (A.P. Indy) and **Nehro** (Mineshaft) both worked half miles over a sloppy and sealed Churchill Downs track Monday ahead possible tilts at Saturday's GI Preakness S. Stonestreet Stable and George Bolton's Astrology covered the distance in :51.60. He went in fractions of

:14.40, :27.40 and :39.40 and galloped out five furlongs in 1:06.20. "He went over the track very well, very handy," Asmussen said. "There were concerns about an awfully wet race track this morning, but he handled it well and went over it well." Astrology, considered a definite starter in the Preakness, was second in

the Mar. 27 GIII Sunland Derby and again in the Apr. 23 GII Jerome S. in two starts this term. Nehro, runner-up in the GI Kentucky Derby, went a half-mile in :50.80. Still officially listed as 'possible' for the Preakness, the Zayat Stables runner was timed in :12.80, :25.40 and :37.80 and galloped out five furlongs in 1:05.20. "We'll just have to evaluate how he's doing, how he comes out of the work and how he's acting," Asmussen explained. "I thought he went over the racetrack well and travelled good." The trainer added that a decision will be made today, with a flight from Churchill to Baltimore scheduled for Wednesday.

oversubscribed field. "I haven't talked to [owners George and Lori Hall] yet, but I don't believe we're going to make the Preakness," Breen said. "I'll talk to them later today and try to see what's best for the horse. It's a long year. We might think about the Belmont, but I'm not sure. He came out of that last race with low blood and we're just

trying to get him pumped up right now." Linda Gaudet, who owns Concealed Identity in partnership with Morris Bailey, reported the Tesio winner was "80-20" to run in the Preakness. "We're very realistic," Gaudet, the wife of trainer Eddie Gaudet said. "We're shooting for the stars, but other than the horses from the Derby--the 1-2-3-4 finishers that are coming--we're on the same page with the other horses. The horse has run very well at Pimlico and has done everything we've asked."

Midnight Interlude Tunes Up

G1 Santa Anita Derby winner **Midnight Interlude** (War Chant) tuned up for Saturday's Preakness with a three-furlong move in :35.60. The Arnold Zetcher runner worked an opening furlong in :12 and then galloped out in :48.60 and 1:02.80. "He acted like he got into his work this morning," trainer Bob Baffert reported. "The track was a little greasy this morning and we haven't had the best of luck with him here catching fast tracks for works. After what I saw today, we are going to the Preakness. I feel pretty good about him. I think he is better now than he was before the Derby." Midnight Interlude is looking for redemption after a 16th-place effort in the Derby. "He never really ran in the Derby; he just laid a big goose egg," Baffert added. "His Santa Anita Derby was a good race, and if he runs back to that, he's right in the mix."

GOLDIKOVA ON COURSE FOR RETURN

Goldikova (Ire) (Anabaa) was the subject of a positive bulletin from Freddy Head as she nears her seasonal debut in Longchamp's G1 Prix d'Isipahan. The Wertheimers' 6-year-old will start on the trail to another G1 Breeders' Cup Mile in the extended nine-furlong contest that she won 12 months ago. "Goldikova has been brilliant in her work and will have a gallop tomorrow morning," her trainer told the *Racing Post*. "She is so well and appears still very much in love with the game."

LUCILLE STEPHENS DIES Lucille Stephens, the widow of famed trainer Woody Stephens, died Saturday in Miami Lakes, Florida. She was 93. Woody Stephens, who trained five straight G1 Belmont S. winners, died in 1998. The couple was married for 60 years. Funeral services will be held 12:30 p.m. Thursday at Kerr Brothers Funeral Home on Harrodsburg Road in Lexington. Interment will be at Hillcrest Memorial Park. Visitation will be held from 10 a.m. until service time. In lieu of flowers, memorial contributions are suggested to the Belmont Child Care Association, the National Museum of Racing Hall of Fame or the Racetrack Chaplaincy of America.

IRISH GUINEAS CUTS UP

There was a raft of withdrawals at yesterday's six-day stage ahead of the G1 Abu Dhabi Irish 2000 Guineas on Saturday, with the most notable being Khalifa Dasmal's **Dream Ahead** (Diktat {GB}). Last year's G1 Prix Morny and G1 Middle Park S. winner, who was rated the juvenile joint-champion of 2010, has been conspicuous by his absence so far this term but trainer David Simcock is not willing to push his stable star during the prolonged dry spell. "Dream Ahead won't be running in Ireland--the forecast is not in his favour," he explained. "It has been a difficult spring for us, as we feel we haven't been able to do the work on grass with the horse that we would liked to have done. We've always genuinely felt that he is a horse who needs cut in the ground. With it having been so dry for so long, it has been frustrating. At the same time, I am delighted with his mindset and how he is, physically. Our next option is the G1 St James's Palace S. [at Royal Ascot June 14], allowing for good ground or easier." Others to be scratched yesterday included the Silverton Hill Partnership's G1 2000 Guineas flop **Pathfork** (Distorted Humor), last year's GII Breeders' Cup Juvenile Turf winner **Pluck** (More Than Ready) and Godolphin's G1 Racing Post Trophy hero **Casamento (Ire)** (Shamardal). Among the 11 in the mix for the mile Classic is Andrew Tinkler's 2000 Guineas runner-up **Dubawi Gold (GB)** (Dubawi {Ire}), who was supplemented at a cost of €32,500 by trainer Richard Hannon. Aidan O'Brien left in a quintet, including last year's G1 Phoenix S. scorer **Zoffany (Ire)** (Dansili {GB}), but he was another to fall by the wayside after it was revealed that he had suffered from a bout of colic yesterday. "Zoffany had a slight colic this afternoon, he has received treatment for it and will therefore unfortunately miss this Saturday's Guineas," Anne-Marie O'Brien tweeted. Ballydoyle could still be represented by last year's G1 Criterium International winner **Roderic O'Connor (Ire)** (Galileo {Ire})--another who was left trailing in the Newmarket Classic--and the Kentucky Derby fifth **Master of Hounds** (Kingmambo), while another notable is John Connaughton's Mar. 27 G3 Leopardstown 2000 Guineas Trial winner **Dunboyne Express (Ire)** (Shamardal) from the Kevin Prendergast stable.

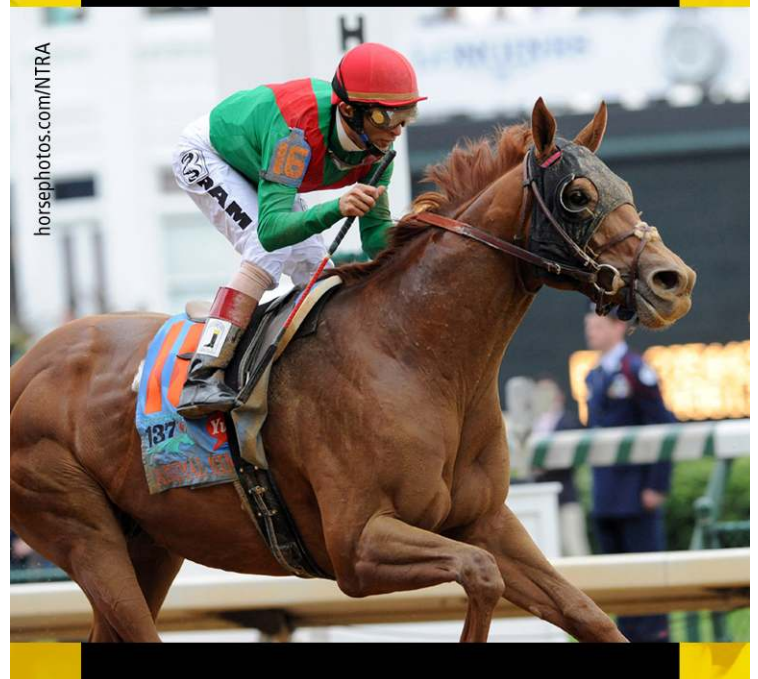

NJTHA TO TAKE MONMOUTH PLANS TO MEMBERSHIP The Board of the New Jersey Thoroughbred Horsemen's Association held lengthy talks with Morris Bailey Monday regarding the Monmouth Park schedule and purse structure, but left the session without signing off on Bailey's proposal. Without releasing the details of the plan, NJTHA President John Forbes explained, "The Board had a cordial meeting with Morris Bailey and, given the length of the agreement we're looking at, we decided we wanted to poll the general membership before making a decision. We have to set up a general membership meeting as soon as possible--we've got to round everybody up. The Board was just uncomfortable making that kind of commitment without input from the membership." Bailey, a real estate developer and Thoroughbred owner, finalized an agreement with the state last Thursday to take over the operation of Monmouth under a five-year lease agreement. He is expected to take control of the track next month.

EFTBA APPOINTS NEW CHAIRMAN AND BOARD

Edited Press Release

Rhydian Morgan-Jones was appointed the new chairman of the European Federation of Thoroughbred Breeders' Associations at the group's general meeting, held May 15 at Longchamp Racecourse. Nearly 30 delegates from the main E.U. Thoroughbred breeding countries attended the annual event. Joining Morgan-Jones is Charles Henri de Moussac and Milo Halik as vice presidents. Andreas Tiedtke assumes the position of Treasurer, while Princess Zahra Aga Khan remains in place as honorary chairman. Following the meeting, His Highness the Aga Khan was presented with an award--accepted by Georges Rimaud--to thank him for his many years in supporting the European racing and breeding industry.

"As more and more decisions in Brussels affect us, having an effective European Federation is increasingly important," the outgoing chairman Joe Hernon said in his closing speech. "I have been honoured to chair the federation for the last three years, and the extent of the work has been surprising. I now hand over to the next chairman a full portfolio. This year, we need to work on the European Commission's Green Paper on online gambling, and a review of Animal Welfare in Transport among other things."

Hernon added, "EFTBA has also been very active on the veterinary and disease control side and the chairman of our Veterinary Advisory Committee, Tim Richardson, has been instrumental in making sure that EFTBA respond in depth to EU consultations and proposals. I am delighted he is to stay on as a vice chairman of the veterinary committee and welcome Dr. Des Leadon as the new chairman. The importance of the veterinary committee and the direct effects of its work for breeders can be seen for example in its current work on emerging issues arising from genetic testing. EFTBA also provides a very useful quarterly veterinary newsletter for breeders.

"EFTBA supports all Thoroughbred breeders throughout Europe--it is important for associations to come together to share information. It also has a very important job in making sure that the specific requirements of Thoroughbred breeders are taken into account at the highest levels of E.U. policy making in Brussels. What happens in Brussels can be seen in the way run our businesses and, at the bottom line, our profits. This is widely recognized and again I need to thank the individual studs who have supported us: France: Aga Khan Studs, Haras de Fresnay, Haras de Saint Pair du Mont, Haras de Petit Tellier, Haras de Quesnay, Haras de la Perelle, Haras de St Leonard, Haras D'Etream Ireland: Coolmore, Irish National Stud, Rathbarry UK: Darley, Lanwades, Juddmonte."
