ANIMAL KINGDOM SET FOR BELMONT

Team Valor International's GI Kentucky Derby hero and GI Preakness S. runner-up **Animal Kingdom** (Leroidesanimaux {Brz}) has been confirmed for the GI Belmont S. June 11, trainer Graham Motion revealed Friday. "We just made the decision that he will be coming to the Belmont," Motion commented from his Fair Hill base. "He bounced out of the Preakness very well and we are looking forward to running in the Belmont S. He will probably come to Belmont Park the week leading up to race,

depending on where we decide to have his final workout." Animal Kingdom attempts to become the 12th horse to complete the Derby/Belmont double. Champion Thunder Gulch (Gulch) was the last to pull it off in 1995. Preakness winner **Shackleford** (Forestry), currently in training at Churchill Downs, has yet to be confirmed for the final leg of the Triple Crown.

Liberian Freighter has turned in a pair of huge efforts on the front end in his last two starts, posting a 9-1 surprise in the GII Arcadia H. at Santa Anita Apr. 9 before fending off **Ryehill Dreamer** and **The Usual Q.T.** in the GIII Inglewood H. over this course Apr. 24. His style may be compromised here by the presence of **Sidney's Candy**, who could be any kind on turf. The 2010 GI Santa Anita Derby hero established a new course record when shifted to the infield for Del Mar's GII La Jolla H. last August. In his only other appearance on sod, the chestnut made the running in the GI Breeders' Cup Mile, but couldn't fend off the likes of Goldikova (Ire) (Anabaa), and wound up sixth by three lengths. After romping in the off-the-turf GIII Sir Beaufort S. on Santa Anita's opening day, the swift colt didn't face the starter again until May 7, when he failed to withstand Crown of Thorns (Repent) in the GII Mervyn LeRoy H. on the local Cushion Track.

Look for the ^(K) throughout the TDN graded stakes entries, denoting Keeneland sales graduates.

Trainer Eoin Harty, who saddled the 3-year-old colt to a victory over Riveting Reason (Fusaichi Pegasus) in the GII Robert B. Lewis S. at Santa Anita Feb. 12, said the colt would be turned out for 30 days. "I gave up on chasing the Triple Crown," Harty told *DRF*. "I was fighting it. Hopefully, I can get him ready for the Travers." Third to Tapizar (Tapit) in the GIII Sham S. in January, Anthony's Cross took the Robert Lewis by a nose, but hasn't raced since finishing fifth to Midnight Interlude (War Chant) in the GI Santa Anita Derby Apr. 9. In late April, he began to spike a temperature after serious exercise, and was diagnosed with an infection in his neck that required antibiotics. The \$300,000 FTSAUG yearling has won two of seven starts and earned \$215,020.

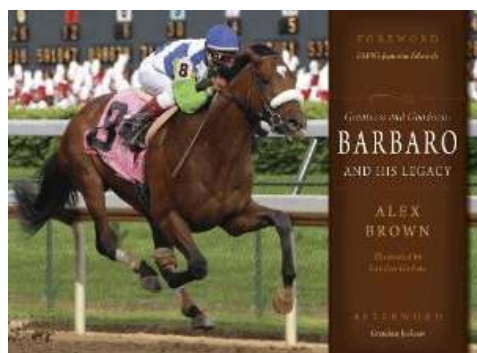


TDN Book Review

GOODNESS AND GREATNESS: BARBARO AND HIS LEGACY, by Alex Brown

Reviewed by Nicole Mattei-Lince

Five years after that fateful Preakness day, another book on the ill-fated Kentucky Derby winner Barbaro has been published, *Goodness and Greatness: Barbaro And His Legacy* (Glen View Media, 235 pages, \$29.99). This one, though, offers something more than just a recap of what every racing fan, and most non-racing



fans, already know. Through the lens of a detailed photographic journal, writer Alex Brown immerses readers in behind-the-scenes moments and introduces the greater public to laminitis--the fatal hoof disease

that ultimately claimed not only Barbaro's life, but the lives of Secretariat, Affirmed, Sunday Silence, and countless other equine athletes.

The man behind TimWoolleyRacing.com, whose 2006 blog carefully followed Barbaro's story, Brown replays the year's Triple Crown season, accompanied by his personal experiences working at Fair Hill Training Center, the home base of trainer Michael Matz and therefore the official camp of Barbaro. Brown's retelling captures the propensity of human emotions with horse racing during the entire Barbaro venture.

Details of the Kentucky Derby and intended Preakness viewing parties at Fair Hill are a reminder that no matter where you're from or the greatness that you've achieved, everyone has those small-town roots that lay the foundation for any champion. This is reinforced through Brown's tributes to Kathee Rengert, who initiated the discussion for the Jackson's to purchase Barbaro's dam La Ville Rogue; or Sanborn Chase, where Barbaro was foaled; or Jill and John Stephens, who trained Barbaro as a yearling. Even in the darker hours during the waiting game at the University of Pennsylvania's New Bolton Center, Brown finds the spark of co-owner Gretchen Jackson, as she devotedly gave thanks to her champion each and every day by delivering freshly picked grass from the Jacksons' home.

Brown takes the time to pay credit where credit is not only deserved, but so often overlooked. When Peter Rotondo, NTRA vice president for television, spends an extended time with the Jacksons, Michael Matz, and jockey Edgar Prado reviewing different angles of the Preakness tapes at New Bolton in an attempt to identify any specific pre-cursor to the breakdown, Brown highlights the human compassion that the racing industry is all too often said to be lacking. Subtle details such as these bring a humbling quality to the Barbaro story and to racing in general. While one chapter spends an undue amount of time trying to prove Barbaro's stature as a "great" racehorse, most of the pages are pure nostalgia of the feel-good kindness combined with the thoughts and experiences of racing's A-listers. Providing readers with a wonderfully detailed photographic essay, he also takes the time to look past Barbaro, and at how the experience can promote future advances in veterinary medicine, while also paying homage to how far veterinary medicine has already advanced. With the innovation of the recovery pool, Brown explains how this new post-surgery setup can prevent dangerous scenarios where a horse attempts to stand too quickly, a system that could have saved the life of Ruffian, for example.

Following up with a deconstruction of laminitis, Brown details the disease in a simple format; prompting a call for laminitis research, while paying the utmost respect to one of horse racing's fallen heroes. A nostalgic coffee-table read, Brown's *Greatness and Goodness: Barbaro And His Legacy* is an insightful tale for the seasoned horseplayer to the newest member of the horse racing generation.

Quantum Miss followed her success in the GIII Cicada S. at Aqueduct Mar. 19 with a front-running tally under 124 pounds in the Trevoise S. at Parx Apr. 19, and was deemed a mortal lock here. She made her 1-10 odds look generous, though. After breaking like a shot from her outside post, the iron grey raced well off the rail, but continued to build her advantage under a motionless Jeremy Rose. Purse Subsidies Slide in Pennsylvania:

Purse subsidies for horse tracks in Pennsylvania took a 16.7% hit in 2010 from the comparable 2009 figure, though the number was still up from 2008, according to a report released Thursday by the Pennsylvania Gaming Control Board. In its yearly Casino/Racetrack Benchmark Report, the PGCB said that Thoroughbred and Standardbred tracks in the state received purse supplements of \$157.1 million in 2010, down from 2009's high-water mark of \$188.6 million. In 2008, tracks received purse subsidies totaling \$155.1 million.

The reason for the drop can be attributed to a decision by the state legislature last year to redirect a portion of the tracks' revenue to the state's general fund. The adopted measure diverted 34% of the tracks' share through the first half of 2010, at which point the percentage of diverted funds was halved to 17%. The measure continues through June of 2013.

The Pennsylvania Breeders' Fund, meanwhile, saw an 11.1% drop, from \$18.1 million in 2009 to \$16.2 million. The 2008 figure was \$14.7 million. The number of race days in Pennsylvania remained stable, with 981 race days in 2010, compared to 999 a year prior.

Approximately 12% of revenue generated from slot machines in the state is earmarked from the horse racing industry, and much of the report focused on the positives that slot revenue has had on Pennsylvania tracks. Over the past four years, purses have increased over 250%, from \$55.9 million in 2006 to \$196.4 million in 2010, while the total number of live races in has increased over 43%, from 7,958 in 2006 to 11,423 in 2010. All-source handle has increased over 32%, from \$580.2 million in 2006 to \$769.6 million in 2010.

"There continues to be no doubt that the inclusion of slot machine gaming at our six racetrack facilities is having a very positive effect on both the horse racing industry and agriculture," Gaming Control Board Chairman Greg Fajt said. "Not to be lost is also the creation of new jobs related to the horse racing industry, and the improvement of living and working conditions of racetrack workers."



Brass Hat to Parade at Churchill:

Fred Bradley's **Brass Hat** (Prized), who was retired from racing earlier this week, will be honored at Churchill Downs this afternoon. The popular 10-year-old will head to the paddock with the runners in the fifth race, which has a post time of 2:55 p.m. EDT. A ceremony honoring him and his connections will be held in the winner's circle after the race. "He still really has the want-to," said trainer Buff Bradley. "If he was ready to run in the [GIII] Louisville H., he'd be in the starting gate. But he's not ready, and I thought it would just take too much time to get him ready to compete this year."

Expanded Gaming Back on Illinois Table:

Gaming expansion legislation in Illinois, which was voted down by a State House of Representatives committee Wednesday, was reintroduced yesterday and passed, according to *Daily Racing Form*. Several of the negative votes came in response to Arlington Park's objection to a "provision concerning organized labor agreements for employees at a future racino." That portion of the bill was taken out in an amendment, and passed out of the House by an 8-3 vote. The legislation could come before the full House by next week, and would need to be passed by the Senate prior to getting the governor's signature. The proposed legislation, introduced by Rep. Lou Lang, would allow for the issue of five new casino licenses, as well as slot machines at Chicagoland airports and casinos at Illinois racetracks.

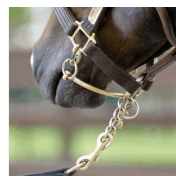
