ALTERNATION TO SKIP BELMONT

Pin Oak Stable's **Alternation** (Distorted Humor) will not contest the June 11 GI Belmont S., connections revealed yesterday. "We just decided to not come to the Belmont," explained trainer Donnie Von Hemel. "We thought we should give him a bit of a breather and point him towards races like the [July 30] GII Jim Dandy and [Aug. 27] GI Travers S. After a pair of allowance victories at Oaklawn this winter, Alternation finished fifth in the Apr. 16 GI Arkansas Derby and is coming off a win in the May 14 GII Peter Pan S.

Susan Magnier's **Master of Hounds** (Kingmambo), shipped back to Ireland after a fifth in the May 7 GI Kentucky Derby, will return to the U.S. for the Belmont on June 7 and is expected to clear quarantine June 9. In his only other sophomore start, the Aidan O'Brien trainee was second in the Mar. 26 G2 UAE Derby at Meydan.

AIKENITE SEEKS 3RD STRAIGHT IN MET MILE

Dogwood Stable's **Aikenite** (Yes It's True), off four months after an eighth-place finish in the Nov. 6 GI Breeders' Cup Dirt Mile, looks to keep his career resurgence going in today's GI Metropolitan H. at Belmont Park. The 4-year-old is the 9-2 second choice on the morning line as he stretches out to a mile after seven-furlong victories in the Apr. 16 GII Commonwealth S. and May 7 GII Churchill Downs S. "It seems like the layoff he got after the Breeders' Cup last year really did him well," reported trainer Todd Pletcher. "He's been more enthusiastic than ever, and he seems to be in really good

form. If you had to pick his absolute best distance, it might be seven-eighths, but a one-turn mile is certainly within his scope." Pletcher will also saddle **Caixa Eletronica** (Arromanches), 8-1 on the morning line, and Churchill Downs S. third-place finisher **Ibboyee** (Medallist), 15-1, in the Met Mile. Caixa Eletronica--a \$62,500 claim for Pletcher and owner Mike Repole in March--is coming off a track-and-trip win in the Apr. 30 GIII Westchester H. "We picked out the Westchester as the first spot where we were going to run him," Pletcher said. "We weren't shocked he won the Westchester, and the horse has trained well since then. He obviously relishes a one-turn mile, is in good form, and sits the right kind of trip." **Cont. p2**

TWO DOWN, NOW THE CROWN FOR ORFEVRE

Orfevre (Jpn) (Stay Gold {Jpn}), winner of the G1 Satsuki Sho at Tokyo in his most recent start Apr. 19, added a win in yesterday's G1 Japanese Derby to become the first colt in five years to claim the first two legs of the Japanese Triple Crown. Unhurried in the early going as the rain fell, the chesnut found a seam while being drawn to the outside by Kenichi Ikezoe at the head of the stretch. Full tilt at the 200-meter pole, Orfevre drew clear late to fend off the late-closing **Win Challenge (Jpn)** (Heart's Cry {Jpn}) by 1 3/4 lengths. **Cont. p3**

SILENT WITNESS HALF TOPS MAGIC MILLIONS

It didn't take long for the fireworks at yesterday's opening session of the Magic Millions National Broodmare Sale on the Gold Coast in Queensland. Group winner **Sister Madly (Aus)** (Redoute's Choice {Aus}), a half-sister to Hong Kong Horse of the Year **Silent Witness (Aus)** (El Moxie), was just the fifth horse through the ring and touched off a bidding duel that ended with a sale-topping bid of A\$1 million (*US\$1,070,000*). Segenhoe Stud secured the 5-year-old mare, who was catalogued as [Lot 706](#) by Edinburgh Park and sold as a racing or broodmare prospect. **Cont. p10**

Trainer Steve Asmussen will saddle a pair of runners in the Met Mile. Stonestreet Stable's **Kensei** (Mr. Greeley) was seventh in this race a year ago. He is looking for his first win since taking the 2009 GII Jim Dandy H.

The 5-year-old, 12-1 on the morning line, was second behind Misremembered (Candy Ride {Arg}) in the Mar. 6 Santana Mile and is coming off a fourth-place effort in the GI Carter H. "I liked his race back at Santa Anita against the Big 'Cap winner," said Asmussen assistant trainer Scott Blasi. "He ran a big number that day off the layoff. He had some trouble in the Carter and we're looking forward to having him run in a Grade I where he has a good draw and he can have a good trip." Stablemate and 7-2 morning-line favorite **Haynesfield** (Speightstown), who captured the GI Jockey Club Gold Cup last October, looks to improve on a fourth-place effort in the Apr. 30 GIII Westchester H.

Danedream, still a maiden entering this contest, has raced exclusively in black-type company. Third in the Listed Oppenheim-Rennen at Cologne in July, she was demoted from first to third in the Listed Criterium du Fonds Europeen de l'Elevage at Deauville the following month before finishing out of the money for the only time when sixth in the Oct. 3 G1 Prix Marcel Boussac at Longchamp. The bay closed her juvenile campaign with another third in the Oct. 24 G3 Preis der Winterkonigin at Baden-Baden, came back to run fourth in the Apr. 10 Listed Premio Seregno here and hit the board again in the G2 Derby Italiano at Rome last time May 7. CANDY, SETSUKO READY FOR REMATCH

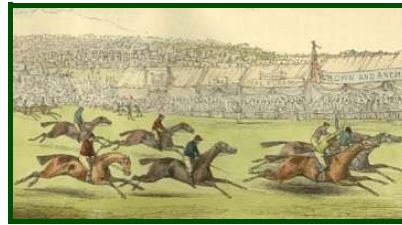

The 6-year-old was fifth in the Mar. 26 G1 Dubai World Cup in his only previous 2011 outing. Also possible for the Manhattan, **Get Stormy** (Stormy Atlantic) worked six furlongs over the Belmont turf yesterday in 1:14.14. "He's doing great, I just have to figure out where to run him," trainer Tom Bush said of the multiple Grade I winner.

"She's a beautiful mare, and Segenhoe is delighted to have purchased her," said Bill Mitchell, acting on behalf of Segenhoe. "The mare still has a future on the racetrack, and she will be heading to the stables of John Sadler in Melbourne prior to joining the broodmare band at Segenhoe. She is an outstanding type. She is by a champion sire and

is a half-sister to a champion sprinter in Silent Witness; she has a lot going for her." Sister Madly was produced by Jade Tiara (Aus) (Bureaucracy {NZ}), who also the dam of SP Very Fit (Aus) (Woodman).

The other star offering on the day was [Lot 733](#), the 4-year-old group-winning filly **Military Rose (Aus)** (General Nediym {Aus}), who was knocked down to Baramul Stud for A\$800,000. Offered by owners Hoss and Gillian Heinrich, Military Rose proved herself one of the nation's star juveniles by winning last year's Magic Millions 2YO Classic, and two races back beat males in the G3 Gold Coast Guineas. "She will race on until she heads to stud in September," Baramul Stud's Gerry Harvey reported. "Gillian [Heinrich] will keep training her for me and, hopefully, she can win another feature race or two before she is retired." Harvey said purchasing Military Rose only made sense. "I own Magic Millions, and I haven't owned a Magic Millions [Classic] winner, so I thought I would change that!" He added of future plans, "She's a top-class mare, and she will visit Redoute's Choice in her first season at stud later in the year."

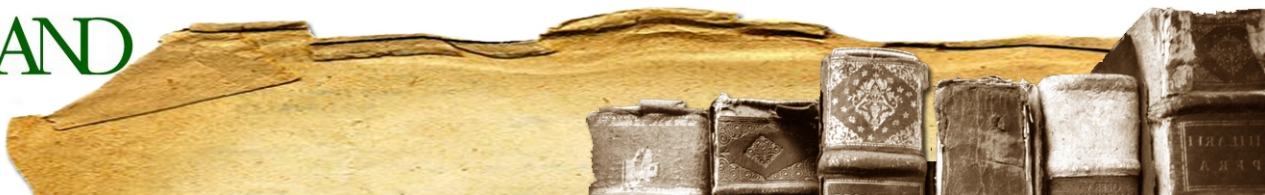

Eight Thirty was the broodmare sire of champion 2-year-old filly Evening Out and her Test S.-winning sister Belle De Nuit, as well as the top siblings Rare Treat and 3-year-old champion Jaipur.

EIGHT THIRTY AND SUN AGAIN BELMONT WINNERS

METROPOLITAN EASY FOR SON OF PILATE

Bold and Bad Second in Handicap —Calumet Youngsters Put On One-Two Act in Juvenile Stakes

NEW YORK, N. Y., May 24.—Eight Thirty gave an enthusiastic crowd of 30,000 New York racegoers a rare thrill at Belmont Park as he took up his steady impost of 132 pounds and galloped to an easy and impressive triumph in the forty-eighth running of the mile Metropolitan Handicap, which headlined today's program. Responding like the superlative performer he is to Harry Richards' every demand, Eight Thirty came from far off a good early pace to drive through between horses at the top of the home lane and on to victory by two lengths at the direct expense of Col. E. R. Bradley's feather-weighted Bold and Bad, who carried his 102 pounds home a length before Greentree Stable's stoutly finishing Hash. The last named, second highweight of the brilliant field under 123, was a head in advance of The Chief, as the latter earned fourth money.

The historic Metropolitan had as its supporting feature the sixty-fifth running of the Juvenile Stakes, in which Calumet Farm's colts, Sun Again and Some Chance, were one-two in that order well in front of The Barrington Stable's Scotland Light, as he accounted for third place. Eight Thirty's tally was the more popular of the two, for he was an odds-on public choice and returned \$3.60 for \$2, while the Wright pair paid \$10.20 in a race in which one of the entry, Some Chance, contributed to the defeat of the favored Amphitheatre in going wide at the stretch turn.

Eight Thirty was moving right along the last part of the Metropolitan, to finish out in 1:37½, though racing in the face of a strong wind that blew up the back stretch all afternoon. It was the third Metropolitan score for George D. Widener, whose Lanus and Jack High had captured earlier renewals of the stake, and Eight Thirty added \$10,250 to earlier earnings through his sparkling exhibition. As in the Toboggan, the son of Pilate made his company look ordinary and his impost appear a feather.

Bright but uncomfortably windy weather was on tap for the Westchester Racing Association's week-end offerings, but the turnstiles clicked off an attendance of 29,760, against 19,557 for the corresponding day last spring. Wagering was brisk throughout the day with Eight Thirty's score a "life saver" for many in the fashionable crowd. After the running of this feature, owner George Widener appeared in the winner's enclosure to accept the trophy from the hands of Alfred G. Vanderbilt, head of the course.

"CHIEF" JOHNSON, FORMER INDIAN RACE RIDER, DIES

LOUISVILLE, Ky., May 24.—"Chief" Johnson, former jockey and turf character, died here today at the Little Sisters of the Poor, charitable institution at which friends had paid his keep for years. A full blooded Indian, "The Chief" rode with success on mid-western, southern and Mexican tracks a quarter of a century ago. Of late years he was an indigent, but never had wanted for a thing, thanks to his race track friends. Practically blind and deaf, his age was variously placed at anywhere from seventy to eighty-five.

The illness which caused his death was sudden, for he had been a daily visitor at Churchill Downs during the recent nineteen-day meeting.

BIG HANDLE AT BELMONT

NEW YORK, N. Y., May 24.—The wagering on the half-holiday program at Belmont Park today closely approached last Saturday's state-wide record of \$1,588,009. Mort Mahony reported a handle of \$1,487,071, which meant a take of \$148,707.10. The break-age amounted to \$11,781.40.

JAMAICA PURSE CHANGES

NEW YORK, N. Y., May 24.—Dr. Edward P. Kilroe, president of the Metropolitan Jockey Club, announced today that the increase in minimum purses from \$1,200 to \$1,500, now in effect at Belmont Park, had been made retroactive for the Jamaica spring meeting just completed. Checks representing the increase will be distributed next week to those owners whose horses placed first, second, third and fourth in all races run at the meeting for a \$1,200 purse.

This step has been taken as the result of a suggestion made by the state racing commission at the close of the Jamaica meeting.

DEL MAR SEEKING OUT-OF-STATE HORSES

The Del Mar Thoroughbred Club has unveiled an incentive program designed to entice out-of-state horses to compete at its upcoming meeting. The "Ship and Win" program will reward owners of horses who start at the track who have made their previous start outside of California. Connections of qualifying horses will receive a \$1,000 check from DMTC for their first start at the meet. The same horse will become eligible for a 20% bonus on top of regular purse earnings. "There is little doubt that we're in competition with every racetrack in the country for racehorses," explained DMTC president and general manager Craig Fravel. "There is also little doubt that running a horse at Del Mar is a special thing. We hope that the incentives we are now providing enable and encourage more people to take part in that experience." The \$1,000 bonus applies to any starter in any race at Del Mar, including its full list of 42 advertised and overnight stakes. The 20% purse bonus applies only to general overnight purses, meaning stakes purses are excluded. "We have set the racing bar high at Del Mar," said DMTC's executive vice president for racing Tom Robbins. "In order to maintain that level and to deal with the reality of the current national horse inventory, we feel it is a good time to step up and offer rewards to those owners--both from within and from outside the state--who are willing to reinforce our stock of runners." The 37-day Del Mar meeting begins July 20.

Conditioner Rick Violette, Jr. was full of praise for both horse, despite her occasional gate antics, and rider. "She's a funny filly," said Violette. "In the morning, she's perfect. You could set a bomb off under her, and she'd stand still in the gate. In a race, once she gets out of the gate, she's just such a consistent filly that you'd like to have a barn full of them. 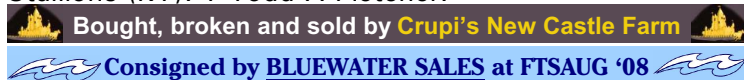
