POUR MOI, POUR VOUS

Susan Magnier, Michael Tabor and Derrick Smith's **Pour Moi (Ire)** (Montjeu {Ire}), who burst onto the Epsom scene only after a successful run in the G2 Prix Greffulhe at Saint-Cloud May 7, finally provided Andre Fabre with a victory after nine failed attempts in the G1 Investec Derby. Brought with his familiar rattle from last to first by the 19-year-old prodigy Mickael Barzalona, the 4-1 second choice grabbed the

Ballydoyle outsider **Treasure Beach (GB)** (Galileo {Ire}) in the shade of the post and his jockey standing up in the irons and celebrating. "He's a good horse, and is the one I wanted to win this race with," Fabre said after saddling the first French-trained Blue Riband winner since Empery in 1976. "It is no accident that he has won. I was surprised to see he had two accelerations, one to catch up and another gear to win. Running a mile and a half for the first time helped him. It is such a pleasure to

win this race with my young jockey--I couldn't be happier." He continued, "He gave everything today and deserves a rest. I will probably give him a summer break and bring him back for a prep ahead of the G1 Prix de l'Arc de Triomphe [at Longchamp Oct. 2]. All horses improve with time." In the end, a head separated the front two, with The Queen's 5-2 favorite **Carlton House** (Street Cry {Ire}) 3/4 of a length behind in third, having run a genuine race after missing the kick and losing a shoe late on.

CHASING HISTORY

Marcel Boussac still holds the record of 12 wins in Chantilly's G1 Prix du Jockey-Club, but His Highness the Aga Khan is creeping closer to that tally with seven spread over the last 51 years. He is double-handed in today's edition, with the Jean-Claude Rouget-trained **Baraan (Fr)** (Dalakhani {Ire}), and with **Sandagiyr (Fr)** (Dr Fong), who is looking to provide conditioner Alain de Royer-Dupre with a sixth renewal. They have experienced vastly contrasting fortune with the all-important draw here, with Baraan exiting from stall one and Sandagiyr set to break widest of all in 16. Baraan beat Ecurie Wildenstein's re-opposing **Prairie Star (Fr)** (Peintre Celebre) and Pour Moi (Ire) (Montjeu {Ire}) in Longchamp's G3 Prix la Force last time Apr. 10 and that form is strong, with the runner-up going on to annex the May 15 G2 Prix Hocquart back at that venue and Pour Moi taking the May 7 G2 Prix Greffulhe before his Epsom Derby bid yesterday. Sandagiyr, who is looking to provide his dam with back-to-back Chantilly Classics, following the exploits of his G1 Prix de Diane-winning half-sister Sarafina (Fr) (Refuse To Bend {Ire}) in 2010, steps up from a mile after registering a first black-type win in the Listed Prix de Pontarme here May 20. De Royer-Dupre, who also saddles the Pride Racing Club's unbeaten **Reliable Man (GB)** (Dalakhani {Ire}), told *Racing Post*, "The only question is the trip as he has never won over more than a mile. His half-sister Sarafina started over this distance, and ended up running over 2,400 metres." **Cont. p6**

In French racing terms, Andre Fabre is as close to a monarch as it is possible to be, and his achievements are much revered in all circles. While his Epsom runners have not always captured the imagination in the past, Pour Moi did just that when putting up a show of dramatic acceleration to come from the tail of the field in the 10-furlong G2 Prix Greffulhe at Saint-Cloud on his latest start May 7.

Flown over to experience the Downs at the "Breakfast With the Stars" gathering last Thursday, the bay exhibited his impressive acceleration once again to the waiting media.

Despite that compelling recent evidence, the fact remained that very few Derby winners start their careers with an unplaced effort at Fontainebleau and, on his penultimate outing, he had ruined his chance by racing freely and finishing third behind tomorrow's G1 Prix du Jockey-Club contenders Baraan (Fr) (Dalakhani {Ire}) and Prairie Star (Fr) (Peintre Celebre) in the Apr. 10 G3 Prix la Force at Longchamp Apr. 10. One of the quickest to break here, he was restrained by Mickael Barzalona and the anchor was down as he allowed all 12 opponents to pass him by. Carlton House, sluggish from the stalls, had been allowed to find his feet gradually by Ryan Moore, who had a target on his back as Pour Moi tracked him down the outer after Tattenham Corner. **Cont. p3**

The two market leaders were still well off the main action as Treasure Beach was sent past his stable companion and pacesetter **Memphis Tennessee (Ire)** (Hurricane Run {Ire}) approaching the final furlong, but neither Moore nor Barzalona was panicking. For a prolonged period, it looked as if The Queen's runner would prevail as he began to eat into the leader's advantage in the final eighth. Although his work rate was high, the Royal representative could never quite make it past the eventual runner-up, and it was left to the Gallic challenger to sweep past with his rider adopting an unorthodox pose for the photo finish. Winning co-owner John Magnier summed up the prevailing underlying sense of disappointment for the royalists when saying, "I wish that somebody else owned the third horse, but that's racing. Andre was confident for the last few weeks, and told us he had more speed than Peintre Celebre--he was telling everyone in the box to back him." Michael Tabor added, "It was utopia--sensational. He was out the back, but he had to be ridden that way and, although it was a tall order, we knew he was very good, and it's not a surprise."

Bringing the House Down...

Carlton House's troubled lead-up to this race has been well-documented and he suffered some misfortunes in running also, being pushed wide on the turn for home and losing a front shoe. Trainer Sir Michael Stoute told *PA Sport*, "He's run very well, but things just haven't gone right. He had a hold-up close to the race and during it he got too far back and then had to run wide into the straight. He's still a high-class colt, and he will have a big day." Aidan O'Brien expressed himself pleased with all his four runners, three of whom made the first six, while the deputising rider of **Recital (Fr)**, Pat Smullen, said, "We had a lovely run down into the straight, but once we got there he didn't handle the camber and kept lying over the top of the fence."

Fallon Barred From Derby Ride...

Kieren Fallon was yesterday forced to sit on the sidelines for the G1 Investec Derby after the Court of Appeal granted an injunction to the owner of Native Khan (Fr) (Azamour {Ire}). While it was expected on Friday that Fallon would be able to partner Recital (Fr) (Montjeu {Ire}) after the High Court judge refused the request, Ibrahim Araci's appeal was successful, and Pat Smullen was called up as his replacement on the Ballydoyle contender. Fallon had signed a contract with Native Khan's owner Araci that allowed the latter the option of calling on his services when possible. Lord Justice Jackson said, "The defendant voluntarily entered into a contract for substantial reward containing both positive and negative clauses. There is nothing special about the world of racing that entitles the major players to act in flagrant breach of contract. He said he would not compete against Native Khan, and, in my view, that should be invoked and I grant an injunction. Some members of the public bet on Native Khan as they thought that the defendant would be riding the horse. When members of the public bet on horses, they run a multitude of risks. I accept that the risk of an injunction is rather less than the risk of injury, but it is one of the vicissitudes of life. The defendant brought this on himself with a deliberate and cynical disregard for the contract he entered in to. He did not improve his position by producing evidence that must be treated as untruthful." Araci's acting solicitor Mehmet Ali Erdogan commented, "It was a breach of contract, and my client is very happy with the judgment. He believes in the Derby and the British judgment system and knows they're bigger than Kieren Fallon." Graeme McPherson QC, representing Fallon, said, "He's very disappointed, but he wishes the connections of Native Khan, Recital and Pat Smullen the best of luck in the race, and will be watching closely from the changing room."

Success at Epsom? It's in the Genes ...

Pour Moi, bred by Paul Shanahan's Lynch Bages Ltd., may have close ties to Ireland through the Coolmore associate, but he hails from a truly international family. And one, it should be added, that has enjoyed great success at Epsom. His third dam was the E.P. Taylor-bred Royal Statute (Northern Dancer), a winning half to six stakes winners--five of those in Canada--including three-time Canadian champ Dance Act. Royal Statute didn't earn black-type herself, but she launched perhaps the most active branch of a hugely successful family. Her daughter Awaasif (*Snow Knight)--another bred by Taylor--was named champion 3-year-old filly in England in 1982, and holds the distinction of being the first-ever Group 1 winner for Sheikh Mohammed, who had purchased her as a yearling for \$325,000. Awaasif, in turn, produced Snow Bride (Blushing Groom {Fr}), heroine of the Epsom Oaks in 1989 (by DQ), who in turn produced Lammtarra, undefeated winner of the 1995 Epsom Derby and G1 Prix de l'Arc de Triomphe. This is also the family of Hector Protector (Woodman) and full-sister Bosra Sham.

Sheikh Mohammed also purchased Pour Moi's second dam, Victoress (Conquistador Cielo). Darley signed for her for a cool \$1 million at the 1985 Keeneland July Sale. She enjoyed limited success on the track and as a producer, though two of her daughters have continued on in the family tradition and are now stakes producers. That, of course, includes Pour Moi's dam Gwynn (Ire), who ironically wound up in the hands of Darley's rival Coolmore.

The unraced Gwynn (Sadler's Wells), a 250,000gns Tattersalls yearling acquisition by BBA Ireland in 1998, produced three foals prior to Pour Moi. The first, bred by Coolmore associate Quay Bloodstock, included the filly Gagnoa (Ire), who was sold by the Coolmore group for €190,000 as a 2006 DEAAUG yearling. Gagnoa won the G3 Prix des Reservoirs as a juvenile, and Coolmore interests came back to purchase the filly privately. Moved from Yves de Nicolay to Andre Fabre, Gagnoa took the G3 Prix Penelope in her first start for Derrick Smith in 2008. She was beaten just 3/4 lengths in the G1 Prix Saint-Alary, then placed second in the G1 Prix de Diane--to Zarkava (Ire), and ahead of third-placed Goldikova (Ire). Gwynn's next three foals were all bred by Shanahan's Lynch-Bages. In addition to Pour Moi, Gwynn is represented by an as-yet unraced 2-year-old filly Kissed (Ire) (Galileo {Ire}), who reportedly is in training with Aidan O'Brien, and has an unnamed Galileo (Ire) yearling filly.

A # will distinguish first-time stakes-winners, a @ will indicate first-time graded stakes-winners, a ▲ will denote a first-time Grade/Group 1 winner, a + will indicate first-time starters, an (S) will be used for state-bred races, a (C) will be used for maiden-claiming races and an (R) will be used for other restricted races.

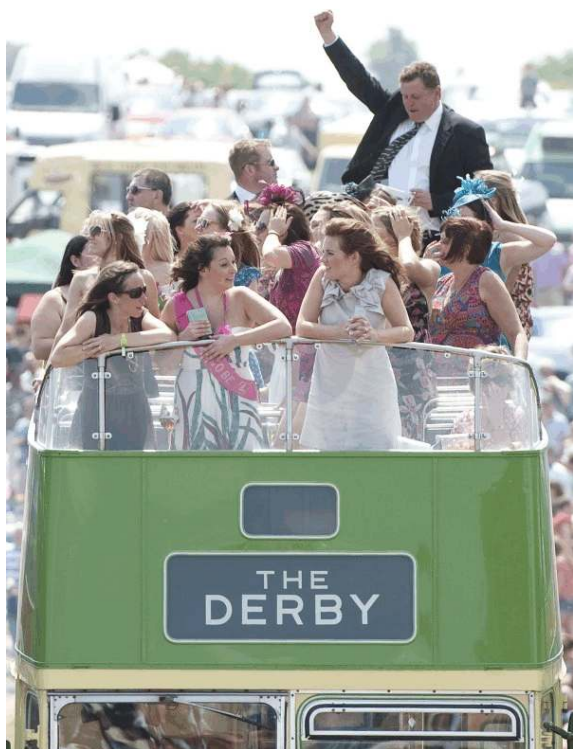

More Suitable Distance for Casamento...

Godolphin rely on **Casamento (Ire)** (Shamardal), who still boasts the highest level of form, having led home Seville (Ger) (Galileo {Ire}), Master of Hounds

(Kingmambo) and Native Khan (Fr) (Azamour {Ire}) in Doncaster's G1 Racing Post Trophy in October. Also runner-up in the G1 National S. and successful in the G2 Beresford S. for Mick Halford in September, he was brought in to deputise for the injured Dubai

Prince (Ire) (Shamardal) in Newmarket's G1 2000 Guineas on his debut in the royal blue Apr. 30.

Sent in closest pursuit of the runaway Frankel (GB) (Galileo {Ire}) there, he paid the toll for that lung-bursting effort and faded under considerate handling once the winner had taken him well beyond his comfort zone. This trip was considered more suitable than the mile and a half of Epsom's Blue Riband, and he is in the right hands, as Frankie Dettori has already ridden four winners of this Classic. As he showed on Casamento's sire in 2005--the first year it was shortened to its current distance--and on the 2007 hero Lawman (Fr) (Invincible Spirit {Ire}), the Italian has a rare talent at judging the pace here. Trainer Mahmood Al Zarooni commented, "Everything went wrong for Casamento in the 2000 Guineas. It was his first start of the season and he couldn't go with Frankel. We chased Frankel for a little bit, but you cannot catch a horse like him, and Casamento is more of a stayer. Casamento improved a lot for that run, and I have been pleased with his progress since. He looks in good order, and the step up in distance will obviously play to his strengths. He is coming up against some nice horses, and it will be tough to win, but he has some of the best form on offer, and I am hopeful that he can run a really good race."

Like Shamardal and his son Lope de Vega (Ire), **Tin Horse (Ire)** (Sakhee) bids to complete the G1 Poule d'Essai des Poulains-Prix du Jockey-Club double, which has been made more achievable with the alteration to the trip from its previous mile and a half. The Marquesa de Moratalla's grey finally delivered after a string of luckless runs, in that May 15 Longchamp Guineas, having finished third behind Khalid Abdullah's re-opposing **Glaswegian (GB)** (Selkirk) in a messy renewal of the G3 Prix de Fontainebleau over the same course and distance of that Classic Apr. 24. He is drawn in 12, but in recent times a double-figure stall proved no hindrance to Blue Canari (Fr) (Acatenango {Ger}) and the aforementioned Shamardal and Lope de Vega. Glaswegian is saddled by Pascal Bary, who has sent forward five winners since 1994, and although he was only eighth in the Poulains, connections are expecting improvement. "We were expecting him to run better in the Poulains, and the distance might have been a little sharp for him," the owner's Racing Manager Teddy Grimthorpe told the *Racing Post*.

Hilda's Passion atoned for a hiccup in the GI Humana Distaff last time out with this dominating score that came within 0.35 of the track record. The bay, who posted a mild upset to earn her first graded-stakes success in the GII Raven Run S. at Keeneland in October, fell a neck short of Tar Heel Mom (Flatter) in Gulfstream's GIII Sugar Swirl S. in her seasonal debut Jan. 15, but easily swept the final two legs of that track's distaff sprint series. Never headed when landing the GIII Hurricane Bertie S. Feb. 13 and the GII Inside Information S. Mar. 19, she set a searching pace in the Humana Distaff at Churchill May 7, and found furlong number seven a bit too tough, as she finished runner-up, three lengths off Sassy Image (Broken Vow). There was nothing in here to threaten Hilda's Passion on paper, and so it unfolded. Despite a bit of a stumble at the break, the Starlight colorbearer--giving anywhere between six and 10 pounds to four rivals--was quickly in front for Javier Castellano. She clicked off an opening quarter in :22.34, got to the half-mile in :44.91, and was on cruise control late. "I was a little worried when she stumbled a bit at the start, but she recovered so quickly," said trainer Todd Pletcher. "I think probably what we'll do is run her in the [GIII] Bed O' Roses [July 3] and then in the [GI] Ballerina [Aug. 27] at Saratoga." Hilda's Passion was bred by Mr. and Mrs. Theodore Kuster. Ted Kuster is a third-generation breeder whose family started Westview Farm in Paris, Kentucky in the 1800s. As the story goes, Kuster's grandfather bred a mare to 1873 Belmont S. winner Springbok, sold the resulting foal and purchased the farm with the proceeds. Kuster bought Hilda's Passion's dam, Executricker (El Prado {Ire}), for \$20,000 at the 2002 KEENOV sale while in foal to Mazel Trick. Hilda's Passion is her first stakes winner. The Kusters also bred High Stakes Player, a MGSW for Mike Pegram and Bob Baffert. Ted Kuster was a former president of the Kentucky Farm Managers Association and was named Farm Manager of the Year in 1989.

Always rumored to be one of the best horses--if not superior to everything--in the deep barn of John Sadler, Twirling Candy showed a new dimension in rallying from last to put his fifth at 1-2 in the GI Santa Anita H. last time out squarely behind him. A 🌟 **"TDN Rising Star"** 🌟, the dark bay took the grassy GII Del Mar Derby to run his winning streak to four to begin his career, but was fourth in the GI Goodwood S. to lose his perfect record. He rebounded to hand the gifted sprinter Smiling Tiger (Hold That Tiger) a nose defeat in the GI Malibu S. Dec. 26, skipped the GII San Fernando S. and crushed his rivals by 4 1/2 lengths in the GII Strub S. Feb. 5. There were no apparent excuses in the Mar. 5 Big 'Cap, and he was having his first run since. Racing without blinkers for the first time in his career, the Lane's End-bound runner grabbed a hard hold of the bit, as Joel Rosario did his level best to get him back in the field. Midpack and uncontrollable for the opening three-eighths of a mile, Twirling Candy didn't do it exactly willingly, but eventually came back enough to his rider and was actually last in a well-bunched field as they made the half-mile pole. Still sixth after six panels in a pedestrian 1:14.22, Rosario swung his mount out for the drive, and he closed like a proverbial freight train, getting his final furlong in :11.66 to win as half an hour the best. "We took the blinkers off because we wanted to see him relax," said Sadler. "He trains without the blinkers in the morning. It was a little puzzling to see him that far back, but then they kind of wanted to box him in, you know, which is race riding. Joel just stayed nice and cool. I'm happy to win this one today and look down the road." Down the road in this case means the GI Hollywood Gold Cup over 10 furlongs July 9.

Caleb's Posse, a stakes winner at Remington Park at two, opened 2011 with a win in the Smarty Jones S. at Oaklawn Park Jan. 17. Sixth in the GIII Southwest S. Feb. 21, he was let go at 24-1 in the GII Rebel S. Mar. 19, and picked up the pieces late to be a distant second behind The Factor (War Front). The bay was off to a rough start in the GI Arkansas Derby Apr. 16 and never got involved, finishing 12th of 13. He was making his first appearance since here. Settled well off the early pace set by dark horse Marco's Fling, he edged closer while hugging the rail as they approached the far turn. Guided to the outside by jockey Eusebio Razo Jr. nearing the lane, Caleb's Posse fanned widest of all into the stretch, charged to the front inside the eighth pole and, after a couple of left-handed taps, drew off to win handily. "I was a little bit concerned about being inside there, and I was thinking, 'How's he going to get out of this mess?'" trainer Donnie Von Hemel said. "But on the turn they kind of started separating a little bit, where you could see he could get up and out of there. I was gaining confidence at the quarter pole. He had clear sailing then and looked like he still had some run." Von Hemel added, "He's a smaller guy and he's by Posse, so the mile and a sixteenth is probably about as far as he'll want to go. As an older horse, we might even stay at some one-turn races, but right now, as a 3-year-old, he can get the job done at the mile and a sixteenth." Apapane won the G1 Japanese Oaks over this course last term en route to champion 3-year-old filly honors, and is coming off a track-and-trip victory over 2010 Horse of the Year Buena Vista (Jpn) (Special Week {Jpn}) in the May 15 G1 Victoria Mile. She'll face the boys this time, but is installed as the 2-1 favorite while enjoying a five-pound weight break. "She did well up against a Horse of the Year and in the mile, so I think she'll do well against the boys," said trainer Sakae Kunieda. The unexposed and lightly raced **Real Impact** offers plenty of upside if he can overcome his lack experience and maturity relative to his elders.

He has just a maiden win to his credit from five prior efforts, but is coming off a third-place run in the G1 NHK Mile Cup here May 8. "It'd have been fine if he'd stayed in the same shape as he'd been in, but...I still think he is improving," said assistant trainer Atsunori Hashimoto. "I don't think there's a great difference in level between this race and the Satsuki Sho or the NHK Mile, so his third-place finish last time out [in the NHK Mile] can put him in the upper ranks. Of course, the competition will be among older horses, but I hope he'll be able to use the weight allowance to his advantage." Real Impact gets nine pounds from the older males and four from Apapane. **Smile Jack** looks to improve on a third-place run--beaten just a half-length--in this event last year. He took the G3 Tokyo Shimbun Hai in February to kick off 2011, and was sixth last time in the G2 Yomiuri Milers Cup Apr. 17.

This sees the return to action of **Behkabad**, who was fourth in the G1 Prix du Jockey-Club on this card 12 months ago. His comeback race is important--but it is not a main target." Among those he has to give five pounds to is **Poet**, who gave Workforce a fright when second in the G3 Brigadier Gerard S. at Sandown 10 days ago. His front-running style could prove dangerous if his rivals are reluctant early, and any late rain will help. **Ley Hunter** represents the Andre Fabre stable successful on eight occasions, and he was a staying-on fifth behind Planteur (Ire) (Danehill Dancer {Ire}) in Longchamp's G1 Prix Ganay last time Apr. 30. Both the runner-up Sarafina (Fr) (Refuse To Bend {Ire}) and third Cirrus des Aigles (Fr) (Even Top {Ire}) have since boosted that form, and he is open to improvement.

Woodbine Oaks cont.

Inglorious headlines this lucrative event and sports an undefeated record at Woodbine for Donver Stable. The bay debuted victoriously in the six-furlong Fanfreluche S. here Oct. 24, and had no problem stretching out to annex the Ontario Lassie S. in early December. The early favorite for the Queen's Plate wintered in Louisiana, finishing second in the GIII Rachel Alexandra S. and fourth in the GII Fair Grounds Oaks. **Inglorious** returned home a winner in the May 15 La Lorgnette S. with a professional 1 1/2-length score when closing into a very slow pace, and does not give the impression that an extra 1/16th of a mile will bother her. Glen Hill Farm's **Marketing Mix** gets two turns for the first time-- which is what she appears bred for. Out of a Kris S. mare, the \$150,000 KEESEP yearling closed from well out of it to break her maiden second out at Keeneland going 6 1/2 furlongs Apr. 10. Third-place finisher **Divalarious** (Distorted Humor) was a very impressive graduate on the Belmont sod a week and a half ago. Conditioner Tom Proctor shipped his charge up north to contest the seven-furlong Fury S. here last time Apr. 30, but she was left with too much to do late and came up 3/4 of a length short of **Roxy Gap**. The talented Fury winner has won at a mile on the turf, but her two stakes wins came sprinting. According to *DRF Formulator*, Mark Casse has won with three of his 21 stretch-outs in stakes on synthetic over the past five seasons.

According to NYRA notes, it represents just the 22nd time in the history of the Triple Crown that the Derby and Preakness winners have squared off in the Belmont. "It's fun to get a rivalry started [with Animal Kingdom]," said Romans. "It's good for racing." Exercise rider Tammy Fox was aboard for yesterday's move on Belmont's main track and guided **Shackleford** through splits of :12.41 and :36.26. The chestnut galloped out six panels in 1:14.21. "I wanted to see him work his normal work, and he did today," said Romans. "I thought he went around there really well and it looked like he did everything the way he was supposed to." **Shackleford** is looking to become the 19th horse to register the Preakness/Belmont double, a feat last accomplished by 2005 3-Year-Old Champion **Afleet Alex** (Northern Afleet), but the 1 1/2-mile distance could pose a problem for the speedy colt. Romans, however, is confident in his charge. "I think he will handle the distance," said Romans. "Under the right scenario, he will be fine. You would think [he would be on the lead]. He's been on the lead the last two races. I don't know who's going to jump in and try to get in front of him."



Shackleford Confirmed for Belmont...

GI Preakness S. hero **Shackleford** (Forestry) was confirmed for Saturday's GI Belmont S. after working five furlongs at Belmont Park in 1:00.30 yesterday. "As long as he comes out of the work good, he will run," trainer Dale Romans said after talking on the phone with co-owner Michael Lauffer. "I am excited he's doing so well and coming into the race the right way. I think he's going to be very competitive."

Santiva Tunes Up at Churchill...

Santiva (Giant's Causeway), sixth in the May 7 GI Kentucky Derby, had his final Belmont breeze at Churchill Downs Saturday morning, going five furlongs in 1:01 under Brendan Walsh, assistant to trainer Eddie Kenneally. Working in company, the bay reeled off fractions of :13, :25.20 and :36.80, and galloped out six furlongs in 1:14.40. "I'm very happy with him," Kenneally said. "He hasn't missed a beat since the Derby. He's been on schedule and has had a good four weeks, and, hopefully, he'll have another good week until we get to the Belmont." As for his chances in the "Test of the Champion," the conditioner said, "The thing about it is, you don't know who is going to really be a mile-and-a-half horse until you try, so you don't know about those horses either. Our horse likes to run, he doesn't quit and he keeps grinding it out. He's a tough little horse and he keeps fighting." He added, "He's tactical and he doesn't have to be coming from way back. He likes to run in the middle of the pack, relatively close to the leader in the first tier of runners, so I think his running style would be effective in a race like the Belmont. I don't think the Belmont favors closers." **Santiva** is scheduled to ship to New York Tuesday.
