## STEADY AS A ROCK

Unbeaten after conditions races prior to yesterday's G1 Prix du Jockey Club at Chantilly, Pride Racing Club's **Reliable Man (GB)** (Dalakhani {Ire}) came out the other side with that record intact to provide Alain de Royer-Dupre with a sixth edition of the Classic. In rear early, the 8-1 shot charted a passage through rivals in early stretch and after swinging wide under Gerald Mosse, delivered an irresistible surge to overwhelm perennial bridesmaid **Bubble Chic (Fr)** (Chichicastenango {Fr}) and score comfortably by 3/4 of a length. "That was a very sweet moment, especially as he is by Dalakhani, who also won this race for me," Royer-Dupre commented. "Ever since he won so nicely first time, we had planned for this race, and it could not have worked out any better." **Cont. p2**

## MACHO MAN FIRES PRE-BELMONT BULLET

With new rider Ramon Dominguez aboard, Reeves Thoroughbred Racing and Dream Team One Racing Stable's G1 Belmont S. hopeful **Mucho Macho Man** (Macho Uno) fired a five-furlong bullet work in :59.57 at Big Sandy Sunday morning. "He went very good today, I think Ramon fit him really well," said trainer Kathy Ritvo. "He was comfortable on him, he let him do it on his own, and he went great.

Finished up well, galloped out good, good energy. I'm happy that he's doing really well." The G1 Kentucky Derby third-place finisher came out shortly after the

renovation break, and traveled in splits of :12.08, :23.93, and :35.22. He galloped out in 1:13.18. "I think he's going to run well on this racetrack," Ritvo added. "It's a great place to train a horse. It's a great place to run. And I think the distance is going to suit him well. He's the kind of horse who wants to keep going." Like so many under the tutelage of Alain de Royer-Dupre, Reliable Man was not for rushing and spent his juvenile days race-free before giving instant notice of his ability when scoring by three lengths on debut at Saint-Cloud Apr. 12. Considered too raw for a Derby trial at that point, he was sent to Chantilly for a 10-furlong conditions race and made light work of deposing Vete (Fr) (Green Tune) by 3/4 lengths. Pushed along initially at the back of the main field, which had left the languid starter **Baraan (Fr)** (Dalakhani {Ire}) far behind, the steel grey warmed up as the pace was slackened by Frankie Dettori on the leader **Casamento (Ire)** (Shamardal). With Frankie stacking them up behind, Reliable Man was stuck against the fence on the final turn and Mosse sought room wide as Bubble Chic was committed at the head of affairs by Ioritz Mendizabal with 300 meters remaining. Swooping on that rival inside the final 100 yards, he was firmly in command when jinking left with the line approaching. "He's a very good horse, and I'm certain he will be even better over a mile and a half, so the plan is to bring him back for the G1 Grand Prix de Paris [at Longchamp July 14]." That is also the destination for Baraan, who was another helped by Dettori's tactics when making up an impossible amount of ground having completely blown the start and snatching third on the line. "Everyone saw what happened," said a disappointed Jean-Claude Rouget. "He had done the same thing at the start first time out this year at Deauville, and he also broke a shade slowly last time, but they went steady there so he could quickly recover. He was never going to be able to recover that many lost lengths in a Derby, so his performance was outstanding, and I consider him the moral winner. He ought to stay further, so the Grand Prix de Paris is where he will go next." Bubble Chic's conditioner Alessandro Botti was taking a sixth straight second placing on the chin afterwards. "He is the bridesmaid, but we would have signed up for second before this race and he has run tremendously well again," he explained. "He has confirmed all his previous good runs, and we'll give him a break now before deciding where he goes. He's definitely better on soft ground, so he could wait for a fall campaign."

**Pride Power...**

The Pride Racing Club is a racing partnership started with four yearling colts, including Reliable Man, in 2009 by Sven Hanson's NP Bloodstock. The syndicate is a partnership of 40 shares and, with a one-time payment, each shareholder purchased 1/40th of all the colts and paid for all costs up to the end of their 3-year-old campaigns. Hanson bred and campaigned champion Pride (Fr) (Peintre Celebre) and the quartet of colts from his initial partnership includes the 11-year-old mare's first foal All By Myself (GB) (Galileo {Ire}). Hanson, who owns Haras de Vieux Pont Stud in Normandy, also campaigned multiple Group 1 winner Fair Salinia (Ire) (Petingo {GB})-Reliable Man's second dam.

The Noriyuki Hori-trained Real Impact, disregarded as the ninth choice here, became the first 3-year-old to capture the prestigious Yasuda Kinen while outshining heavily favored Apapane (Jpn) (King Kamehemeha {Jpn}), who checked in seventh. Strong Return was a neck behind in second, giving trainer Noriyuki Hori a one-two finish. The final leg of the Asian Mile Challenge attracted Hong Kong's Beauty Flash (NZ) (Golan {NZ})

and Thumbs Up (NZ) (Shinko King {NZ}), but the pair failed to make an impact, running ninth and 11th, respectively. As the field got underway, jockey Keita Tosaki carefully camped Real Impact behind Silport (Jpn) (White Muzzle {GB}), who sprinted to the front, while Jo

Cappuccino (Jpn) (Manhattan Cafe {Jpn}) was hustled up to press from the outside. As they headed for the final turn, Silport still led Jo Cappuccino, with Real Impact another two lengths back. The latter launched his bid in earnest shortly thereafter and the three locked in a tussle in the uphill drive to the wire. Real Impact finally shook free a furlong from home and held off his stablemate to earn a first Group 1 tally. "It was overwhelming to see both my runners hit the wire," said Hori. "As for Real Impact, to be honest, I wasn't exactly too sure whether a 3-year-old colt was up to face competition at this level. Perhaps the advantage of carrying less weight and being still fresh, coming off only two starts this season, have helped--in addition to his ability--to win this race. He had a poor start last time, so we have been working on that up until this race. He was perfect this time. I also concentrated on maintaining his physical condition from [his last start], and that seemed to work out. He's a very clever colt and easy to train, and I will see how he is once back at my yard before discussing his future plans with the owners." Winning jockey Keita Tosaki offered, "It was my first time on Real Impact today, but the moment I sat on his back, I could feel his energy underneath me and I knew that we hit it right off from there. He flowed into the rhythm and I urged him forward early at the stretch because he's not the explosive type, but rather he extends his strides within the rhythm. Becoming a Group 1 winner was a dream come true for me, and I couldn't quite believe what I had been watching on TV was actually happening to me."

Real Impact was a 1-5 chance when he won on debut over this course last October, and followed up with good seconds to eventual champion 2-year-old Grand Prix Boss (Jpn) (Sakura Bakushin O {Jpn}) in the G2 Keio Hail Nisai S. and G1 Asahi Hai Futurity in November and December. He was beaten only 3 1/2 lengths when 11th in the G2 New Zealand Trophy on return at Hanshin Apr. 9, then finished third--behind Grand Prix Boss once again--in the G1 NHK Mile Cup here May 8. Yesterday's form offers interesting clues to Grand Prix Boss, who may line up against Frankel (GB) (Galileo {Ire}) in the G1 St. James's Palace S. at Royal Ascot. Aiming for her sixth Group 1 victory after a tally in the G1 Victoria Mile, Apapane was in traffic in upper stretch and made a belated rally to finish sixth. Trainer Tony Cruz, sending Beauty Flash to his second try at the Yasuda Kinen, said succinctly after the race, "No excuse."

Immortal Verse, who was no match for Helleborine (GB) (Observatory) when second in Longchamp's G3 Prix d'Aumale in September, returned to be a length fourth behind her pace-making stable companion Glorious Sight (Ire) (Singspiel {Ire}) in a mile conditions back there Apr. 4. Unable to be loaded after proving troublesome at the start of Newmarket's G1 1000 Guineas May 1, the homebred was unable to land any kind of a blow when 11th as Glorious Sight was second in the G1 Poule d'Essai des Pouliches back at Longchamp a fortnight later, but her trainer Robert Collet kept the faith. Keen early kept under wraps by Olivier Peslier, the bay was shuffled back to last on the home turn, but her ever-cool rider was unconcerned. Finding just enough gap with 1 1/2 furlongs remaining, she quickened in dramatic fashion to cut down Mixed Intention in the final 50 yards. "I have never made any secret that I have always held her in high regard, and so far she has not been able to prove it, as she was short of work first time, got left behind the stalls in the Guineas, and suffered from a messy race in the Pouliches," said Collet. "I was confident that she would show her quality one day, and now we can go back to Group 1s again, in Royal Ascot's G1 Coronation S. [June 17], and then possibly for the G1 Prix Rothschild [at Deauville July 31]."

Robert Collet launched Wizz Kid in the Listed Prix Yacowlef for unraced juveniles over five furlongs at Deauville at the start of July and, after a winning debut, she ran a respectable fourth in the G2 Prix Robert Papin at Maisons-Laffitte at the end of that month. Off until November, the bay was put in her place by the impressive winner Blu Constellation (Ity) (Orpen) in the G2 Criterium de Maisons-Laffitte over six furlongs and failed to stay the extra panel when returning to that venue for the third time to be eighth in the Apr. 7 G3 Prix Imprudence. In mid-pack early off a speed duel early, she made her run against the stand's rail and wore down Prohibit and Inxile close to home. "She is a very small, slight filly who had problems after the Papin, which meant we had to give her a break, but she ran a good race in the Criterium de Maisons-Laffitte," Collet said. "Things didn't go too well in the Imprudence, but she probably didn't stay as well, so I told the owner she could either go for the G1 Poule d'Essai des Pouliches or have a first-class chance here and, luckily, we made the right decision. She will remain sprinting, but is not in the major races at Royal Ascot and, being a light filly, she probably won't be supplemented. We will take our time to decide, as there are plenty of opportunities from here until the end of the season."

Unbeaten at three, but not seen since the G2 Prix Hocquart at Longchamp last May, Silver Pond returned to be third behind Polytechnicien (Royal Academy) in the Mar. 19 G3 Prix Exbury at Saint-Cloud before being caught in the closing stages of the G2 Prix d'Harcourt and finishing fourth behind Planteur (Ire) (Danehill Dancer {Ire}) in that Apr. 10 Longchamp event. Behind that rival again when sixth in the G1 Prix Ganay back there 20 days later, the grey benefitted from the strong pace set by the British challenger Poet (GB) (Pivotal {GB}) and a possible lack of race fitness from Behkabad here to revert to winning ways. Settled in the slipstream of Poet, with the returning G1 Grand Prix de Paris hero Behkabad following next, he held a slight edge over that rival as the pacesetter started to fade inside the final quarter. Behkabad looked likely to prevail for much of the run to the line, but he could not quite deliver for Christophe-Patrice Lemaire, and it was Silver Pond and Olivier Peslier who held the advantage where it counted. "The heavy rain that fell overnight was exactly what he needed, as he had two runs on fast ground after the Exbury and didn't like it," trainer Carlos Laffon-Parias commented. "That was a good performance, but we have to be realistic as the second was having his first start of the season and was giving us seven pounds. I am happy anyway and the logical next step is the [June 26] G1 Grand Prix de Saint-Cloud."

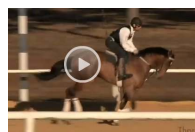

The connections of Inglorious were so confident in what they had waiting in the wings that they bypassed maiden company altogether and unveiled their charge in the six-furlong Fanfreluche S. here last October--she circled the field to win going away that day and was even better when stretched out, scoring by 5 3/4 lengths in the Ontario Lassie S. in December. The bay resurfaced down in Louisiana over the winter to be second in the Feb. 19 GIII Rachel Alexandra S. and a tough-trip fourth in the GII Fair Grounds Oaks Mar. 26. She was back to her winning ways while returning to her home track last time May 15, annexing the La Lorgnette S. by 1 1/2 lengths--four spots ahead of Spooky Kitten. The latter, claimed two back for \$20,000 from her breeders Ken and Sarah Ramsey by Roddy Valente and Mark Casse while scoring by 7 1/4 lengths in a Keeneland sprint, carved out splits of :24 4/5, :50 2/5 and 1:15 1/5. Inglorious, meanwhile, bided her time in mid-pack between horses. Marketing Mix came to challenge the front-runner in upper stretch and briefly appeared a threat for the top slot, but she failed to switch leads as Inglorious flew by her to mount a bid of her own. Spooky Kitten couldn't hold off the favorite, who won clear and relatively easily. "She's done everything we've asked of her," said Josie Carroll, who campaigned fellow Donver Stable colorbearer Careless Jewel (Tapit) to a win in the 2009 GI Alabama S. Of the prospect of taking on the boys in the June 26 Queen's Plate, Carroll commented, "My immediate thought is, 'Let's see how she bounces out of the race.' It would be wonderful to go to the Queen's Plate, but not if she's not going into it 100%. She'll have to be 100% to run against the boys, so it will depend very much on how tired she is." 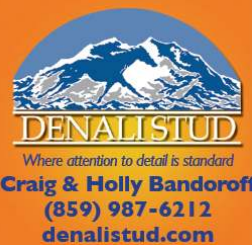

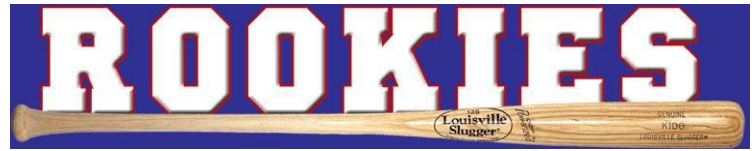

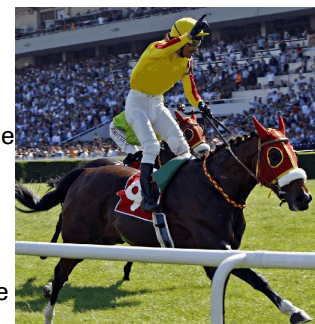

"We are just trying to buy them as we are giving his stock a big chance this year. We have a couple of good ones in the stable, Leading City (Aus) and Able Charm (Aus). The yearling is out of Running Jeans (NZ) (Volksraad {GB}), a three-quarter sister to group winner Katana (NZ) (Volksraad {GB}). The session topper was one of 10 yearlings to top A\$100,000 Sunday. During the session, 132 yearlings grossed A\$4,457,750. The average of A\$33,771 was up 5% from a year ago, while the median rose 25% to A\$25,000. The clearance rate was 64%. **Cont. p8**
