NO WAY, JOSE!

The parade of upsets on a rainy New York afternoon continued when the unconsidered **Ruler On Ice** (Roman Ruler), forwardly placed from the start by jockey Jose Valdivia Jr., kept right on going to post a 24-1 upset in the 143rd running of the GI Belmont S. Favored GI Kentucky Derby hero **Animal Kingdom** (Leroidesanimaux {Brz}) saw his chances diminish after clipping heels soon after the start, causing jockey John Velazquez to lose his left iron for a few strides.

Valdivia was emotional after the race. "Turning for home, everything started going in slow motion," he said. "At the sixteenth pole, I thought, 'This is the true Test of the Champion.' It's a great feeling. I have to thank the connections, George and Lori Hall and [trainer] Kelly [Breen]. I started working this horse this winter. I told Kelly that I liked him so much, I was going to freeze my butt off to come and work him every morning. He acts like he's something special, and I don't think we've gotten to the bottom of him yet." Cont. p2-3

DO 'OVA

Just two days before her esteemed half-sister Goldikova (Ire) (Anabaa) goes for more Group 1 glory at Royal Ascot, **Galikova (Fr)** (Galileo {Ire}) bids to shine in her own right in today's G1 Prix de Diane Longines at Chantilly. Labeled a **★ "TDN Rising Star" ★** on debut at Longchamp in September, the Wertheimers' latest star was fifth in the G1 Prix Marcel Boussac back there on Arc day before returning to win a 10-furlong conditions event at Saint-Cloud and that track's G3 Prix Cleopatre over this trip May 7. Goldikova was only third in the 2008 renewal over the farthest trip she has tried, but Galikova is bred for this test and was not lacking in the stamina department in her prep. "Galikova's been very well since her last run," trainer Freddy Head told the *Racing Post*. "She's very happy and is in fine form." Cont. p4

Ruler On Ice, owned by New Jersey-based financier George Hall and his wife Lori, was fifth when unveiled at Monmouth Sept. 19. The chestnut graduated by a neck in the slop at Delaware next out Oct. 4; the third-place finisher that day was Toby's Corner (Bellamy Road), who would go on to annex the GI Wood Memorial this past April. He was narrowly beaten in his first route attempt, a Feb. 4 optional claimer on Aqueduct's inner track, but was a popular winner of two-turn allowance at Parx 18 days later. That effort earned him a trip to New Mexico, where he ran third in the GIII Sunland Derby Mar. 27. The Halls hoped to have him join their GII Louisiana Derby hero Pants On Fire (Jump Start) in the starting gate for the Kentucky Derby, but, with just \$96,000 in graded earnings, his chances were icy at best for the first Saturday in May. Ruler On Ice made his next appearance at Pimlico in the Federico Tesio S. May 7 and was the runner-up as the 3-2 chalk. Trainer Kelly Breen opted to add blinkers for this class hike, and an upset was born.

GI Preakness S. winner Shackleford (Forestry), on the muscle in the post parade, bounced out of his outside post and quickly went to the lead. Meanwhile, Animal Kingdom was caught between Monzon (Thunder Gulch) and Mucho Macho Man (Macho Uno) and clipped heels, then scrambled to regain his footing as jockey John Velazquez attempted to get his left iron back. The two wound up spotting the field several lengths. **Cont. p3**

Ruler On Ice tracked Shackleford from the start as the chestnut put up splits of :49.08 and 1:14.51. The Preakness winner didn't let out a notch on the sweeping second turn, however, and Ruler On Ice edged closer. Brilliant Speed loomed a serious threat entering the stretch, but appeared to hang, and Ruler On Ice forged on determinedly to secure the unlikely victory. Longshot Stay Thirsty, who was also in touch early, stayed on gamely along the fence to generate a \$928 exacta.

"He wouldn't grow up," Breen explained. "We were trying to see if with time he would mature without having to put blinkers on him. We were disappointed in the Tesio because we were looking at the Preakness, but maybe it was a blessing in disguise. Ever since he ran at Sunland Park, he came back with low red blood count, and it showed in the stall and it showed in the feed tub. It took a little time to get back to normal." He added, "(Blinkers) was part of the maturity. He didn't mature as fast as we wanted to. He's already a gelding, so we can't castrate him again, so we put blinkers on. The first time out of the gate, Jose was on him. He was still goofing off and didn't break great. Last week, he broke right and it's like sometimes, the bulb just goes on. It was a perfect storm of things going right, and that's how we got here."

Animal Kingdom made an admirable outside move on the far turn, but had nothing left for the final furlong. "It looks like he was pinched by the horses on either side," said trainer Graham Motion. "The horse almost fell down--Johnny couldn't believe the horse stayed up. He lost his iron." Motion added, "It's really disappointing. It's disappointing not to give the horse a chance to run his race. I thought down the backside we didn't have any shot at all, and then he started to make that incredible move. But it was asking too much, too late."

Shackleford ran out of gas and was tagged at the wire by Nehro (Mineshaft). "We had it the way we wanted,"

acknowledged trainer Dale Romans. "He just didn't hang on." Jockey Jesus Castanon added, "My horse is a fighter. He tried

not to let anyone pass him, but he got a little tired. He handled the off track fine, no problem."

Numbers Game...

A crowd of 55,779 wagered \$10,098,573 on Belmont Stakes Day races, a 32.9% increase over \$7,598,840 in 2010. An additional \$1,465,484 was wagered on incoming simulcasts, bringing the total on-track handle to \$11,564,057 compared to \$8,229,318 in 2010, a 40.5% increase. Attendance was up 23.3% from 45,243 on Belmont Stakes Day 2010. All-sources handle, which includes all wagering on Belmont Stakes Day races nationwide, was \$81,245,326, a 8.9 percent increase over last year's all-sources total of \$74,613,144.

Family Tradition of Upsets...

A year ago, Ruler On Ice's half-sister Champagne d'Oro (Medaglia d'Oro) posted a 39-1 upset in the GI Acorn S., and little brother was able to do so in the day's marquee event. Their dam Champagne Glow was runner-up in the 1990 GI Frizette S., but took her time producing her first black-type runner. Her 2004 Orientate filly Lost On Champagne ran third in the Cinderella S. at two. Champagne d'Oro emerged as one of the better distaff sprinters in 2010, capturing the GI Test S. and finishing second in the GI Prioress S. She produced an A.P. Warrior filly last spring that was purchased by Sue Casner for \$130,000 as a weanling at KEENOV, and was covered by both Rockport Harbor and Unbridled's Song in 2010.

Like Galikova, Gestut Ammerland's **Golden Lilac (Ire)** (Galileo {Ire}) is another with a family score to settle, as her dam Grey Lilas (Ire) (Danehill) was third here in 2004. Like Goldikova, Grey Lilas went on to excel at a mile, but Golden Lilac was getting stronger the farther she went when annexing the G1 Poule d'Essai des Pouliches over a mile at Longchamp last time May 15. Trainer Andre Fabre is guessing as to whether she will prove as effective at this trip. "The big question mark is the distance," Fabre told the *Post*. "I have no ideas whether or not she'll stay. Her dam didn't quite stay a mile and a quarter, and she's a very fast filly. We'll have the answer on Sunday, but the distance is a concern." Fabre also saddles Godolphin France's **Wavering (Ire)** (Refuse To Bend {Ire}), who followed a strong-finishing third behind Galikova in the Cleopatre with a defeat of **Epic Love (Ire)** (Dansili {GB}) in the G1 Prix Saint-Alary at Longchamp May 22. She also holds Richard Strauss's fourth-placed **Glorious Sight (Ire)** (Singspiel {Ire}) on that running and the latter holds a formline to Golden Lilac, having been runner-up to her in the Pouliches.

Wavering bids to follow in the steps of the last two Saint-Alary winners Stacelita (Fr) (Monsun {Ger}) and Sarafina (Fr) (Refuse To Bend {Ire}), who completed the double here. Epic Love had previously taken the Apr. 30 G3 Prix Vanteaux at Longchamp and attempts to use that prep as a springboard to glory here; Zainta (Ire) (Kahyasi {Ire})--who also took the Saint-Alary--and Latice (Ire) (Inchinor {GB}) did in 1998 and 2004, respectively.

C.S. Silk holds a special place in the heart of trainer Dale Romans, who saddled her to win the 2008 GIII Arlington-Washington Lassie, but the headstrong dark bay has done her best to try the Kentuckian's patience. Unplaced in three graded-stakes appearances on dirt during the spring of her 3-year-old campaign, she had her picture taken in a pair of turf allowance races from eight starts.

Third by a neck in the GIII Locust Grove H. at Churchill last July, she notched a win in Saratoga's Addison Mallory S., and concluded 2010 with two solid showings; she ran Proviso (GB) (Dansili {GB}) to a neck in the GI First Lady S. at Keeneland Oct. 9, and romped by 9 3/4 lengths in an optional claimer over a yielding Churchill course Nov. 28. Favored in her 5-year-old bow, the GIII Marshua's River S. at Gulfstream Jan. 9, C.S. Silk chucked the bit and wound up 10th. She came up just a half-length short in the GIII Endeavour S. at Tampa Bay Feb. 12, but called it a day a half-mile into the GII Jenny Wiley S. at Keeneland Apr. 16 and finished ninth. The mare had her mind on running this time, however. With overnight storms softening the sweeping Belmont course, C.S. Silk went up to show the way through comfortable splits of :25.24 and :50.58. The challenges began to mount after six furlongs in 1:15.59, but there was plenty left in the tank. Jockey Javier Castellano shook the reins and his mount responded, opening up despite drifting out en route to her first Grade I success. Fantasia, well back early, took the overland route on the turn before outfinishing the others for second. Favored Aviate (Dansili {GB}) was handy early, but never switched gears. "The ground was too much for her," reported rider Kent Desormeaux. "It takes a special kind of horse to enjoy the going, and I don't think she did at all." It was a different story for the winner. "The turf today suited us perfectly," Romans said. "She's from Medaglia d'Oro's first crop, and everybody knows what his fillies have done. She has three or four half-brothers and sisters who are stakes horses, and it's huge getting a Grade I win with her." The affable conditioner added, "We've had her since she was a yearling, and she has been a little bit fickle where she'd throw in a bad race and then throw a good one. We just can't give up on her. She pays you off when she's right."

C.S. Silk is owned by William Pacella, Fred Barbara and George Bonomo, who grew up together in Chicago. Bonomo, an amateur Standardbred driver who campaigned the successful pacer Armbro Animate, joined his childhood friends in the Thoroughbred game when C.S. Silk was just getting started.

All eyes were on California sensation Turbulent Descent, but local lass It's Tricky proved the spoiler. She opened her career with three straight victories at Aqueduct, including an eight-length tally in the Busher S. on the inner track Feb. 20. That earned the bay a trip to Florida, but she apparently didn't care for the Sunshine State. Sent off at 8-5 in the GII Gulfstream Park Oaks Apr. 2, It's Tricky faded to finish fourth, some 22 1/4 lengths behind the streaking R Heat Lightning (Trippi). "I have to give a lot of credit to [assistant] Art Magnuson and the staff here, because when we went to Florida she just didn't do well with the heat," said trainer Kiaran McLaughlin. Content to let second-choice Savvy Supreme (Distorted Humor) make the running through a :45.90 half, It's Tricky ranged up to challenge approaching the quarter pole. Turbulent Descent, off a beat slowly, made a four-wide move entering the stretch to reach the hip of It's Tricky, but the Darley filly repulsed the challenge of the odds-on choice, and drew clear late. "She handled [the wet track] really well," said winning rider Eddie Castro. Turbulent Descent's trainer Mike Puype made no excuses after the race. "She got outrun," he admitted. "The filly on the lead ran big." It's Tricky has an Irish-bred 2-year-old half-sister by Successful Appeal, and her dam produced a Medaglia d'Oro filly this past February.

Acclamation was looking to defend his title after taking the 2010 renewal of the Charlie Whittingham in wire-to-wire fashion. The bay was blanked in his next four starts, though, including in the GI Frank Kilroe Mile at Santa Anita Mar. 5 and, in the move to the dirt, in a sloppy edition of the GIII Charles Town Classic Apr. 16. He finally got back to winning ways returning to California last out, airing by seven lengths in the 1 1/2-mile GII Jim Murray H. over the Hollywood sod May 14, and was backed into odds-on favoritism here. The only thing I didn't want to do was let that other horse come up and go head and head with me. He's really a pleasure to ride, and I really appreciate the connections giving me an opportunity to ride."

Looking for an upset? Mission accomplished! Out of action for 11 months, Mission Approved took control of the Manhattan early and kept right on going. A solid campaigner in the New York-bred ranks at three and four, the bay notched a win in the 2008 renewal of the GIII Singspiel S. at Woodbine, and was second in that event the following year for owner Jennifer Contessa and trainer Gary Contessa. He failed to hit the board in three subsequent state-bred appearances, however, and went to the sidelines. Dropped in for a \$35,000 tag at Delaware last May, Mission Approved scored off a nine-month hiatus, and was haltered by his current connections.

He was second in an open optional claimer over this course and distance last June, and just failed to hold off Gio Ponti when second by a neck at 53-1 in the GI Man o'War S. July 10. The veteran hadn't faced the starter in the interim, but proved up to the task here. "[He was off] because he had a quarter crack, nothing major," said winning trainer and co-owner Naipaul Chatterpaul. "I thought it was best to put him up and wait for this race. [I claimed him because] I liked the horse--a lot of back class. As long as he's in front, he's not going to give it up. It's awesome. It's the greatest feeling in the world." Mission Approved bowled along through fractions of :51.47 and 1:17.75, while favored Gio Ponti was far back in the early stages. The champ got going on the outside in the stretch, but Mission Approved had his sights on the wire, and prevailed over fellow longshot Bim Bam. Trainer Christophe Clement was satisfied with Gio Ponti's effort. "This was his first race back from the break," the Frenchman pointed out. "He will improve from this race on firmer ground. He'll be back." Rider Ramon Dominguez echoed those sentiments. "My horse ran an awesome race," said the Eclipse Award winner. "It's very soft out there, and I feel that in the last sixteenth or so the ground may have gotten to him. Overall, I was very happy with his race."

While it was a disappointing result for Animal Kingdom back east, another 3-year-old by Leroidesanimaux (Brz) offered her young sire further laurels in California. Sarah's Secret proved she had the gas to get it done, shading :12 for the final eighth and accounting for favored Star Billing by a half-length. Cambina closed well to nearly get up for place honors. "She was a little nervous in the paddock, so in the post parade, I tried to keep her quiet...jogging and walking," said winning jockey Rafael Bejarano. "She showed me a big kick in the stretch. I wasn't even whipping her." Added trainer Kathy Walsh, "We would have liked to be able to cover her up, but there just wasn't any speed at all. The race was paceless and Rafael just had to use his own judgment. It was one of those things were he did a great job in rating her and getting her to settle." Walsh added that Mr. and Mrs. Al Kirkwood bought a major interest in the filly two weeks ago.

Havre de Grace was pounded down to 20 cents on the dollar and did very little to damage her reputation as the nation's leading distaffer. After dropping a pair of heartbreaking decisions to eventual Eclipse Award winner Blind Luck (Pollard's Vision) in the GII Delaware Oaks and GI Alabama S. last year, the Fox Hill runner turned the tables on the California-based rival in the GII Fitz Dixon Cotillion S. in October. Third--with Blind Luck second--in the GI Breeders' Cup Ladies' Classic Nov. 5--the bay had been perfect in two prior tries at four with Larry Jones this term. She waltzed to a 3 1/4-length victory over Blind Luck in the GIII Azeri S. at Oaklawn Mar. 19, and was entering this off a deceptively easy 3/4-length success in the GI Apple Blossom H. Apr. 15. Confidently handled here by Gabriel Saez, subbing for the Belmont-based Ramon Dominguez, Havre de Grace chased from second, but was in no real hurry to go after the pacesetter. Given her cue turning for home, she took command at will and was never really out of a high gallop in her prep for the GII Delaware H. July 16.

Coil was unveiled by breeder Glen Hill Farm and trainer Tom Proctor in an Oct. 9 maiden at Oak Tree's Hollywood meet. He was third that day to Awesome Patriot (Awesome Again), but a deal was struck soon after, and the muscular chestnut found himself joining that colt in the Bob Baffert shedrow. Carrying the McDonald's colors of Pegram, Watson and Weitman at Hollywood Nov. 15, he donned cap and gown with a stylish performance ([video](#)), but missed some time thereafter. Coil picked up where he left off by upending another stablemate, ☆ **"TDN Rising Star"** ☆ Smash (Smart Strike), in a six-furlong optional claimer at Hollywood May 6. He earned a 106 Beyer Speed Figure that day, and was heavily favored while stretching out to two turns. Awesome Patriot attempted to slow things down up front, but Coil upped the ante on the backstretch. After making a strong middle move up the rail to take over, the chalk looked to have plenty in reserve entering the stretch, and duly fended off the valiant Runflatout in the final sixteenth. "I wished I could have reversed posts with [Awesome Patriot]," said Baffert. "He [Martin Garcia] said he couldn't hold him, they were going so slow. He was still pretty green when he made the lead and coming down to the wire." The Hall of Famer added, "I was hoping to get a good Point Given. I was pretty impressed today with him, what he did and the way he did it. He's still learning how to run."

Coil is a son of the 2001 Belmont winner and Horse of the Year, and Baffert considered sending the sophomore for the GII Woody Stephens S. "I was actually going to run him seven furlongs today at Belmont, but I changed my mind," the conditioner offered. "I wanted to run him two turns to see how he'd handle it. I thought [Awesome Patriot] would put up more of a fight, but he got a little hot going to the gate." Baffert indicated that Coil would be heading east sometime soon. "We could either run in the [GII] Dwyer [at Belmont July 2], the [GII] Swaps [at Hollywood July 9] or the [GI] Haskell [Invitational at Monmouth July 31]," Baffert said. "But the Haskell's the main goal."

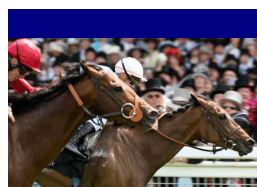

Queen Anne: a History...

Royal Ascot gets underway on Tuesday with the traditional curtain-raiser, the G1 Queen Anne, which is named in honor of the monarch who first envisaged racing here at the start of the 18th Century. Inaugurated in 1840 and known then as the Trial S. before its regal title was created 81 years ago, this mile contest has grown quickly in stature from its initial Group 3 status in 1971 to Group 2 some 13 years later. Now a top-level event after the European Pattern Committee upgraded in 2003, it has also become a race solely for the older milers since that date.

Very few have managed to double up here and therefore emulate the winner of the first two editions in Flambeau (GB). Only three others have registered two victories...and the last of those came 103 years ago. Recent history has been kind to Henry Cecil, who established four consecutive successes at the start of the 1980s before the era of Khalid Abdullah's star milers and subsequent sires Rousillon and Warning (GB). It was 1990 that proved a modern watershed, as the then 19-year-old Italian rider Frankie Dettori recorded his maiden Royal Ascot victory on Markofdistinction (GB) (Known Fact). That precursor to a longstanding love affair with this venue was the first of six wins in this contest; the following five, all coming in Godolphin's royal blue silks, helped him equal the record of Sir Gordon Richards. They included the emphatic eight-length verdict of Intikhab (Red Ransom) in 1998, and Sheikh Hamdan bin Rashid Al Maktoum's now-established sire remains one of the race's most formidable winners. Outdoing Frankie is Saeed bin Suroor, whose remarkable tally of seven wins since Charnwood Forest (Ire) opened the scoring in 1996 makes him the most successful trainer and Godolphin the leading owner.

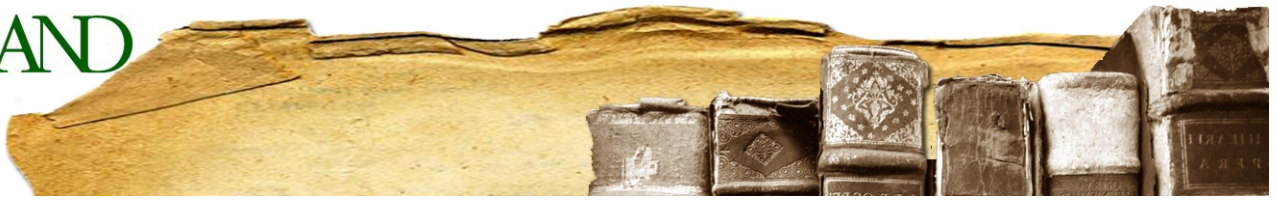
Since being granted its Group 1 status, the race has gone to overseas horses on four occasions, with Ireland and France accounting for two renewals apiece. Flying the emerald green flag is Aidan O'Brien, who saddled both the 2006 and 2008 winners in Ad Valorem (Danzig) and Haradasun (Aus) (Fusaichi Pegasus). Haradasun helped to extend the increasing international influence at this meeting, having been previously trained in Australia. Andre Fabre and Freddy Head have been responsible for the pair of Gallic triumphs, courtesy of His Highness The Aga Khan's Valixir (Ire) (Tremolino)--whose day in the sun came at York due to the redevelopment of Ascot in 2005--and Goldikova (Ire) (Anabaa), respectively. The latter's success 12 months ago was the first by a mare in over 50 years, and established her as one of the all-time greats to have graced this week of racing. If the Wertheimers' multiple champion can make it 14 at the top level in two days' time, she will no doubt become the Queen Anne's most celebrated luminary.



Memory in Coronation List...

Highclere Thoroughbred Racing's **Memory (Ire)** (Danehill Dancer {Ire}) yesterday featured among the 14 fillies remaining in Friday's G1 Coronation S. at Royal Ascot. Left trailing when planting herself in the stalls in the May 1 G1 1000 Guineas at Newmarket, last year's G2 Cherry Hinton S. winner was forced to sidestep the French equivalent a fortnight later after coming into season. Richard Hannon Jr. is hoping she can get back on track in the mile contest. "She appears to be in great form, and we've been doing plenty of stalls work with her," Hannon said. "We've moved her to one of our other yards and she has been cantering on different gallops, which appears to have lightened her up a bit. She's got a much better outlook on life now and, if she does go, which I think she will, she'll be very hard to beat." Joining her in the list after the six-day declaration stage is Bobby Flay's GII BC Juvenile Fillies Turf scorer **More Than Real** (More Than Ready), Derrick Smith's G1 English and Irish 1000 Guineas runner-up **Together (Ire)** (Galileo {Ire}) and Sheikh Hamdan bin Rashid Al Maktoum's **Maqaasid (GB)** (Green Desert), who was third in the Newmarket Classic. Andrew Rosen's G3 Prestige S. winner and G1 Fillies' Mile third **Theyskens' Theory** (Bernardini) is another notable entry, while Richard Strauss's G2 Prix de Sandringham scorer **Immortal Verse (Ire)** (Pivotal {GB}) is set to represent the Robert Collet stable.

This week: the 1964 Belmont S. It was the Canadian invader Northern Dancer who belied his small, sprintish stature to wear the roses on Kentucky Derby day five weeks earlier. In front of a crowd of 97,000 people, Northern Dancer became the first Dominion-bred winner in the Derby's 90-year history, establishing a new course record in 2:00 flat while beating favored runner-up Hill Rise, the 7-5 choice. Northern Dancer then came back two weeks later to again defeat Hill Rise--third this time as the 4-5 chalk--in the Preakness S.--and would once again re-oppose the colt in the Belmont. But in the end, it was the Elliott Burch-trained Quadrangle, winner of the Wood Memorial but only fifth in the Derby and fourth in the Preakness, who posted the 6-1 upset.

61,215 See Decisive Triumph Over Roman Brother, 'Dancer'

Mellon Star, Ycaza Combine To End Triple Crown Dream For Game Canadian Favorite

AQUEDUCT, N. Y., June 6.—After today's 96th running of the \$154,600 Belmont Stakes, Citation remained the last Triple Crown winner, E. P. Taylor's Northern Dancer having failed in the role of odds-on favorite to duplicate the feat last achieved in 1948. Paul Mellon's Quadrangle won the mile and a half "test of the champion" with authority, scoring by two lengths over Louis E. Wolfson's Roman Brother. Northern Dancer, winner of the Kentucky Derby and Preakness, was four lengths farther back and a half length before George Pope Jr.'s Hill Rise.

Fractions Off Record

Willie Shoemaker, who rode Hill Rise, promptly claimed foul against Bill Hartack, pilot of the favorite, alleging that Northern Dancer came over on him at the end of a mile. The patrol films showed that Northern Dancer did come in, but the stewards decided that there was no reason for a disqualification. It was a hairline decision as Shoemaker did have to check somewhat.

Quadrangle paid \$15.10 and Manuel Ycaza urged him over the distance in 2:28½, just the fractions slower than Smart's track record set in last year's Manhattan Handicap. Chateaugay won

last year's Belmont Stakes in 2:30½, the first time it was run at Aqueduct.

Quadrangle is a bay son of Cohoes—Tap Day, by Bull Lea, who won the Wood Memorial and an allowance race this year, was fifth in the Kentucky Derby, fourth in the Preakness and second to the older Olden Times in last week's Metropolitan Mile.

Trainer Elliott Burch used the Metropolitan as a stepping stone to the 1959 Belmont Stakes with Brookmeade Stable's Sword Dancer. Last year, Quadrangle won the Pimlico Futurity. Today's victory added \$110,850 to his earnings, plus a trophy presented by James Cox Brady, chairman of the board of trustees of the New York Racing Association.

The throng of 61,215 topped last year's Belmont Stakes crowd by 7,934 and was the largest Saturday crowd in New York racing history. All previous crowds larger than 60,000 were either on Memorial Day or Labor Day. Memorial Day was on a Saturday this year and 59,202 turned out to see the Metropolitan Mile. Today's fine attendance was despite chill and threatening weather. The New York record crowd was the 71,876 that turned out on Labor Day in 1963.

He Beat the Best, Can Do Even Better: Ycaza

Quadrangle's Rider Jubilant; 'Dancer' Tried Hard—Hartack

AQUEDUCT, N. Y., June 6.—Manuel Ycaza, the third rider to get the mount on Quadrangle in the '64 Triple Crown, said his mount "can do even better," following the Belmont Stakes victory. Ycaza had ridden Quadrangle before today, but Bob Ussery piloted the Rokeby colt in the Derby, while Ycaza was on The Scoundrel at Louisville, and Braulio Baeza rode Quadrangle in the Preakness, in which Ycaza did not have a mount.

In his two best efforts this spring prior to today, Bill Hartack (of Northern Dancer fame) brought Quadrangle home first in the Wood Memorial and second to the older Olden Times in last week end's Metropolitan Mile.

After the race, a jubilant Manuel Ycaza said:

"He was acting just wonderful and he was perfect for the race. He can do even better. I think he can beat the best in the country, and he did just that today. I let him open up a length and a half after the start going to the first turn. Then around the clubhouse bend Shoemaker (Hill Rise) tightened up on him a little bit, but he was going easy and I held the position. When Orientalist went to the lead, I just stayed with him and had plenty of horse. Going to the half mile pole it seemed Baeza's horse tried to go out a bit so I

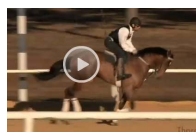

HENRY CECIL RECEIVES A KNIGHTHOOD

Henry Cecil yesterday learned that he will be knighted in the Queen's Birthday Honours List. Joining fellow Newmarket-based trainers Sir Michael Stoute and Sir Mark Prescott in receiving the award, the 68-year-old resident of Warren Place was "overwhelmed" by the news. "It's a wonderful surprise," Cecil said. "I'm very honoured and grateful to the people responsible. It is such a thrill for my family and myself. I couldn't feel more proud. To be quite honest, I'm overwhelmed by it all." Cecil, who first took out a licence in 1969 after a spell as assistant to his stepfather Cecil Boyd-Rochford, is now the winner of 25 British Classics and 10 championship trainer titles. The announcement comes on the eve of Royal Ascot, where he leads all trainers with 72 successes. Still, Cecil said, "I feel there are people much more deserving of this than me." But, he added, "I've always been very competitive and wanted to be at the top of my profession. People are very good to me--I would like to thank everyone involved in giving it to me." Among his fellow colleagues to offer their congratulations yesterday was Ed Dunlop, who said, "Many, many congratulations to the governor, fully deserved for all he has done for our industry." James Fanshawe tweeted, "No one deserved it more. His achievements are exceptional."

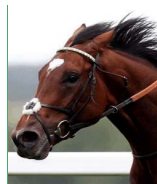
