So impressive when successful in the G1 Poule d'Essai des Pouliches over a mile at Longchamp May 15, **Golden Lilac (Ire)** (Galileo {Ire}) made light of the step up in trip to remain unbeaten in yesterday's G1 Prix de Diane Longines at Chantilly. Held up by Maxime Guyon early, Gestut Ammerland's homebred quickened to lead approaching the furlong marker and was beyond recall as chief market rival **Galikova (Fr)** (Galileo {Ire}) reached top gear too late. At the line, a length separated the 13-5 second choice from the even- money pick and Golden Lilac had emulated recent stars Divine Proportions (Kingmambo) and Zarkava (Ire) (Zamindar) in completing the Longchamp-Chantilly Classic double. This renewal revolved around the star Galileo duo of Golden Lilac and Galikova, both with immediate relations who had tried, and failed, in this race. Lack of stamina was ultimately the chief factor in the defeat of the former's dam Grey Lilas in 2004, while it was a combination of that, and the presence of Zarkava, that led to the downfall of Goldikova three years ago. "Beforehand, I really had doubts about whether she would stay, as her dam Grey Lilas (Ire) (Danehill) was a fast filly who was best at a mile," Andre Fabre said. "So I had concerns, but she shook them off in great style and won well." **Cont. p2**

We'll take it one day at a time. We'll see how he is and how everything comes about. When he's ready, that's when we'll run him again." Being by a stouter influence than her celebrated half-sibling, Galikova was unlikely to be let down by staying power, but in the event the pair were not truly tested by the gallop here. That was due to the early decision of Olivier Peslier to ignore his pacemaker Polemique (Ire) (Poliglote {GB}) and race beside the rail-running Golden Lilac in a share of fourth. Golden Lilac, who had shown abundant speed when winning the Pouliches, reaped the benefit of that tactic when the time came to accelerate in the home straight. Leaving Galikova floundering for a few strides, the Ammerland homebred picked up smoothly to cut between the fading pace-setter and Haya Landa (Fr) (Lando {Ger}) after receiving a shake of the reins from Maxime Guyon. By the furlong marker, she had subdued the Pouliches runner-up Glorious Sight (Ire) (Singspiel {Ire}) with a flick of the whip and the contest was won as Galikova stayed on without threatening. "As I didn't know whether she would stay or not before the race, I had not decided where she would go next," Fabre said. "It was a case of either reverting to a mile or going farther, and now it seems the obvious progression is to go for the G1 Prix Vermeille [Longchamp Sept. 11] and try a mile and a half after a summer break." Golden Lilac's owner-breeder Dietrich Von Boetticher added, "It is an unbelievable moment in such a lovely atmosphere. I am very proud of what we have achieved, and winning the Prix du Jockey Club last year with Lope de Vega (Ire) (Shamardal) and the Diane today is just fantastic and something any owner-breeder has to savor. The dam was very good and, although she ran well in this race, was limited to a mile, but this one is something else." Glorious Sight's trainer Robert Collet said of the third, "I am very happy with the performance, but this is probably as far as she wants to go." Galikova's trainer Freddy Head was left befuddled at the runner-up's effort and said, "I don't really have an explanation as to how she ran, as she usually shows more speed than that. It looks as if she wasn't herself, as she hit a flat spot halfway down the straight and then kept finding more. It isn't a bad result, but I didn't expect her to run that way. She will go to the Prix Vermeille next."

Disappointment Remains from 'Kingdom' Trip...

Trainer Graham Motion expressed his disappointment Sunday morning, a day after his stable star **Animal Kingdom** (Leroidesanimaux {Brz}) came home sixth--beaten 9 1/4 lengths--after a troubled trip in the GI Belmont S. Animal Kingdom was shipped back to the Fair Hill, Maryland Training Center at 8 a.m. Sunday. "It's just disappointing, because you would have liked him to have a fair shot to run his race," said Motion. "When you come this far, you know how much goes into it...These horses only have so many races in them and to waste a race like that was very disappointing." Animal Kingdom, sent off the 5-2 favorite, was bumped and clipped heels early, causing jockey John Velazquez to lose his left stirrup. "[Johnny] said he was surprised the horse didn't go down," explained Motion. "I think what really hurt us was that it took [Velazquez] so long to get his foot back into the iron. He said he went to get his iron and he couldn't find it because it had flipped behind him. It took him until almost to the turn to find his iron. In that time he couldn't do anything, so he had to let the horse drop back, and at that point he couldn't see anything because his goggles were completely covered. So it was a combination of everything." As for what's next for the handsome chestnut, Team Valor's Barry Irwin said, "I don't know now. We want to make this horse the champion. I really thought we were going to win the Belmont or at least run second. He's probably the leader of the 3-year-old class right now, but he's no cinch to be the champion, so I think we're going to have to put him where he can solidify that. We're going to have to take a look at the [GI] Travers [S. Aug. 27]."

So Close, Yet so Far for Pletcher, Repole...

Stay Thirsty (Bernardini), let go at generous odds of 16-1 in the GI Belmont S., gave his best effort, but was 3/4-of-a-length shy of giving 5-time Eclipse Award winner Todd Pletcher his second Belmont score following Rag's to Riches (A.P. Indy) win in 2007. Runner-up in the GI Hopeful S. last year, the bay won the GIII Gotham S. at the Big A Mar. 5 before finishing seventh in the GI Florida Derby. Campaigned by Mike Repole, the \$500,000 FTFFEB juvenile was 12th in the May 7 GI Kentucky Derby. "I think it validated his [second] in the [GI] Hopeful [S.] last year and his win in the Gotham," said Pletcher. "It justified our placement of him this spring, but at the same time, anytime you get that close, you're a little disappointed if you don't actually win. At the end of the day, we're proud of his effort." Pletcher indicated that Stay Thirsty will be pointed toward the July 30 GII Jim Dandy S. followed by Saratoga's marquee event, the GI Travers S. Aug. 27. Also on the Belmont undercard, fellow Repole runner **Calibrachoa** (Southern Image) had to settle for third behind the well-regarded Trappe Shot (Tapit) in the GII True North H.

The dark bay came into the six-furlong test on a four-race winning skein, including the GIII Tom Fool H. Mar. 5. "We kind of had a tough schedule recently trying to get him ready for [the True North]," conceded Pletcher. "It's the kind of race that could move him forward down the road. I'd say a race like the [GI] Vanderbilt [Saratoga, Aug. 14] is a possibility." Pletcher is scheduled to depart for England this evening to saddle Melnyk Stables' **Bridgetown** (Speightstown) in Tuesday's G1 King's Stand S. and Bobby Flay's **More Than Real** (More Than Ready) in the G1 Coronation S. at Royal Ascot.

Belmont 3rd Brilliant Speed to Remain on Dirt...

Brilliant Speed (Dynaformer) exited a third-place finish in the GI Belmont S. in good order, trainer Tom Albertrani said Sunday. "He ran well and looked like he had every chance turning for home," Albertrani said.

"He was a little farther back again than I wanted to be and we lost some ground again, but other than that he ran terrific. I was just a little surprised he hung on me the last sixteenth of a mile. It looked like he was going to go by. Maybe he was just getting a little tired from the distance. The horse ran well and we were just a little short." The colt will be

freshened for a campaign that will likely include the July 30 GII Jim Dandy S. followed by the GI Travers S. Aug. 27 at Saratoga. "We're going to stick to the dirt," said Albertrani of Brilliant Speed, who won the GI Blue Grass S. over Keeneland's Polytrack before hitting the board in a pair of grass stakes at Gulfstream earlier this year. "Overall, I think he fits well with the competition that we've been running with, Animal Kingdom and Shackleford. He fits right in there with them and it's just a matter of changing positions one of these days. He will get his turn."

Nehro Well After Belmont Fourth...

Nehro (Mineshaft), sent off at 9-2 odds in Saturday's GI Belmont S., appeared well a day after a fourth-place finish in the 1 1/2 mile Classic. "He looks in pretty good order, no worse for the wear and tear," said Toby Sheets, assistant to Steve Asmussen, who departed for Kentucky Sunday morning. "He ate a lot of dirt, but he came back and ate up and came out of it in good order, so everything looks good." Owned by Zayat Stables, the dark bay was second in the GII Louisiana Derby, GI Arkansas Derby and GI Kentucky Derby May 7. Explaining the colt's atypical off-the-board performance, Sheets said, "I don't know if it was the surface or eating all the muck," Sheets said. "All the winners [Saturday] were on the front end or close to it, or ate no mud, and he ate a ton of mud. The horse that ran second [Stay Thirsty] was on the fence not eating any mud, and the horse that won was on the outside. The note of the day, basically, is that most of the horses that won, their bridles were all clean when they came back." Nehro's next start is uncertain, but Sheets said the horse will stay with Asmussen's Belmont string before heading to Saratoga next month.

Preakness winner **Shackleford** (Forestry) exited his fifth-place effort in the GI Belmont S. in good form, according to Scott Everett, assistant trainer to Dale Romans. "He came out of the race fine," said Everett. "He ate up fine, his legs are sound, he's good. The 1 1/2 miles might just have been too long for him, but there aren't many horses bred to go that distance anymore. We are very proud of what he has done." According to Everett, the handsome chestnut is scheduled to ship back to Kentucky today and spend a few weeks on the farm before Romans makes a decision on his next start.

Belmont Ratings Up 55%...

Edited Press Release

NBC Sports first broadcast of the Belmont S. since 2005 registered a 4.8 overnight rating and an 11 share for the race portion, up 55% from last year's race on ABC, according to overnight ratings data provided by The Nielsen Company. The NBC Sports Group presented 6 1/2 hours of Belmont S. coverage (4 1/2 hours on VERSUS and two hours on NBC), the first time the entire Triple Crown was broadcast on one network since 2005. The race portion of the Belmont (6:15-7 p.m. ET) registered a 4.8/11 overnight rating, 55% higher than last year's race portion on ABC (3.1/7 from 5:30-7 p.m. ET). The rating is down just 4% from the Belmont in 2009 when jockey Calvin Borel attempted to make history by becoming the first jockey to win the Triple Crown on two different horses (Mine That Bird in the Kentucky Derby and Belmont and Rachel Alexandra in the Preakness). The pre-race (5-6:15), bolstered by a two-hour Belmont Access show on VERSUS that preceded the NBC broadcast was up 86% over last year's pre-race on ABC (2.6/6 vs. 1.4/3). The 2.6 overnight rating for the pre-show was the best for that segment in a non-Triple Crown year since 2006.



FRANKEL, GOLDIKOVA AND ROYAL ASCOT

With the country still reeling from a dramatic Epsom Derby, where Carlton House (Street Cry {Ire}) went so near to providing a victory in the Queen's silks, it will be a case of the famous British stiff upper lip for the royalists this week as the action switches to the hallowed Berkshire site. Now in its Tercentenary year, which is celebrated by the re-naming of Thursday's upgraded Hampton Court S., the fixture continues to dominate the summer of the international season. There is no commanding equine presence running for the monarch over the next five days, but if the Derby was all about the Queen, this illustrious week in the racing calendar is all about Henry Cecil. Or *Sir Henry*, as he is now to be addressed after the monarch finally announced the bestowal of the award the British public yearned for. Fittingly, the icon from Warren Place fills centrestage on day one with the meeting's most important turn **Frankel (GB)** (Galileo {Ire}), who looks to take his stable's tally here to 73. This freakish product of Khalid Abdullah's Juddmonte breeding operation won by 10 lengths over this track and trip in the G2 Royal Lodge S. in September, where a certain Treasure Beach (GB) (Galileo {Ire}) was made to look ordinary prior to his close second in Epsom's blue riband. Cecil is aware of the public expectation surrounding his colt and, despite feeling the nerves, is happy to be in the position of handling the colt at the eye of the storm. "He's obviously a very good and exciting horse, and I'd love him to continue being a champion, because it's so good for racing," Cecil said. "Racing needs a Sea the Stars, a Mill Reef, or an Arkle over jumps--it lifts the whole industry up and people who are not really involved in racing catch on and show an interest. When you have a horse of this calibre, it's a case of keeping him right and dreading something happening every day, but he's a lovely horse to train and, so far, everything is going well. I just hope he continues doing what he has been doing. There is no such thing as a certainty, and we'll do our best."--*Tom Frary*

The Gold Standard...

Sticking to the royal theme, racing's own queen **Goldikova (Ire)** (Anabaa) follows the traditional procession with her own version in the curtain-raising G1 Queen Anne S. Bidding to become the first dual winner of this race in over 100 years, Gerard and Alain Wertheimer's 6-year-old shows no sign of stopping if her 13th Group 1 win in Longchamp's Prix d'Ispehan is anything to go by. Whether she can master **Canford Cliffs (Ire)** (Tagula {Ire}), the colt that Richard Hannon claims is the best he has trained and who faces his biggest test since being acquired by Coolmore, remains to be seen. While there will be inevitable disappointment if Goldikova is

dethroned, few would harbor any resentment for Hannon, whose tenure in the British training ranks has also seen him taken to the hearts of the public. The G1 King's Stand S. looks below-par this year, and with no Black Caviar (Aus) (Bel Esprit {Aus}), the best Antipodean offering is **Star Witness (Aus)** (Starcraft {NZ}), who was only seventh behind her in Flemington's G1 Newmarket H. when last seen Mar. 12. What this year's edition lacks in star quality--which also applies to Saturday's G1 Golden Jubilee S.--it makes up for in diversity, as the runners hail from the States, Hong Kong, Hungary, France and Germany as well as Australia, Britain and Ireland. Probably the most important juvenile race of the meeting also takes place on the opening day and all eyes will be on Ballydoyle's unbeaten ☆ **"TDN Rising Star" ☆ Power (GB)** (Oasis Dream {GB}) as he bids to provide Aidan O'Brien with a sixth renewal.

So Exciting...

Few will get rich on Goldikova, Canford Cliffs and Frankel tomorrow, and even fewer will have the firepower it takes to make a healthy profit from **So You Think (NZ)** (High Chaparral {Ire}) in the following afternoon's G1 Prince of Wales's S. Forecast at 1-2 at best at present, the brilliant dual G1 Cox Plate hero has had a relatively soft time of things in the Emerald Isle so far, but the gloves will have to come off if last year's runner-up **Twice Over (GB)** (Observatory) can regain some momentum after unplaced efforts in Dubai and Newbury. To a large extent, the betting is not a factor here, as Royal Ascot wants to see a star, and the noises from Ballydoyle suggest we will see one.

Wesley Ward, who has taken France by storm over the past few weeks, is looking for a third juvenile success at the meeting and there are exciting things expected from his G2 Queen Mary S. representative **Gypsy Robin** (Daaher). Thursday's G1 Gold Cup is missing last year's hero Rite of Passage (GB) (Giant's Causeway), but in **Fame and Glory (GB)** (Montjeu {Ire}) this fixture's historic showpiece still has a fascinating draw. What Aidan O'Brien did with Yeats (Ire) (Sadler's Wells) is now the stuff of legend, and to show that was no aberration, Ballydoyle nearly repeated the feat of transferring middle-distance class over this marathon trip with Age of Aquarius (Ire) (Galileo {Ire}) 12 months ago. Success here would also be a major boost for Jim and Fitri Hay following their recent investment in the sport and high-profile link with Coolmore.

An American Coronation?

Friday features the G1 Coronation S. for the sophomore miling fillies, and represents a new venture for Todd Pletcher as he sends **More Than Real** (More Than Ready) up against Europe's finest. He also saddles **Bridgetown** (Speightsown) in the King's Stand and, along with Wesley Ward, will be flying the star-spangled banner. One fascinating aspect of the undercard is the G3 Albany S., which features a rematch between Michael Tabor's ☆ **"TDN Rising Star" ☆ Maybe (Ire)** (Galileo {Ire}) and Jim Bolger's **Teolane (Ire)** (Teofilo {Ire}) in what could prove to be an important early pointer to next year's fillies' Classics. Ryan Moore will bid to soften the blow of losing out on Carlton House last Saturday by justifying favoritism in the betting for the London Clubs International Charity Trophy for leading jockey, with past master and Ascot specialist Frankie Dettori set to miss the last two days due to suspension. The latter boasts 44 winning rides at this meeting and, although he has no "banker" to ride this time, he is back on Godolphin's G1 Dubai Sheema Classic hero **Rewilding (GB)** (Tiger Hill {Ire}) in Wednesday's Prince of Wales's.

The Magnificent Seven...

This week sees a total of seven races--all the Group 1s--in the QIPCO British Champions Series, which is starting to take shape following the first four Classics. Frankel currently tops the Mile rankings on 130, from Canford Cliffs on 127, and so tomorrow's action is a crucial point in the inaugural staging of this initiative. "Royal Ascot will provide the series with a massive impetus--after it we will be halfway through the 30 races which take place prior to the five on QIPCO British Champions Day at Ascot on 15 October," commented Chris McFadden, Chairman of British Champions Series Ltd. "The ranking tables should make fascinating reading by next Saturday evening." On an afternoon when Andre Fabre ruled the roost, Kreem gave his trainer and rider Maxime Guyon a group-race treble by becoming the stable's 14th winner of this contest, joining the likes of Swain (Ire), Doyen (Ire) and Rail Link (GB) on the honor roll. Third in the nine-furlong G3 Prix de Conde at Longchamp in September, the bay was seventh in the G1 Criterium de Saint-Cloud in November.

He returned to be third in the Listed Prix Maurice Caillault over 1 5/16 miles at Saint-Cloud Mar. 19. Unsuccessfully dropped back to a mile in two conditions events, he was back to winning ways over 10 furlongs at Longchamp last time May 19. Settled in rear initially off the strong tempo set by Ibicenco's pacemaker [Arlington \(Ger\)](#) ([Tertullian](#)), Kreem stayed on in grim fashion to wear down Ibicenco in the shade of the post. "He's a courageous horse in the race, but also difficult to handle and train," Fabre said. 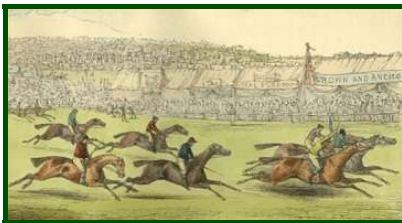

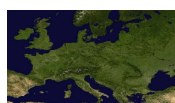
