



SIDNEY'S CANDY ON TRACK FOR PLETCHER

Sidney's Candy (Candy Ride {Arg}), recently acquired by WinStar Farm, turned in his first work for new trainer Todd Pletcher yesterday at Belmont Park. The

Grade I winner went four furlongs over the main track in :49.73. "It was our first work with him and it seemed to go well," commented Pletcher. "We'll talk to [WinStar President/CEO] Elliott [Walden] about a game plan. One thing we had mentioned as a possibility is the [Aug. 6 GI] Whitney H., but we have a ways to go." Racing for the Craig Family Trust and trainer John Sadler, Sidney's Candy won last year's GI Santa Anita Derby, and is a graded stakes winner on turf, dirt and synthetics. He was most

recently second, beaten just a nose, in the May 28 GII American H. "He's successful on three different surfaces, so we have a lot of options," Pletcher added. "He has a lot of speed and can carry it a distance. There are a lot of possibilities." The Pletcher-trained **Buster's Ready** (More Than Ready) also worked four furlongs yesterday at Belmont, covering the distance in :51.97. "It was a little slow, but she did it relaxed and on her own, and she's very fit," said Pletcher. Owned by the Estate of Edward P. Evans, the filly is coming off a runner-up effort in the May 20 GII Black-Eyed Susan S. and is expected to start next in Saturday's GI Mother Goose S. at Belmont. "It was a good performance last time in the Black-Eyed Susan, and I hope she continues that trend of improvement," Pletcher added.

SPA TIME FOR POOL PLAY

Pool Play (Silver Deputy) exited his upset win in Saturday's GI Stephen Foster H. in fine shape and is in line for a summer at Saratoga, according to trainer Mark Casse. "We've been planning to go to Saratoga with a string, so what I think I'll do is take him to Saratoga and see how he trains over the dirt," Casse explained. "Just because you like the dirt at Churchill Downs doesn't mean you're going to like it at Saratoga. We'll train him there and, if he trains all right, we'll think about the [Aug. 6 GI] Whitney H. Our number one goal will be the Breeders' Cup. How we get there is kind of secondary, really. So everything we do from now on will be that kind of plan. I wouldn't even be shocked if he ran on the grass again."

ZAZU READIES FOR HOLLYWOOD OAKS

Grade I winner **Zazu** (Tapit), off since running third in the May 6 GI Kentucky Oaks, is on track for a start in next Saturday's GII Hollywood Oaks after a six-furlong work at Hollywood Park Saturday. "Zazu came back good from Kentucky and worked six furlongs in 1:13 [1:13.40] here [Saturday]," trainer John Sadler reported yesterday. The work was second fastest of 15 at the distance on the day. Owned by Jerry and Ann Moss, Zazu was jostled back in tight quarters on the first turn in the Kentucky Oaks, but finished strongly to be beaten 2 3/4 lengths by Plum Pretty (Medaglia d'Oro). "She went a big trip in the Oaks," Sadler continued. "It was a big field and she was running at the end." Zazu captured the GI Las Virgenes S. in February and was second, beaten a neck, in the GI Santa Anita Oaks in March. Also aiming for the Hollywood Oaks, **Big Tiz** (Tiznow) worked a bullet five furlongs at Hollywood Sunday in :58.60. The Mark Glatt trainee, second in last year's GI Hollywood Starlet S., is coming off a runner-up effort in the May 21 GIII Railbird S.

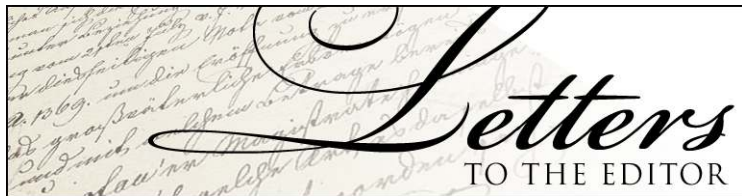
Dublin Returns Thursday

The chestnut colt has been sidelined since running fifth in last year's GI Preakness S. and makes his return to the races in Friday's Kelly's Landing S. at Churchill.

Curatolo Ok After Sunday Spill:

Apprentice jockey Ryan Curatolo, thrown from his mount during the post parade for Sunday's first race at Belmont Park, was released from North Shore University Hospital after x-rays proved negative. The 19-year-old expects to resume riding when racing returns to Belmont Wednesday. "I had an exam and everything is OK inside," said Curatolo. "In two days I think I'll be OK. Tomorrow there is no racing, Tuesday no racing, just today I lost a winner because in the second race [my mount won]. But, it could be much worse. You have 365 days to win races, so if you lose one day, there are many more." The Frenchman captured the first stakes victory of his riding career Saturday when **Street Game** (Street Cry {Ire}) won the GIII Hill Prince S.

A winner when thrown in for a \$35,000 tag at the Big A in January, Smokin Hero returned two starts later to finish runner up in the state-bred Hollie Hughes S. Feb. 21. Sixth in his sole start for John Trebbutt in a 6 1/2-furlong handicap Mar. 31, he came home second in a \$50,000 optional claimer for Empire bred Apr. 21 before scoring in a Finger Lakes allowance May 30. Smokin Hero delayed the start of the race while the gate crew scrambled to make adjustments to his tack. The dark bay broke running, however, prompting Spa City Fever through an opening quarter in :23.38. With Rank and on the bit early early, the gelding was asked to ease up by jockey Alan Garcia, and the 5-year-old conceded through three quarters in 1:10.41. Pilot Ramon Dominguez maneuvered his mount in between horses and to be a three-wide joint leader at the top of the lane, and the race was over at that point. Race to Urga kicked clear to a three-length success, getting her final 5/16ths in :29.54. Abaco (Giant's Causeway) outfinished An Absolute Ten (Rock Hard Ten) for the place, while Style Squad (Dynaformer) turned in a decent fourth-place debut.
