## A MOMENT TO TREASURE

Since taking over at Ballydoyle, Aidan O'Brien has retrieved all the former glories of the legendary stable, and when **Treasure Beach (GB)** (Galileo {Ire}) led home stable companions **Seville (Ger)** (Galileo {Ire}) and **Memphis Tennessee (Ire)** (Hurricane Run {Ire}) in yesterday's G1 Dubai Duty Free Irish Derby, another historic milestone was reached. That result meant a sixth consecutive renewal for the Rosegreen establishment, a ninth overall for its trainer and a remarkable fourth

one-two-three in the race since 2002. Having been denied in the final yards of the June 4 G1 Epsom Derby, Treasure Beach had no Pour Moi (Ire) (Montjeu {Ire}) to spoil his party this time, and the 7-2 second choice was delivered with accurate timing by Colm O'Donoghue to work his way past Seville and the pacesetter Memphis Tennessee in the final 150 yards and win by 3/4 of a length. **Carlton House** (Street Cry {Ire}), who was again the hot favorite as he had been at Epsom, never looked like justifying odds of 5-4 and was a one-paced fourth. **Cont. p2**

## QUEEN OF CANADA

Donver Stable's **Inglorious** (Hennessy) became the 34th filly to beat the boys in Woodbine's historic \$1,000,000 Queen's Plate S. Sunday with a decisive 2 1/2-length score. Made the 9-2 third choice behind impressive Plate Trial winner

**Check Your Soul** (Perfect Soul), the Woodbine Oaks heroine tracked that rival from well out of it, but flew by him--and 61-1 runner-up **Hippolytus** (Philanthropist)--when produced and steered wide by leading pilot Luis Contreras, who was riding in his first Queen's Plate. **Pender Harbour** (Philanthropist) came late to be third, while Check Your Soul flattened out after putting in a bid turning for home to check in a disappointing seventh. "It's just overwhelming--I'm still just taking it all in," said trainer Josie Carroll, who became the first woman to condition a Queen's Plate winner when Edenwold (Southern Halo) took the Canadian Classic in 2006. She continued, "We knew she was going to give us a big kick and it was all about getting her room to run and letting her do what she does." **Cont. p3**

Introduced over seven furlongs at Leopardstown in May, Treasure Beach shaped like a typical middle-distance prospect when second there before winning despite veering in the closing stages of a Gowran Park maiden over that trip in August. Later that month, the bay visited the Galway Festival and was delivered late to notch a nursery again over seven before finding traffic and finishing runner-up upped to a mile in a similar race at the Listowel Festival in mid-September. He again met trouble when chasing the

shadow of Frankel (GB) (Galileo {Ire}) in a distant third in Ascot's G2 Royal Lodge S. 12 days later before being tucked away for the winter recess. Back with a workmanlike win over Nathaniel (Ire) (Galileo {Ire}) in the May 5 G3 Chester Vase, he entered the "Blue Riband" as the unconsidered 25-1 outsider of the Ballydoyle quartet and, after swooping on Memphis Tennessee approaching the furlong pole, there looked booked for the upset.

Losing out only to the late-coming Fabre raider, he again failed to fire the imagination of the punters in the lead-up to this race as they prepared for the redemption of The Queen's runner. Keen early in a share of fourth several lengths off the pace set by Joseph O'Brien on Memphis Tennessee, he was traveling notably better at the top of the straight than Carlton House in his slipstream. As Seamus Heffernan steered Seville past the front-runner with a quarter mile remaining, Treasure Beach was looming large and Colm O'Donoghue only went for his stick with a furlong remaining. Driven to the lead with 150 yards left to race, he asserted from his game barnmates for the almost customary trifecta, with Carlton House never able to land a serious blow in their immediate wake. "Memphis Tennessee set a nice even pace and it suited everyone," Aidan O'Brien said. "Colm was excellent on Treasure Beach, and he has progressed with every run." With a plethora of top-class older horses already lined up for midsummer targets, the conditioner faces a quandary now regarding the winner. "He has a few options, as he could go for the G1 Grand Prix de Paris [at Longchamp July 14], the G1 King George VI and Queen Elizabeth S. [at Ascot July 23], or have a break," he explained. "We are very lucky that his owners have decided to keep their horses in training as 4-year-olds, and so we have the chance to give the 3-year-olds breaks now." Jockey O'Donoghue, who had been runner-up on three occasions and third on another two, added, "I've been riding out at Ballydoyle since I was 15, and I'm very grateful for the opportunities. I am relieved more than anything else, as I had been placed in the race a number of times. I was confident coming here, as I learned more about the horse at Epsom." Connections of Carlton House felt in the immediate aftermath that the Royal runner had run flat and was likely to be dropped in trip to 10 furlongs for his next start.

Inglorious had shown so much talent in the mornings that her connections opted to bypass maiden company and debut her in the six-furlong Fanfreluche S. here last Oct. 16. She donned cap and gown with a 1 3/4-length success, and promptly romped in the 1 1/16-mile Ontario Lassie S. by 5 3/4 lengths Dec. 4. The bay wintered at the Fair Grounds, where she was second in the GIII Rachel Alexandra S. Feb. 19 and fourth in the Mar. 26 GII Fair Grounds Oaks. She remained unbeaten north of the border with a workmanlike tally in the La Lorgnette May 15, and flew home to get up in the June 5 Woodbine Oaks last time by 3/4 of a length. Inglorious was looking to become the fourth filly to complete the Oaks/Queen's Plate double. Relaxed well out of it and in the clear behind Check Your Soul as a trio that included the eventual runner-up zipped through fractions of :23.86, :47.66 and 1:12.35, Inglorious shadowed the chalk and picked off foes easily on the outside along the home bend. She went off-stride briefly as she wheeled into the lane, but once Inglorious leveled off it was all over. Hippolytus dug in and was very game to hold second after his early exertions, but the Mark Casse trainee had no response for the filly. Of Contreras's ride, Carroll said, "I thought he showed wonderful judgment. In a big field of horses, he put her in a position where she'd get a clear trip. He moved her at the right time--he just did everything he was supposed to do." She added, "I was pretty shocked with the kick she gave us--I have to say that. I knew that she was heading into this race in super, super order and I said before the race, 'Whatever happens, this filly is going to run a big race. She's just so right on right now.'" Carroll said she would wait to see how Inglorious came back before deciding whether or not she would ship to Fort Erie for the July 17 Prince of Wales S.--the second leg of Canada's Triple Crown. This win, which was widely expected with Sarafina starting at 2-5, was as much testament to Christophe-Patrice Lemaire's sense of timing than his mount's inherent quality as the homebred was delivered in the nick of time to register a third success at the top level. Her tendency to over-race early off the moderate tempo forced her rider's hand and, after being eventually switched off in last, she was called on for her trademark acceleration as the front-running Cirrus des Aigles began to get away at the quarter pole. Hitting top stride out wide, the bay was always going to reel him in, and she was firmly in command despite the lateness of her challenge. This success adds to the bay's 2010 G1 Prix Saint-Alary and G1 Prix de Diane haul and she is one step closer to a return tilt at the Oct. 2 G1 Prix de l'Arc de Triomphe, in which she was third last year. "They broke slowly and the jockey had trouble getting her to relax today, but he did a good job to place her last and settle her," said de Royer-Dupre. "I knew she had enough class and turn of foot to get to whatever is in front, and her main target remains the Arc, with one or two runs beforehand. They have not been decided yet, but the G1 Prix Jean Romanet [at Deauville Aug. 21] is a possibility." **Cont. p5**

The Grand Prix de Saint-Cloud is a Breeders' Cup "Win and You're In Event" for the GI Breeders' Cup Turf, and if Sarafina makes the trip to Churchill, her \$90,000 entry fee will be waived, and her connections will receive a \$20,000 travel allowance. If she's pre-entered, The Aga Khan, her owner/breeder, will also receive a \$10,000 foal nominator bonus. Cirrus des Aigles was again playing second fiddle to a high-class distaffer following his defeat at the hands of Goldikova (Ire) (Anabaa) in the G1 Prix d'Ispahan, and his trainer Corine Barande-Barbe said, "He is an exceptional horse for me, as he can run at the top level from nine furlongs to a mile and a half with the same result. He deserves a Group 1, and it is no disgrace to be beaten by Sarafina, who is a class act. The G1 Juddmonte International [at York Aug. 17] is a possibility, although I might find an easier race at Deauville instead. I'll wait and see how he comes out of this, but in the autumn he will be going back to Asia."

Defending Highlander winner Signature Red hadn't returned to the winner's circle since he bested Heros Reward in this event last July 4. He was 12th when stretched out for the GI Woodbine Mile in September, and returned to this trip for the GI Nearctic S. Oct. 16, but could do no better than seventh. The bay bounced back a bit to be second in a main-track allowance on Halloween, and fell just a head short in the Nov. 20 GIII Kennedy Road S. on the Polytrack to conclude his 4-year-old season. Signature Red resurfaced this term to be second behind Essence Hit Man (Speightstown) in the seven-furlong Jacques Cartier S. Apr. 17, and was last seen filling the show slot in the May 8 GIII Vigil S. Signature Red stalked pacesetter Essence Hit Man from the two path through swift splits of :22 flat and :44 4/5 with ignored-in-the-betting Heros Reward saving ground to the inside in third. Signature Red confronted the pacesetter at the top of the lane, and Heros Reward and Sheldon Russell attempted to split that dueling duo, but were shut off when Signature Red came in slightly. Despite switching back to his wrong lead after the bump, Signature Red dug in gamely to narrowly deny Fiddlers Patriot, the unexpected favorite who had also traveled close to the pace early. An objection was lodged against the winner by the connections of Heros Reward, but it was disallowed by the stewards. "

He was no more than nice at home before his maiden and never worked brilliantly, so he surprised us by how well he won at Naas, and he'd come on for that at home since. This year we'll be making plenty of hay with him."

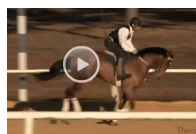

I thought I could out-kick Joe's horse (Restless Soul)--I was more worried about Cozi Rosie getting the jump on me. When Joe picked it up on the lead, I went right on with him and I just tried to make the same move I did in the Santa Barbara. She just drew away from them." John Sadler, trainer of the runner-up, said of his charge, "She looks OK. The start hurt her and then again she gets no pace. [Restless Soul] would have come down if we lost the [place] photo, but we won the photo so you can't take the horse down."

It was Earnestly's first win at the Group 1 level and an improvement from his third-place finish a year ago. Jockey Tetsuzo Sato, who has partnered with the bay in 17 out of 20 starts, kept Earnestly close as they sped through the opening 1000 meters in :58.70, and, in a replay of the 2010 renewal, the pair surged to the front in upper stretch. Earnestly didn't falter this time, however, striding out powerfully to a clear lead before ultimately holding Buena Vista safe. Japan's reigning Horse of the Year, in mid-pack before rallying down the center of the course, covered the final three furlongs in :34.50--fastest in the race--but was given too much to do. The Takarazuka Kinen was the first-ever Breeders' Cup Challenge "Win and You're In" race in Japan. Earnestly has earned a spot in the starting gate for the GI Breeders' Cup Turf at Churchill Downs if his owners choose to make the trip. If they do, the Breeders' Cup will pay the \$90,000 entry fee and provide a \$20,000 travel allowance. The 6-year-old Earnestly isn't currently nominated to the Breeders' Cup program, though his sire is. That means his connections can nominate him by Thursday midnight for \$25,000 under the Open Enrollment program, instituted this year to get previously non-nominated runners into the event at reduced prices. If the deadline passes, however, the price skyrockets to \$200,000, with an Oct. 24 deadline for supplementing.

### Hollywood Redistributes Purse After DQ:

Hollywood Park officials said they will redistribute the \$35,800 purse of a starter allowance held at the track June 10 after it was revealed that the horse who won was ineligible under the conditions of the race. Trainer Paul Aguirre's **Doc Can Dance** (Wild Zone) was a 27-1 outsider in a \$40,000 starter allowance on the Hollywood lawn, but belied those odds to get up and win by a half-length. Upon closer inspection, however, the 3-year-old gelding shouldn't have been in the race in the first place. In the condition book, the race was restricted to "3-year-olds and upward which have broken their maidens for a claiming price of \$40,000 or less, or Cal-bred or -sired horses which have broken their maidens in a state-bred race for \$50,000 or less and which have never won two races." A Kentucky-bred, Doc Can Dance broke his maiden in a \$32,000 maiden/optional claimer at Turf Paradise Jan. 28, but since he wasn't entered for a tag that day, the race is essence is considered a maiden special weight. According to *Daily Racing Form*, Richard Rosales, the trainer of runner-up Preferred Behavior, filed a protest the day after the race, by which point stewards had already begun an investigation. Doc Can Dance's owners Peter Accardy, Gloria Ryan, and John Xitco will now have to forfeit the \$21,000 winner's share of the purse.
