IN ONE WEEK

DON'T THINK TWICE, IT'S ALRIGHT

Since his defeat at Royal Ascot, **So You Think (NZ)** (High Chaparral {Ire}) has been the talking point of Europe, and he ended the jibber-jabber yesterday with a game defeat of **Workforce (GB)** (King's Best) in an epic renewal of the G1 Coral-Eclipse at Sandown. While his reversal at 4-11 in the

reversal at 4-11 in the June 15 G1 Prince of Wales's S. was a deflating result for all concerned, Aidan O'Brien had remained steadfast that the multiple Group 1 winner had more to offer. The trainer explained before this showdown with last year's Derby and Arc hero that the 5-year-old was fitter

than he had been for the Royal meeting, and the difference in conditioning was evident once he was pulled out to duel with his chief rival. Getting on top passing the furlong pole, Derrick Smith's colorbearer stayed on grimly to reward the gamble into 4-6 favoritism by a half-length under Seamus Heffernan. After expressing his gratitude for the opportunity on the major stage, that jockey paid tribute to the winner. "Bart Cummings [who trained So You Think in Australia] always had big plans for this horse and he's carried them to this side of the world with him," Heffernan said. "I've ridden too many good horses to compare, but he's one of the classiest I've ridden."

Back To Work...

Denied only by So You Think, Workforce covered himself in glory when finishing clear of the others, and connections were satisfied with the performance of the 4-year-old. "Everything went accordingly and he has run a very decent race," Khalid Abdullah's Racing Manager Teddy Grimthorpe told *PA Sport*. "Ryan said that maybe the ground was quick enough for him, but he felt it was a pretty decent run. We've not been beaten out of sight, and we've got two or three fairly obvious options to think about." Trainer Ed Dunlop was not disappointed with the effort of last year's dual Oaks heroine **Snow Fairy (Ire)** (Intikhab), who was fourth. "That was almost exactly what I expected," Dunlop said. "She hit a bit of a flat spot and the track didn't suit her. I tried to tell the world that she needed this run, and the next stop will be the G1 Nassau S. [at Goodwood July 30]."

That kind of precocity is not usually associated with a horse who can win an Eclipse at five, but the dark bay is now beginning to demonstrate why

everyone who has had dealings with him is prone to over-excitement. After two easy wins at The Curragh in the May 2 G3 Mooresbridge S. and May 22 G1 Tattersalls Gold Cup, many expected a cakewalk in the Prince of Wales's, but in the event, he galloped freely to post and in the early part of the race and was run down late by the strong stayer Rewilding (GB) (Tiger Hill {Ire}). Despite Aidan O'Brien's protestations that he

was to blame for leaving So You Think undercooked, opinion was split as to whether he could redeem his reputation in this test, as this week's major gamble spoke loudly for him. Customarily keen early in third in the slipstream of Workforce, who in turn tracked his stable companion **Confront (GB)** (Nayef), he stayed behind the 7-4 second favorite as that rival was sent to the front with over a half-mile remaining. For a while, it appeared that Ryan Moore had the edge in front, but once Seamus Heffernan asked him to fight, So You Think wore down his rival's resolve in the grueling climb to the post. "Kieren Fallon and Mick Kinane gave me advice beforehand, but that's confidential," quipped the winning rider, who had also steered George Washington (Ire) (Danehill) into third in this race four years ago. "I wasn't really under that much pressure and just wanted to get him to settle, so I was very happy to be on Ryan's horse's heels. I know my horse's ability, and my opinion was that last time maybe he was a little bit fresh and things didn't go smoothly, so he probably ran a very good race to just get beaten. Some mornings he settles brilliantly, and on others, he can be a little bit keen, so it's a case of different humors on different days. He's just a very good horse, and I was delighted to be on him. It was a nice pace, and it was just like a piece of work with a good horse leading me. At home, he feels quite a pacey horse, but once he relaxes, you'd be sure he'd get any trip."

Aidan O'Brien revealed afterwards that he is looking at a possible return to Australia for a third Cox Plate at Moonee Valley Oct. 22. "We are having a little issue with quarantine, but the Cox Plate is a definite possibility, if we can sort that out, and he is also open to the G1 Juddmonte International [at York Aug. 17] or G1 Irish Champion S. [at Leopardstown Sept. 3]," O'Brien said. "He is a very unique horse who is really enjoying it now. He's getting professional and is starting to relax now--when he came down to us, for a horse that had had a lot of racing, he was still a bit babyish, but he has got into the routine very well, and improved and improved. Seamus gave him a beautiful ride and Seamus, Colm [O'Donoghue] and Joseph [O'Brien] have all ridden Classic winners for us this season, so we're lucky to have such a team."

The answer: about \$24,000. The question: how much a win parlay on Teaks North would have returned if the winnings from each of his four wins--in as many starts at Monmouth--had been reinvested in his subsequent local appearance. A 30-1 chance when taking a first-level allowance at the Elite Meet last summer, he posted an 11-1 upset in the 2010 running of the Restoration S. He was just 9-2 when a 3/4-length winner of the Gill Monmouth S. last time out and returned a juicy mutuel here again.

It has already been a productive season for Teaks North, who more times than not falls into perfect trips. He rode the rails en route to a 25-1 stunner in his 2011 bow in the GI Gulfstream Park Turf H. Feb. 5, but couldn't take advantage of a clean journey when fifth in the Gill Tampa Bay S. Mar. 19. Fourth to Rodman (Malibu Moon) in the Apr. 14 Irish Tower S. on the Aqueduct main track, he was an even seventh to Get Stormy (Stormy Atlantic) in the GI Turf Classic on the Derby undercard May 7 prior to his last-out success back in Oceanport.

Neatly drawn in post position two, Teaks North took advantage of that inside alley and hugged the fence as longshot Pulsion (Include) led from a headstrong Sleepless Knight (War Chant). Stacelita, the slight post-time favorite, and defending champion Chinchon were content to switch off nearer the back of the field. Positions were largely unchanged for the opening six furlongs until Joe Bravo let Stacelita slide to the outside and allowed the French-bred to roll up into a contending position, while Chinchon began a steady advance three off the inside down the backstretch. Back on the front end, the pacesetters were beginning to call it a day, and Eddie Castro found his way off the fence to let Teaks North challenge three wide at the quarter pole. Stacelita led past the midstretch marker, but Teaks North--spotting the mare nine pounds--was doing the better work and found the wire first, as Chinchon closed nicely for a runner-up effort in defense of his title.

"We had a nice trip," Castro commented. "He was comfortable the whole way around. When the horses from the back were starting to move, we were able to slip out and go. He really kicked it in through the stretch. I was very confident in him throughout the race."

Winning trainer Justin Sallusto indicated that Teaks North could go next in the GI Sword Dancer at Saratoga Aug. 13 or in the GI Arlington Million the same afternoon, with the GI Breeders' Cup Turf the longer-term objective.

Storm Cat may be pensioned, but his legacy lives on. One of his best sons from his twilight crops, Courageous Cat, outbattled a tenacious grandson in Caracortado down the length of the Hollywood stretch.

The blaze-faced bay kicked off 2011 with a sharp win in Belmont's GIII Poker S. June 10, and was even-money against a solid group of locally based runners. Jockey Pat Valenzuela positioned his mount in second as

Liberian Freighter led through a poky :47.31 half. Courageous Cat pounced on the front-runner approaching the stretch, with Caracortado in hot pursuit, and the two market leaders treated the Hollywood faithful to a thrilling stretch run. "He relaxed perfectly behind the leader," Valenzuela confirmed. "I could have gotten him any time I wanted. I waited as long as I could and he kicked on for home. When that horse came to him, he fought back--that horse was never going to get by him."

Courageous Cat needed four tries to break his maiden, but, once he earned his diploma in June of his 3-year-old season, he made rapid progress up the class ladder. He followed his graduation with success in an overnight stakes at Belmont, then collected the GII National Museum of Racing Hall of Fame S. at Saratoga in August. Third in the blanket finish of the GI Jamaica H. at Belmont, he outran his 22-1 odds next out in the GI Breeders' Cup Mile at Santa Anita, falling just a half-length short of the great Goldikova (Ire) (Anabaa).

The Wygod homebred got a quick start to his 4-year-old campaign with a win in Gulfstream's GIII Canadian Turf H., but ran ninth in the G1 Dubai Duty Free in March 2010, and was benched thereafter. Though he returned to run third in the GI Shadwell Turf Mile at Keeneland Oct. 9, his connections opted to skip another crack at the Breeders' Cup, and Courageous Cat didn't see action again until the Poker.

The Shoemaker is a "Win and You're In" for the Breeders' Cup Mile at Churchill Nov. 5, and Marty Wygod confirmed that his runner will point to that event.

"I'm looking for revenge [against Goldikova] in the Breeders' Cup Mile," he said. "You could see he wasn't going to give it up today. I was pretty confident." Wygod added, "He's going back East now, I had to give Bill Mott my word that I wouldn't keep him here."

Love of Tranquility...

Courageous Cat, whose second dam is a half-sister to 1983 GI Belmont S. winner Caveat (Cannonade), stems from a family that the Wygods are very familiar with, and has repaid them handsomely. In 1991, Pam and Marty Wygod secured a colt from the final crop of Alydar out of MGSP Winters' Love (Danzig) for \$475,000 as a KEENOV weanling and named him Benchmark. It took the bay a while to reach his potential, but he earned back his purchase price and captured three graded stakes before becoming a solid California sire. The couple acquired his half-sister by Rahy as a yearling for \$250,000 at KEEJUL in 1996 and dubbed her Tranquility Lake. The bay captured a pair of Grade I events and earned over \$1.6 million through four seasons, and her first foal for the Wygods was multiple Grade I winner After Market. The couple sold Tranquility Lake's 2004 Storm Cat colt for \$9.7 million to John Ferguson; racing as Jalil, he landed the G2 Maktoum Challenge - Round 3 in Dubai. Courageous Cat is her fourth foal. Her most recent reported offspring is a 2-year-old colt by A.P. Indy.

It wasn't going to take a whole lot--\$647 to be exact --to push the consistent Smiling Tiger past the \$1-million mark in career earnings, but the fleet chestnut crashed through that barrier in style with a powerful front-running victory for a third career Grade I success. After defeating his elders in the GI Bing Crosby S. and GI Ancient Title S. last season, Smiling Tiger was a good third in the GI Breeders' Cup Sprint Nov. 6 and was beaten a nose by Twirling Candy (Candy Ride {Arg}) in the GI Malibu S. to close the season. Somewhat disappointing when third to Euroears in the GII Palos Verdes S. at Santa Anita Jan. 22, he went back-to-back in the GII San Carlos H. Feb. 19 and in the GIII Count Fleet Sprint H. at Oaklawn Apr. 14. He found trouble on a pair of occasions when favored in the GII Churchill Downs S. May 7 and could do no better than sixth. He was returning to the synthetic track for the first time since taking the Ancient Title over this surface, but was the close second choice in the wagering to Amazombie (Northern Afleet).

Leaving nothing to chance, Joel Rosario put the pedal to the medal leaving the gate and had the lead as the field emerged from the seven-furlong chute and hooked up with the course proper. Allowed to bowl along through reasonably comfortable fractions of :22.29 and :44.95, he cut the corner smartly into the stretch and was moving away from his rivals late. Amazombie, favored off a controversial DQ to third in the GIII Los Angeles H. May 30, was caught out three wide, tried to make a run at the eventual winner at midstretch, but was ultimately outfinished for second by Camp Victory. "We got a good trip today and the horse got to express himself," commented winning trainer Jeff Bonde. "When he has his days he comes with a good one. This horse has the ability to go quick and still rally. He's got a very long stride, he's a big, long stretchy horse. He's not a typical sprinter type horse to look at. But he's very athletic and he has the heart of a warrior. He comes to fight every time." With an eye on a return trip to Churchill for this year's GI Breeders' Cup Sprint, Smiling Tiger could race in the GI Bing Crosby S. July 31 and/or the GI Pat O'Brien S. Aug. 28.

Flat Out flew in under the radar off a sixth-place finish in Churchill's GI Stephen Foster H. June 18, but stamped himself as one to watch for the second half of the season with a dazzling win here. The lightly campaigned 5-year-old scored in Oaklawn's Smarty Jones S. at three, and followed with a fourth-place finish in the GIII Southwest S. in February and a sixth behind Papa Clem (Smart Strike) in the GII Arkansas Derby in April. The bay finally returned to make one start at four, delivering in a \$40,000 optional claimer at Fair Grounds in December. Sidelined again, Flat Out resurfaced with a good second-place finish in the GIII Lone Star Park H. May 30 and was beaten by only 2 3/4 lengths in the aforementioned Foster. Not given much respect by the Belmont faithful here, Flat Out sat just off the pace in fifth through early fractions of :23.95 and :47.02. With Alex Solis aboard, he crept up four wide to challenge for command on the turn for home and hit the gas in the stretch to win for fun.

"He beat some good horses today," owner Jack Preston commented. "We won the [GI] Belmont S. with Victory Gallop; this is only the second time we've taken money from [Belmont Park] back to Texas. We've had faith in him the whole time; he's just had problems, one after the other. He's a super horse and we found out today how good he is." Trainer Charles "Scooter" Dickey's patience with Flat Out has paid off. "Today, he was laying perfect," he said of the trip. "He's just a super horse. He suffered from a couple of quarter-cracks. We gave him time, and waited on him, and today, he's paid us back. We'll talk it over and decide where we want to go. Our goal is to try and run in the Breeders' Cup."

About 11 minutes after Dominus emerged victorious in the GII Dwyer S., barnmate Kensei got the job done in the Salvator Mile, snapping a nine-race losing streak in the process. Rule held for third, while Morning Line weakened to fifth. "He broke sharp and the other horses went for the lead," commented winning rider Edgar Prado. "I was in the garden spot. I was very happy with my position early. He was running pretty easily around there and made his move when I started to ask him. He really dug in."

In a sad postscript, the 2009 July hero Big City Life (SAf) (Casey Tibbs {Ire}) had to be euthanized after sustaining a fractured leg after the line. Igugu's dam Zarinia, from the family of the great Zarkava (Ire) (Zamindar), was sold by Aga Khan Studs for €30,000 at the Goffs International Sale in 2004. She was scooped up by De Burgh/Farrington, and imported to Kia Ora Stud in Australia. Kia Ora offered Igugu at the Inglis Premiere yearling sale in 2009, where she sold for A\$65,000. She later sold to her current connections for R1 million at the Emperor's Palace Ready to Run Sale. Zarinia has 2-year-old and yearling half-brothers by Holy Roman Emperor (Ire).

When you get the combination of a Juddmonte homebred trained by Andre Fabre with a perfect record, there is a sense of inevitability, and **Mutual Trust** ticks all boxes entering this prize. Fabre is set apart from many of his peers by the ability to vastly step his runners up with each start, and this colt's win in the G3 Prix Paul de Moussac over course and distance June 12 suggested there was more to come. "He's been an improving horse," Khalid Abdullah's Racing Manager Teddy Grimthorpe told *PA Sport*. "He won his maiden, a conditions race, and then won the Group 3 at Chantilly nicely. He'll need to be progressive as it's a very competitive race, but he's definitely been going the right way." Improvement is required to deal with **Zoffany**, who had become something of a forgotten horse after his impressive success in last year's G1 Phoenix S. over six furlongs of the Curragh.

There is no better trainer than Aidan O'Brien at stretching a horse's speed over longer distances, and the colt proved he could see out a mile when narrowing the winning margin of Frankel (GB) (Galileo {Ire}) to 3/4 of a length in the G1 St James's Palace S. at Royal Ascot June 14. **Strong Suit**, who also went into the wilderness after showing top-class early summer juvenile form when winning Royal Ascot's G2 Coventry S. last term, bounced back at that meeting when annexing the June 15 G3 Jersey S. over seven furlongs, but needs to prove he is as effective over this trip. "We always reckoned that he was a top horse, but [Richard] Hughes felt that after the Coventry he never felt the same horse last year, and when we put him under the camera to check his wind, it was obvious that he was struggling to breathe," trainer Richard Hannon commented. "This looks a very competitive race, as you would expect of a Group 1, but he has won his Group 2 and Group 3, so this is the only route to take."

This fascinating renewal has added spice by the inclusion of **Brown Panther**, who is owned and bred by the renowned England footballer Michael Owen. The colt was deeply impressive when routing some progressive middle-distance sophomores in Royal Ascot's King George V S. last time June 16. "You go into a Royal Ascot handicap hoping you've got a stone up your sleeve and be there or thereabouts, and clearly we went in with a bit more, so we were thrilled," trainer Tom Dascombe said. "We didn't expect to win by six lengths, but he's a backward horse who is improving a lot, and will be a better 4-year-old. He shows a lot of speed and he does tend to put an awful lot into his races, but we're very happy with him." Brown Panther shares his 2004 Derby-winning sire with a clutch of hopefuls, including **Arrigo**, who lost out by a nose to stable companion **Mawingo** in the G3 Bavarian Classic at Munich May 22 before besting **Ametrin** and **Gereon** in Cologne's G2 Oppenheim-Union-Rennen last time June 13. Adrie de Vries, who opted to ride Mawingo of the Hirschberger quintet, explained his decision earlier this week. "We haven't had much rain and though it was very hard to decide, the ground could make the difference as this ground will be no problem for him," de Vries said. "I picked the horse who is the most straightforward and experienced, but it was a very hard choice. We are very aware of Brown Panther here." One from left field is the unbeaten **Waldpark**, who booked his slot here with a convincing defeat of **Sommernachtstraum** in the Listed Derby-Trial over 11 furlongs at Baden-Baden last time June 2.

It is going to be an interesting race, but Sahpresa looks very well and I am hopeful that she can win another Group 1 at Newmarket." Aidan O'Brien yesterday declared Michael Tabor's four-time Group 1 winner **Misty For Me (Ire)** (Galileo {Ire}), who could make a quick return after an impressive win in the G1 Pretty Polly S. last Saturday, while Jean-Claude Rouget could add further international flavor by running Bernard Barsi's 2010 G1 Prix de l'Opera heroine **Lily of the Valley (Fr)** (Galileo {Ire}).

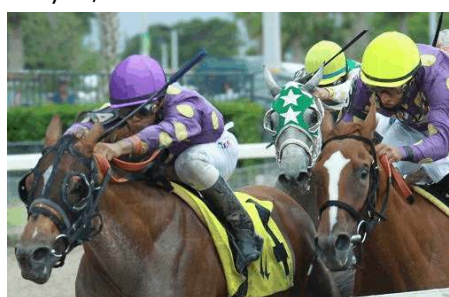

Canterbury Cancels Sunday, Monday Racing:

Edited Press Release

At 2:15 p.m. Saturday, Ramsey County Chief Judge Kathleen Gearin issued a ruling, denying Canterbury's request that the Minnesota Racing Commission (MRC) continue to operate during the state shutdown. With no regulatory body in place, Canterbury Park was forced to cancel racing programs for July 3- 4. Racing on July 1- 2 had already been canceled due to the shutdown. The MRC, which is fully funded by the racing industry, oversees gaming at the state's two racetracks. "I am extremely disappointed in Judge Gearin's interpretation and ruling," Canterbury Park President Randy Sampson said. "We will seek an expedited appeals process. This is potentially devastating to Minnesota's racing industry. This ruling puts the entire season in jeopardy." The MRC receives license fees from racetracks as well as all employees and horsemen. They also are paid in advance for expected expenses. No general fund dollars are used to operate the MRC. "The company has paid a license fee, the employees; the horsemen and the vendors have, too," Sampson said. "The expectation is that the MRC regulate our business. The MRC's expenses for July have already been paid." The yearly July 3 fireworks display traditionally attracts 12,000 viewers. With the shutdown, the fireworks display will not be held. "I appreciate the support and patience of the horsemen and our race fans," Sampson added. "The state shutdown did not need to impact the racing industry and its employees."

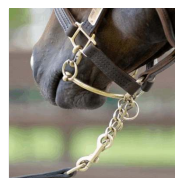

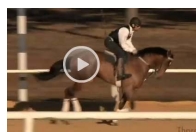
