Celebrity chef Bobby Flay's **Her Smile** (Include) gave her owner his first Grade I victory with a determined last-to-first rally in the GI Prioress S. at Belmont

Monday. "Yes, first Grade I!" said a jubilant Flay. "It was awesome, a great feeling." A 7-1 shot in a contentious group of six sophomore fillies, the Virginia-bred sat well off a hot pace before shooting through on the rail like a bottle rocket to out-kick Amy Tarrant's GII Forward Gal S. winner **Pomeroy's Pistol** (Pomeroy) and earn the half-length decision. Favored **Alienation** (Rock Hard Ten) was another 3 1/2 lengths back in third, and a neck in front of **Quantum Miss** (Smoke Glacken). "I think she's a versatile filly--obviously, the key

was the set-up," said trainer Todd Pletcher. "Today, we were talking :21 and :44 and change. We wanted to be back off the pace and make one run. We were able to save ground and come up the fence--it couldn't have worked out any better." Cont. p2

'DAN' EXPLODES ON TURF IN FIRECRACKER

Morton Fink's homebred **Wise Dan** (Wiseman's Ferry) relished his first taste of turf in the GII Firecracker H. at Churchill Downs yesterday, stalking and pouncing his way to a 14-1 upset in the Kentucky oval's traditional July 4 feature. The GIII Phoenix S. winner was 2 3/4 lengths clear of favored **Baryshnikov** (Empire Maker), who stuck his neck in front of **Strike Impact** (Smart Strike) to secure the place spot. Tom McCarthy's **MGISW General Quarters**

(Sky Mesa) faded to seventh in the field of 10. "Wow! He ran huge," beamed winning conditioner Charlie Lopresti. "[Jockey] Jon [Court] rode him perfectly and that's what this horse has needed all along. He had him sit back and just make one big run. I wanted that kind of a race. I didn't want him in a speed duel. He needed to learn how to relax, and he's grown up and matured."

Her Smile began her career at two for breeder William M. Backer with a 4-3-1-0 record, culminating in a victory in the restricted Donna Freyer S. at Parx Racing in November. She wintered at Tampa Bay Downs,

finishing fourth over the turf in the Feb. 12 Florida Oaks and a close-up third back on the main track in the Suncoast S. a month later. The dark bay ventured up to Aqueduct to be second in the GIII Comely S. Apr. 9, and was subsequently purchased by Flay and transferred to Todd Pletcher.

Her Smile failed to make an impact in her first try for the new connections, checking in 11th in the GI Kentucky Oaks under the Twin Spires May 6. But she came with a late run last time to be third in the one-mile GI Acorn S., contested over a muddy surface here on Belmont Stakes Day, June 11.

Reined in by pilot Javier Castellano after breaking from the rail, Her Smile bided her time four lengths behind Pomeroy's Pistol, who was traveling second-to-last, as **Roman Treasure** (Roman Ruler) and Quantum Miss slugged it out through an opening quarter in :21.78. The eventual winner came off the rail around the turn to pass a fast-fading **Our Year** (Grand Slam), and was a closer fifth behind the two pacesetters and Alienation, who were three-abreast at the head of the lane after posting a half in :44.55. Her Smile appeared full of run, but Javier Castellano had to locate the right seam to go through as the speed horses began to grow leg weary directly in front of her. The rail opened up around the eighth pole, and Her Smile spurred through the gap at the first sight of daylight to take command, holding the runner-up at bay late.

"It was a jockey's dream trip," said Castellano. "They were burning speed, and they backed up really quick to me at some point. I had to choose the best direction to take, and I'm glad it opened along the rail. It was a short cut--the best way to go. I got very lucky, and my filly went through a tiny hole and got it done. I knew if I could get through, I'd win the race."

Flay's Recipe for Grade I Success...

Her Smile, purchased for an undisclosed sum earlier this spring, rewarded her new owner, celebrity chef Bobby Flay, with his first victory at the Grade I level. With Classic aspirations in mind, the filly--who was runner-up in the Apr. 9 GIII Comely S.--was brought to Flay's attention by Jerry Brown's *Thoro-Graph* three weeks before the May 6 GI Kentucky Oaks. "When I initially bought her, my thought was initially GI Kentucky Oaks, GI Mother Goose S. and GI Alabama S.--I can tell you right now, the Priress was never in the plans," said Flay. "She was flying under the radar with the rest of the Oaks fillies, so we thought we might have a chance to buy her. We went back and forth while we were trying to buy her, and Bradley Weisbord did a fantastic job negotiating the deal and getting the horse from Maryland to [trainer] Todd [Pletcher]'s barn at Churchill."

As for the initial impression of the filly soon after her arrival at the Pletcher barn, Flay recalled, "Todd thought she was very sound, a very straightforward filly to train and he thought she would be better down the line."

Following a third place-finish in her latest start in the June 11 GI Acorn S., the team was faced with the task of selecting an ideal race for the filly. **Cont. p3**

“Just this morning, Todd and I were still trying to figure out whether she wanted to go shorter or longer,” admitted Flay. “The choice was to run her in the GII Delaware Oaks on Saturday or run in the Prioress. We were both really confused about which way to go with her and, if Todd is confused, then I’m *really* confused. Basically, Todd felt her sweet spot is seven furlongs, and it might be a good idea to throw her in this race and see how she runs, because the [GI] Test S. [Aug. 6] is in a month at Saratoga. He also felt her running style suited this race, so we decided to run here.”

Last season, Her Smile showed an affinity for a shorter trip, reeling off three straight victories, including the 6 1/2-furlong restricted Donna Freyer S. at Parx Racing Nov. 14. While having failed to visit the winner’s circle in five subsequent starts at a mile or further, the filly had hit the board in three of those outings. Despite the lack of check marks in the win column, Flay insisted his newest stable star is not a one-trick pony.

“I don’t think she’s a one-dimensional sprinter,” he said. “I think it was very helpful to us today that the horses up front went so quick, which obviously helped her. I think she might race at seven furlongs and a mile.”

Following successes like More Than Real (More than Ready)’s victory in last November’s GII Breeders’ Cup Juvenile Filly Turf and a score by Super Espresso (Medaglia d’Oro) in this spring’s GIII Allaire Dupont Distaff S., Flay indicated that Her Smile’s win marks the continued evolution of his program.

“I’ve been a lot more focused over the last few years,” Flay explained. “Basically, my plan is to buy fillies that can run and have good pedigrees. It’s great when you have a filly that can do both, which is not always the case. I haven’t spent more money, I’ve spent smarter money,” he added. “I’m buying fillies with great pedigrees, that even if they can’t run, they still will have residual value as a mare. Now that Her Smile is a Grade I winner, it makes her a lot more valuable as a mare.”

Flay continued, “I’m not trying to win the Kentucky Derby. My goal is to take a filly with a nice page that I can move up on the racetrack. I have tons of fun racing fillies and think there are so many possibilities with them. With the colts, there’s the jackpot of winning a race like the Kentucky Derby, but I think racing the fillies makes much more business sense.”--CBoss

Wise Dan earned his diploma by 15 1/4 lengths at Turfway last March in his second career start, cleared his first-level allowance condition sprinting in the slop at Churchill that May, and handled another step up the class ladder to annex the GIII Phoenix S. over the Keeneland Polytrack Oct. 8. He was a close-up sixth in the GI Breeders' Cup Sprint back here Nov. 6, and finished up his sophomore season with a one-mile allowance tally Nov. 25. The chestnut hadn't appeared to develop from three to four, however. He was fourth of five as the even-money choice in the GII Commonwealth S. at Keeneland Apr. 16, and faded to eighth after setting the pace in the 8 1/2-furlong GIII Alysheba S. on the GI Kentucky Oaks undercard May 6. Wise Dan was coming off a fourth-place effort in a seven-furlong \$100,000 optional claimer Jun. 10--two slots behind General Quarters.

Breaking from post 10, Wise Dan and Jon Court did not seem concerned with tucking in, and the homebred was perched three-wide behind Strike Impact and big longshot **Plutonium** (Monarchos) around the first turn. The pacesetters carved out splits of :23.81, :47.19 and 1:11.12 as Wise Dan continued to travel comfortably and in the clear. He asserted in midstretch, and strode out nicely while receiving some encouragement from Court to put away his rivals and cruise home an easy victor. **Cont. p5**

Of the decision to try Wise Dan on the sod, Lopresti explained, "Mr. Fink and I were talking about it and decided that, since he was nominated [to the Firecracker], we would go up and work him on the grass just to see what he would do. They had him coming home [in that four-furlong June 28 workout] in :23, and everyone was telling me he worked phenomenal. Jon told us he could have gone around the track again." Lopresti did not have definite immediate plans for Wise Dan's next start, but indicated that the Nov. 5 GI Breeders' Cup Mile over the Firecracker course-and-distance will be the gelding's long-term goal.

Owner Morton Fink, an octogenarian from Chicago, was an executive in the media, broadcast, cable and electronics industries, and was the founding CEO of Warner Home Video. He got into racing in 1971, teaming up with nine friends to claim a horse for \$10,000. In 1974, he formed the Carelaine Farm partnership with Roy Gottlieb, buying a sextet of yearlings at Keeneland September, and the two were in business together until dispersing in 1993. Fink acquired Wise Dan's dam Lisa Danielle for \$29,000 as a KEESEP yearling in 1995, and campaigned her to a moderate record of 7-1-0-1 and earnings of \$20,120.

Lisa Daniella has proven a bargain in the breeding shed, however. Wise Dan is the third stakes winner out of the mare, who also produced MGSW Successful Dan (Successful Appeal), a winner of \$354,455, and Our Royal Dancer (Roy), a stakes winner of \$195,070, in Fink's gold and brown colors. The 17-year-old, who has a yearling filly by War Chant, is Fink's only broodmare. Of his win in the Firecracker, the owner said, "This is one of the most exciting things that's happened to me. This makes up a little bit for getting disqualified from the [2010 GI] Clark [H. with Successful Dan]. He's a super horse."

Celtic Princess took two Group 1 events in her native Brazil in 2007 to earn Horse of the Year and champion 3-year-old filly honors, but did not race the following season. The homebred resurfaced for Eduardo Caramori at the end of 2009, and came up a neck short in the My Charmer S. at Turfway Park in her American debut. She didn't do much in subsequent runs for Caramori, however, failing to hit the board in her next five starts--most recently in the GIII Arlington Matron S. at Arlington in May of 2010. The bay was transferred to A.C. Avila after that, and she showed improved early speed to break through with an optional-claiming score at Santa Anita Dec. 30. Celtic Princess continued her forward progression coming off the bench last time, falling just a head short in the nine-furlong GI Gamely S. here May 30 after setting the pace. Made the betting public's choice this time on the turn-back, Celtic Princess broke very awkwardly, allowing Givine (Fr) (Blackdown {Fr}) to inherit pacesetting duties. The chalk recovered to press from the two path through splits of :23.77, :47.14 and 1:10.14, and came to even terms with the front-runner in upper stretch. Givine had no response for Celtic Princess from there, and the Brazilian champ had the race all to herself. MGISW Harmonious, making her first start since she was third in the GII La Canada S. Feb. 13, closed well from last, but never threatened the trophy-getter. "She's really good," said Rafael Bejarano after his heady display of damage control. "In the gate, I loaded last and the guy in the gate was holding her trying to keep her straight. But just then, the gate opened and she chewed the bit a little bit and threw her head. I didn't try to fight her, I just left her alone."

Avila pointed out that prominent Brazilian-based owner/breeder Jessica Coudelaria, who traveled to California for the race, had taken advantage of the Breeders' Cup open enrollment program, paying the \$25,000 nomination fee for Celtic Princess last month. He said possible next spots for the mare could be the GI John C. Mabee Aug. 14 at Del Mar or the GI Beverly D. S. at Arlington Aug. 13.

RACETRACK Round-Up

Delegator Heads Cup List...

Godolphin's **Delegator (GB)** (Dansili {GB}) yesterday featured among the 19 sprinters remaining for Saturday's G1 Darley July Cup at Newmarket. Having missed the G1 Golden Jubilee S. at Royal Ascot due to the rain-softened conditions, the 5-year-old pleased trainer Saeed bin Suroor in a final piece of serious work on the Newmarket gallops last week. "He missed Royal Ascot, because the ground was too soft for him, so we are just hoping for good ground at Newmarket," bin Suroor told *PA Sport*. "The horse is in good form, he's working well and we are very happy with him. It might not be the worst thing that he missed Ascot, because he has always run his best races when he has been fresh. Frankie [Dettori] will be on board."

One who is unlikely to line up is Michael Tabor's **Zoffany (Ire)** (Dansili {GB}), who looks set for a return to France following Sunday's runner-up finish in the G1 Prix Jean Prat at Chantilly. Trainer Aidan O'Brien's wife Anne-Marie tweeted yesterday, "Zoffany ran very well when just touched off in the Prix Jean Prat. He is likely to go to the [G1 Prix] Maurice de Gheest in Deauville next [Aug. 7]." Ballydoyle may still be represented by the G1 Irish 2000 Guineas third **Oracle (Ire)** (Danehill Dancer {Ire}). Khalifa Dasmal's 2010 G1 Prix Morny and G1 Middle Park S. winner **Dream Ahead** (Diktat {GB}) and the 2010 G1 Haydock Sprint Cup hero **Markab (GB)** (Green Desert) are other top-level performers to stand their ground, alongside the second, third, fourth and fifth, respectively, in the Golden Jubilee. They are **Monsieur Chevalier (Ire)** (Chevalier {Ire}), **Star Witness (Aus)** (Starcraft {NZ}), Sheikh Hamdan bin Rashid Al Maktoum's **Elzaam (Aus)** (Redoute's Choice {Aus}) and Khalid Abdullah's **Bated Breath (GB)** (Dansili {GB}). The most important defection was Simon Gibson's Golden Jubilee winner **Society Rock (Ire)** (Rock of Gibraltar {Ire}), who is suffering from a foot ailment. The current going on the July Course is good-to-firm, with watering likely.

Beach and Seville to Paris...

Aidan O'Brien's G1 Irish Derby winner **Treasure Beach (GB)** (Galileo {Ire}) and runner-up **Seville (Ger)** (Galileo {Ire}) are being aimed at the July 14 Grand Prix de Paris, it was revealed yesterday. Following their runs in last Sunday's Curragh Classic, the duo will renew rivalry in Longchamp's Bastille Day feature. Anne-Marie O'Brien tweeted yesterday, "Treasure Beach could possibly go to the Grand Prix de Paris with Seville at Longchamp in two weeks' time."

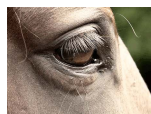


On to the Ballerina for Hilda's Passion...

MGSW Hilda's Passion (Canadian Frontier), sixth as the 1-4 favorite in Sunday's GIII Bed o'Roses H. at Belmont Park, came out of the race in good order and will now target the GI Ballerina S. at Saratoga Aug. 27. "The only explanation I would have is I don't think she liked the surface, which obviously was playing pretty slow," trainer Todd Pletcher told *Daily Racing Form*. "Besides that, we don't see any other physical explanation for it at this point. Just got to throw it out and regroup--point for the Ballerina and see what happens." The 4-year-old filly, owned by Starlight Partners and C.E. Glasscock, had been first or second in seven straight starts before the Bed o'Roses, with wins in the GII Raven Run S., GIII Hurricane Bertie S., GII Inside Information S. (where she set a track record of 1:20.45 for seven furlongs) and GII Vagrancy H. She was giving her six rivals from seven to 11 pounds Sunday. Overall, the bay sports a record of 13-7-2-0 with earnings of \$589,493.

One of the great divides between the European and American breeding industries has been the general lack of American interest in Danehill, a three-time champion sire in Britain and Ireland, in much the same way that Europeans have tended to ignore the two-time champion American sire A.P. Indy. The simple explanation is that Danehill is understandably perceived as a turf sire, whereas Europeans regard A.P. Indy principally as a source of excellence on dirt. **Cont. p9**

As many as 22 of Danehill's progeny became stakes winners in North America, with no fewer than 11 of them scoring at the highest level. However, all 11 gained their victories on turf. For the record, these 11 Grade I winners were Artiste Royal, Aussie Rules, Banks Hill, Cacique, Champs Elysees, Danish, Dress To Thrill, Intercontinental, Landseer, Light Jig and Luas Line.

When Mutual Trust stuck his head out to win the Prix Jean Prat two days ago, his win made Cacique the 13th son of Danehill to sire a Group 1 winner in the major Northern Hemisphere countries. In this case, it is unfortunately an example of unlucky 13, as this winner of the GI Manhattan H. and GI Man o'War S. was forced into retirement from the breeding shed by infertility.

Coincidentally, Cacique had contested the 2004 Jean Prat. He finished runner-up to the future Arc winner Bago, beaten three lengths, but closed the gap to half a length when the pair met again in the Grand Prix de Paris. Cacique later gained three group successes in France before being transferred to the U.S.

The future had looked bright for Cacique at the end of 2006 when he returned from his year's stay with Bobby Frankel to commence stallion duties alongside his brother Dansili at Banstead Manor Stud. Dansili had proved a revelation with his early crops, to the extent that his fee, which had been no higher than £12,500 in his first six seasons, had been raised to £30,000 for 2007. Dansili's achievements included finishing champion sire in France in 2006, thanks partly to the Group 1 victories of Rail Link and Passage of Time. He had also finished among the top 12 sires in Britain and Ireland for the first time in 2006, with only three crops on the track, and he'd also notched up his first Grade I success in the U.S., thanks to the demoted French 1000 Guineas winner Price Tag in the Matriarch S.

With Dansili beginning to be out of the financial reach of many of the breeders who had supported him in his early years, there was a definite opening for his younger brother. Adding to his attraction was the fact that their dam Hasili had become something of a legend by producing four consecutive Grade I winners, including the Breeders' Cup heroines Banks Hill and Intercontinental.

Cacique proved popular at a fee of £12,000. But then came the news that all stallion managers dread: a lot of Cacique's mares were failing to conceive. While his problems initially proved less serious than those affecting George Washington, another first-season son of Danehill, Cacique ended up with a first crop of 31 registered foals. **Cont. p10**

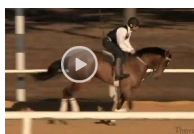

As a May foal from a family that tends to improve with age, Cacique never raced at two, and his first runners didn't make a huge impact at two in 2010. However, it is proving a very different story this year. Two of his sons performed with credit at Royal Ascot. First came Slumber, who followed up his third to Treasure Beach (Galileo {Ire}) and Nathaniel (Galileo {Ire}) in the G3 Chester Vase with third place, after trouble in running, in the G3 Tercentenary S. Then Census finished second of 18 behind the smart Brown Panther (Shirocco {Ger}) in the King George V S.

The next son of Cacique to underline his potential was Dominant, who had five lengths to spare at the end of the £150,000 Tattersalls Millions 3-Y-O Cup. The main standard-bearer for Cacique, though, has been his French son Mutual Trust. Steadily climbing the ladder, he has now won all four of his starts, including the G3 Prix Paul de Moussac and now the G1 Prix Jean Prat. He is in the care of Andre Fabre, the man who has trained all of Hasili's progeny. If Mutual Trust can maintain his rapid rate of progress, perhaps he will one day replace his sire at Banstead Manor.

Stallions who suffer fertility problems in their first season often improve as they mature. Sadly, the opposite has been the case with Cacique. He has only four foals in his second crop and his results in his third season convinced his connections that there was no point in persevering further--especially as there was a ready-made replacement waiting in the wings. This is Champs Elysees, the last of Hasili's Danehill foals. A triple Grade I winner in the U.S. and Canada, he suffered none of the problems that beset his older brother when he covered more than 100 mares in his first year in 2010.

Cacique had looked a good match for Mutual Trust's dam, the Lear Fan mare Posteritas, for several reasons. Danehill had done well with another mare by Lear Fan, notably siring Danetime, a very smart sprinter who became a Group 1 sire. Danehill had also sired the smart miler Stronghold (Timeform 120) from a half-sister to Posteritas' dam Imroz.

Another compelling pointer was that Dansili's 2006 Group 1 winner Passage of Time was sired by Dansili from another mare from Posteritas' family. Passage of Time's brother Father Time was to win the G2 King Edward VII S. in 2009. It will be interesting to follow the progress of Stipulate, a 2-year-old Dansili colt out of Indication, a half-sister to Stronghold. Sir Henry Cecil nominated him as one of six Dansili colts to keep an eye on when interviewed in the *Racing Post* before the Royal Ascot meeting.

Posteritas was a listed winner over 10 furlongs without showing nearly as much talent as her second dam All At Sea. This daughter of Riverman was one of the best fillies of her generation, winning the Prix du Moulin after finishing second in the Oaks, Nassau S. and Juddmonte International.

Mutual Trust's family was introduced to the Juddmonte studbook with the purchase of his fourth dam Lost Virtue for \$375,000 as a 9-year-old in 1986. The daughter of Cloudy Dawn had already been represented by two stakes winners, and another of her early foals, Quack A Doodledo, became the second dam of the top American filly Banshee Breeze.

Lost Virtue produced two notable daughters for Juddmonte. One was All At Sea and the other was Quandary, one of the last stakes winners by Blushing Groom. Quandary's first two foals were Clepsydra, the dam of Passage of Time, Father Time and Timepiece, and Double Crossed, the Lingfield Oaks Trial winner responsible for the top mile-and-a-quarter performer Twice Over.

Canterbury Horsemen to Get Aid During Shutdown:

Canterbury Park and the Minnesota Horsemen's Benevolent and Protective Association agreed to plans Monday that would give money intended for purses to horsemen during the track's forced closure due to a state shutdown, *Daily Racing Form* reports. "Horses affected by the cancelled dates will be eligible for payouts based upon the purse of the race," Tom Metzen Sr., CEO of Canterbury, said at Minnesota HPBA members' meeting. "Horses entered for cancelled non-stakes races that carried purses over \$18,000 will be eligible for a \$2,000 payment; races for purses between \$10,000 and \$18,000, a \$1,000 payment; and races with purses under \$10,000 would receive \$500 payments. To be eligible, the horse must make its next start at Canterbury Park after the track reopens." Canterbury has had to cancel four race dates--July 1-4--while the Minnesota state legislature works out a budget agreement. The Minnesota Horse Racing Commission is a state agency and therefore subject to the temporary shutdown. A decision on the cancellation of Thursday's card--the next scheduled--will come late Wednesday or early Thursday.
