**ELZAAM SET FOR CUP TEST**

Sheikh Hamdan bin Rashid Al Maktoum's **Elzaam (Aus)** (Redoute's Choice {Aus}) has been given the green light to contest tomorrow's G1 Darley July Cup at Newmarket after pleasing connections in his recent work. Fourth in the G1 Golden Jubilee S. on soft ground at Royal Ascot last time June 18, the Southern Hemisphere-bred had previously registered an impressive six-length win in Listed Carnarvon S. over this trip at Newbury May 13. That effort followed two seven-furlong outings when

third in the G3 Horris Hill S. at that track in October and fifth in the Listed European Free H. on the Rowley Mile course here Apr. 13. Connections have experimented with blinkers and a visor on those starts, but are getting back to basics now. "He seems very well and came out of the Ascot race in good order," trainer Roger Varian commented yesterday. "I've been very pleased with him over the past 10 days and I'm very much looking forward to running him. We were perhaps blunting the horse's assets going over seven furlongs on his last start as a juvenile and on his first run this year, as he seems like a horse who can travel very well off a fast six-furlong pace and show a good turn of foot. He's much happier with no headgear on and is a progressive horse who is thriving. The 3-year-olds have a good record, so we won't be shirking it on that basis." Cont. p7

**SHUMOOS LOOKING FOR GROUP TITLE**

★ "TDN Rising Star" ★ Shumoos (Distorted Humor) bids to build on her short-head second to Best Terms (GB) (Exceed and Excel {Aus}) in Royal Ascot's G2 Queen Mary S. June 15 in today's G2 Cherry Hinton S. at Newmarket. Her prior decisive defeat of Frederick Engels (GB) (Iceman {GB}) in a five-furlong Haydock maiden May 28 stamped her as a filly of the highest order and she is bred to be suited by this step up in trip. "That [Queen Mary] performance convinced us that she will stay the extra furlong here and Shumoos is the one to beat," trainer Brian Meehan commented. **Caledonia Lady** (Firebreak {GB}) was 100-1 in the Queen Mary, but outran those odds when a head behind Shumoos in third on that occasion, while **Inetrobil (Ire)** (Bertolini) was denied only by Samitar (GB) (Rock of Gibraltar {Ire}) in the June 17 G3 Albany S. at the Royal meeting. The re-opposing **Illaunglass (Ire)** (Red Clubs {Ire}) was 1 3/4 lengths behind in third. Inetrobil's conditioner Kevin Ryan told *PA Sport*, "She's come out of Ascot in absolutely great form. She has such a great temperament and is a pleasure to train. She's a fine filly and is big and scopey, so hopefully she'll improve for racing." Cont. field p6

Crystal Capella's career has been stop-start so far, but there was some serious forward momentum on display here as she tore apart the opposition to provide Sir Michael Stoute with a record eighth edition of this race. Having won the G2 Pride S. on the Rowley Mile here in October 2008, she returned to lower the colors of Dar Re Mi (GB) (Singspiel {Ire}) in the G3 Middleton S. at York the following May before training problems derailed her progress. Runner-up in the 2009 Pride, the homebred was having her only subsequent start when recording an authoritative 4 1/2-length success in the latest renewal of that contest on Champions' Day in October. Sent to Sha Tin for an ambitious tilt at the G1 Hong Kong Vase, she paid the price for being ridden too close to the pace and faded into 10th in that Dec. 12 contest before coming back to be fourth under a seven-pound penalty in the Listed Pinnacle S. at Haydock May 28. Racing with only one behind early as Buthelezi set the pace, she cruised between rivals and past Redwood with over a quarter mile remaining and required only hand riding to draw away in impressive style. "She's a good filly and, when she's spot-on like today, she is very good," Stoute commented. "After beating Dar Re Mi at York, she popped a splint and it kept getting bigger and bigger and then did the same thing to us last year. It is pretty sporting of the Rothschilds to keep her in training, but there was some petrol left in her. The [Aug. 18] G1 Yorkshire Oaks springs to mind, but I'm not quite sure where she would go in the interim." Frederick Engels came up against the subsequent G2 Norfolk S. hero Bapak Chinta (Speightstown) when second on debut at Hamilton May 13. Then met the G2 Queen Mary S. runner-up Shumoos (Distorted Humor) when again in the runner-up's spot at Haydock 15 days later. After getting off the mark in a quick time at Musselburgh June 4, the bay justified 9-4 favoritism in the Listed Windsor Forest S. at Royal Ascot June 14. He was stepping up from five furlongs for the first time here. Always traveling strongly in behind the early pace set by Bannock, he split that rival and Roman Soldier to lead passing the furlong pole en route to a convincing success. "I was pretty confident beforehand, as he worked with a good horse this week and I thought the others would have to run to a rating of 125 to beat him," trainer David Brown explained. "I told Eddie [Ahern] to sit on him as long as he could. He has so much class, he can run over five furlongs, six and further. I would think we'll go to the G2 Gimcrack S. [at York Aug. 19] or G1 Prix Morny [at Deauville Aug. 21]." Winning owner Sheikh Fahad added, "The future looks bright and we're pleased to have a horse of his calibre. Masked Marvel booked his ticket to the Epsom Derby with a win in the Listed Cockeyed Hat S. over 11 furlongs May 18 and was not disgraced when eighth in the June 4 "Blue Riband." Settled in second early by Jimmy Fortune, the bay was allowed to stride to the front with over a mile remaining, and after kicking clear inside the final quarter, held on from the closing Census. "He didn't handle the track very well at Epsom, but he came here in good order, and I told Jimmy if there was no pace, it was up to him," trainer John Gosden commented. "He did say that in the last furlong, the horse was looking at the stands and pulling himself up, but I like the way he galloped out to the line. ## Animal Kingdom Exits Surgery in Good Order...

Team Valor International's **Animal Kingdom** (Leroidesanimaux {Brz}), GI Kentucky Derby winner and GI Preakness S. runner-up, exited his June 30 surgery in good order, according to Barry Irwin, CEO of Team

Valor International. In the surgery performed by Dr. Dean Richardson, two screws were inserted to compress a hairline slab fracture. "The leg would have healed on its own," Dr. Richardson explained, from his headquarters at the University of Pennsylvania's New Bolton Center. "But by using screws, we will have a more

reliable, consistent time schedule for healing, and have given the horse his best chance to minimize any arthritis that might occur in the leg had we just let nature do its job." Animal Kingdom, who was returned to trainer Graham Motion's barn at Fair Hill training center last weekend, will have a couple of weeks of stall rest before he resumes walking and begins an exercise regime on a water treadmill for 30 days. Following 60 days of rehabilitation, he is expected to return to training after 90 days of inactivity. Animal Kingdom's initial diagnosis was comprised of two sites of concern. Dr. Richardson later discovered an additional hairline fracture in the site of the slab fracture of the left hock. "Dean said that in the final analysis, the extra hairline meant nothing, but he noted it just to show how important it is to have the use of the scan available, because until these surgeons go in there, nobody knows what they will find for sure," Motion said. "He says he expects no complications from this event."

## Rail Trip Targets Whitney...

**Rail Trip** (Jump Start), a close-up second in his seasonal debut in the June 5 Easy Goer S. at Belmont, will be targeted toward the Aug. 6 GI Whitney H. at Saratoga, according to trainer Richard Dutrow Jr.

Accompanied by jockey Ramon Dominguez, the bay worked six furlongs in 1:13.36 over Aqueduct's main track yesterday. "I could not have been any happier with his last race," Dutrow Jr. told *Daily Racing Form*. "I know that he finished second, but he ran a winning a race. It was what we wanted to see.

He got beat by a horse [Friend or Foe {Friends Lake}] that really likes Belmont, and our horse was just getting ready to run. It's not like we were sitting on the race for a month, he just got ready and I put him in." Winner of the 2009 GI Hollywood Gold Cup, the Jay Em Ess Stable runner failed to repeat by a half-length last season before being transferred to Dutrow on the East Coast. Last season's GII Californian S. and GII Mervyn Leroy H. winner was fifth in the GI JC Gold Cup in his first start for Dutrow before heading to the sidelines for three months while being treated for foot issues by Dr. Larry Bramlage at the Rood and Riddle Equine Hospital in Lexington, the 6-year-old's foot issues resurfaced, and Rail Trip was fitted with a protective plate to help protect the frog of his right front foot. "I wasn't aware when he came to us that he had a history with this foot," Dutrow told *DRF*. "[The frog] is where it starts, but it seems like it went a whole lot deeper, is what Bramlage explained to us. We came up with a design to help protect whatever went wrong. Since he's come back, every single day has been unbelievable for him." According to Dutrow, the horse will have his shoes removed and will walk the shed for a couple of days. "He's all ready to run, so I don't have to freak out about a missing a day," Dutrow added. "It's hot. Any horse on the grounds wouldn't mind having an extra day off. It might help, and it's certainly not going to hurt."

in November at Churchill Downs. Following the Sword Dancer, Teaks North might have another race before heading to Kentucky. Sallusto told *DRF* that he has had offers to race the horse overseas late in the year, including an invitation to the G1 Japan Cup, but prefers to remain stateside. "That would be a little too much," Sallusto told *DRF*. "It's very nice to be asked." Following the Breeders' Cup Turf, Teaks North will be rested prior to his title defense in the GI Gulfstream Park Turf H.

### Fairy on Course for Nassau...

Snow Fairy (Ire) (Intikhab) was the subject of an upbeat bulletin yesterday as she gears up for the G1 Nassau S. at Goodwood July 30. Only fourth in last Saturday's G1 Eclipse S., Cristina Patino's four-time Group 1 winner was one of 26 entries remaining in the 10-furlong contest yesterday. Patrick Cooper, the owner/breeder's racing manager, said, "The plan is for Snow Fairy to head to Goodwood for the Nassau S. We are delighted with how she has come out of her run in the Coral-Eclipse and we thought that she ran very well there, especially considering she had been off for seven months. We will probably keep her against her own sex in Europe for the time being and the plan is to head East with her once again later in the year."

**Sahpresa** returns to Newmarket, where she has enjoyed success in the last two renewals of the G1 Sun Chariot S. on the Rowley Mile across Devil's Dyke. She could hardly have been more impressive on her return when swooping on **★ "TDN Rising Star" ★** and subsequent G3 Prix de la Porte Maillot scorer Moonlight Cloud (GB) (Invincible Spirit {Ire}) at the end of the G3 Prix du Palais-Royal at Longchamp June 4 and trainer Rodolphe Collet is expecting another bold show. "She looks good and everything is well," he told *PA Sport*. "She knows the other track at Newmarket. It is an open race, but she has arrived there in good shape. I was really pleased with her run at Longchamp." France is also represented by **Lily of the Valley**, who upstaged stable companion Stacelita (Fr) (Monsun {Ger}) in the G1 Prix de l'Opera de Longchamp on Arc day, but who faded out of matters on her return when fifth in the G2 Prix Corrida at Saint-Cloud last time May 23. She drops markedly in trip, while **Maqaasid** is one who has still to prove the stamina for this mile despite her third in the May 1 G1 1000 Guineas at Newmarket. Only eighth in the G1 Poule d'Essai des Pouliches at Longchamp a fortnight later, the homebred missed the G1 Coronation S. at Royal Ascot due to the testing conditions. "She seems to have held her condition well and is in good form at home. John [Gosden] is very happy with her. 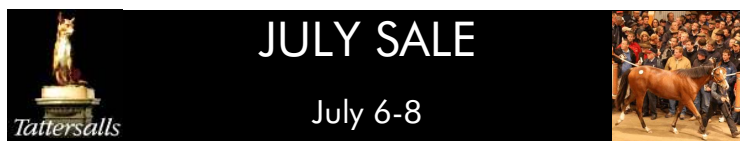

RED RANSOM FILLY TOPS DAY TWO

A duel between Greek agent Anani Antoniadias and fledgling breeder James Atkinson saw unraced 3-year-old **One Day In Spain (GB)** (Red Ransom) sell for 80,000gns on a low-key day two of Tattersalls' July Sale in Newmarket yesterday. Antoniadias, buying for Russian breeder Vartan Vartanov, secured the filly who appeared as the property of Darley from David Simcock's locally-based stable. Vartanov, who buys as Stud Farm 711, is set to send his purchase to Ireland before she is covered next year. "She'll go to Joe Rogers at Ballintry Stud and then next year is likely to be covered by either a Darley or Coolmore stallion," said Antoniadias. "She had great conformation and was the only one on my list today." Swiss-based Atkinson, who keeps his mares in Britain with the Rawding family at Manor House Farm Stud in Hertfordshire, had earlier paid 70,000gns for 3-year-old **Redskin Dancer (Ire)** (Namid {Ire}), a winner as a 2-year-old for trainer John Oxx in Ireland last year. Atkinson, with wife Marta Ortega, breeds as James Ortega Bloodstock, and is advised by the BBA's Martin Percival. "We got three mares in December from Northern Dancer bloodlines and were keen on this one as she is an outcross," said Atkinson. "We might put her into training."

The jumping buyers were out in force. Irish trainer Gordon Elliott was thwarted by New Zealand agent Guy Mulcaster in his bid to get 3-year-old **Above All (GB)** (Nayef) at 75,000gns. "He's going into training with Chris Waller in Sydney and is an honest horse that fitted our bill," said Mulcaster. The sale finishes today with sessions before and after racing.

## JACK'S IN THE DECK Comes Up Aces In Futurity S. G2

Two-year-old **JACK'S IN THE DECK**, from the second crop of graded stakes winner **LOVE OF MONEY**, broke his maiden in his second start by posting a dominating 4-length score in the historic \$150,000 Futurity S.-G2 at six furlongs on Sunday, July 3 at Belmont Park.

The Skeedattle Stable-owned runner has "been getting better as he's trained, and we all felt like going longer would be better for him," said winning conditioner Robin Graham. Out of the Partner's Hero mare Thracian, and closely related to multiple stakes winner Spirited Game, Jack's in the Deck was entered in the Futurity off a second-place finish in his debut at Delaware Park on May 25.

The son of Not For Love won four times in 10 starts, from 6 fur. to 1 1/8 mi., by an average margin of nearly 7 lengths, earning \$602,705.

Ronnie Sheffer hosted a group of friends at Churchill Downs July 4 to watch his very first racehorse run in her very first race. But he wasn't expecting very much from his 2-year-old **Georgie's Angel** (Bellamy Road) in the day's third race.



"People asked me how to bet and I said, 'I just hope she doesn't run backwards,'" Sheffer admitted yesterday. "I had no expectations. Zero. I looked up at the odds board at one point and she was 8-5. I thought, 'My God, what are these people thinking?' She ended up at 9-2, but at one point she was 8-

5. Somebody said to me, 'You must have unloaded.' But all I did was bet \$20 across the board."

Georgie's Angel, meanwhile, blithely unaware of her owner's reticence, promptly romped home by an eased down 6 1/4 lengths under jockey Jesus Castanon.

"I was in a state of shock," Sheffer recalled. "Hell, I expected her to finish dead last. I look up and she's pulling away. My wife was just going bonkers, screaming and yelling. So was the whole group of friends with me. I was so shocked, I couldn't yell. I couldn't believe it."

Sheffer is a native of Henderson, Kentucky, where he was the starting quarterback on Henderson City High School's 1955 state championship team. After serving in the army from 1960 to 1964, he attended law school at the University of Kentucky. A trial attorney for over 30 years now, Sheffer and his wife Anne have lived in Louisville since 1966. It was his law practice that originally got him involved with horseracing.

"I was the attorney for Ellis Park through two different owners," the 72-year-old explained. "That's how I first got involved years ago. I represented Ellis when Roger Kumar was there and then when Tinkham Veale took over. I used to argue for them before the Kentucky Racing Commission."

Sheffer also represented Jerry Bailey and other top jockeys in their efforts to wear advertising logos on their riding pants in 2004.

"I had no background in racing," he admitted. "I just happened to be in Kentucky and a lawyer and I got involved in representing some people in the horse business."

It wasn't until a year ago, however, that Sheffer decided to become a racehorse owner.

"I got the papers on this horse and I got a picture," Sheffer explained. "I had gotten to know [trainer] Todd Pletcher a little bit and I sent the picture and the papers to him. He said, 'Of course, I can't tell you for sure without seeing her, but just from the picture, she looks fine and the papers look fine. I think she's worth it.' I just took his word for it. I didn't know anything. I just took the plunge."

Of course, once he had the horse, Sheffer had the challenge of naming the filly. For that, he got an assist from Kelly Wietsma of Equisponse.

"Kelly is the one that brought the logo case to me--she was the agent for Jerry Bailey and those guys," Sheffer explained. "So I got to know her through that. She was excited because I was going to have a horse that Todd would train. She said, 'You know Bellamy Road was George Steinbrenner's favorite horse. You ought to name her Georgie's Baby or something like that.' My wife is an ordained minister and, instead of baby, we liked angel. That is how we came up with Georgie's Angel."

So, naturally, naming a horse after Steinbrenner, Sheffer is a big fan of the late owner's New York Yankees?

"Hell, no," the Kentuckian chuckled. "I'm a Red Sox fan. I go to Fenway Park for one game every year. This will be my 19th year in a row. I've already got my tickets--I'm going in August when they play the Yankees. But I'm not a Yankees hater like some people. I've got a real good friend in Owensboro, Kentucky, who is an uncle of [Yankees designated hitter] Jorge Posada. So I don't pull against the Yankees, except when they play the Red Sox. And I always like to see them play each other in the playoffs--it's a lot more fun."

Still, Sheffer wasn't above taking a good omen or two from the Boss, who would have been 81 last Monday--the same day Georgie's Angel made her debut.

"My wife was telling me Monday, 'There is no way we lose this race,'" he said. "The jockey was Jesus Castanon. She said, 'We've got Jesus riding an Angel.' Then she looked in the paper and she said, 'Oh my God. Here is another omen. It's George Steinbrenner's birthday today. There is no way we lose.'"

Owning a promising juvenile does have its drawbacks, however, as Sheffer soon learned.

"I go fly fishing once a year with Denny Crum, who used to be our basketball coach [at the University of Louisville]," Sheffer said. "He has a place out in Idaho. This year we have a flight to go out the 16th of July and we come back the next Saturday, the 23rd. But now Todd tells me that, if everything goes ok, he is going to try and get Georgie's Angel into the [July 22 GIII] Schuylerville. Now I've got to fly from Idaho on Thursday to Albany, so I can go to the races on that Friday. So I have to cut my fishing trip short. But I've always wanted to go to Saratoga, I've never been."

While Sheffer will be flying in from Idaho for the Schuylerville, his wife, a fellow Henderson City High School graduate, will be flying in from Louisville. Asked what his wife's reaction would be to a Saratoga stakes victory, Sheffer said, "My wife, like I said, is a minister. And she talks all the time. I think if we win the Schuylerville, she'll be speechless."

The Sheffer Racing Stable is currently batting 1.000. One horse. One start. One win. Sheffer likes the numbers.

"I don't think I'll get out of the business," he said. "I think I'll always want one. All we've got is one and I think one at a time might be the best way to do it."

Georgie's Angel has already attracted plenty of interest.

"You know, we've already had three people call--I'm shocked about this--to talk about wanting to buy her," Sheffer said.

Was he tempted to part with the promising youngster?

"No," he said. "Not right now. No. I'm not."

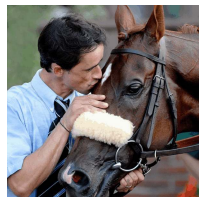

**FIGURES CAUSE CONCERN FOR AUTHORITIES**

Horse Racing Ireland yesterday reacted to the publishing of the latest six-month figures, which show a fall in the number of horses in training of 14 per cent. That drop coincided with a fall in on-course bookmaker betting of 10% and in race sponsorship by 8%. HRI's Chief Executive Brian Kavanagh said, "With prize money down by a further 5% (€1.1m) to date this year and 25% in total since 2008, a decline in entries and runners was inevitable. However, the 14% fall in the number of horses in training for the first six months is very worrying as this has a direct impact on employment levels throughout the country." After discussing the rise in bloodstock sales and Tote betting, Kavanagh added, "If there is a theme running through these figures, it is that international interest in Irish racing and breeding remains strong, but the domestic sector is under enormous pressure. The industry has suffered a series of cutbacks in recent years and urgently requires a long-term funding solution which is not dependent on Government grants."
